U.S. Dept. of Commerce to Grant \$1 Billion to Tribe for broadband and internet infrastructure

Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo announced it is investing \$1 billion in grants for in broadband and high-speed internet infrastructure on tribal lands.

The Covid-19 pandemic exacerbated and shined a bright light on a number of issues in Indian Country, perhaps few more than the need for broadband connectivity on tribal lands.

The \$1 billion was an amount determined by Congress and comes from the Commerce Department's National Telecommunications and Information Administration, and was included in the Consolidated Appropriations Act.

Interior Secretary Deb Haaland, Laguna Pueblo, echoed those sentiments in comments through her official Twitter. Haaland said the government has a responsibility to help bridge the broadband gap in Indian Country.



"Kids shouldn't have to sit outside libraries, fast food places, or other public spaces to use the wi-fi for homework. We have a responsibility to build infrastructure that will fuel economic development, keep families safe, and ensure everyone has opportunities to succeed," Haaland wrote. *"These funds through @CommerceGov are a critical step toward our collective work to promote equity, ignite job creation, and make sure Indigenous voices and businesses aren't left behind in the #digitaldivide any longer."*

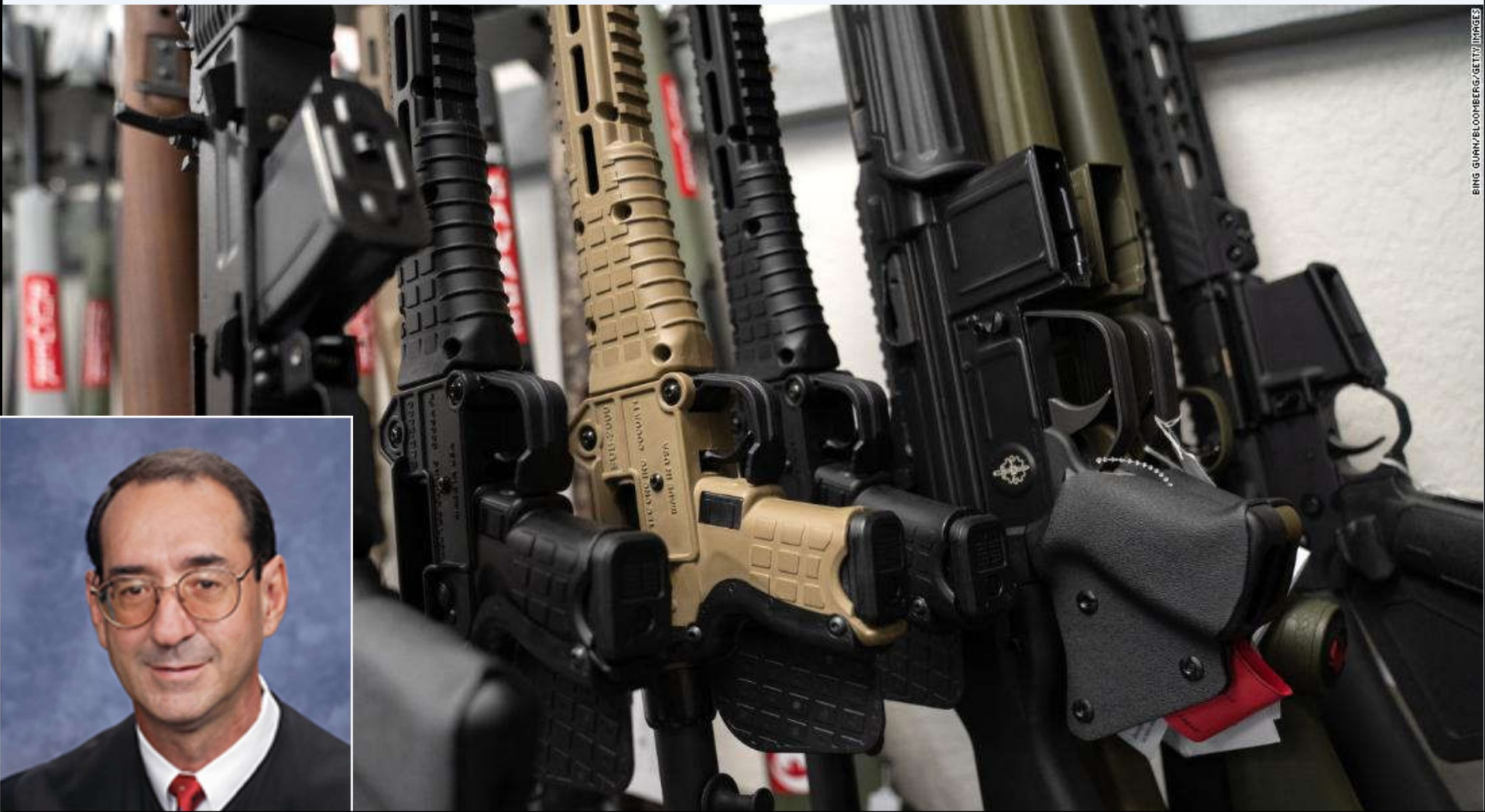

Federal judge Roger Benítez Ruled California's longtime ban on assault weapons; He likened the AR-15 to a Swiss Army knife.

"Judge Roger Benitez highlighted what all gun owners know: these types of restrictive gun laws don't make anyone safer and infringe on the rights of law-abiding Americans. We look forward to the positive impact this ruling will have on current and future Second Amendment cases."

Judge Roger Benitez was Born in Havana, Cuba in 1950 and nominated to the federal bench by George W. Bush in 2003, he overturned a law in California requiring background checks for anyone purchasing ammunition with a mammoth 120-page ruling in April of last year.

On Friday, June 4, 2021 US District Judge Roger Benitez of U.S. District Court in San Diego ruled that the California assault weapons ban violates the Second Amendment's right to bear arms and deprives the California citizens from owning assault-style weapons commonly allowed in other states. Benitez issued a permanent injunction Friday so the law cannot be enforced.

"Like the Swiss Army Knife, the popular AR-15 rifle is a perfect combination of home defense weapon and homeland defense equipment," Benitez said in the ruling. *"Firearms deemed as 'assault weapons' are fairly ordinary, popular, modern rifles."*

