Gavin Newsom is 'Incredibly Proud' of Biden leaving Californians to be captured and killed in Afghanistan

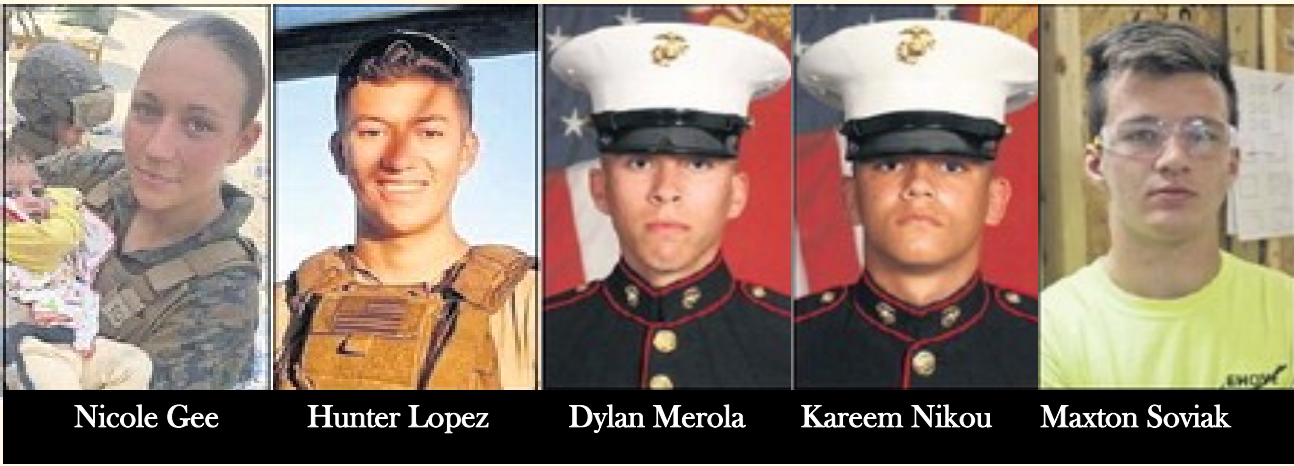
Gavin Newsom, the silver-spoon governor who faces a recall election next month, has come out in defense of Joe Biden after his disastrous execution of the U.S. evacuation from Afghanistan.

The California Democrat said what he did not have to and should not have — that he was "incredibly proud" of the president's job giving back the fruits of 20 years of American effort to the Taliban. He then ignored a question from a reporter who asked about Biden backing off of the campaign trail.

Our abandonment of Afghanistan and our allies has global implications, but California bears a crucial burden — five of the 13 American service-members killed by the terrorist attack in Kabul hailed from the Golden State.

Two of them were not yet born when the U.S. initially invaded after 9/11. **The five were Marines Nicole Gee, Hunter Lopez, Dylan Merola, and Kareem Nikou and Navy Hospital man Maxton Soviak.**

Even though Biden quit the evacuation on Monday, before any deadline, his administration admits that some 250 Americans remain in the country. In spite of the State Department's downward revision (by more than 50%) of the number of Americans left in Kabul, the real figure is po-



tentially much larger.

We don't know just how many Californians remain in Afghanistan, but we do know the stories of a select few. Of **eight El Cajon families stranded there before the Biden** administration's arbitrary withdrawal deadline, two families failed to escape, according to the Cajon Valley Union School District.

Also included in the number of people left stranded are 30 middle school children.

Despite Pentagon spokesman John Kirby's assertion that we *"have other tools available to us as a government to help the safe passage of Americans," the district noted that airlift is "no longer an avenue."*

A three year old boy born in California is also stranded in Afghanistan with his family along with other American families, all permanent U.S. residents. Despite Democratic Rep. Jackie Speier's efforts to contact the White House, Pentagon, and State Department directly, the family is reportedly hiding in a safe house after the Taliban physically beat them while en route to the airport.

Californians murdered by terrorists. Californians waiting to be murdered by terrorists. And Gavin Newsom is proud of Biden's fiasco.

