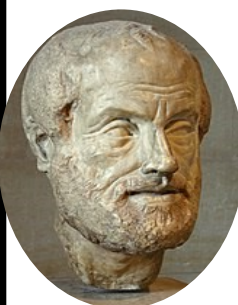
Regardless of their mindset and given my first Amendment rights granted by the U.S. Constitution I just can’t help myself from sharing my views.

However, they fail to understand that the Marxist do not adhere to the Constitution and the American Indian tribes will no longer exist.

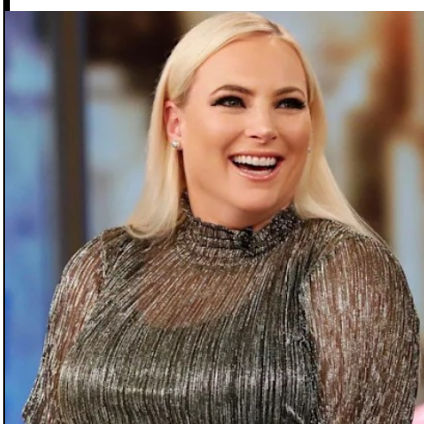
In short, during the Obama years the ruling class was becoming an oligarchy that ruled by exercising the powers of government and of incumbency in corporations as well as all manner of social institutions.

RINO Meghan McCain: on Afghanistan, calls Biden 'Jimmy Carter on acid'

"Even if you thought leaving Afghanistan was the right decision - this is a reckless, dangerous, blundering, and embarrassing withdrawal," she previously wrote.

McCain, the daughter of the late Sen. John McCain (RINO-Ariz.), also took aim at Democrats, invoking her father in tweets last week.

"Democrats like to wax poetic a lot about what my dad would have done and said (most of the time reinventing some weird fantasy of who he was)," McCain tweeted. *"Let me tell you one god damn thing - he would be raging in public and to President Biden about this withdrawal in Afghanistan. Raging."*

McCain previously expressed doubts about the withdrawal of U.S. troops from Afghanistan in April, saying on "The View" that she was *"very skeptical of what is going to happen if we withdraw."*

Biden has nominated her mother, Cindy McCain, to be the U.S. representative to the United Nations Agencies for Food and Agriculture, with her nomination recently sent to the Senate.

RINO Meghan McCain took to Twitter on Thursday to criticize President Biden over Afghanistan, slamming the president as "Jimmy Carter on acid."

"No press briefings from the Biden White House from the President or his staff," McCain tweeted. *"They're all on vacation. He is like Jimmy Carter on acid and he and his team will be remembered in history worse than him. Also anyone in the press want to jump in on criticism of him in hiding?"*

McCain, a "conservative" commentator who left her co-hosting spot on "The View" earlier this month, criticized Biden's decision to withdraw troops from Afghanistan last week.

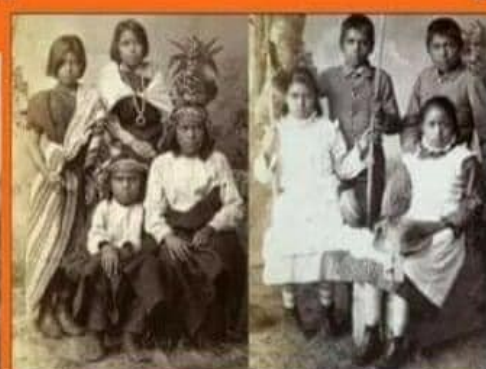
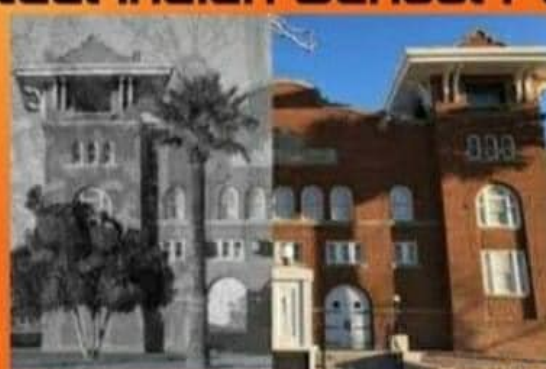

Tribal Membership: Blood Degree vs Tribal Heritage

First, the 25-cent preview of the origin of the Indian Blood Degree requirement for Tribal membership. To spare you from a lengthy dissertation on American Indian policies with regard to the Indian Blood Degree or Degree of Blood (DOB) requirement for Federal Recognition was set at one quarter degree of Indian blood.

