She is the first American Indian tribal member to serve as a Secretary in the 245-year history of the United States of America and for that she should be honored.

The U.S. Senate Approved Deb Haaland of Scandinavian and American Indian heritage as Secretary of the Department of the Interior earlier in the month.

A token for the minorities? Given all the blacks and Hispanics appointee it would appear as such. And in reality it doesn't matter only winning matters in the world of politics

In addition to race, gender or genders seem to be the order of the day as well as skin pigmentation for political appointment.

However, if one looks at the inter power circle it doesn't seem to be the case. It is pure and simply, Sal Alinsky's 8-Steps for a Socialist Government.

As a political appointee she is no longer an elected official and doesn't have the burden of running for re-election every two-years.

First and foremost one must understand that the Department of Interior is a bureaucracy and as such is run by bureaucrats that are resistant to change, incompetent and can't be fired.

Bureaucrats loyalist is with the civil service and the bureaucracy they have created and not with any political appointee. Examples: the Postal Service and Veterans Administration which are two of the most widely publicized. .

Many of us old timers remember back in the late 60's and early 70's when the Bureau of Indian Affairs begin hiring and promoting American Indian Tribal folks into positions of authority within the Agency.

Our expectations were similar to those shared today by many of the tribal leaders with regards to Secretary Haaland, that changes are coming!

And as much as many of the BIA Indian employees wanted to bring about the desired changes the tribe wanted, the bureaucracy wouldn't allow it.

So what does the Government do to solve the "Tribal Problem?" It defunds the Bureau of Indian Affairs, freezes hiring and implements the "Peter Principal." Yet, all the policies, regulations and procedures remained in place with fewer and fewer staff capable of undertaking these responsibilities until the agency became dysfunctional, which wasn't much of a transition.

A great example of the power of the government bureaucracy is with Public Law 93-638, the Indian Self Determination and Education Act of 1975 which allowed the American Indian Tribes to contact and administer program services provided by the various Government agencies. To this day many of these agencies bureaucrats have refused to even consider this legislation.

And in many cases when an agencies is forced to comply with the 638 legislation the contract compliance regulation are made so complicated that the tribes are not able to meet the requirements.

Over a half a century has passed since the 60's and although many of the tribes have made some progress toward self-governance they are still under the control of the Government.

Although I am not a great supporter of the Bureau of Indian Affairs it is my hope that Secretary Haaland will be able to gain adequate funding to conduct a full reorganization of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The other issue is to revisit the tribal land restriction and create "Economic Development Zones" in the tribal lands that will allow tax incentive for investors and manufacturing.

And although Secretary Haaland's Socialist political views and my personnel view differ, I will be the first one in line to support any and all efforts to better the economic, health and living conditions of our people.

Now, given the Socialist leaning administration will the Tribal Gaming industry be banned since gambling is forbidden by Socialism?

But until them I am willing to give her the benefit of the doubt. And all thing set aside, it s a historical moment for the American Indian people. Congratulations Secretary Haaland!

One Year of COVID-19: Life and Loss for Three Native American Families in Southern

"She always told me, 'If I could have 12 kids, I would,'" Cantu said.

Cabazon reservation: Joseph Benitez

When Trayci Benitez was growing up, running a "quick" errand with her dad was never quick. Joe Benitez seemed to know everyone, and wherever they went people were reaching out to him, hugging him, stopping for a conversation.

"I don't know anybody who didn't like this man," Trayci said in January. *"I'm sure there must be someone out there, but men, women, children, animals — they all loved him."*

Joe, an elder and former chairman of the Cabazon Band of Mission Indians, died on December 26, 2020. He was 85 years old. He spent his life on the tribe's reservation, checkerboarded across and around Indio, and was dedicated to sovereignty and to helping Native Americans, Trayci said.

Pala reservation: Virgil Yazzie

Heather Yazzie spent one long, strange night in a Temecula hospital bed last summer, losing sleep over her parents.

Her mom, Janice, was in a room down the hall; her dad, Virgil, in another. All three had coronavirus. Staff moved through the hallways in white suits and circular helmets. Once, a doctor paid a visit to Heather's room virtually, via an iPad on wheels.