In his ruling, the judge also criticized the news media, writing, *"One is to be forgiven if one is persuaded by news media and others that the nation is awash with murderous AR-15 assault rifles. The facts, however, do not support this hyperbole, and facts matter."*

According to FBI data for 2019, the handgun was the most commonly used weapon in murders and accounted for 6,368 murders in 2019. Knives or cutting instruments accounted for 1,476 murders, rifles accounted for 364 murder victims, (*Less than 3.7 percent of the total murders*) and "firearms, type not stated" accounted for 3,281 victims, the data shows.

Benitez also struck down a California ban on high-capacity magazines in 2019. The case is scheduled to be reheard on June 22. In 2017, he had temporarily barred the law from taking effect in the first place.

Judge Benitez has previously ruled against other state firearm restrictions. Last year, he ruled California's ban on high-capacity magazines was unconstitutional.

He also struck down the state's restriction on remote purchases of gun ammunition.

California officials pledge to appeal ruling. The comparison of the AR-15 to a versatile pocket knife favored by campers drew sharp criticism from California officials including Gov. Gavin Newsom, who called the AR-15 a "weapon of war."

Newsom added: *"We're not backing down from this fight, and we'll continue pushing for common sense gun laws that will save lives."*

The ruling and injunction are stayed for 30 days, during which time the attorney general may appeal and seek a stay from the Court of Appeals.

California Attorney General Rob Bonta said he will be appealing the ruling. *"Today's decision is fundamentally flawed, and we will be appealing it,"* Bonta said in a news release.

Benitez may make another ruling on weapons soon: a case challenging California's ban on billy clubs and blackjacks is currently on his docket.

U.S. Supreme Court Votes 9-0, Tribal police may detain non-American Indians on Tribal highway

On June 1, 2021 the Supreme Court ruled 9-0 that tribal police may detain non-American Indians on highways running through their reservations, overturning the far-left U.S. Court of Appeals for the 9th Circuit that said such powers were out of bounds absent an "apparent crime." *"To deny a tribal police officer authority to search and detain for a reasonable time any person he or she believes may commit or has committed a crime would make it difficult for tribes to protect themselves against ongoing threats,"* Associate Justice Stephen Breyer wrote for the court.

The case stems from an interaction that took place in 2016. James Saylor, a highway safety officer for the Crow Police Department, approached a vehicle stopped on U.S. Route 212 in the Crow Indian Reservation in southern Montana. As Saylor began to question the driver, Joshua Cooley, he grew suspicious of his answers. Saylor noticed two semiautomatic rifles on the passenger seat of Cooley's truck.