What most non-American Indian don't know is that ever American Indian Tribal member has a United State Government legally issued certification of Degree of American Indian Blood or *"Pedigree Paper"* as most tribal people refer to them. American Indians are the only race of people in the world that have ever had to have proof of race by blood degree. **Think about that for a while.**

Russell Means, Co-founder of the American Indian Movement warned the American people in the mid-80's that they were to become the new Indians. And low and behold mandated shut down of American, wear a mask and now all the American people are being dictated to show proof of vaccination to simply but food.

A little off subject but, the American Indian people have over five centuries of experience under authoritarian rule with over two hundred year of it under the USA.

Back to some history of American tyranny over the American Indians. The one quarter degree of Indian blood was established by the U.S. Government for Federal recognition as an American Indian.

The original premise for the DOB was for the eventual termination of the American Indian people as part of the **"Termination of the American Indian Policy"** of the United States Government.

The DOB was adopted by a majority of the American Indian Tribes within the 48 State that existed at that time. Yet, many tribes refused to accept the government DOB requirement and maintained lineal descent policies for Tribal membership.

However, those Tribal members that didn't meet the government's one quarter DOB requirement were not eligible for government services because they were not a federally recognized Indian.

The **"Indian Termination Policy"** ended in 1975 with the passage of

Public Law 93-638, the Indian Self Determination and Education Act sponsored by President Richard M. Nixon.

This single legislation changed the political relationship between the American Indian Tribes and United States Government forever. The determination of Tribal membership being one of the most significant components.

The 638 legislation empowered the American Indian Tribes to not only determine their own tribal membership policies it provided for federal recognition of the members of the tribe regardless of DOB.

One would think that the tribes would automatically abandon the DOB requirement for Tribal membership allowing for more of their people to be federally recognized. And, a large number of tribe that didn't have lineal decent policies did in fact adopt them. But, surprisingly a great majority maintained their existing DOB policies and some even increased them. Some ever limiting the DOB to their specific tribe, which mathematically increases their end time.

It has been 46-years since the passage of P;L. 93-638 and the issue of tribal membership has reached a critical point for the political future of the American Indian Tribal Government including the Alaskan Natives as they were also included in the legislation even though they were 4-years new in 1975.

The Alaskan Native and Alaskan Corporations are facing the same tribal enrollment crisis as the American Indian Tribe in the lower 48 States.

Simple mathematic dictate that any blood degree as a requirement for Tribal membership will eventually lead to the termination of the tribe. In way of example, under the leadership of Wilma Mankiller the Cherokee Nation reset there membership criteria to any lineal descendent of a tribal member whose name was listed Dawes Rolls (1887) and met the 1/164 blood degree requirement. And although the immediate impact was a surge in tribal membership, but mathematically the tribe will eventually vanish.

However, knowing Wilma, she was most likely playing the political long

game and agreed to the 1/164 blood degree membership requirement thinking that once a significant number of the membership reached the point where their children were not eligible for enrollment they would have the vote to eliminate the blood degree requirement insuring that the Cherokee Nation lives as long as the Constitution of the United States of America.

Was she that forward thinking? You bet she was. When I first met her in the late 70's, she self identified herself to the left of Karl Marx, but after becoming Chief of the Cherokee Nation she became a consumed conservative.

However, if anyone knew Wilma Mankiller it would be Rachael Joseph from the Bishop Indian Reservation in California. Rachael and Wilma were very close and she introduced me to Wilma Mankiller.

Supporters for maintaining a degree of Indian blood for Tribal membership express many worthy and valued reasons, such as cultural, tribal identity and traditions but fail to recognize that blood quantum's were never part of any tribal culture.

Another problem with the DOB policies is the **"Disenrollment"** of tribal members. The reason given for the disenrollment or tribal member is that they don't meet the tribal membership requirements. In many cases of disenrollment many of the individual disenrolled have be recognized tribal member for years and in many cases they have served on the tribal councils.

