California Democratic Party opposes out-of-state corporate online sports betting measure

State Democrats stand with tribes, say Proposition 27 an assault on tribal sovereignty

Californians for Tribal Sovereignty and Safe Gaming

At their July Executive Board Meeting, the California Democratic Party (CDP) officially voted to Oppose Proposition 27, the out of state corporate online sports betting ballot measure. The California Young Democrats also voted over the weekend to oppose Proposition 27.

"[On July 10] the California Democratic Party overwhelmingly voted to oppose Prop 27," said California Democratic Party Chair Rusty Hicks. "We stand with California's Native American tribes and reject this threat to their tribal sovereignty. Together, we can send a clear message to out of state corporations who seek to exploit California's initiative process for their own gain. The California Democratic Party will connect with 10 million Democrats to defeat Prop 27 in November."

"There is no question that Proposition 27 is an assault on tribal sovereignty," said California Democratic Party Native American Caucus First Vice Chair Dr. Joely Proudfit. "Proposition 27 threatens decades of progress for California's Indians, erodes Tribal sovereignty and threatens the future economic sustainability of California's Indigenous people."

The California Democratic Party and the California Young Democrats join local Democratic parties; the California Teachers Association; veterans' organizations; health groups; housing and homeless advocates; community, civil rights, and local government groups; public safety organizations; business organizations; dozens of local elected officials and more than 50 Native American tribes in opposition to Proposition 27.

The National Education Association announces its priorities for teachers: “Abortion and LGBTQ agenda”

Delegates pledge the union to “political campaigns ... and other actions”

Delegates to the National Education Association convention have pledged the allegiance of public school teachers across the nation to the extreme leftist agendas of the abortion industry and the LGBT identity campaign.

A report in Decision Magazine explained the *NEA* "continued its descent into left-wing political and social engineering during its national convention this week."

The vote was by a more than 3-to-1 margin to promotion abortion and LGBT identity choices to students.

"NEA delegates committed the union to 'publicly stand in defense of abortion and reproductive rights and encourage members to participate in ... rallies and demonstrations, lobbying and political campaigns, educational events, and other actions ..." said a social media statement from Mike Antonucci on the teachers' blog called "The 74."

Explained Decision, *"The convention of the nation's largest teacher's union reportedly drew some 6,000 delegates to Chicago, where, Antonucci wrote on*

his blog, many of the decisions are all but determined by NEA's staff and board officers. Delegates can raise business items and resolutions, but the 6,000 delegates represent a tiny slice of the NEA's 3 million members."

Said Meg Kilgannon, of the Family Research Council, *"This organization has a left-leaning political agenda that they are very proud of and that they will support to the bitter end."*

She said *"...the leftist ideology is being pushed on children at the expense of their education."*

Tony Perkins, of the FRC, pointed out, *"If they're saying this in public, what are they doing in the classroom?"*

