## U.S. Congress Passes “Red Flag Gun Law”





## Military readiness takes back seat to wokeness at the Pentagon

**Military readiness** appears to have suffered yet another setback in the name of **"equity."**

Earlier this month, responding to a **Virginia lawsuit**, the Department of Defense amended its existing policy on service by personnel diagnosed with the human immunodeficiency virus.

Earlier this year, the Army chose to **abandon its gender-neutral combat fitness test** that it had spent over a decade preparing over concerns that the test did not produce equitable results between men and women.

**This is not the first time** the Biden administration has amended its military policies in the name of greater inclusion.

**Along with discarding the test**, the Army also weakened the test standards, allowing soldiers four more minutes to complete the 2-mile run and pass. Now a soldier can complete 2 miles in 22 minutes and still pass.

**These changes are part of a larger trend.**

In 2021, the Air Force moved to **strike both college grade point average and previous flying experience**—two elements that accurately predict how well a student will perform—from its flight school candidate screening process in order to increase the diversity of the force.

**With a historically low 0.3% washout rate** for performance in flight school, those two pre-screening elements were the last real quality control measures not just for candidates applying to be pilots, but in the entire pilot production process.

In still another example of the pursuit of equity and inclusion over readiness, in 2021 the **Biden administration amended** existing policy to allow unrestricted service by **transgender personnel without regard to whether they suffer from gender dysphoria**, a condition that can, as medical evidence has conclusively demonstrated, leave individu-

als with a higher risk of mental injury and disability.

**Transgender individuals suffering from gender dysphoria** have been found to suffer severe anxiety and attempt suicide at rates nine times those of the general population.

**On a battlefield** where stress and danger skyrocket, this change by the Biden administration not only hinders military readiness, but also puts personnel with gender dysphoria in greater danger.

**The implementation** of policy such as this, alongside other diversity- and equity-focused reforms within the Defense Department, has only served to erode public trust in the military over recent years.

Whether it be the changing standards for individuals infected with HIV, or those suffering from gender dysphoria, or the abandonment of the proposed Army fitness test, **Americans should be concerned** by the Biden administration and Defense Department's recent string of decisions in the name of equity.

**By placing diversity and equity** above all in recruitment and inclusion efforts, the Defense Department and the Biden administration have only **created the conditions for deteriorating combat readiness**, potential increased personnel shortfalls, and growing mistrust between the military and those it serves.

And the absurdity continues as West Point Cadets are forced to attend critical race theory classes.



## More Insanity from the Socialist State of California: Use Taxpayers Money to Train Illegal Immigrants

Ok, for the record for you nit pickers and wokers,' illegal immigrants and undocumented workers are synonymous. The point is how can the state legislators justify spending public funds for the benefit of "criminals" that enables them to continue to break federal immigration laws? How is this even legal?

Prohibits EDD from seeking information from employers to verify applicant eligibility. (*Federal law requires that employers obtain proof of eligibility to work.*)

Requires EDD to report to the Governor and Legislature by January 1, 2025, with **recommendations for making the program permanent**.

# U.S. Supreme Court Upholds Tribal Sovereignty

The Supreme Court issued a 5-4 decision Wednesday morning, allowing Ysleta Del Sur Pueblo, located near El Paso, Texas, to offer electronic bingo at its gaming facility.

Conservative Justice Neil Gorsuch wrote the opinion for the court and was joined by fellow conservative Justice Amy Coney Barrett and the three liberal justices to form the majority opinion.

*"In this case, Texas contends that Congress expressly ordained that all of its gaming laws should be treated as surrogate federal law enforceable on the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo Reservation. In the end, however, we find no evidence Congress endowed state law with anything like the power Texas claims,"* Gorsuch wrote.

While the decision is a victory in a decades-long fight for the Ysleta Del Sur Pueblo, Gorsuch added that it does not mean it can add any gaming activity it wishes; but that the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals, *"erred in their understanding of the Restoration Act."*

*"Under that law's terms, if a gaming activity is prohibited by Texas law it is also prohibited on tribal land as a matter of federal law. Other gaming activities are subject to tribal regulation and must conform with the terms and conditions set forth in federal law, including IGRA to the extent it is applicable,"* the opinion reads.

There are still multiple cases related to Indian Country that have yet to have opinions released, including one on the Indian Child Welfare Act and another dealing with fallout from the landmark *McGirt* case.