Politics, factions and greed are at the root of a great majority off the tribal disenrollment's. A good example of this was the fiasco at the Santa Rosa Indian Reservation in central California a few year back where the Chairman had his father and sister disenrolled.

One of the biggest problems with the disenrollment process is that the tribal member that have been disenrolled have no recourse. The Supreme Court of the United State has ruled that the American Indian tribal members are not protected under the U.S. Constitution because of tribal sovereignty.

Frankly, the court got it wrong. The American Indian tribal members are American citizens and as such are

entitled to Constitutional protection.

One solution is the reemergence of kinship based enrollment policies, says Gabe Galanda, Round Valley Indian Tribes of California, an Indigenous rights lawyer who has done extensive work towards countering tribal disenrollment.

Lineal descent policies mean that anyone descended from an original tribal enrollee would be eligible for tribal citizenship, regardless of how much blood quantum they have.

"Lineal descendant supporters think about high memberships through the lens of existence as a resistance right. And so there's a desire to build up tribes' numbers and capacity in order to survive and perpetuate the tribe," said Elizabeth Rule, Chickasaw Nation, who is the director of the AT&T Center for Indigenous Politics and Policy.

"On the other side, those who defend blood quantum requirements also evoke this language of survival, and they look upon those blood quantum minimums as a way to preserve an already existing closed community that's very close and ... usually very culturally connected," she said.

"As Native people, it's not just about who we think we are. It's about our responsibility to our people in our communities, and to our homelands. And that has to be a core part of identity. Unfortunately, the way that federal policy has played out over the years, it has been intentionally set up to disconnect us and take us away from that," said La quen náay Liz Medicine Crow, Tlingit

Again, the American Indian Tribes and Alaskan Natives have had the authority to address the tribal membership policies for the past 46-years and many tribal leaders still lack the foresight, leadership and seventh generation vision which is negated by the implementation of Blood Quantum for tribal membership.

Some tribes have decided to keep blood quantum requirements, but lower the amount needed to enroll as the Cherokee Nation did a few years ago.

Senate approves paid California Native American Day for state court workers

SACRAMENTO CA — A measure to grant state Judicial Branch employees the first-ever paid state holiday on California Native American Day was approved today on a 32-0 bipartisan vote on the Senate floor.

Ramos, a member of the Serrano/Cahuilla tribe, is the first California Native American lawmaker elected in the state's 170-year history. He has been laboring to enact a California Native American Day since 1998.

"I was a San Manuel council member when I started working toward this goal with then-Assemblymember Joe Baca Sr. This is one more step forward in recognizing and building knowledge about the history, culture and contributions of California's Native Americans," Ramos said.

Judiciary employee holidays are set in the Code of Civil Procedure and a change requires legislation. Other state employees are covered in the Government Code. AB 855 would amend the Code of Civil Procedure to recognize California Native American Day as a judicial holiday to pro-

vide proper recognition for the state's First People and celebrate their history. It would not create an additional paid holiday for court personnel because Columbus Day would be exchanged for another state holiday, California Native American Day which is celebrated on the fourth Friday in September. Court personnel are currently the only state workers receiving the existing October 12 holiday as a paid day off.

The Judicial Council, a sponsor of the proposal, voted in January to seek authority to ensure California Native American Day is designated as a paid holiday for court employees.

"The Judicial Council is proud to sponsor AB 855, and thanks Assemblymember Ramos for authoring this historic bill. The judicial branch recognizes that access to justice is served by ensuring all Californians feel seen by the justice system, and this bill recognizes and celebrates the important contributions of Native Americans to this state. The Judicial Council extends its gratitude to the members of the Senate for their support of AB 855."

"Our state Judicial Council brought the idea for this bill forward, and I thank them for their initiative," Ramos added. *"For more than 20 years, I have worked to help create a day recognizing California's First People and their history. California has the greatest number of Native Americans residing within its boundaries, and it is fitting that we begin to expand our commemoration of this holiday."*

AB 855 is sponsored by the Judicial Council of California. It is also supported by the Morongo Band of Mission Indians, the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians, the Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation and the California Tribal Business Alliance.
