"Build Back Better Act" AKA "The Inflation Reduction Act."

Old Fakowee Indian trick, change the name until the people buy it. The recession becomes a "Transition" and the Build Back Better Act is renamed "The Inflation Reduction Act." So what happened to the "Transition?" I guess the word "Inflation" is much more threatening than "Transition."

Just so you understand where I'm coming from - basic economic dictates that Government reduces or stops spending, does not raise taxes and the federal Reserve stops printing money in order to stop inflation.

I even watched Sen. Joe Manchin of West Virginia get all testy with the Fox News host over her claiming that the average hard working taxpayer would be paying more taxes to cover the \$739 billion price tag. He said that it was a "Lie."

The problem with his claim is that a year ago he refused to vote for the Build Back Better Act because it raised taxes. No biggie, I get it, he's just another corrupt politician.

However, According to an analysis by the majority Democrats in the Senate, it would "invest approximately \$300 billion in deficit reduction and \$369 billion in energy security and climate change programs over the next 10 years."

But it would do that by raising taxes by \$739 billion, slamming the economy

just as it is dropping into recession. This would include grabbing \$313 billion by imposing a 15% corporate minimum tax. *But corporations don't pay taxes, they only collect them from customers. They would have to raise prices, actually increasing inflation.*

The Tax Foundation calculated this "is the most economically damaging provision in the bill, reducing GDP by 0.1 percent and costing about 23,000 jobs. The tax increase on carried interest also eliminates about 5,000 jobs."

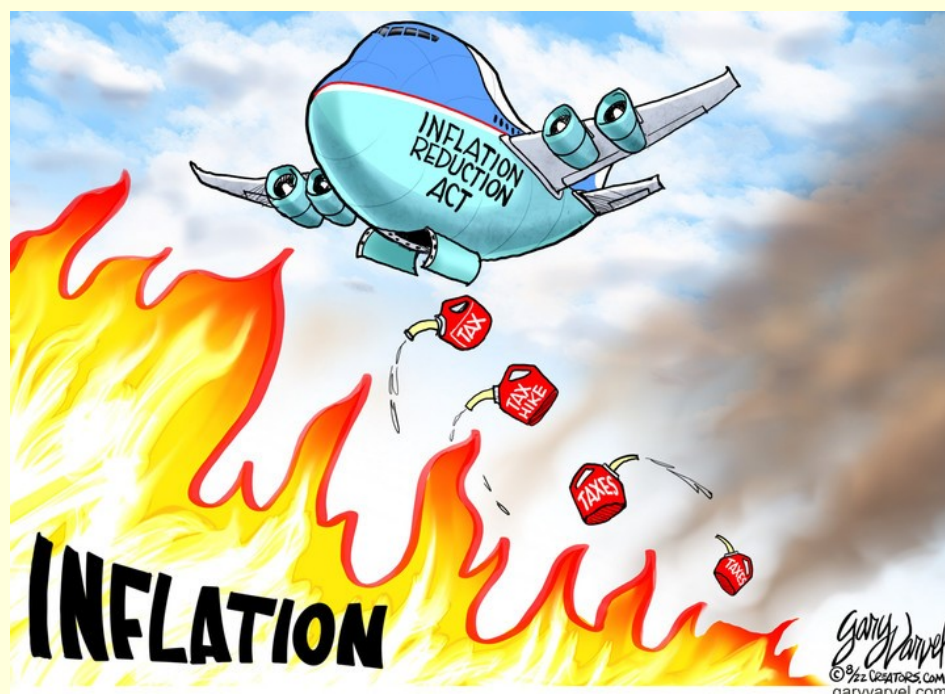
Another \$124 billion supposedly would be raised through tax enforcement with the 87,000 new IRS agents that will be hired with funds from this Bill. In other words, pushing the IRS to go on fishing expeditions with their auditing powers. Tightening the thumbscrews on taxpayers also is a terrible idea at the beginning of a recession. Or anytime.