Hunter Lopez, 22

Cpl. Hunter Lopez is the son of two members of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, Deputy Alicia Lopez and Capt. Herman Lopez, who serves as the chief of the La Quinta Police Department.

Hunter Lopez, who graduated from La Quinta High in 2017, had participated in the department's Sheriff's Explorer Program for three years before joining the Marine Corps in September 2017, Sheriff Chad Bianco said.

"When I was his age, I had the same dream of joining the Marines," said Julian Valles, a Marine Corps veteran and close friend of Lopez. "And I remember when I met Hunter when he was 11 years old and he had that same dream."

Valles was not close to Lopez growing up, he said, but the pair quickly bonded through a mutual friend in the five months leading up to his deployment. The group of friends would often workout together, go to the shooting range and talk about their goals in life. "Hunter had a way of pushing his friends," Valles said. "He would ask what your goals are, and you would tell him and he would say 'OK, then what?'" "I told him I wanted to be a nurse," he said. "And he kept pushing me for what was next, and I ended up with the goal of becoming a flight nurse."

That drive, he said, was emulated in Lopez' own life too. Bianco said Lopez planned to follow in his parents' footsteps and become a Riverside County Sheriff's Deputy after his deployment.



Nicole Gee, 23

A week before she was killed, Sgt. Nicole Gee cradled a baby in her arms at the Kabul airport. She posted the photo on Instagram and wrote, "I love my job."

Gee, 23, of Roseville, just north of the Sacramento area, was a maintenance technician with the 24th Marine Expeditionary Unit from Camp Lejeune in North Carolina.

Sgt. Mallory Harrison, who lived with Gee for three years, wrote about the magnitude of her loss.

"I can't quite describe the feeling I get when I force myself to come back to reality and think about how I'm never going to see her again," Harrison wrote on Facebook. "How her last breath was taken doing what she loved — helping people. ... Then there was an explosion. And just like that, she's gone."

Gee's car was still parked in a lot at Camp Lejeune and Harrison mused about all the Marines who walked past it while she was overseas.

"Some of them knew her. Some of them didn't," she said. "They all walked past it. The war stories, the losses, the flag-draped coffins, the KIA bracelets and the heartbreak. It's not so distant anymore."



Dylan R. Merola, 20

Lance Cpl. Dylan R. Merola, of Rancho Cucamonga, was a graduate of Los Osos High School. On Friday, students there honored him during the school's first football game of the season by wearing red, white and blue.

"Dylan's heroism, selfless courage and ultimate sacrifice will never be forgotten," Chaffey Joint Union Superintendent Mat Holton wrote in a statement Saturday. "He joined the Marines because he wanted to make a difference, and in the end stood side-by-side with his fellow soldiers in helping more than 100,000 people evacuate one of the most dangerous places in the world."

Merola worked as a theater technician during his years at Los Osos, Holton wrote, and was "one of the kindest students ever to call Los Osos home."

Merola's mother, Cheryl, told CBS2 her son had been in Kabul for less than two weeks and was planning to go to college and study engineering. "He was one of the best kids ever," she told the news channel. "Kind. Loving. Giving to every single person. He would give anything for anybody."



Taylor Hoover, 31

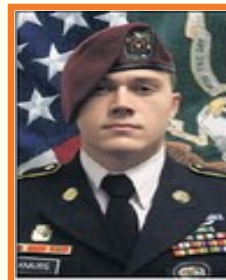
Staff Sgt. Taylor Hoover, of Utah, had been in the Marines for 11 years and was remembered as a hero, his father, Darin Hoover, said. "He gave his life protecting those that can't protect themselves, doing what he loved serving his country," said Hoover, who lives in a Salt Lake City suburb.

Taylor Hoover was living in Aliso Viejo with his girlfriend, Nicole Weiss, ABC7 reported.

"His life revolved around his family, the Marine Corps, and the men he served," Weiss said in a statement to the news channel. "It has been my honor and privilege to have stood by his side and to have had the opportunity to love him and live a beautiful life together."