Heather was released the next day, but her parents had to stay. *"Dad, I love you,"* she told Virgil before she left. *"You're gonna be okay."*

Heather touched his hand, promised she'd be back with his hearing aids and a phone charger. By the time she returned his condition had deteriorated. No family members, except for her mom, were allowed in the room.

"I was the last one to talk to him, where he could talk back," she said.

Virgil Wilbert Yazzie, 68, died on Aug. 31, 2020. He was a member of the Navajo Nation, part of the Bitter Water clan, and a fixture on the Pala reservation in northern San Diego County which he embraced as his home.

He was a father, a grandfather and a Vietnam War veteran. He was a "super smart man," Heather said, a jack of all trades. His family called him Yaz.

Five other relatives have died from COVID-19 in the past year, including Virgil's niece, 66-year-old Jo Ann Smith. *"On a community level, for our family, it's been horrible,"* Heather said. *"Our elders are dying."*

The virus raged through the rest of Heather's extended family that summer, and throughout the rest of the year. Her cousin and godmother, Jo Ann Smith, died from COVID-19 less than two weeks later.

Smith, also a member of the Pala tribe, was known by most as "Goo," a nickname with no concrete origin story, said one of her daughters, April Cantu.

Smith was multifaceted. On one hand, she was all about tough love and brutal honesty, a single parent who stressed the importance of working hard to get what you want, Cantu said. But Smith was also deeply maternal. For more than three decades she worked as the director of the Pala Youth Center, giving her time to kids on the reservation. She had four children and 10 grandchildren. After her own kids grew up, she fostered a 2-year-old boy for several years.

Ramos introduces California Education Act to review California Native American social studies standards

SACRAMENTO CA — An Assembly constitutional amendment and bill to strengthen and assert current instructional California Native American social science standards and frameworks was introduced today by Assembly-Member James C. Ramos (D-Highland).

The language in ACA 6, the California Indian Education Act, is also included in AB 1554 which Ramos introduced earlier this year and has since amended.

“California’s Native Americans resided in our state long before explorers, missionaries and settlers, yet little is acknowledged or even studied about that past or even present. Native people have been made invisible,” Ramos said. *“California history and social science standards were adopted in 1998. The framework which offers guidance on teaching those standards was adopted in 2016. It’s time to review whether those standards and frameworks still have merit and are sufficiently specific for developing what teachers teach in their classrooms.”*

Ramos, a member of the Serrano/Cahuilla tribe is a lifelong resident of the San Manuel Indian reservation and is the first California Native American elected to the legislature.

San Manuel Band of Mission Indians’ Chairman Ken Ramirez said, *“We are sponsoring this measure because our Native and non-Native students should have the same opportunity to learn the factual history of California’s indigenous peoples,”* said Chairman Ken Ramirez, San Manuel Band of Mission Indians. *“Today, more than ever, we must make this investment in education so all of the state’s citizens may determine a future as voters and community decision makers.”*

“Native Americans suffer from the stereotypes, biases and lack of knowledge about our culture and history,” said James Siva, Chairman of the California Nations Indian Gaming Association. *“Part of the remedy is education and understanding how tribal governments developed and their historical interaction with local, state, and federal governments.”*

Mary Levi, a Hopi tribal member and fourth grade teacher for more than 30 years, said, *“Context is key to understanding. For too many of my fellow Californians, Native American history and atrocities against them stopped centuries ago. Yet, forced sterilization of Native American women occurred as late as the 1970s. Today, health professionals are battling Native American wariness about the COVID-19 vaccine, not knowing that past history have led many in my community to view the medical community with skepticism.”*

Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians Chairman Kenneth Kahn said, *“Many Native American organizations, tribes, and individuals have stepped up to offer educational and cultural classes and events for our young people, but students could also benefit from learning in our schools about the history of California’s first people and the interactions between Native people and those groups that created our state’s history—good and bad.”*

A bipartisan group of more than 20 lawmakers have signed on to ACA 6 and AB 1554 as co-authors.

