And as much as many of the BIA Indian employees wanted to bring about the desired changes the tribe wanted, the bureaucracy wouldn't allow it.

So what does the Government do to solve the "Tribal Problem?" It defunds the Bureau of Indian Affairs, freezes hiring and implements the "Peter Principal." Yet, all the policies, regulations and procedures remained in place with fewer and fewer staff capable of undertaking these responsibilities until the agency became dysfunctional, which wasn't much of a transition.

A great example of the power of the government bureaucracy is with Public Law 93-638 the Indian Self Determination and Education Act of 1975 which allowed the American Indian Tribes to contact and administer program services provided by the various Government agencies. To this day many of these agencies bureaucrats have refused to even consider this legislation.

And in many cases when an agencies is forced to comply with the 638 legislation the contract compliance regulation are made so complicated that the tribes are not able to

Virgil Wilbert Yazzie, 68, died on Aug. 31, 2020. He was a member of the Navajo Nation, part of the Bitter Water clan, and a fixture on the Pala reservation in northern San Diego County which he embraced as his home.

He was a father, a grandfather and a Vietnam War veteran. He was a "super smart man," Heather said, a jack of all trades. His family called him Yaz.

Five other relatives have died from COVID-19 in the past year, including Virgil's niece, 66year-old Jo Ann Smith. "On a community level, for our family, it's been horrible," Heather said. "Our elders are dving."

When Trayci Benitez was growing up, running a "quick" errand with her dad was never quick. Joe Benitez seemed to know everyone, and wherever they went people were reaching out to him, hugging him, stopping for a conversation.

"I don't know anybody who didn't like this man," Trayci said in January. "I'm sure there must be someone out there, but men, women, children, animals — they all loved him."

Joe, an elder and former chairman of the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians, died on December 26, 2020. He was 85 years old. He spent his life on the tribe's reservation, checkerboarded across and around Indio, and was dedicated to sovereignty and to helping Native Americans, Trayci said.

The Pandemic has done many things, the least 2. Does each family have? of which is to point out or underscore weaknesses or gaps in community's ability to react to and to mitigate disasters. On top of wildfires, floods and a variety of weather events, pestilence is no long prophetic.

Whether is be a broken heart, a failed exam or a 3. natural catastrophe, it is always beneficial to review the event and learn from it.

While it is best to clean the wound and bandage the boo-boo, it is also paramount to ask "how did this happen? and determine what factors might have been avoided.

Prevention Planning and Disaster Response Planning.

**Prevention Planning** is done in times of peace and quiet and therefore sometimes never gets done! It is too easily ignored and life has too many other deadlines, interruptions and distractions.

Some families and facilities have specific plans; others do not. It is key for a community to determine what plans exist where and if they coorshould be collected and stored in two sites as al entity? well as online.

Step One is to inventory each component of the aid/services across jurisdictional community. This includes storage sheds, irriga-boundaries? tion ditches and fields, abandoned buildings, etc. in addition to obvious physical structures. At minimum:

#### 1. Does each department and facility have a safety plan?

At minimum this would include;

- a. Name/contact information of the person in charge
- b. Evacuation map(s)/protocol
- c. Map of utility connections/on-off switches
- d. Records management disaster plan

- - a. emergency kits
  - b. evacuation plan and supplies
  - c. out-of-area contact numbers
- d. photocopy and "cloud copy" of essential papers and contact information
- What are your vulnerability sites:

  - b. electrical lines/transmission towers
  - c. cell towers
  - d. solar fields
  - e. nuclear plants
  - f. vegetation/forests

  - firefighters, electricians, plumbers, line-

  - f. blood donors

#### 6. What are the physical facilities in your community that can be utilized in an emergency?

This will vary widely, depending on the size and It is a good exercise for youth groups to experience. They get to know their community better, make positive contributions to the whole and take direct responsibility for their immediate family's disaster prevention.

#### **Disaster Response Planning**

Once all this information is collected and comdinate or compliment one another. These plans 2. Are they local, adjacent jurisdiction or region-piled, a list of gaps and weakness can be made and addressed. Many may be addressed internally.

> Others may require training or partnerships with outside agencies such as the Red Cross, FEMA, state disaster agencies, etc.

> When the compilation is made, it should be filed with each department or institution within the community. Needless to say, it should be updated periodically. You may want to share portions with regional emergency agencies.

> My personal feeling is that review of the document should be part of employee sign-off orientation. Youth groups also need to be included in the information dissemination; it is also a wonderful opportunity to train them as an auxiliary Disaster Response Team.

Pope Francis approved the twopage document that explained "God cannot bless sin." The Vatican's orthodoxy office on Monday, March 15, 2021 formally responded to a question about whether Catholic clergy have the authority to bless same-sex unions.

An accompanying article said any sexual activity outside of a marriage between a man and a woman contradicts God's design. The church may, however, bless individuals "with homosexual inclinations who manifest the will to live in fidelity to the revealed plans of God as proposed by church teaching."

What prompted the statement? In the document and article, the Vatican said it had received questions about blessing such unions sacramentally in recent years.

The Rev. James Martin, a prominent Catholic advocate of LGBT issues, said the statement was likely in response to conversations within the German church about celibacy, contraception, and homosexuality.

Pope Francis has also drawn questions with comments encouraging the Catholic Church to be more welcoming toward LGBT people.