Hoover's father said he had heard from Marines who said they were grateful they had his son as their sergeant.

"They look back on him and say that they've learned so much from him," Hoover said. "One heck of a leader."



Ryan Knauss, 23

Army Staff Sgt. Ryan Knauss was remembered as a funny man who loved his country and was looking forward to coming home and moving to Washington, D.C., relatives told WATETV in Knoxville, Tennessee.

"He was a super-smart hilarious young man," said stepmother Linnae Knauss.

Knauss had been stationed at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, and he was part of the 9th Psychological Operations Battalion, 8th Psychological Operations Group, the Defense Department said.

"A motivated young man who loved his country," his grandfather, Wayne Knauss, told the TV station. "He was a believer, so we will see him again in God's heaven."

Johanny Rosario Pichardo, 25



Sgt. Johanny Rosario Pichardo was being mourned in the Massachusetts mill town of Lawrence she called home. Her birthplace was in the Dominican Republic.

"We will not allow her to be forgotten," said Jaime Melendez, director of veterans services in Lawrence, where Rosario attended high school. Rosario served with the Naval Amphibious Force, Task Force 51/5th Marine Expeditionary Brigade, which praised her work as supply chief this spring.

Deagan William-Tyler Page, 23



Cpl. Daegan William-Tyler Page planned to go to trade school and possibly become a lineman after his enlistment ended, his family said in a statement. Page was raised in Red Oak, Iowa, and in the Omaha area and joined the Marines after graduating from Millard South High School. He is mourned by his girlfriend, parents, stepmom and stepdad, four siblings and grandparents, the family statement said.

"Daegan will always be remembered for his tough outer shell and giant heart," the statement said. "Our hearts are broken, but we are thankful for the friends and family who are surrounding us during this time."



Humberto Sanchez, 22

Marinemembers of his Indiana high school class who joined the Cpl. Humberto Sanchez was among 17 military after graduation.

Sanchez played on Logansport High School's varsity soccer team and was in the homecoming court his senior year, Principal Matt Jones said. Jones called Sanchez a dedicated artist who took many art classes along with honors and dual credit college courses.

"Humberto was a bright, athletic young man who was popular, well liked by his soccer teammates, classmates, coaches and teachers," Jones said. "He was honored to be putting on the Marine uniform and serving his country."



Maxton Soviak, 22

Navy Hospital Corpsman Maxton Soviak, of Berlin Heights, Ohio, was remembered as a friendly guy who amused others. "Max always was smiling," said Vince Ragnoni, his electrical technology teacher. "Max was good for pulling shenanigans and liked to get other people to laugh."

Soviak graduated from Edison High School in 2017, where he also wrestled and played football. He enlisted in September 2017 and attended Hospital Corpsman School in San Antonio, Texas, before postings in Guam and at Camp Pendleton.

"He had just joined the Navy and he started telling me about what he'd be doing," Ragnoni said. "I told him I knew he would do great things. He was happy and excited about that."



Jared Schmitz, 20

Marine Lance Cpl. Jared Schmitz grew up in the St. Louis area. "This was something he always wanted to do, and I never seen a young man train as hard as he did to be the best soldier he could be," Mark Schmitz, told KMOX Radio, about his son. "His life meant so much more. I'm so incredibly devastated that I won't be able to see the man that he was very



David Lee Espinoza, 20

Lance Cpl. David Lee Espinoza, a Marine from Laredo, Texas, joined the military after high school, and was being remembered as a hero by his mother. "He was just brave enough to go do what he wanted and to help out people. That's who he was, he was just perfect," his mother, Elizabeth Holguin, told the Laredo Morning Times.

