


Rittenhouse Acquitted By Jury, Not Guilty

Interior Sec. Haaland Orders Changes of Derogatory Indian Names of Sites



Secretary of the Interior Deb Haaland formally declared "squaw" to be a derogatory term and ordered a task force to find replacement names for valleys, lakes, creeks and other sites on federal lands that use the word. The order, which takes effect immediately, stands to affect more than 650 place names that use the term, according to figures from the U.S. Board on Geographic Names.

California Sports Betting Vote Cause Tribes Concern

California voters will be asked to decide in 2022 if they will approve sports betting in the state and where they will be allowed to make their wagers. Sports betting has been approved in several other states with betting limited to State regulated Casinos, Indian Casinos and horse racing tracks.

However, the California Sports Betting initiatives are much broader in that one would allow Sports Betting is card rooms and other locations in addition to the Indian Casinos.

Nationwide sports betting has been controlled by the underworld. Although illegal it has flourished and estimated to have generating billions of untaxed revenue.

Currently, the revenue generated from Sports Betting in the states that have already approve it is exceeding most predictions.

Gaming like any other market is limited to a specific percentage of the population and to expand the venues where the wagers can be made decreases the market shares for the California Gaming Tribes. Basic economics 101 of "Supply and Demand."

Biden called on the Federal Trade Commission to investigate whether oil-and-gas companies are participating in illegal conduct aimed at keeping gasoline prices high.


The American Petroleum Institute, the industry’s top lobbying group, called the letter a “*distraction from the fundamental market shift that is taking place,*” adding that demand has increased as the economy picks back up.

“Rather than launching investigations on markets that are regulated and closely monitored on a daily basis or pleading with OPEC to increase supply, we should be encouraging the safe and responsible development of American-made oil and natural gas,” Frank Macchiarola, the group’s senior vice president of policy, economics and regulatory affairs, said in a statement.

New landmark at Redlands museum recognizes Serrano people in San Bernardino County

San Bernardino County museums in Redlands, Apple Valley and Yucaipa are on the ancestral territory of the Maara'yam, or Serrano, people, and a landmark new entrance display at the facility in Redlands acknowledges as much.

Leaders from the San Manuel and Morongo tribes joined county officials Wednesday, Nov. 17, in unveiling what is believed to be the first permanent, physical native land acknowledgment in county history.

Presented in Serrano, English and Spanish, the proclamation is the latest step toward "being very truthful and accurate about our history and where we come from," Melissa Russo, county museum director, said. *"It's important for us to tell the full history, part of which is acknowledging the land on which we sit is ancestral land."*

Russo lauded San Manuel and Morongo leadership for their guidance, mentorship and support in crafting more transparent and progressive museum practices.

With so many Serrano collections

and collections of other indigenous people, the county intends to honor and celebrate those native to the land, Russo added.

"Their trust allows us to move forward in a way that's respectful and

honors the tribe," she said. "The museum is just the vehicle for the information we want to present to the public."

Both tribes' respective connection to the land goes back generations,

Morongo Chairman Charles Martin said.

"The land provided the sustenance to survive; it provided for us and cared for us," Martin said.

The San Manuel tribe hopes museum visitors educate themselves on the native people, not only of the region, but of California and the country as a whole, Vice Chairman Johnny Hernandez Jr. said.

"We hope people acknowledge the history was atrocious," Hernandez added, *"and that we need to do better in the future to make sure it doesn't happen again."*

Moreover, Hernandez continued, *"Us native people, we're still here, and it's so important to educate ourselves and educate the community ... on the real history and what we accomplished as a people and what we've been through and how we see our future as good stewards of our land."*

The San Bernardino County Museum is at 2024 Orange Tree Lane in Redlands.

Wyoming GOP Dump Liz Cheney

The Wyoming Republican Party will no longer recognize Rep. Liz Cheney as a member of their party, the **Associated Press** reported.

On Saturday, November 3, 2021 the party voted 31-29 to no longer recognize Cheney, who has been critical of former President Donald Trump.

Republican officials in nine of the state's counties had previously voted to no longer recognize Cheney as a member of the GOP. The **Casper Star-Tribune** reported. The vote does not take any power from Cheney and is only symbolic.

"It's laughable to suggest Liz is anything but a committed conservative Republican," Cheney Spokesperson Jeremy Adler told Insider in a statement.

Adler added: *"She is bound by her oath to the Constitution. Sadly, a portion of the Wyoming GOP leadership has abandoned that fundamental principle, and instead allowed themselves to be held hostage to the lies of a dangerous and irrational man."*

The Wyoming GOP central committee had previously voted in February to censure Cheney for her vote to impeach Trump following the January 6 Capitol riot.

The party said Cheney defied the will of the state's residents, who overwhelmingly supported Trump.

"Does the voice of the people matter and if it does, does it only matter at the ballot box?"

Joey Correnti, the GOP chairman in Carbon county said following Cheney's censure, according to the **Associated Press**.

Cheney had defended her vote to impeach Trump and said she was *"compelled by the oath"* she *"swore to the Constitution."*

The Star-Tribune reported that Cheney's role as the vice chairwoman of the House select committee has also garnered criticism from her party.

"To further her own personal political agenda, Representative Liz Cheney has not only caused massive disruption, dis-



traction, and division within the House Republican Conference, but has also willingly, happily, and energetically joined forced with and proudly pledged allegiance to democrat Speaker of the House Pelosi, as a means of serving her own personal interests while ignoring the interests, needs, and expectations of Wyoming Republicans," the Wyoming GOP's resolution to oust her as a Republican said, the Star-Tribune reported.

On Saturday, Sen. Ted Cruz, a Trump loyalist, suggested Cheney should run as a Democrat in the 2024 presidential elections.

Wilma Mankiller, the first woman Chief of the Cherokee Nation, would have been 76 years old on November 18, 2021. She was born in 1945.

She served for 10 years as Chief of the Cherokee Nation and in that time, reinvigorated the Cherokee Nation with community development projects and transformed the relationship between the Cherokee Nation and the federal government.

Mankiller was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1998, was inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame in 1993, and was a Ms. Magazine Woman of the Year in 1987. -- via Ms. Magazine
