The primary purpose of the Indian boarding school was for the transformation or reeducation of the American Indians to simulate into the dominate society. In other words a one cultural order in America.



U.S. Dept. of Commerce to Grant \$1 Billion to Tribe for broadband and internet infrastructure

Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo announced it is investing \$1 billion in grants for in broadband and high-speed internet infrastructure on tribal lands.

The Covid-19 pandemic exacerbated and shined a bright light on a number of issues in Indian Country, perhaps few more than the need for broadband connectivity on tribal

The \$1 billion was an amount determined by Congress and comes from the Commerce Department's National Telecommunications and Information Administration, and was included in the Consolidated Appropriations Act.

Interior Secretary Deb Haaland, Laguna Pueblo, echoed those sentiments in comments through her official Twitter. Haaland said the government has a responsibility to help bridge the broadband gap in Indian Country.



"Kids shouldn't have to sit outside libraries, fast food places, or other public spaces to use the wi-fi for homework. We have a responsibility to build infrastructure that will fuel economic development, keep families safe, and ensure everyone has opportunities to succeed," Haaland wrote. "These funds through @CommerceGov are a critical step toward our collective work to promote equity, ignite job creation, and make sure Indigenous voices and businesses aren't left behind in the #digitaldivide any longer."



Some of the largest media outlets in the United States have not reported on Hunter Biden's repeated use of the **N-word** in text messages to his lawyer.

MSNBC, CNN, ABC, CBS, NBC, New York Times and Washington Post have all stayed silent on the matter, according to searches of their respective websites.

Eric Trump also slammed Biden over the texts, saying. "Hunter Biden smokes crack, uses horrible racist rhetoric, and sells his father's influence around the world to enrich himself, yet he is praised by the media while writing books titled Beautiful Things," he added. "Give me a break."

Others echoed the former president's sons on social media, with some remarking that private citizens have been canceled for making similar remarks, yet the president's son gets a free pass. (Joe Bidens' comments on June 2, 2021 seem to fit the family mindset with regards to Blacks, racist to the bone!)

'If we fall for this, we are FOOLS': Glenn Loury warns Dems are 'buying black votes by waving a bloody shirt of racism'

On "The Rubin Report," Glenn Loury, professor of economics at Brown University, joined BlazeTV host Dave Rubin to talk about why it's controversial for a black man to be against diversity and inclusion training, affirmative action, and reparations.

Glenn also shared his thoughts on the narrative of systemic racism and racial disparities, why it's wrong, and how the Democratic Party pushes lies to get the support of black voters.

In this clip, Glenn shares his thoughts on how Democrats have fanned the flames of the racism bogeyman in a cynical attempt to get more of the black vote.

"They're buying black votes by waving a bloody shirt of racism, that's what they're doing." Glenn said of the Democratic Party. "If we fall for this, we are fools. We're being led around with a ring through our noses. They show nothing but contempt for black peo-

Glenn argued that if black people in this country want to start eliminating disparities, they need to stop using the issue of slavery to play the victim as that mentality only encourages society to lower the bar for black America.

"The racial conflict coming out of [the issue of] slavery threatens the existence of the republic," Glenn said. "Three hundred thousand people in a country of 3 million were slaughtered on the battlefields of the civil war. The consequence of which was the emancipation of the African slaves. Here we are now, 150 years later and the descendants of those slaves are citizens of the freest, richest and most powerful republic in the history of the world."

Glenn also explained why he believes former President Barack Obama missed many opportunities to engage the country in an honest conversation about race, and called out former first lady Michelle Obama for saying that she fears for the safety of her daughters.