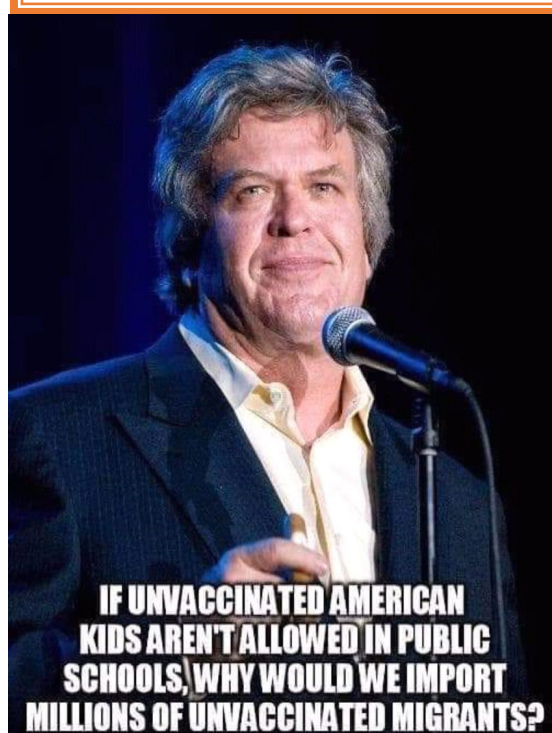

Pascal Cleatus Poolaw, Sr., Kiowa:

The most decorated American Indian soldier in U.S. history

First Sergeant Poolaw's a full blooded Kiowa, was born on January 22, 1922 in Apache, Oklahoma.

Poolaw served in World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War and was awarded 42 medals which included 4-Silver Stars,, 5-Bronze Stars, 2-Distinguished Service Crosses, 3-Purple Hearts

He died on the battlefield in the Republic of Vietnam on 7 November 1967, while on a "Search and Destroy mission" near Loc Ninh. He was serving with Company C, 26th Infantry Regiment, 1st Infantry Division. It should be noted that in the ferocious fighting at the Battle of Loc Ninh where he posthumously awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor.

In 1942, Poolaw, his father, and his two brothers joined the armed forces. While serving with the 8th Infantry Regiment's M Company near Recogne, Belgium on September 8, 1944, he earned his first Purple Heart and Silver Star.

On that day, Poolaw's unit was engaging fire with the Germans. He pushed his company forward while facing heavy machine gun fire for give minutes as he hurled hand grenades, causing numerous enemy casualties.

Poolaw's military career did not end in Belgium or with the Germans. During the Korean War, Poolaw saw combat and was wounded again and awarded the Distinguished Service Cross, a second Purple Heart and two more Silver Stars.

His first Silver Star for that war was for his heroic actions on September 1950 when his company met still enemy resistance.

Poolaw volunteered to lead his squad in an assault, charging up a slop to hit the perimeter of the North Korean's position. His squad



engaged in fierce hand-to-hand combat and Poolaw's persistence encouraged his squad to keep going until they were able to seize their objective.

The second Silver Star during this war came on April 4, 1951 near Chongong-ni where Poolaw and his platoon was pinned down by a automatic weapons and mortar barrage.

He exposed himself to the enemy and slowly advanced across the open terrain, firing his weapon as he went. By keeping the North Koreans' eyes on him, his platoon maneuvered to a better position and were able to carry on the mission at hand.

He returned to the U.S. in 1952 and retired from the Army IN 1962.

This is not where is story - or military career - ends

During the Vietnam War, all four of the Poolaw's sons were in the military. In February 1967, his son, Pascal Jr., was injured by a landmine in Vietnam.

This injury resulted in amputation of his right leg below the knee. Poolaw's youngest son, Lindy, was



drafted. Afraid of what could happen to his sons as the war progressed, Poolaw rejoined the Army at the age of 45. Giving up his rank as a 2nd Lieutenant (a promotion he earned in Korea), with the intentions of serving in direct combat, Poolaw hoped to keep his youngest son away from the front lines by taking his place. Regulations prohibited two members of the same family from serving in combat at the same time without their consent. Unfortunately, by the time he arrived on the West Coast, Lindy had left for Vietnam the day before.