Sponsors of the bill are the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians and Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians. Supporters include the Soboba Band of Luiseno Indians, Barona Band of Mission Indians, Viejas Band of Kumeyaay Indians, Jamul Indian Village of California, Pala Band of Mission Indians, Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians, Wilton Rancheria, Yurok Tribe, Torres Martinez Desert Cahuilla Indians, California Nations Indian Gaming Association, California Tribal Business Alliance and Tribal Alliance of Sovereign Indian Nations.

Assembly-Member James Ramos proudly represents the 40th Assembly district which includes Highland, Loma Linda, Mentone, Rancho Cucamonga, Redlands, and San Bernardino. He is the first and only California Native American serving in the state’s legislature.

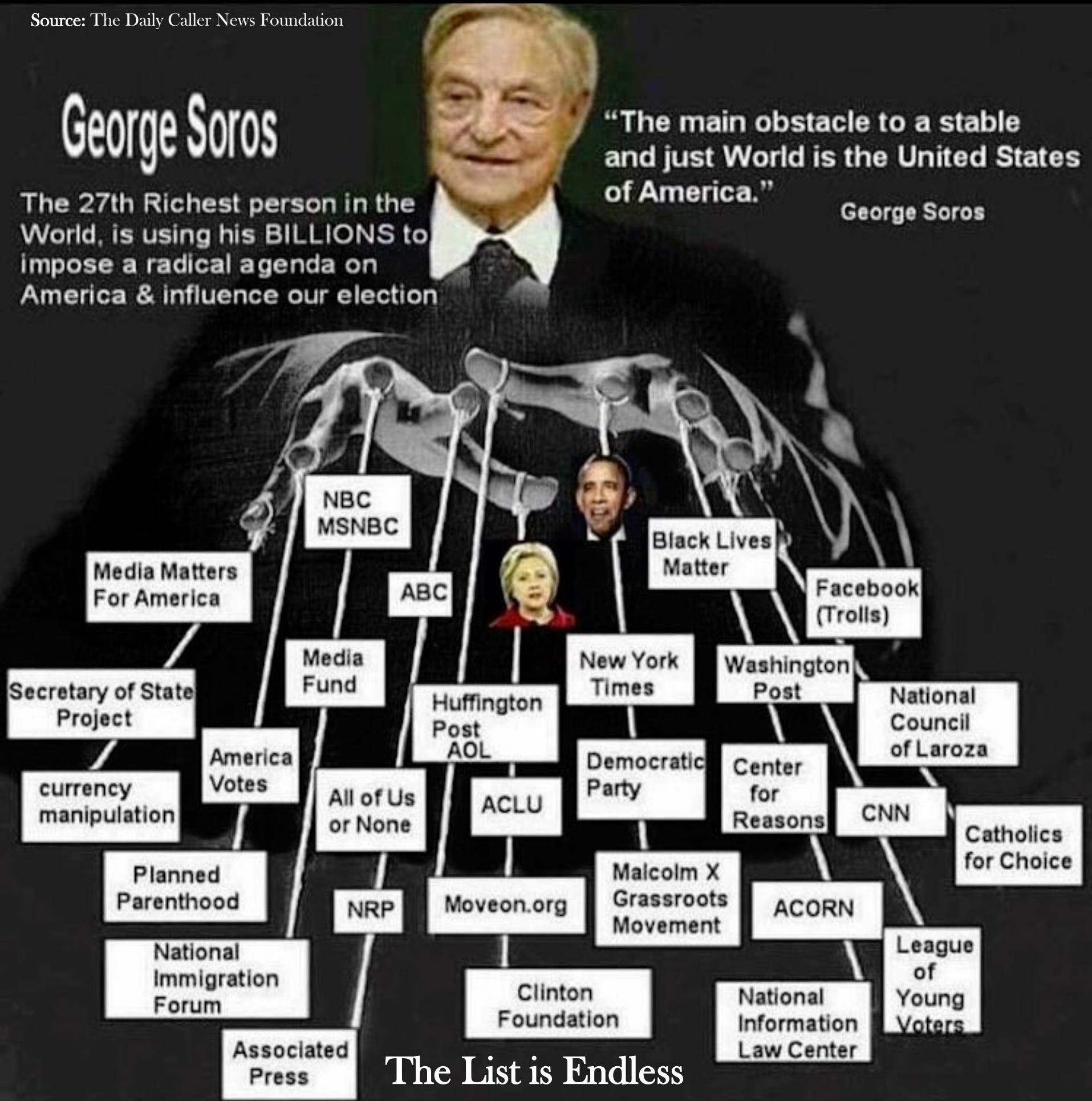

BOMBSHELL Details Of Ocasio-Cortez’s Deep Ties To George Soros EXPOSED - WOW, What a Revelation!!!