As Cooley fished through his pocket for his driver's license, Saylor said Cooley's breathing became shallow and that he "stared straight forward." Saylor recognized the "thousand-yard" stare as a signal of potential violence and unholstered his pistol.

Saylor moved to the passenger side of the truck and opened the door, revealing a semiautomatic pistol near Cooley's hand. Saylor moved Cooley and a child who was also in the truck to his patrol car and, in the course of patting Cooley down and searching the vehicle, found methamphetamine and other drug paraphernalia. Cooley was ultimately charged with drug and firearm crimes.

Cooley sued to throw out the evidence, arguing Saylor acted outside his jurisdiction when he pulled his weapon – an act that amounted to a seizure of Cooley – and ordered him out of his truck.

But the Supreme Court held that an alternative standard suggested by the San Francisco-based U.S. Court of Appeals for the 9th Circuit was unworkable. The appeals court ruled that Saylor

first needed to determine if Cooley was Native American. Once a tribal officer establishes a suspect is not a Native American, his options are limited. To conduct a search, the appeals court found, Saylor would have needed to determine that Cooley was involved in an "obvious" or "apparent" crime.

"The first requirement, even if limited to asking a single question, would produce an incentive to lie," Breyer wrote. *"The second requirement that the violation of law be 'apparent' introduces a new standard into search and seizure law."*

The decision comes a year after the court found that the eastern half of Oklahoma is Native American territory. That suit concerned an appeal from a Native American who claimed his state rape conviction from 1997 should be overturned because Oklahoma lacked jurisdiction.

Associate Justice Samuel Alito wrote a one-paragraph concurring opinion in the case, saying he agreed with the majority insofar as its decision was limited to the notion that a non-Native American motorist could be stopped by a tribal officer and held for as long as *"reasonably necessary for a non-tribal officer to arrive on the scene."*

Tribal law disputes at the court often involve a complicated stew of federal law, treaties and powers recognized for other sovereign entities – a legal morass that underscores the knotty relationship the federal government has had with Indigenous tribes.

The cases can make for unusual splits, too. In last year's case, Associate Justice Neil Gorsuch, President Donald Trump's first nominee, sided with the court's liberals and wrote the majority opinion.

EDITORS NOTE: Although the Supreme Court ruling is a step in the right direction, tribal jurisdiction is still limited to a short timeframe as defined by Associate Justice Samuel Alito wrote in his one-paragraph concurring opinion in the case, saying he agreed with the majority insofar as its **decision was limited** to the notion that a non-

Native American motorist could be stopped by a tribal officer and held for as long as *"reasonably necessary for a non-tribal officer to arrive on the scene."*

Again, *"Limited"* is the key operative language as voiced by Associate Justice Samuel Alito in his statement as *"reasonably necessary."* His comments make it clear that the issue of jurisdiction is time sensitive to a specific issue and not to be misunderstood to imply any extended jurisdiction over non-American Indians.

The American Indian Tribal leaders must focus on tribal jurisdiction, water rights and tribal sovereignty and leave the "Woke" garbage to the BIA Indians.

Congress must allow the tribal governments full jurisdiction over all matters and people regardless of race on tribal lands.

The main reason congress has refused to allow the tribes jurisdiction over non-American Indians is based solely on **"Congressional Racism."**

Congressional leaders have refused to allow the American Indian Tribal Governments jurisdiction over non-American Indians because they believe that the tribes would not be fair with the non-tribal people. Without one ounce of proof of racism on the part of the American Indian Tribal Governments the U.S. congress has declared them racist.

Yet, these are the same hypocrite's that are promoting the Marxist-Socialist agenda, of woke, social justice, racial equality, critical race theory, project 1619, Cancel Culture, Black Lives Matter and Antifa just to name a few of their insanities. While the Republican's preach less government, individual right and local control except for the American Indian tribal Governments.

The American Indian people have been fighting oppression for hundreds of years. And although the oppression has been overwhelming, it has always been from Government Supremacy.

The Tribal Government are becoming more proactive with the local, state and national political arena but have yet to form a national political PAC. Hello!

Critical Race Theory & NY Times' "1619 Project" in classrooms Under Attack as Un-American

Fox News reports that a coalition of 20 state attorneys general called for the Biden administration to withdraw education proposals that they argue are meant to promote critical race theory and the New York Times' "1619 Project" in classrooms.

The group's criticism centered on recent proposals from the Department of Education that detail plans in April to provide grants under American History and Civics Education programs for a curriculum teaching diversity and the effects of "systemic" inequality.