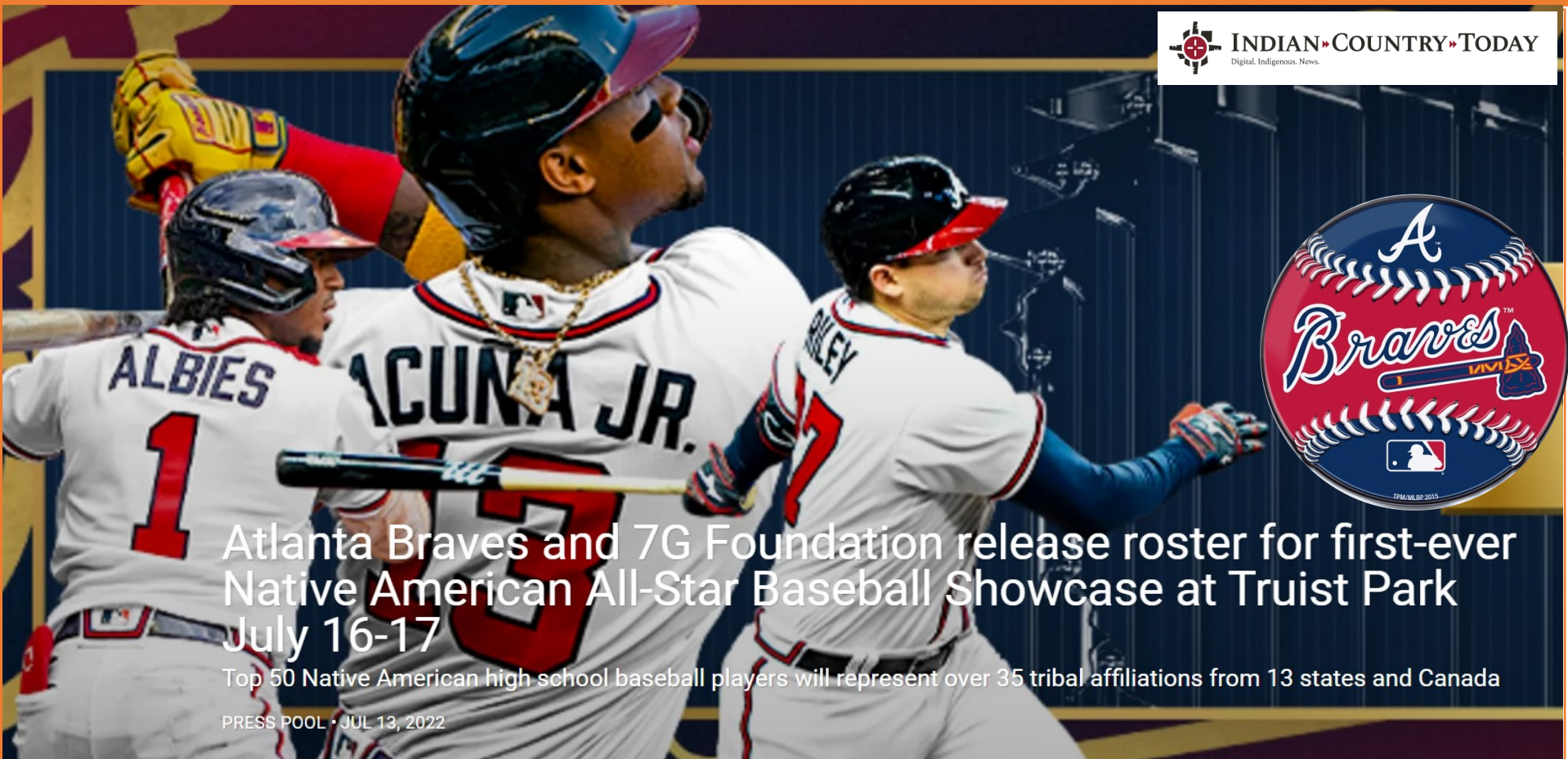

MAUI WOMAN ON THE HOME STRETCH IN QUEST FOR VIETNAM VETERAN PHOTOS

Janna Hoehn down to final six photos for memorial wall after 11 years of searching

It was just about 11 years ago to this date that Janna Hoehn combed through yearbooks at the old Maui High School campus, focused on finding photos of some of the 42 Maui Vietnam War veterans killed in the conflict.

In six months she succeeded.

But that wasn't enough for the Launiupoko resident, who went on to post more than 8,000 photos — some 5,000 she found on her own — to *"The Wall of Faces" online memorial, where the goal is to feature a photo of the approximately 58,300 names inscribed on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C.*

Hoehn said on Thursday that she has actually stopped counting the photos that she and her volunteer friends have found through yearbooks, obituaries, internet searches, visiting and writing to government organizations, contacting families and even knocking on people's doors.

Hoehn, a freelance floral designer, said she would have never imagined 11 years ago that she would still be working on the project and uncovering thousands of photos from across the country.

She has also gathered awards locally and nationally for her efforts along the way.

In 2011, Hoehn was asked by the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund to handle gathering photos from Maui, so she did.

"I felt I would be so thrilled when I got it done and I was. I enjoyed meeting the families and everything, I didn't want it to end," she said looking back.

Volunteers in other states also took on the same monumental task, with some finding thousands of photos.

And through efforts by volunteers along with veterans associations across the nation and others, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund's Wall of Faces is just shy of six photos.

"Can you really believe we are finally down to needing six photos?" Hoehn asked.

Three veterans are from New York — Roger Brown (June 13, 1949 to April 9, 1969), Steven Brian Calhoun (Feb. 12, 1947 to May 18, 1969) and Hector Da-

vid Oyola (April 13, 1949 to Aug. 14, 1970); two veterans are from Puerto Rico — Juan Ortiz-Rivera (June 24, 1942 to Dec. 28, 1967) and Jaime Rodriguez-Rivera (Aug. 27, 1948 to April 27, 1970); and one veteran is from Michigan — Saul Zayas (March 24, 1949 to Feb. 3, 1968).

Hoehn said finding photos from New York has been tough as the state's libraries do not carry high school yearbooks and most newspapers there, especially in the city, have turned down her requests for stories to be done about the effort.

Newspapers and other publications are Hoehn's go-to tactic for getting widespread attention in various communities where she is searching for photos.

"It has been 11 years since (The Maui News) did my first story," she said. *"You kept on doing a little story, showing my progress and who I still needed. There is no way I would have finished Maui if it hadn't been for you guys."*

Other small hometown papers have also contributed to her success.

Hoehn has also done podcasts, which have also brought in valuable volunteers and photos.

Finding photos from Puerto Rico has also been challenging, as Hurricane Maria in 2017 caused widespread damage, destroying homes, buildings and personal items, all of which could have contained those precious photos.