Incumbent Joseph Crowley whose footprint in the Democratic establishment led to speculation that he would succeed Nancy Pelosi as Democratic leader of the House – greatly outspent Ocasio-Cortez.

However, her strong online presence, thanks to the coverage of the Soros-linked digital media, she was able to gain traction and defeat Crowley in the primary.

She has won New York’s 14th congressional district handedly, given the district’s Democratic history.

After Ocasio-Cortez’s website, Ocasio2018.com, was first registered on May 3, 2017, it redirected to Ocasio-Cortez’s now-deleted page on BrandNewCongress.Org, according to an Internet archive captured June 29, 2017.

Brand New Congress is another organization, just like Justice Democrats, that aimed to get socialists elected to Congress in the 2018 mid-terms. It has close ties to Justice Democrats.

In a June 27, 2018 interview with Uygur on his YouTube channel “The Young Turks,” Ocasio-Cortez thanked Uygur and other media platforms for covering her before the primaries, which she says “in no small part” helped her win.

“I wouldn’t be running if it wasn’t for the support of Justice Democrats and Brand New Congress,” Ocasio-Cortez told Uygur.

“In fact it was, it was JD (Justice Democrats) and it was Brand New Congress that asked me to run in the first place.”



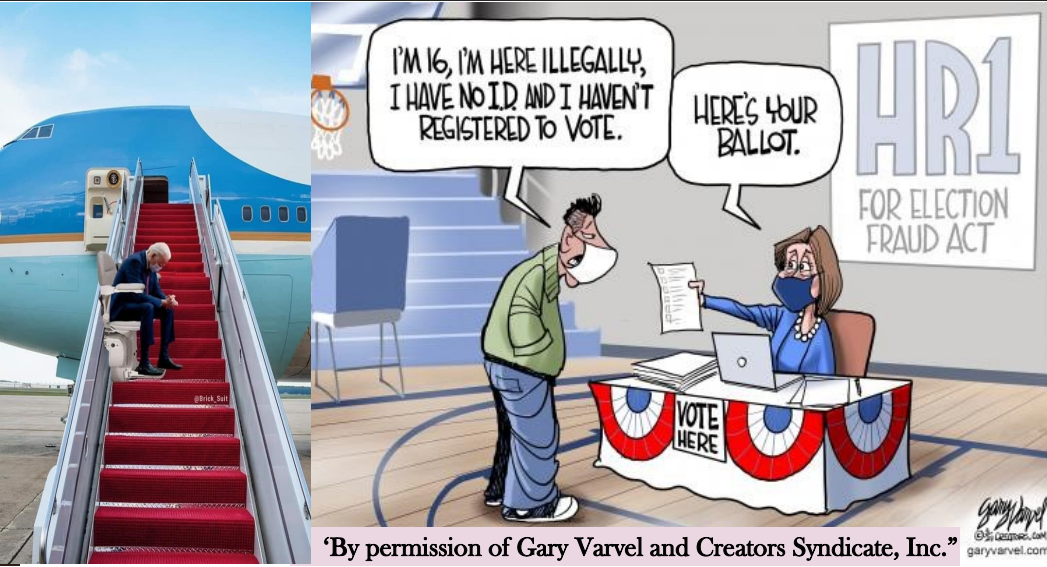
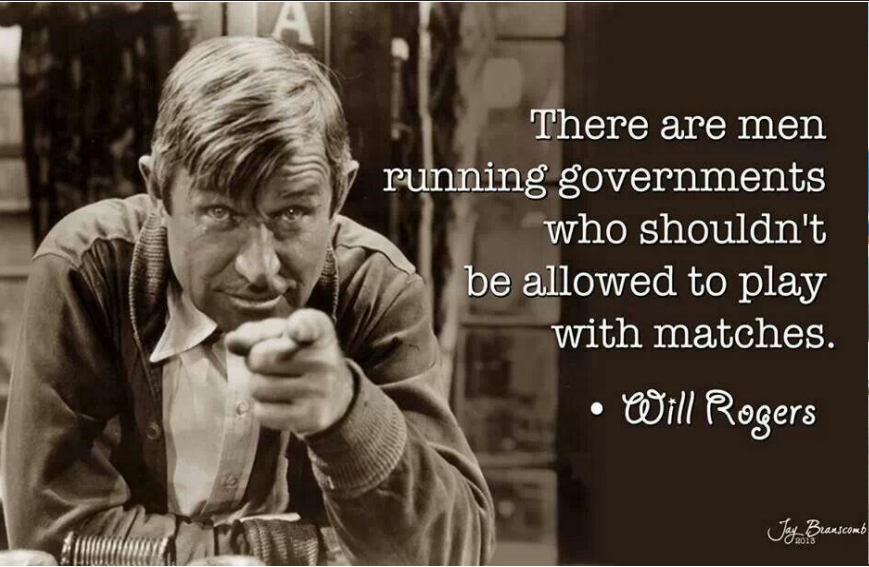
The Young Turks is a member of The Media Consortium – a network of far left media publications which includes Mother Jones, Democracy Now!, and dozens of other outlets, funded by Soros.