One Twitter user noted, Coney Barrett joining this coalition of justices is a big deal and could affect the outcomes of other federal Indian law cases the court has yet to rule on.

*"Not only was it likely the swing vote here, but it is also suggests that she's a fifth vote to \*reaffirm\* (rather than overrule) the 5-4 McGirt decision from 2020,"* Steve Vladeck tweeted.



Chief Lynn Malerba, Mutáwi Mutáhash (Many Hearts), Mohegan Tribe, has been named as President Joe Biden's appointment to be the next U.S. Treasurer – the first Indigenous person to hold that position. The appointment no longer needs to be confirmed by the U.S. Senate.

*"I am honored and humbled by Secretary (Janet) Yellen and the Biden Administration's commitment to ensuring that all voices are heard by Treasury as we work together to create an equitable and just society," Malerba said in a press release. "It is especially important that our Native voices are respected. This appointment underscores this Administration's commitment to doing just that. I am excited to serve our communities as Treasurer and for the work ahead."*

James Gessner Jr., chairman of the Mohegan Tribe, said the appointment is well-deserved.

*"This appointment is an honor for her and for our tribe," Gessner said. "The Mohegan Tribe and its members have benefited tremendously from the leadership of Chief Lynn Malerba, and we are thrilled that she will now bring her expertise, energy, and compassion to the role of Treasurer of the United States."*

*"Her appointment is another positive step by the Biden administration to show inclusiveness with Native Americans and ensure we have a seat at the table of the federal government," Gessner said. "We congratulate Lynn on this incredible appointment. The Nation will be stronger with her serving in the administration."*

Treasury officials also announced the creation of the Office of Tribal Native Affairs, which will be overseen by Malerba. The office will communicate

directly with tribes and be a hub for tribal policy.

**Malerba comes from a long line of Mohegan leadership.** Her mother holds the position of Tribal Nommer, an elder female of respect, and her great-grandfather was Chief Matagha.

In 2010, Malerba was appointed the Lifelong Chief of the Mohegan Tribe and the first woman in the tribe's modern history to hold that role.

She also served as chairwoman of her tribal council and as executive director of the tribe's Health and Human Services.

Malerba currently sits on the Board of Trustees for the Chelsea Groton Bank, which has more than a dozen banks across Connecticut in 10 different cities. She is chair of the Tribal Self-

Governance Advisory Committee of Indian Health Service, a member of the U.S. Department of Justice's Tribal Nations Leadership Council, a member of the Tribal Advisory Committee for the National Institute of Health, and a member of the U.S. Treasury's Tribal Advisory Committee.

*"I am deeply honored that Chief Malerba will serve as the nation's Treasurer and spearhead the department's new Office of Tribal and Native Affairs. This is an historic appointment," Yellen said. "Her leadership and experience will deepen our commitment to help expand economic opportunities for all Tribal communities."*

Malerba graduated from Yale University with a doctorate in nursing practice. Prior to being a tribal leader, Malerba was a registered nurse and worked her

way up to becoming the director of Cardiology and Pulmonary Services at Lawrence & Memorial Hospital.

**Fawn Sharp, president** of the National Congress of American Indians, applauded Biden's choice.

*"There is much work to be done to enhance economic development opportunities, achieve governmental tax parity for Tribal Nations, and address Indian Country's capital needs," Sharp said. "The creation of this office and Chief Malerba's pending appointment are truly historic and positive steps toward these goals. The importance of Native American leadership, partnership, and representation within the Department of the Treasury cannot be overstated."*

## The term "Squaw" to be Removed from all Public Lands

Ramos is a tribal member of the San Manual Band of Mission Indians and the first and only California American Indian to serve in the state legislator.

The following is an overview of the propose legislation:

**AB 2022 (Ramos)** Requires the term "squaw" to be removed from all geographic features and place names in the state beginning January 1, 2024, and creates a process that requires the CA Advisory Committee on Geographic Names within the CA Natural Resources Agency to choose a replacement name if local bodies fail to do so within a specified time frame.



## “The Quad”: Four ‘Real Deal’ GOP Mexican Women Who Pledge to Fight for the ‘American Dream’




As four Latina GOP women, dubbed “The Quad,” celebrate political victories, “Outnumbered” co-host Kayleigh McEnany is calling them the “real deal” despite being ignored by the Democratic Party.

“The Quad” is a spinoff name that is politically the polar opposite of the far-left progressive group “The Squad.” Should the two groups face off, it promises to be explosive.