Now here's the kicker, not just corporations and the rich will pay higher taxes. A July 29, 2022 study by the nonpartisan Joint Committee on Taxation

found those making from \$20,000 to \$100,000 in income would pay from 0.8% to 1.1% more in taxes. Even those making less than \$10,000, the very bottom, would pay 3.1% more. "A Lie?"

Democrats have touted how their most moderate member, Sen. Joe Manchin of West Virginia, stopped obstructing the bill and now is supporting it.

Well, Politico reported, "Clean energy manufacturing companies with plans to set up shop in Manchin's state helped orchestrate the 13-day effort to change his mind," according to more than 20 people it talked to. And that push "included a call from Bill Gates, whose venture capital firm has backed a West Virginia-based battery start-up."

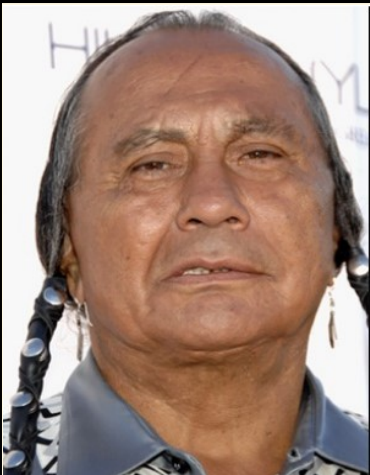

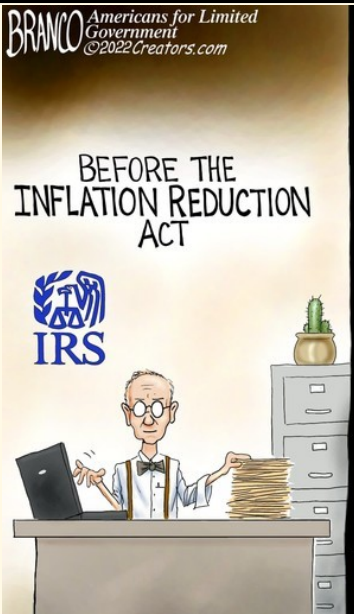


Russell Means American Indian Movement

Los Angeles county waives citizenship requirement to get a government job

While most were focused on whether or not one California county would reinstate draconian mandates related to the COVID pandemic last week, the Board of Supervisors quietly and unanimously moved forward with a plan to grant illegal immigrants a brand new right.

At Thursday's (July 30, 2022) regular meeting of the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, an agenda that featured 64 items addressed a "New Board Policy" just past the halfway point on "Inclusive Hiring." Though initially couched in the ambiguous language of progressives, the policy introduced by supervisors Hilda L. Solis and Sheila Kuehl in June 2021 stated its intent clearly as a "Waiver of Citizenship Requirements for Los Angeles County Employment" and was officially adopted on July 26, 2022.

In her original statement addressing the policy, Solis wrote, "Los Angeles County is a community of immigrants from

each corner of the world. And while our County-government workforce reflects the community it represents, there is room for improvement. This motion seeks to make clear that the County, as one of the largest employers in the region, strives to be an inclusive and diverse workforce, and is committed to not excluding nor allowing citizenship to be a barrier to employment."

Solis and Kuehl contended that of the 880,000 "non-citizens," according to 2018 estimates, illegal immigrants "who often express deep interest for public service" are barred from doing so because of citizenship requirements. They cited, for example, the Public Defender's office which was said to receive applications from "otherwise qualified non-U.S. citizens who, although permitted to practice law in California, are disqualified from the examination process" for hire.

Fox Business reported Los Angeles County Public Defender Ricardo García, who promotes himself as the first "Latinx" public defender in LA County, as saying, "Barriers to employment based on cultural, racial, ethnic, or religious characteristics are contrary to our core values. Citizenship overlaps these demographic characteristics. This motion, by Supervisors Solis and Kuehl, will promote equity in hiring and give the Public Defender's Office access to the most qualified applicants for employment, irrespective of their citizenship status."

Meanwhile, the promotion of "equity" was already found to be leaving nearly 20 million American men sidelined from the labor force without making further inroads for illegal immigrants. Steven Camarota, director of research at the Center for Immigration Studies, found among working-age (16-64) "there's a huge pool of potential [American] workers for employers."