The Biden regime has been force feeding racism down all of our throats all the while claiming they want "peace and unity", which is nothing more than lies and manipulation.

People need to stop listening to anyone who endorses critical race theory and start openly shutting down anyone and any corporations who endorse it. a necessary critique of systemic racism and the country's failings. However, a number of historians have questioned its accuracy, and critics argue it misrepresents the country's institutions.

"Congress made clear that the purpose of the programs is to advance a traditional understanding of American history, civics, and government," the letter added. *"The proposed priorities would do little to advance that goal and, based on the proposal's support for the '1619 Project,' would endorse teaching factually deficient history."*

The role of schools in examining systemic inequality has been a source of partisan discord in recent months. In January, President Biden issued an executive order disbanding the "1776 Commission," an initiative formed by former President Donald Trump as a response to the 1619 Project.

People need to start writing to their state officials to push for their state Attorney Generals to do the same and continue to put the pressure on to make it happen.

This is the way to but the brakes on government controlled racism and to start to heal communities at the state levels. When the federal government refuses to lead the way when it comes to real healing, real unity and accountability, then it must fall on each state to do what is right and prevent federal indoctrination.

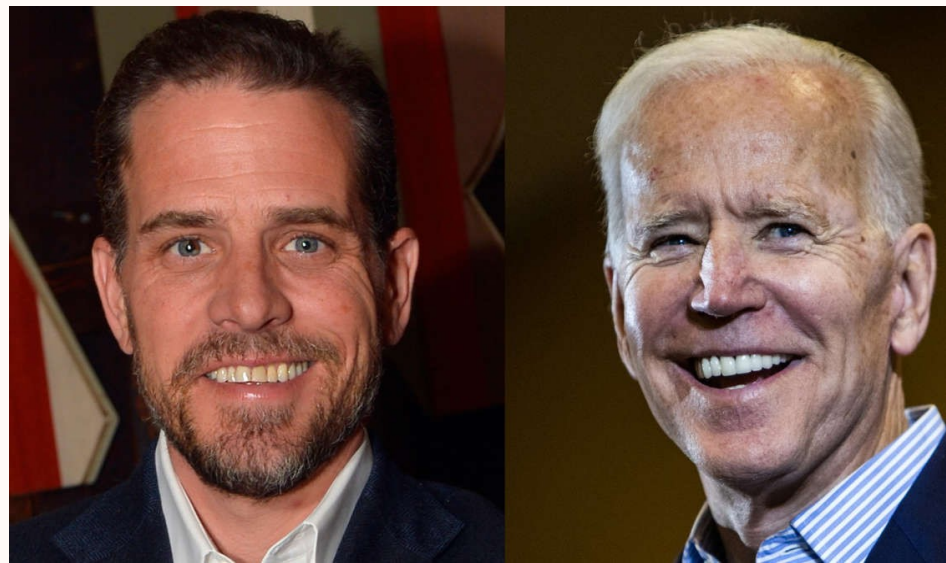
Some of the largest media outlets in the United States have not reported on Hunter Biden's repeated use of the N-word in text messages to his lawyer.

MSNBC, CNN, ABC, CBS, NBC, New York Times and Washington Post have all stayed silent on the matter, according to searches of their respective websites.

Biden's texts were revealed earlier this week by the *Daily Mail* and showed President Joe Biden's son casually using the racial slur in correspondence with his lawyer, George Mesires.

"How much money do I owe you?" Biden asked Mesires, who is white, in one exchange on Dec. 13, 2018, before adding, *"Because n**** you better not be charging me Hennessy rates."*

"I only love you because you're black," he wrote in another text, followed by *"true dat n*****"* in a conversation about unconditional love, which was followed by jokes about his penis.



"God loves unconditionally. Beau unconditional love is what I should loves you unconditionally. Children rely on and my kids aren't children are too young to understand what it George."

His use of the slur and the media's silence on the matter sparked the ire of conservative commentators, as well as the sons of former President Donald Trump.

Biden responded, *"OMG n**** did you just a fictional character from the imagination of the collective frightened and my dead brothers outlets for weeks straight,"* Donald

Trump Jr. told *Breitbart* when asked how the media would respond if he had used such a word.

"Don Lemon, Yamiche [Alcindor], all of the usual suspects would go nuts, but amazingly, they are 100% silent on this," he continued.