The Media Consortium is a Soros media empire that, according to Media Research Center (MRC), reaches nearly 300 million people a month.

“Soros funds nearly every major left-wing media source in the United States,” Media Research Center stated.

“Forty-five of those are financed through his support of the Media Consortium. That organization ‘is a network of the country’s leading, progressive, independent media outlets.’ The list is predictable – everything from AlterNet to the Young Turks.”

The Media Research Center report goes on to detail the progressive echo chamber Soros intentionally created with the Media Consortium with the intention of shaping public opinion.

What's Hidden in the Equality Act?

Family Policy Alliance President and CEO Craig DeRoche told the Daily Caller News Foundation that the Equality Act's sponsors so-named it to hide *"what's really lurking in it"* — which DeRoche called *"a broken proposal that sets us back decades when it comes to America's long and hard-fought march toward equal justice for all."*

"The bill would erase the concepts of male and female throughout the most basic parts of American life — sports, locker rooms, small businesses, classrooms, and even parent-child relationships in the home," DeRoche said. *"Most concerning of all, the Equality Act endangers children — from the very beginning of their lives by sanctioning abortion, to childhood by pushing oversexualized curriculum, and to adolescence by forcing children struggling with their bodies to transition away from their biological sex."*

- The Democratic Equality Act, which will most likely pass the House of Representatives Thursday, would impact abortion, marriage, family, gender, and more.
- H.R. 5 would amend the 1964 Civil Rights Act with the stated purpose of preventing *"discrimination on the basis of sex, gender identity, and sexual orientation."*
- Should it pass, the legislation would impact a variety of hot button topics including abortion, marriage, family, gender, sexuality, biological males in women's sports and locker rooms, and more.

Biological Men In Women's Spaces

Under the Equality Act, individuals who identify as another gender cannot be denied access to the locker room of their choice.

Religious Freedom

The legislation explicitly says that it would trump the Religious Freedom Restoration Act of 1993, meaning that Americans could not use the RFRA to challenge and defend against any provisions in the Equality Act that violated their religious freedoms.



Abortion

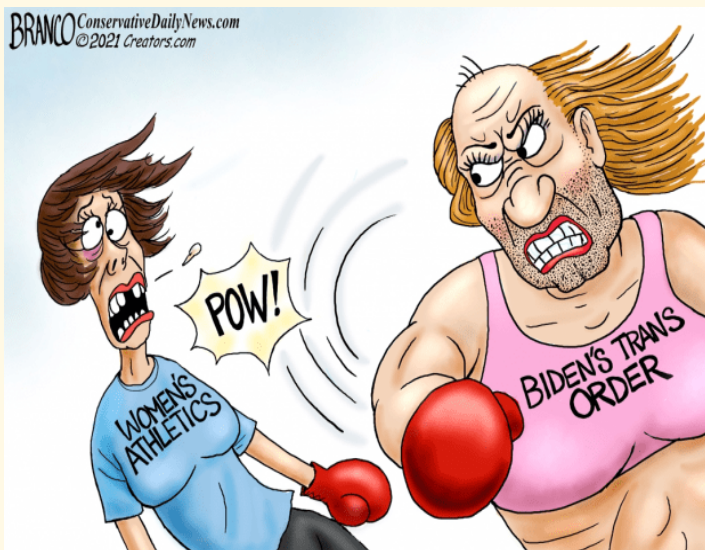
The Equality Act would redefine *"sex"* to include *"pregnancy, childbirth, or a related medical condition,"* according to the National Review. The publication noted that federal courts have already interpreted *"related medical condition"* to include abortion.