"Since 2000, the number of working-age immigrants rose from 18.4 million to 27.6 million, nearly nine million," Camarota explained. "In the same span of time, the number of Americans who have dropped out of the labor force rose by more than 10 million."

So, while the Board of Supervisors works within the confines of the law to open more paths for non-citizens, they continue to slam doors in the face of Los Angelenos. For the time being, the policy includes exceptions for state and federal laws and therefore the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and other peace officer hirings still require citizenship.

García went on to add, "An immigrant's experience will advance our vision, mission, and values to protect our clients' legal and human rights and enable us to more readily realize my goal that our employees fully represent the demographics of the population that we serve."

China seeks foothold on U.S. with Oak Flat land grab by mining giants Rio Tinto & BHP; Apache Stronghold organization taking religious freedom case to the U.S. Supreme Court

Dr. Wendsler Nosie Sr., former Chairman of the San Carlos Apache Tribe and founder of the Apache Stronghold asks;

"The question for the United States Government becomes why do you support and even go so far as to say you "protect" the sovereignty of Taiwan, when domestically, you are violating the very sovereignty of the original inhabitants of this land by giving away sacred places to mining corporations like Rio Tinto, knowing full well that the Copper ore is going to China?"

"So it leaves me to think that by the U.S. Government giving exemptions of federal laws to Resolution Copper, that the U.S. Government should be aware that control of Arizona land, water, and its resources will be for foreign gain, the U.S. Government still embracing the great deception of the birth of America. But, since time immemorial it has always been an Apache Sacred Place, Chi'chil Bildagoteel, which in English means: "Emory Oak extends on a Level." Oak Flat is a federally registered Apache Traditional Cultural Property and National Historic District within the mapped lands of the Apache's, per the U.S. Treaty of

1852 with the Western Apache Nation.

Hundreds of Native American governments support us Apache's in our defense of Oak Flat, with many dozens of formal governmental, charitable, and religious organizations' statements opposing the mining of Oak Flat and the 2-mile wide, 1,000-foot crater that China, Rio Tinto, and BHP would cause to collapse and fall into the earth there. And, the copper ore that would be extracted from Oak Flat is destined for China's consumption, shipped to a smelter in Asia via the Port of Guaymas, Mexico.

"When we pass the Inflation Reduction Act, working families will get rebates to buy efficient appliances and weatherize their homes. And folks will have tax credits for efficient heating and cooling and rooftop solar. Families will see their energy bills drop by the hundreds," he wrote. President Joe Biden continues to generously distort the alleged perks of the widely panned Inflation Reduction Act.

In his latest stretch of the truth made via Twitter, Biden claimed that the American people "will see their energy bills drop by the hundreds" thanks to the bill.

"When we pass the Inflation Reduction Act, working families will get rebates to buy efficient appliances and weatherize their homes. And folks will have tax credits for efficient heating and cooling and rooftop solar. Families will see their energy bills drop by the hundreds," he wrote.

The president's claim is rooted in the assumption that every American can afford to go "green." Sure, those who

can afford to go "green" may indeed see savings. But what about those who can't?

Thanks to the inflation crisis spurred by the president's policies, most Americans can barely afford their cost of living, let alone going "green."

"The hottest inflation in forty years is taking its toll on families, with three-quarters of middle-income Americans saying their earnings aren't enough to pay for their cost of living," CBS News reported late last month, citing a recent survey.

Most Americans likewise have barely any savings to dedicate toward purchasing "green" products.

"Nearly half of all hourly workers in the U.S. have been unable to save even a dime to guard against financial emergencies, according to a new survey of 3,000 employees by Branch," CBS News also reported late last month.

"That figure, 48%, is up 7% from last year, a sign the higher cost of food, rent, gas and other staples is taking a severe toll on hourly workers. More than 80% of respondents said they had less than \$500 tucked away for emergencies."

To make matters worse, the so-called Inflation Reduction Act will raise taxes on virtually all Americans, meaning the American people will have even less

money to dedicate to the Democrats' beloved "green" projects.