Eric Trump also slammed Biden over the texts, saying, *"Hunter Biden smokes crack, uses horrible racist rhetoric, and sells his father's influence around the world to enrich himself, yet he is praised by the media while writing books titled Beautiful Things,"* he added. *"Give me a break."*

Others echoed the former president's sons on social media, with some remarking that private citizens have been canceled for making similar remarks, yet the president's son gets a free pass. *(Joe Bidens' comments on June 2, 2021 seem to fit the family mindset with regards to Blacks, racist to the bone!)*

None of the main stream media has respond to the *Washington Examiner's* requests for comment.

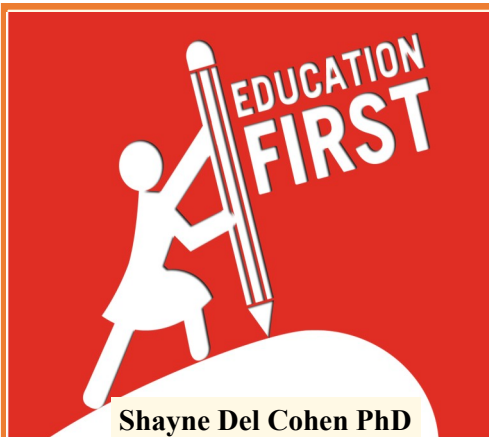

“Thoughts on innovation city. Part One”

While seemingly off point, I am including this article I wrote because it points out that another era is upon us, or in another analysis, history is about to repeat itself wherein a group of individuals perceive that the rules of the world they inhabit are not working for them - that they have a vision of how the world should be and any persons or laws in their way can be overrun. Corporate governance is not new; John Collier thought the only way for tribes to transit from the Age of Agriculture to the Industrial Age.

A Over 150 years ago, probably 10,000 or more persons tramped across Nevada territory, doing some irreparable ecological damage and, of course, altering traditional lifestyles of existing residents forever.

Some had visions of empire building; some were adventure seekers exploring new worlds and realities. Others were wanting to reinvent themselves with unknown opportunities. And there were the gold seekers.

Later came those sent by the Church; those sent by Eastern capital to create a human support system to Pacific markets and ports, and then the Railroads tying together the edges of the emerging empire.

Out of this chaotic parade of disparate goals and objectives, with assistance from Washington, D.C., a group (of men) created a Territory and then State of Nevada in 1864.

Over the next few years, the land base expanded and counties were

created. (Historical anomaly is the acquisition of some Clark County land from Arizona which was not legally consecrated until the 1970's).

The seventeen county state prospered, starved, prospered and starved in varying epochs. Government institutions were kept at a minimum for a small population. “Leaders” spent one hundred years decrying (and attacking) the devastated tribal communities as they developed a system of self governance, home rule and emergent economies.

Legislatively, politicians developed a stratified system to respond to the different realities of local government, often passing laws that distinguished between “populations over 400,000, for populations over 100,000 and those less than 100,000.”

The population/political center moved from Elko (*mining and agriculture*) to Reno (agriculture and gambling) to Las Vegas, a phenomena known throughout the world. (*What goes on in Vegas, doesn't always stay in Vegas*).

The face of Vegas was not mining or agriculture. The image of sin, glamour and glitz covering a nuclear age industry, was the precursor to the new realities of the Information Age and all the possibilities the electronic world brings - an eon away from the loquacious days of Paiutes at Warm Springs.

History is repeating itself. Enter the Innovation City.

exploring new worlds and realities. Here come others were wanting to reinvent themselves with unknown opportunities. And now, instead of gold, it is data, information and emergent technologies and electronic finance systems that spark imagination for some.

And this concept arrives with the proposal of its own governmental system, one that is oblivious to current form and constituency. Now it is “old” Nevadans who are experiencing what happened to the indigenous populations in the 1800's.

Storey County, the first site proposed for this “pioneer” effort, is unhappy that its economic base will be destroyed. Rural Nevada fears its bucolic serenity will be upset. The culture of Nevada will be dramatically changed if/when this new generation of “techie” entrepreneurs who's world view and interests are vastly different than those of the current residents.

Did the transition of lifestyle from living off the land to being in the bottom sectors of most USA statistics benefit Nevadans?

Probably no one wants to spend their time grubbing the land for something to eat. We love shopping and revel in the creature comforts of the times. The pandemic has caused many to reexamine values and goals. Emergent 21st technologies are prevalent throughout our lives and lifestyles. We have definitely arrived in the Age of Information from the Era of Agriculture and the Industrial Age.