Those with *"a related medical condition shall not receive less favorable treatment than other physical conditions,"* according to the bill. The language would make it illegal, in effect, for doctors to refuse to perform abortions, according to National Review.

Controversy Over The Equality Act

Supporters of the legislation say it ensures that LGBTQ Americans share equal rights with their fellow citizens.

These supporters herald the Equality Act as legislation that only promotes love and equality.

A Recent Scientific Study Destroys Democrats 'Climate Change' Claims

The study was led by scientist Qinghua Ding of the University of California, Santa Barbara. Ding was also the lead author of a 2017 study that found natural fluctuations in the climate *"may be responsible for about 30-50 percent of the overall decline"* in sea ice.

Scientists published similar findings in 2017 regarding Antarctic sea ice. In that

study, British Antarctic Survey researcher John Turner found Antarctic sea ice decline recorded in 2016 was likely caused by a series of Southern Ocean storms, not global warming.

Up to half the observed decline in Arctic sea ice is likely the result of natural climate cycles, according to a new study out of the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL).

The study, published three years ago in 2018 found, that *"internal variability contributes to about 40-50% of observed multi-decadal decline in Arctic sea ice"* observed since the late 1970s, based on climate model simulations.

Natural climate cycles, like El Ninos and La Ninas, can speed up or negate Arctic sea ice retreat driven by man-made global warming, the study found.

October sea ice extent has shrunk 31,000 square miles per year.

"When natural variability is taken into account, Arctic sea ice loss is quite similar across models and observations," Po-Chedley said.

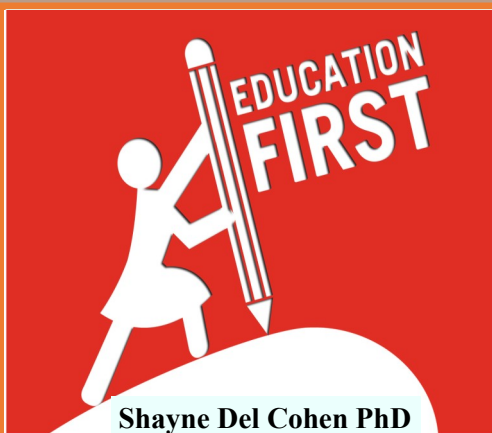

"A Tribal Disaster & Response Planning Guide"

The Pandemic has done many things, the least of which is to point out or underscore weaknesses or gaps in community's ability to react to and to mitigate disasters. On top of wildfires, floods and a variety of weather events, pestilence is no long prophetic.

Whether is be a broken heart, a failed exam or a natural catastrophe, it is always beneficial to review the event and learn from it.

While it is best to clean the wound and bandage the boo-boo, it is also paramount to ask "*how did this happen?*" and determine what factors might have been avoided.

This brings us to two discussion item: **Disaster Prevention Planning and Disaster Response Planning.**

Prevention Planning is done in times of peace and quiet and therefore sometimes never gets done! It is too easily ignored and life has too many other deadlines, interruptions and distractions.

Some families and facilities have specific plans; others do not. It is key for a community to determine what plans exist where and if they coordinate or compliment one another. These plans should be collected and stored in two sites as well as online.

