

And although the majority of the tribes lean towards a more liberal view they tend to practice a conseritive ideology with their policies, values and traditions.

In way of example, tribal membership at the very minimum is restricted to lineal decent. Tribalism and Collectivism are not synonymous. Other examples is that most tribal governments require a

photo ID to vote in any tribal election and on many reservation, villages and rancherias access is restricted by tribal security.

In addition, there are very few tribal members that do not support the second amendment of the Constitution, the right to bear arms. And yes, many tribes have restrictions as to where guns can be used, which is a reasonable policy.

Tribal sovereignty, Freedom of religion, Indian Child Welfare Act and tribal jurisdiction over tribal lands and self-governess are all concepts supported by the conservative ideology.

That said, the **American Indian Reporter** has not been able to publish a monthly printed copy of the newspaper for over a year due to the covid-19 pandemic which caused many of our advertisers and sponsors to cancel their subscriptions.