Moreover, the bill will most likely either have no effect on inflation. Even Sen. Bernie Sanders, a Democrat, has admitted this.

"I want to take a moment to say a few words about the so-called Inflation Reduction Act that we are debating this evening. I say so-called because according to the CBO and other economic organizations that have studied this bill, it will in fact have a minimal impact on inflation," he said on the Senate floor Saturday.

Meanwhile, some experts have predicted that the bill could in fact worsen inflation.

"[W]e estimate that the Inflation Reduction Act would reduce long-run economic output by about 0.1 percent and eliminate about 30,000 full-time equivalent jobs in the United States," according to the Tax Foundation.

"It would also reduce average after-tax incomes for taxpayers across every income quintile over the long run. By reducing long-run economic growth, this bill may actually worsen inflation by constraining the productive capacity of the economy."

Does tribal sovereignty allow tribes to govern the activities of churches and missionaries on their lands? Pine Ridge will find out

A Christian missionary whose message condemns Lakota spirituality and religion recently hit a sort of reverse sweet spot of outrage among citizens on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation.

In an unusual decision, the Oglala Lakota Nation tribal council voted in July to exclude Matt Monfore, a non-Native from the Jesus is King Mission, from Pine Ridge lands, saying he was spreading hate by distributing pamphlets on tribal lands.

"This week the Jesus is King Missionary was found distributing material that literally demonizes the Lakota culture and faith," according to a letter released by the office of Tribal President Kevin Killer on July 22.

"This is unacceptable and completely disrespectful. It is the view of the President and Council that these 'pamphlets' seek to promote hate instead of peace. Hate has no place on Oglala land."

Monfore and the Jesus is King Mission have been ordered to leave Oglala Lakota Sioux Nation lands and *"cease any further hate speech actions."*

In meetings July 26-27, the council also required any churches or missionaries conducting work on tribal lands to register with the tribe and to clear a background investigation, and ordered an investigation into any connections between Monfore and The Dream Center operated by Wings as Eagles Ministries.

The tribal actions are now raising questions about how far tribal authority can extend over religion and whether long-entrenched Christian churches on tribal lands will be forced to suspend operations until the registration process is completed.

Shawnee and Lenape author Steve Newcomb, a former columnist for *Indian Country Today* who wrote the book, *"Pagans in the Promised Land: Decoding the Doctrine of Discovery,"* said modern evangelical missionaries remain guided by the same tenets of the Doctrine of Discovery that describe global domination by the Christian faith as a desired goal and means to fulfill Jesus's Great Commission to go forth and make disciples of all nations.

Indigenous peoples are pawns serving the larger agenda, Newcomb told *ICT* in an earlier interview.

"The evangelical agenda of converting Native Americans to Christianity is a very-well-thought-out strategy," he said.

Monfore expressed surprise over the tribe's reaction. *I'm not racist; I love Native Americans,"* he told *ICT* during a telephone interview. *"I'm against Native religion. I'm not against Native people."*

'PEOPLE ARE OUTRAGED'

Public outcry about Monfore and his proselytizing materials emerged earlier in July when members of the Indigenous Youth Council Oglala Chapter posted copies of his pamphlets on social media.

In his written materials and information posted on the mission's website, Monfore compares *Tunkshila*, the Lakota word for the Creator and/or grandfather, to a corrupt and unjust demon. He goes on to describe Nicholas Black Elk, a famous Lakota medicine man, as racist and dismisses well-known Lakota spiritual leader Leonard Crow Dog as a "drunk."

Mixing biblical scripture with his interpretations, he writes, *"Jesus said, 'I am the way and the truth and the life; no one comes to the Father except through me. The white buffalo calf woman is not a savior; she is a demon/demonic belief. If your life does not bring exclusive glory to Jesus alone, it is not from God. Native teachings are of the spirit of the antichrist.'"*

Posting these writings on the International Indigenous Youth Council Lakota chapter's Facebook page, Youth Council mentor Eleanor Ferguson of the Oglala Lakota tribe challenged the propaganda.