“These are the real deal here,” McEnany asserted on Wednesday. “It’s the year of the Latina Republican women. I couldn’t be more pumped about it.”

The members of “The Quad” include Yesli Vega (R-Va.), Mayra Flores (R-Texas), Cassy Garcia (R-Texas), and Monica De La Cruz (R-Texas), all of whom are of Hispanic descent.

Vega cemented her GOP nomination for Virginia’s Seventh Congressional District Tuesday night. She is a former deputy sheriff and a military spouse who beat out five other Republicans who had more money and name recognition than she did.

“Vega is the fourth Latina to win a primary this election season, highlighting the growing trend of Hispanic voters shifting to the GOP which could pose a real problem for Democrats heading into midterms and beyond,” McEnany noted. “We are calling them ‘The Quad,’ not ‘The Squad.’”

Fellow co-host Carley Shimkus was ecstatic over the wins, claiming that she “eagerly await[s] to see the group shot on the cover of Vogue for breaking a glass ceiling.”



“Something tells me that’s not going to happen,” she mused. Shimkus thoroughly agreed with McEnany that the wins are indicative of the majority of Hispanic voters who are “swinging right.”

“Look at the president’s approval rating within the Hispanic community,” she pointed out. “It’s 26%. I think it’s because Democrats have become so extreme that it’s peeling a lot of Hispanics away and towards the Republican Party.”

Mayra Flores has become a thorn in the side of Democrats already after she cinched her win and was sworn in on Tuesday, becoming Texas’ first Republican Latina to join Congress. Her victory has thrown open the floodgates for Latina women on the right and the left is petrified over it. She flipped a historically solid blue district red with her win.

“What does it mean exactly? How did you do this? It would have been unimaginable ten years ago,” Carlson told Flores.



“Honestly, I just focused on the issues that really mattered to my district. And, you know, we’re all about faith, family, and hard work. That’s exactly who we are,” she replied.

“Yeah, but I mean it was an overwhelmingly Democratic district, so...” Carlson continued.

“Yeah, but you know, we didn’t have the funding before. We didn’t have the funding before to get the message across our district and now we do have the funding and the support from the Republican Party. But prior to 2020, we did not have that support. We were all alone,” Flores charged.

“You know, the Democrat Party took us for granted and we also did not have the support from the Republican Party. And, you know, that’s a fact,” she asserted.

“Yeah, nobody thought it was possible,” Carlson responded.

Flores went on to say that she was born in Mexico and was raised with strong conservative values. That’s why she’s Republican. She claims she’s not willing to put aside those values for a political party. She also says she’s not loyal to a party. She’s loyal to God, her family, and her community.

“I tell the people in South Texas, ‘Who are you loyal to? Are you loyal to God or are you loyal to the Democrat Party?’ And they tell me, ‘No, I’m loyal to God.’ Okay, well, let’s stop being loyal to a party that has done nothing for us for over a hundred years,” Flores proclaimed, expressing exactly why the



Democrats are in big trouble come the November midterms.

As Flores proudly declared her love of God and Christian beliefs, Carlson found it incredibly refreshing and said he loved it.



The cast includes Northern California people from Pit River, Maidu, Miwok, Hoopa, Yurok, Karuk and Nisenan Nations, and will star many Native actors of Yaqui, Mohawk, Quechan,

**RISE and On Native Ground** have two decades of collaboration with Native youth and communities. Their creative and audience-appealing prevention films have screened on PBS stations, the FXN channel, Native conferences and film festivals across the globe.

Both organizations were founded on a need for our younger generation to find meaningful learning strategies and to own a positive focus through culture and community. Film sets were adult workplaces with valid concerns for child actors that demanded formal regulations to the industry.

All twenty RISE youth were screened for entertainment work permits, and supervised on set by a Placer County theater/studio teacher and RISE staff throughout their performances.

Youth had pivotal roles and speaking parts during a full week of fight choreography, a jiu jitsu tournament and group home scenes. While none are launching into a film career, a few secondary students were identified by pro-

The 2nd Amendment was ratified on December 17, 1791, along with the other nine amendments that make up the **Bill of Rights**.


While it is a very short amendment, its exact meaning in terms of what types of weapons are protected and what constitutes a well-regulated militia is still in contention today.



## American Indian Tribes Awarded Funding To Build Tribal Capacity & Create or Expand Tribal Language Preservation Programs.