Step One is to inventory each component of the community. This includes storage sheds, irrigation ditches and fields, abandoned buildings, etc. in addition to obvious physical structures. At minimum:

1. Does each department and facility have a safety plan?

At minimum this would include;

- Name/contact information of the person in charge
- Evacuation map(s)/protocol
- Map of utility connections/on-off switches
- Records management disaster plan

2. Does each family have ?

- emergency kits
- evacuation plan and supplies
- out-of-area contact numbers
- photocopy and "cloud copy" of essential papers and contact information

3. What are your vulnerability sites:

- roads
- electrical lines/transmission towers
- cell towers
- solar fields
- nuclear plants
- vegetation/forests

Step Two is to determine and inventory the physical and human resources within the community that can respond to emergencies and disasters.

This will vary widely, depending on the size and location of the is). Minimally:

Who are your first responders/contact information?

- Public Safety (fire/police)
- Medical
- Volunteer teams

2. Are they local, adjacent jurisdiction or regional entity?

3. Do they have the ability to provide mutual aid/services across jurisdictional boundaries?

4. If not, does the community wish to engage in a memorandum of agreement?

5. Who are the members of the community who hold special skills needed during disasters?

- firefighters, electricians, plumbers, line-men, etc.
- specialized equipment operators (fire truck, ambulance, backhoe, dump truck, etc.)
- first aid, trauma management/other counselors
- cooks, babysitters/caregivers
- records management and recovery
- blood donors

6. What are the physical facilities in your community that can be utilized in an emergency?

- water resources/reserves
- immediate shelter (list capacity)
- long-term shelter (list capacity)
- inoculation sites
- quarantine sites
- warehousing of supplies
- alternative school sites
- heavy equipment
- emergency power
- information systems

This inventory should be done by various sectors of the community for each will have their own perspective and perhaps (hopefully not) experience gained as a result of experiencing famine, flood, fire or pandemic.

It is a good exercise for youth groups to experience. They get to know their community better, make positive contributions to the whole and take direct responsibility for their immediate family's disaster prevention.

Disaster Response Planning

Once all this information is collected and compiled, a list of gaps and weakness can be made and addressed. Many may be addressed internally.

Others may require training or partnerships with outside agencies such as the Red Cross, FEMA, state disaster agencies, etc.

When the compilation is made, it should be filed with each department or institution within the community. Needless to say, it should be updated periodically. You may want to share portions with regional emergency agencies.

My personal feeling is that review of the document should be part of employee sign-off orientation. Youth groups also need to be included in the information dissemination; it is also a wonderful opportunity to train them as an auxiliary Disaster Response Team.

Vatican: No Gay Union Blessings

Pope Francis approved the two-page document that explained “*God cannot bless sin.*” The Vatican’s orthodoxy office on Monday, March 15, 2021 formally responded to a question about whether Catholic clergy have the authority to bless same-sex unions.

An accompanying article said any sexual activity outside of a marriage between a man and a woman contradicts God’s design. The church may, however, bless individuals “*with homosexual inclinations who manifest the will to live in fidelity to the revealed plans of God as proposed by church teaching.*”

What prompted the statement? In the document and article, the Vatican said it had received questions about blessing such unions sacramentally in recent years.

The Rev. James Martin, a prominent Catholic advocate of LGBT issues, said the statement was likely in response to conversations within the German church about celibacy, contraception, and homosexuality.

Pope Francis has also drawn questions with comments encouraging the Catholic Church to be more welcoming toward LGBT people.

The Vatican in 2019 backed Biblical doctrine on gender with a statement for Catholic educators titled, “*Male and Female He Created Them.*” Gender fluidity is “*often founded on nothing more than a confused concept of freedom in the realm of feelings and wants, or momentary desires provoked by emotional impulses and the will of the individual, as opposed to anything based on the truths of existence,*” the statement declared.



Meanwhile, a 2020 documentary about Pope Francis highlighted his support for legal, civil unions for homosexual couples.

Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco told the Associated Press he welcomed the bishops’ statement for its “*reaffirmation of the church’s care for those struggling with sexual identity issues.*” He reiterated the Catholic Church’s commitment to help them and all individuals live a life of virtue.

A recent statement from the chairmen of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops condemned President Joe Biden’s January 20, 2021 executive order on gender discrimination and equality as “*misguided.*”

“*It threatens to infringe the rights of people who recognize the truth of sexual difference or who uphold the institution of lifelong marriage between one man and one woman,*” the bishops wrote.