Are our institutions and government systems able to deal with this in their present form? These academic, administrative and often surreal topics are now the subject of hot debate (in some circles).

Where there is hot air, there is smoke. Where there is smoke, there is fire. To suppress fire, one needs chemical suppressant or water.

With a nod to beef, where is the water?

The final historic irony is that, at present, the Pyramid Lake Tribe holds the key to the first proposed Innovation City in that water is to be transported by pipeline from CA/NW Nevada through the res to the new city.

My last column (**Nevada's Innovation City Part One**) might have seemed off-topic and a little out there. It wasn't.

It was putting a focus on a bubble of reality inhabited by a group of people with whom any of us are unfamiliar

Google, Tesla and Blockchain proposed to build a city in Nevada that would be a government unto itself, a concept not unknown to Native Americans, but not in keeping with those that have sworn fealty to the Nevada Constitution and the hundred year plus tradition of seventeen counties.

Frustration and impatience with the wheels of existing government, the vision of the three companies is rooted in their view of the world that has nothing to do with hands-on coral reefs, rainforests, expansive deserts, and other living organisms but envisions project management of those through algorithms and artificial intelligence.

For those of us born in the pre-internet world, there is a lot of vocabulary to learn: bitcoin, SNARK, cryptocurrency, IPFS, fault tolerance, polymorphic characteristics, smart contracts, cybersecurity, virtual reality, etc.

It is predicted that the vocabulary of mainframes, databases, network server, software operating systems and programming languages will

become archaic, a dead language. (*To tell the truth, I never learned Fortran, COBAL, etc.*)

If you are unfamiliar with these terms, do not fret, but pay attention.

This world is predicated upon what is termed to be more revolutionary than the world wide web, blockchains.

Blockchains are envisioned to enable frictionless value exchanges, a new flow of value, a technology that “*permanently records transactions in a way that cannot be later erased but can only be sequentially updated, in essence keeping a never ending historical trail.*”...Blockchains will challenge government and centrally controlled ways of enforcing transactions. For example, why pay an escrow to clear a title insurance if the blockchain can automatically check it in an irrefutable way?”

Blockchain is defined as a compromise between capitalism and public control by its proponents. It could be a major economic shift, bringing/engendering new cultures and new opportunities, moving across enterprises. It will demand lifelong learning and a new process of technology.

(For continued introduction to this phenomena, I suggest “**The Business Blockchain**” by William Mougayar a “short 169 page” essay of explanation.) So what is the implication for tribal communities?

For those still waiting for reliable broadband or internet access, it is another car racing by on the highway while you're hitchhiking.

On another level, just like the Internet, it will smash many former barriers experienced by marginalized groups. It will permeate the economy at all levels, introduce new players, threaten power structures and force change on organizations and institutions that want to survive. Will it be transformational and issue in the next era of social democracy?

The sacred heritage for tribal leaders is to ensure the safety and survival of the immediate community and/or the extended nation. Sometimes the tasks were meted out among a group or council of leaders; sometimes it resided in a single individual.

Thus the question comes, do you have members of the community that have the skills and knowledge to deal with the predicted tsunami?

As frequently opined in these columns, for every “traditional job” eliminated (ie telephone receptionist), usually two new jobs are created: a programmer and a trouble shooter/fixer. Depending on the volume of “work”, sometimes they can be combined into one.

Does your housing or maintenance teams have the ability to create structures with 3-D technology?

Those that can create and maintain a supply chain or policing capability with drones? Those that can correct mistakes/inconsistencies in maps and like records before they become entrenched in a blockchain?

But for every “one,” a community needs a backup, another person with similar knowledge and skills. Human relations professionals have set a standard of 4.3 personnel for any job function, the minimum essential for 24 hour coverage.

COVID killed some jobs and created new ones. Educational institutions pivoted from traditional, on-campus models to distance learning. Large corporations like Google are developing partnership training models that can reach the most remote communities. One does not need to be geographically adjacent to any urban area to access this new world.

Some of these changes will go away with the “*return to normalcy*”. Others will become hybrids as individuals and institutions find their comfort levels with one another.

So again, do you have or are you creating the environment/opportunity for youth and others to grow into these roles? (*And how will you deal with those of us with minimal “techie skills?”*)

On "The Rubin Report," Glenn Loury, professor of economics at Brown University, joined BlazeTV host Dave Rubin to talk about why it's controversial for a black man to be against diversity and inclusion training, affirmative action, and reparations.