The Bureau of Indian Affairs Makes Significant Investment to Protect and Preserve Native Languages With Living Languages Grants Assistant Secretary for Indian Affairs Bryan Newland announced today that the Indian Affairs Office of Indian Economic Development has awarded \$7 million in grants under the Living Languages Grant Program to 45 American Indian and Alaska Native Tribes and Tribal organizations.

The Living Languages Grant Program provides an opportunity for Tribes to receive funding to document and revitalize languages that are at risk of disappearing because of a declining native speaker population. For more than 150 years, Native languages in the U.S. have been subjected to suppression and elimination from a variety of factors

such as federal boarding and other types of schools that forced American Indian, Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian children to forgo speaking the language of their peoples.

*“Native language preservation has for many years been cited by Indigenous leaders as important to their self-preservation, self-determination and sovereignty. Native preservation and language revitalization is a critical priority because languages go to the heart of a Tribe’s unique cultural identities, traditions, spiritual beliefs and self-governance,”* said Assistant Secretary Newland.

*“Through the Living Languages Grant Program and other interagency efforts, the Biden-Harris administration is working to invest in and strengthen the*

*nation-to-nation relationship and ensure that progress in Indian Country endures for years to come.”*

Native language preservation is a priority for the Biden-Harris administration and its all in for a government approach to strengthening and supporting Indigenous communities. During the 2021 White House Tribal Nations Summit in November 2021, the U.S. Departments of the Interior, Education and Health and Human Services launched a new interagency initiative to preserve, protect and promote the rights and freedom of Native Americans to use, practice and develop Native languages.

The program evaluated 59 applications, totaling \$9.37 million in requests, to support Tribal programs that document

Native American languages or build Tribal capacity to create or expand language preservation programs.

Grant proposals were rated on the extent to which funding would document, preserve or revitalize a Native language; the degree to which the language addressed by a proposal risks extinction; the likelihood that the instruction to be funded would revitalize the language by preventing intergenerational disruption; and the number of students or percentage of Tribal members the proposal would benefit.

While only federally recognized Tribes and Tribal organizations are eligible for the Living Languages Grant Program, grantees can retain for-profit and non-profit community groups to perform a grant’s scope of work.

## Gender ideology's fatal consequences

A common accusation from transgender advocates is that those who disagree with and oppose gender ideology are endangering the lives of gender-confused persons, especially young adults. Deny these youths the care they need, including puberty blockers and other irreversible medical interventions, and they’ll be at a much higher risk for suicide than their peers — or so the argument goes.

A new study from the Heritage Foundation, however, proves the exact opposite: Children and adolescents who are exposed to so-called “gender-affirming care” are actually at a much greater risk of suicidal thoughts and attempts than those who are not.

From the study:

In the past several years, the suicide rate among those ages 12 to 23 has become significantly *higher* in states that

have a provision that allows minors to receive routine health care without parental consent than in states without such a provision. Before 2010, these two groups of states did not differ in their youth suicide rates. Starting in 2010, when puberty blockers and cross-sex hormones became widely available, elevated suicide rates in states where minors can more easily access those medical interventions became observable.

Rather than being protective against suicide, this pattern indicates that easier access by minors to cross-sex medical interventions without parental consent is associated with higher risk of suicide.

Without making any adjustments, suicide rates among those ages 12 to 23 (blue line) begin to spike in states that have provisions that allow minors to access health care without parental consent relative to states that have no such

provision around 2016, after cross-sex medical interventions became more common.

By 2020, there are about 3.5 more suicides per 100,000 people ages 12 to 23 in states with easier access than in states without an access provision.

This research confirms the findings of several other extensive studies, most of which were conducted in Europe, on the matter of “gender-reassignment” interventions and procedures.

A study from Sweden, for example, followed hundreds of gender-confused persons over the course of 30 years and found that those who underwent medical transition were 20 times more likely to kill themselves than those who didn’t.

Another British review of more than 100 follow-up studies of those who medically transitioned found that “none

of the studies provides conclusive evidence that gender reassignment is beneficial for patients.” In most of the examined studies, the researchers said, the patients who underwent medical intervention showed signs of decreasing mental stability and happiness rather than improvement.

So why is it that almost every one of our major institutions, from prestigious medical and academic associations like the American Academy of Pediatrics to the Department of Health and Human Services, has endorsed “gender-affirming care” and all of its consequences without question?

Perhaps because, despite what they claim, they don’t care at all about the long-term health and happiness of the young adults being swept away by transgenderism. They have an ideology to uphold — and that’s all that matters.