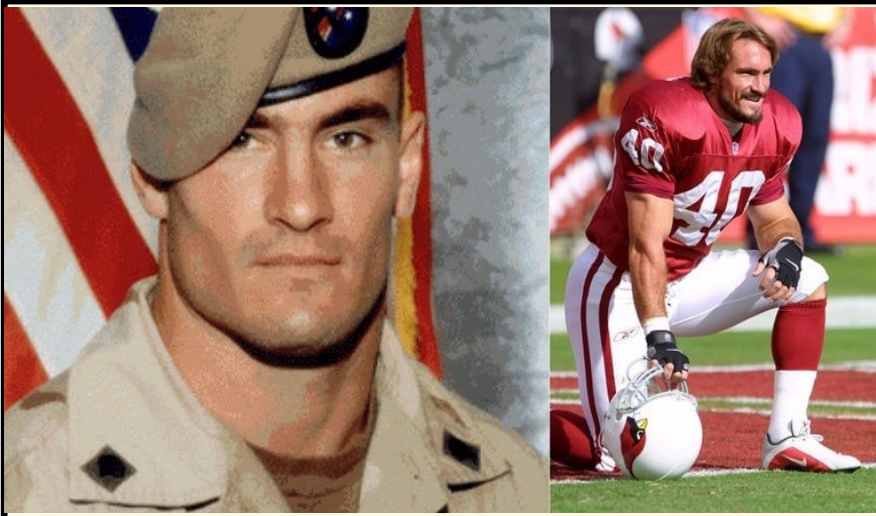
Poolaw was deployed on May 31, 1967 as a first sergeant of the 26th Infantry Regiment's C Company. His last Silver Star was for an event that occurred a few months later. On November 7, 1967, Poolaw's unit were part of a search and destroy mission near the village of Loc Ninh. Their unit was ambushed by

a Viet Cong force with intensive claymore mine, rocket, small arms, and automatic weapons fire.

Through a hail of bullets, Poolaw raced to the lead squad position to lay down a base of fire - saving countless lives. While wounded, he continued moving among his squad making sure everyone was positioned properly while pulling casualties back.

As Poolaw was carrying a wounded soldier to safety, he was struck by a rocket propelled grenade and killed.

For his heroic actions Poolaw was awarded a Silver Star and a third Purple Heart posthumously. *"He has followed the trail of the great chiefs,"* his wife Irene said at Poolaw's funeral. *"His people hold him in honor and highest esteem. He has given his life for the people and the country he loved so much."*

The story of this American hero is burned into all our minds because of what he sacrificed to serve his country and he paid the ultimate price but lest not forget the 2,448 American soldier who we lost that bravely served our county with 20,000-plus who were injured.

During the war in Afghanistan, more than 3,500 allied soldiers were also killed. 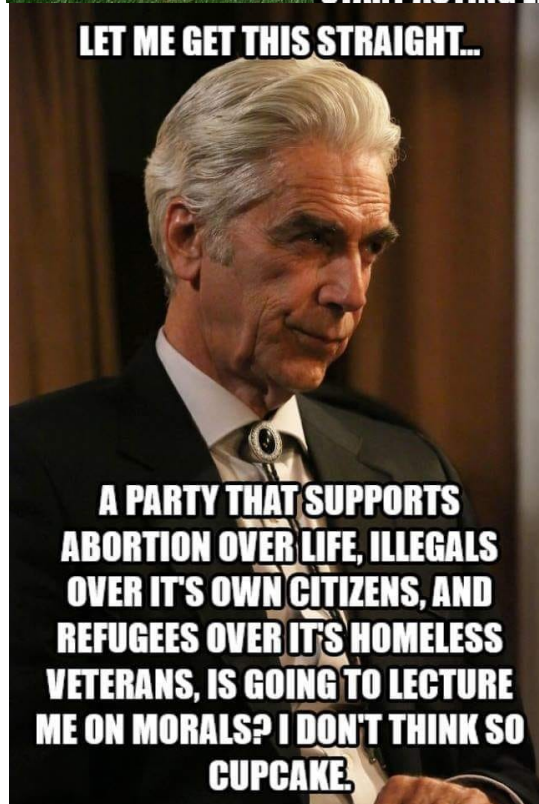