"This is modern day indoctrination and what cultural genocide looks like," she wrote. *"Why are we allowing these outsiders to disrespect us and our culture on our own territory? Something needs to be done."*

Ferguson's challenge to the community came on the heels of the announced visit of Pope Francis to Canada as well as increased media attention on the prominent role that Christian missionaries and churches played in operating Indian residential schools.

The Pope traveled to Canada in a self-described "penitential pilgrimage" to issue an historic apology for the role that Catholic institutions played in promoting the government's genocidal policies of assimilation and disenfranchisement. The Catholic Church and other Christian missionaries operated at least one third of the more than 400 Indian boarding schools in the U.S.

Many Indigenous people across Canada and the U.S. criticized the apology as not going far enough, however, and were especially critical of images of the Pope wearing a traditional feather headdress presented to him by chiefs in Maskwacis, Alberta.

Community reaction in Pine Ridge to Ferguson's postings were strong and immediate.

"I had people contacting me late at night about these missionaries; people are outraged, seeing the Pope get a headdress in Canada just added fuel to the fire," said Oglala Sioux tribal a council meeting televised on the tribe's Facebook page on July 26.

Monfore told *ICT* he was genuinely shocked that people equated his message with teachings by the Catholic Church. *"People are trying to tie me into the Catholic Church's oppression of Native people and things like that, but I preach that the Catholic Church isn't Christian,"* he said.

Monfore also noted that he has been handing out similar materials and preaching this message on and around Pine Ridge for years.

NEW OPPOSITION

The events leading up to the current controversy, according to Monfore, began earlier in July when he was preaching his beliefs to a work crew made up mostly of Native men who were at his mission installing a new floor.

The Jesus is King Mission is based on non-tribal lands in the town of Oral, South Dakota, near the reservation. The Wings as Eagles Ministries is also based near the reservation in Caputo, South Dakota, though The Dream Center is located on tribal lands.

Monfore said he gave the work crew some of his pamphlets and invited them to a seminar he was presenting at The Dream Center. He said he was invited by a visiting church group that was conducting volunteer work at the center.

At some point, he said, the men passed along the literature and descriptions of the conversation to Ferguson and other Indigenous Youth Council members who in turn posted the information on Facebook.

'UNTOUCHED GROUPS'

Evangelical and fundamentalist missionary groups and churches focusing on the Native population in and around Pine Ridge and other Native communities in the past 10 years share common elements in their messaging.

Indeed, there is a growing fundamentalist interest in converting Indigenous "untouched groups," to Christianity.

Indeed, although Wings as Eagles Ministries describes itself as a non-denominational evangelical relief agency and is registered as a nonprofit organization, its statement of faith and other writings state that the Bible is the infallible word of God, that Jesus Christ is the only way to salvation and the literal second coming of Christ will reward believers.

Many people in Pine Ridge complain that Wings as Eagles' programming at its Dream Center is heavy-handed in proselytizing, especially towards the youth, and conducts fundraising in ways that are misleading.

In 2019, *ICT* reported about the proliferation of fundamentalist Christian missionary organizations and churches on the Pine Ridge reservation. Priscilla Locke, an Oglala Lakota citizen who lives on Pine Ridge, described how the Wings as Eagles Ministries used the story of her 12-year-old grandson's suicide as a fundraising tool on the organization's website, without the family's permission.

"WE ARE ANGRY"

Discussion about the new ordinance requiring churches and missionaries to register with the tribe were heated and emotional during the July meetings.

Many expressed outrage at what they viewed as a revived focus by some missionaries on oppressive, colonial tenets of the Doctrine of Discovery. During the Pope's visit to Canada, many Indigenous people demanded that he and the Catholic Church rescind the doctrine.

"Our objective is to decolonize mind, heart, spirit, land and return to our Lakota ways; we don't need any more churches to assimilate us," Tyler Star Comes Out of the Lakota chapter of the Indigenous Youth Council told the tribal council.

"We are angry and also heavy-hearted that this is still happening," she said.

Others at the meeting, however, expressed concern about how the registration ordinance would impact tribal members who are active members of various Christian denominations on the reservation.

