sponding to a Virginia lawsuit, the Department of Defense amended its existing policy on service by personnel diagnosed with the human immunodeficiency virus.

Earlier this year, the Army

chose to abandon its gender-neutral combat fitness test that it had spent over a decade preparing over concerns that the test did not produce equitable results between men and women.

This is not the first time the Biden administration has amended its military policies in the name of greater inclusion.

Along with discarding the test, the Army also weakened the test standards, allowing soldiers four more minutes to complete the 2-mile run and pass. Now a soldier can complete 2 miles in 22 minutes and still pass.

These changes are part of a larger trend.

In 2021, the Air Force moved to strike both college grade point average and previous flying experience-two elements that accurately predict how well a student will perform-from its flight school candidate screening process in order to increase the diversity of the force.

With a historically low 0.3% washout rate for performance in flight school, those two pre-screening elements were the last real quality control measures not just for candidates applying to be pilots, but in the entire pilot production process.

In still another example of the pursuit of equity and inclusion over readiness, in 2021 the Biden administration amended existing policy to allow unrestricted service by transgender personnel without regard to whether they suffer from gender dysphoria, a condition that can, as medical evidence has conclusively demonstrated, leave individu-

als with a higher risk of mental injury and disability.

Transgender individuals suffering from gender dysphoria have been found to suffer severe anxiety and attempt suicide at rates nine times those of the general population.

On a battlefield where stress and danger skyrocket, this change by the Biden administration not only hinders military readiness, but also puts personnel with gender dysphoria in greater danger.

The implementation of policy such as this, alongside other diversity- and equity-focused reforms within the Defense Department, has only served to erode public trust in the military over recent vears.

Whether it be the changing standards for individuals infected with HIV, or those suffering from gender dysphoria, or the abandonment of the proposed Army fitness test, Americans should be concerned by the Biden administration and Defense Department's recent string of decisions in the name of equi-

By placing diversity and equity above all in recruitment and inclusion efforts, the Defense Department and the Biden administration have only created the conditions for deteriorating combat readiness, potential increased personnel shortfalls, and growing mistrust between the military and those it serves.

James Gessner Jr., chairman of the Mohegan Tribe, said the appointment is well-deserved.

"This appointment is an honor for her and for our tribe," Gessner said. "The Mohegan Tribe and its members have benefited tremendously from the leadership of Chief Lynn Malerba, and we are thrilled that she will now bring her expertise, energy, and compassion to the role of Treasurer of the United States.

The following is an overview of the propose legislation:

AB 2022 (Ramos) Requires the term "squaw" to be removed from all geographic features and place names in the state beginning January 1, 2024, and creates a process that requires the CA Advisory Committee on Geographic Names within the CA Natural Resources Agency to choose a replacement name if local bodies fail to do so within a specified time frame.

"The Quad': Four 'Real Deal' GOP Mexican Women Who Pledge to Fight for the 'American Dream'



As four Latina GOP women, dubbed "The Quad." celebrate political victories, "Outnumbered" co-host Kayleigh McEnany is calling them the "real deal" despite being ignored by the Democratic Party.

"The Quad" is a spinoff name that is politically the polar opposite of the farleft progressive group "The Squad." Should the two groups face off, it promises to be explosive.

"These are the real deal here," McEnany asserted on Wednesday. "It's the year of the Latina Republican women. I couldn't be more pumped about it."


The members of "The Quad" include Yesli Vega (R-Va.), Mayra Flores (R-Texas), Cassy Garcia (R-Texas), and Monica De La Cruz (R-Texas), all of whom are of Hispanic descent.



Vega cemented her GOP nomination for Virginia's Seventh Congressional District Tuesday night. She is a former deputy sheriff and a military spouse who beat out five other Republicans who had more money and name recognition than she did.





"A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed"





By 2020, there are about 3.5 more suicides per 100,000 people ages 12 to 23 in states with easier access than in states without an access provision.

This research confirms the findings of several other extensive studies, most of which were conducted in Europe, on the matter of "gender-reassignment" interventions and procedures.

A study from Sweden, for example, followed hundreds of gender-confused persons over the course of 30 years and found that those who underwent medical transition were 20 times more likely to kill themselves than those who didn't.

Another British review of more than 100 follow-up studies of those who medically transitioned found that "none

ficial for patients." In most of the examined studies, the researchers said, the patients who underwent medical intervention showed signs of decreasing mental stability and happiness rather than improvement.

So why is it that almost every one of our major institutions, from prestigious medical and academic associations like the American Academy of Pediatrics to the Department of Health and Human Services, has endorsed "genderaffirming care" and all of its consequences without question?

Perhaps because, despite what they claim, they don't care at all about the long-term health and happiness of the young adults being swept away by transgenderism. They have an ideology to uphold — and that's all that matters.