Several council members wanted to know if all churches on the reservation would be forced to suspend worship services, funerals and weddings until the registration process was completed.

Therein lies the rub surrounding the complex relationship in Indian Country with Christianity.

Christian churches and missionaries have existed on many reservations and Native lands for well over 100 years and are deeply entrenched in some communities. Red Cloud Indian School in Pine Ridge, for instance, was founded as Holy Rosary Mission in 1888 by Catholic Jesuits, predating the existence of the reservation.

Although initially guided by a philosophy of Christian hegemony and disdain for Lakota spirituality, Red Cloud has a long history on Pine Ridge with ties that go back generations.

"People are texting us and getting upset. What about upcoming bible studies and other church services, will they still be able to have those?" asked councilmember Sonia Little Hawk-Weston. *"Some of these are small churches that have been here for years."*

Another council member whose name was not announced asked about the ordinance's impact on the Native American church.

"The members are all Native; their church is a teepee; would the road man need to register?" he asked.

Responded councilmember Garfield Steele, *"It was never our intent to stop anyone from praying; as Lakota people we know how that feels because it was done to us."*

The council voted to amend the ordinance to include a 90-day period for churches and missions to comply; until then activities could continue.

As the tribe's attorney, Thomasina Real Bird, explained during the July 27 council meeting, there is limited legal precedent for tribal governments to permanently banish or exclude non-tribal citizens from reservations.

As of early August, Monfore said he had not received any official notification of the council's decision to exclude him.

"My ministry is not located on the reservation," he said. *"So far, I have no plans to travel there."*

Mission complete: Photos of all veterans on Vietnam memorial have been found

Maui woman plays major part in finding photos of 58,281 service members

After more than two decades and a herculean effort by a Maui woman, photos of all service members whose names are inscribed on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial have been found.

The last photo of the 58,281 service members was found on Tuesday, according to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund.

A few days earlier, Launiupoko resident Janna Hoehn and her team found the second-to-the-last photo, officials from the memorial fund confirmed.

Hoehn began her journey 11 years ago when she sought to find photos of all 42 Maui Vietnam War veterans killed in the conflict. After successfully doing so, she went state by state and found around 8,000 photos with the help of a team; 5,000 of those photos were found on her own. *"Because I don't give up, I always hoped we would find them all,"* she said after finding her last photo. *"I truly like a challenge. And this was definitely a challenge."*

EDITORS NOTE: (The 8,000 photos include the 232 American Indians and Alaskan Natives that were killed in Viet Nam.)

"There were times that it was quite frustrating when you get so close, finding the family and then they don't have a photo to share . . . There were a lot of days like that," Hoehn said.

Jim Knotts, president and CEO of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund, celebrated the work of Hoehn and other volunteers.

"When VVMF began this effort, the goal was to put a face with a name for each of the 58,281 service members whose names are inscribed on The Wall," Knotts said in a news release. *"To ensure that visitors to The Wall understand that behind each name is a face — a person with a story of a family and friends who were forever changed by their loss. Today, the Wall of Faces tells these stories through photos and remembrances left by both friends and family members. We couldn't have done this without the tenacious work of a small army of volunteers across the country. Their ingenuity, commitment and dedication are tremendous."*

Knotts said this initial photo gathering phase is now complete, but their team and volunteers will continue to seek better-quality photos and add remembrances to show the full story behind each name.

He also requests that the public also

look at the photos and add additional higher-quality images as well as leave remembrances. The Wall of Faces is available at www.vvmf.org/wall-of-faces.

A short-term initial effort to find the photos began in fall 2001, but a larger, more concentrated effort launched in fall 2009. VVMF said "hundreds of volunteers" and family members submitted photos.

In addition to Hoehn, some of the other volunteers included Andrew Johnson, a newspaper publisher in Wisconsin who began looking for photos in 2014; David Hine, who got involved in 2009 after reading about the effort in the VVMF newsletter; Herb Reckinger, who started looking for photos of Minnesotans in 2014; Steve and Annie Delp, who began representing VVMF and the Wall of Faces project at Vietnam unit reunions in 2013; Norman Murray, who attended a Veterans Day ceremony at The Wall in 2014 and met Annie Delp; and John Thomstatter, who got involved in 2016 after hearing about the effort.

Hoehn said she is "absolutely thrilled" and called the completion "a dream come true." She said the same feelings came over her as when she found the last photo of the Maui veterans.

"I was so happy I was able to find all of their photos. However, at the same time, I loved getting to know the families and that is when I decided to have the photo display made (of the Maui fallen) and taking it all over Maui. . . . I didn't want it to end there. I wanted to make sure these young men were never forgotten."

Hoehn said the last photo her team found was that of Juan Ortiz-Rivera of Puerto Rico. The photo was among the last half a dozen that volunteers were looking for on July 4.

Hoehn acknowledged that the last photos did come in pretty quickly, within a month or so. She attributed some of that success to one of her team members, who wishes to remain anonymous, but has access to basic training books and was able to pull in the last few photos when the team received the exact state and location of the veterans' basic training from the National Personnel Records Center in St. Louis, Mo.

Hoehn said that finding photos of veterans from Puerto Rico has been challenging since Hurricane Maria ravaged the country, destroying libraries and high schools.

Another area that was challenging was New York, as none of the libraries carried any old yearbooks. Hoehn said she also had difficulty getting a story into larger newspapers there, which she said would have helped spread the word.

Hoehn said she tried to get stories in various newspapers to assist in the efforts. The search for photos has also included making cold calls, visiting residences and libraries, reading through obituaries, searching the internet and visiting and writing to government organizations.

Now that the grunt work is done, Hoehn, a freelance floral designer, said she is working on a book about her experience along with stories of the Maui fallen.

She said many of the families have been interviewed but still has a few more families to speak with. Reflecting back, Hoehn recalled how Jan Scruggs, founder of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, told her that they probably wouldn't find all of the photos.

But she said he is now thrilled that all of the photos have been found.

"I have believed all along that we would find a photo for each one," Hoehn said.

And although Janna lived in Hemet her extended family lived in the adjacent City of San Jacinto.

Due to her growing up in Hemet, and attending school with many of the American Indians from the local Indian Reservations, Soboba, Santa Rosa, Cahuilla and Ramona she took on the challenge of collecting the photographs of the 232 American Indians and Alaskan Natives that were killed or MIA in Viet Nam.

California is forcing 70,000 truckers out of work, the Supply Chain will Suffer & Us Peons Pay More



California is winning its war on freelance truckers. With no allies among Democratic state leaders, the truckers have taken it upon themselves to protest the decision, but the effects will reach far beyond them and far beyond California's borders.

The Supreme Court declined to take up the truckers' challenge to California's AB 5, the anti-freelance, anti-freedom law designed to restrict independent contractors and suffocate the gig economy.

According to Bill Aboudi, the owner of AB Trucking in Oakland, he will no longer be able to use drivers who own their own trucks anymore, and he will have to reduce his workload as a result.

Nevada Trucking Association CEO Paul Enos said the trucking industry is already 80,000 drivers short and that

more will quit in California now that they are no longer allowed to be independent contractors.

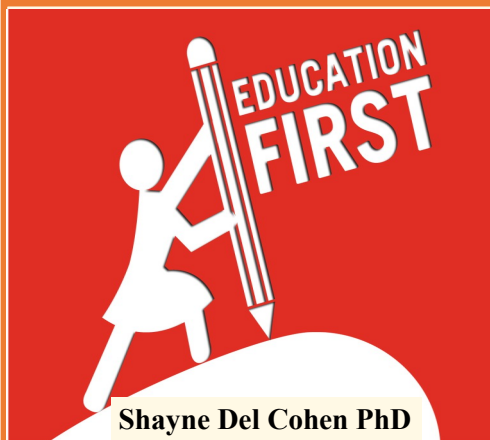

I find myself reading things I do not understandfeeling that I am reading something written in another world. An old dictionary is not helpful; nor does spell check recognize many of these terms (*so don't take the above as 100% correct!*) Yet these are some of these terms are cornerstones of the future.

If you do not recognize or understand the concepts therein, a quickie introductory class is needed so that you can communicate with the creatures that now speak this language and/or can help shape the economy and infrastructure needed for your Tribe.

This is not really a new dilemma.

Groups that wrangle over biodiversity forget the intricate clan system that had the same understanding of human genetics.

The co-author of the book that predicted President Barack Obama's rise to power, The Emerging Democratic Majority, has left the Center for American Progress (CAP) for the American Enterprise Institute (AEI).

Why is Ruy Teixeira leaving the most prominent liberal think tank for a conservative one?

"It's class," Teixeira told Michael Schaffer.

"I would say that anybody who has a fundamentally class-oriented perspective, who thinks that's a more important lens and doesn't assume that any disparity is automatically a lens of racism or sexism or what have you ... I think that perspective is not congenial in most left institutions," Teixeira said.

Teixeira went on to recount how his idea to start a "Bobby Kennedy Project" that would appeal to the black and white working class together was ignored by CAP. *"We did have some conversations with people in and*

around the foundation world, and nobody wanted to touch it," Teixeira said. *"People were leery of talking about the white working class, as if it was de facto racist."*

The antipathy white educated elites like those at CAP have for the white working class is well-documented. One recent paper found that white college-educated people have far more bias against less-educated whites than they did against any other group.

The reason for the antipathy is simple: Today's Democratic Party believes that unequal outcomes only exist because of racism or sexism. If white people are poor or uneducated, therefore, it must be their own fault.

This bias against the white working

class has made it tempting for Democrats to write off these voters entirely. *"For every blue-collar Democrat we lose in western Pennsylvania,"* Majority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) famously said in 2016, *"we will pick up two moderate Republicans in the suburbs in Philadelphia, and you can repeat that in Ohio and Illinois and Wisconsin."*

Unfortunately for the Democrats, Schumer's math doesn't add up. More than 6 in 10 people do not have a college degree.

Until Democrats stop making every issue about race, expect them to lose more working-class voters and more scholars who focus on working-class issues, like Teixeira.

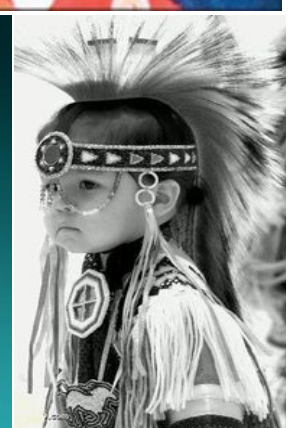

WOODLAND, CA — The Commission on Native Children
will hold its Pacific Regional Hearing in Woodland, CA
August 25–26, 2022 at the California Tribal College, and
virtually. The prior regional hearing was held in June 2022
in Bismarck, ND.

The Alyce Spotted Bear and Walter Soboleff Commission
on Native Children was established by Congress as an
independent federal entity charged with conducting a
comprehensive study of federal, state, local, and tribal
programs and developing recommendations on solutions
that would improve the health, safety, and well-being of
Native Children.

The Commission will examine the unique challenges Native
children face and make recommendations on improving
the current system by building on the strengths and
leadership of Native communities, with the goal of
developing a sustainable system that delivers effective,
culturally appropriate, meaningful wrap-around services to
Native children.

“For too long, in spite of their resilience and rich heritage,
the life experiences of Native children have been
disproportionately marred by poverty, child abuse,
domestic violence, crime, and substance abuse; it is our
job, as Commissioners, to do all we can to change those

circumstances for our youngest and most vulnerable Native people,” said Commission Carlyle Begay.

The Pacific Regional Hearing is currently scheduled to be held simultaneously in-person and virtually on August 25 and 26. During the two days of the Regional Hearing, the Commission will hear from respected researchers and experts in the region on the successes and challenges in supporting Native children on four key topics:

1. Physical, mental, and behavioral health;
2. Education and early childhood development;
3. Child welfare, juvenile justice, and violence; and
4. Systems innovations and best practices in Native communities.

The Commission also invites Native children, their families, tribal leaders, and community members to share their thoughts on issues that are important to protecting Native children served in the various communities following the panel on August 26.