Hoehn said that one volunteer in Puerto Rico is trying to help, but the woman is afraid to venture into a town that is unsafe to explore.

Looking back, all of Hoehn's efforts stemmed from a visit to the nation's capital years ago when she stopped at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall. She did not know anyone who died in the war but randomly chose a name, made a rubbing from the wall and brought it home as a memento. Hoping to find a photograph to add to her scrapbook, she did some research and found nothing.

Tapping her cousin with genealogy skills, they were able to find a photograph of the veteran. After learning about the national project to collect photographs of fallen Vietnam service

members, she sent her photo to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund. The organization thanked her and asked her to help with the effort on Maui.

Once done on Maui, she then went on to search for photos in her home state of California and also picked up the task to find all the photos for Hawaii.

She remembers she was in high school in Hemet, Calif. when the war was going on and she saw the bad treatment the veterans suffered. She said *"it disturbed me greatly" and "I was only 18 years old."*

Hoehn also had a cousin who fought in the war, came back and *"was never the same person again."*

He died when he was 63 years old from exposure to Agent Orange, a chemical used by the military in the war.

Hoehn wrote to this cousin once a week while he was away at war, and about every month she would get a letter in a red, white and blue air mail envelope.

Her cousin never really spoke about the war but was more concerned about Hoehn. This, too, left an impression on her.

HARD WORK AND A LITTLE LUCK

Over the years, the dates and names of the thousands of photos of veterans Hoehn has encountered through her experience may be fuzzy, but she does have some more notable recollections of her journey, some of which were serendipitous.

She remembers once visiting a Texas home with another volunteer about two weeks after a story about her efforts ran in the Dallas Morning News.

Hoehn recalled she was excited seeing cars outside the home, hoping it was the veteran's surviving family. She approached a windowless door, and the man inside opened it, no questions asked, saying, *"Well, hi, come on in."*

Puzzled, Hoehn asked the man, *"Do you want to know who I am?"*

"I know who you are," the man said, referring to the newspaper story.

He said his sister was supposed to contact Hoehn with his brother's photo but had forgotten.

"He invited us in and ... there was a whole corner in their living room dedicated to their brother. It had his uniform, his hat, his flag, tons of pictures. And all I did was just took pictures with my cellphone of all the pictures."

The man's mother was still alive but in a nursing home. But the son said his mother was so *"ecstatic about this project."* He also offered Hoehn and her family a place to stay if they were in Texas again.

"I've met these kinds of people all over the United States, just knocking on a door," she said.

Another experience Hoehn will not forget is how she found four remaining photos of fallen veterans in Santa Cruz, Calif.

A historian wrote a book about the veterans in the area and had found 32 of 36 photos. But the last four were elusive for years. She contacted the historian, who was skeptical she could find the last four.

"Good luck, honey," the historian told her.

A local paper ran a story of Hoehn's efforts in Santa Cruz and about two weeks later she was contacted by a man who lived in Illinois or Indiana. The man provided one of the photos they were looking for.

"My heart stopped, it was one of the four," she said.

Hoehn said the man told her he is a truck driver and had to take a load to Santa Cruz. He ate at a diner and picked up the newspaper with her story.

"I'm going to myself, What are the chances that man would be in Santa Cruz the day my story came out?" Hoehn asked.

She later found the three remaining photos and sent them all to the historian.

"That is just one of my favorite stories and I got lots of them like that," she said.

Joe “The Big Guy” Biden Sold American Strategic Reserve Oil to a Chinese company that Hunter Biden is a Partner.

President had promised to free up Strategic Reserve oil to help American consumers

There really seems to be no limit to the convolutions that develop when the Biden family works on its international business schemes.

Probably one of the most famous was when Joe Biden was vice president and traveled to Ukraine for Barack Obama. At that time Hunter Biden was taking in tens of thousands of dollars a month from a Ukrainian company under investigation for corruption.

Joe came to the rescue, ordering officials there to fire the prosecutor, threatening to withhold \$1 billion in scheduled U.S. aid if they didn't.

A Chinese company in which Hunter Biden has interests, the report said.

It's through Hunter Biden's links to Sinopec, in which he, through an equity firm, previously bought a \$1.7 billion stake.

The report explained Joe Biden *"sold roughly one million barrels from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve to a Chinese state-controlled gas giant that continues to purchase Russian oil."*

The sale was to Unipecc, the trading arm of the China Petrochemical Corporation, also known as Sinopec, which is owned by the Chinese Communist government.

"The Biden administration also claimed the Unipecc sale would 'support American consumers and the global economy in response to Vladimir Putin's war of choice against Ukraine' and combat Putin's price hike," the report said.

That's even though most of the gasoline price inflation Americans are suffering under now happened before the Russian conflict with Ukraine, and was triggered by Joe Biden's extreme opposition to fossil fuels.

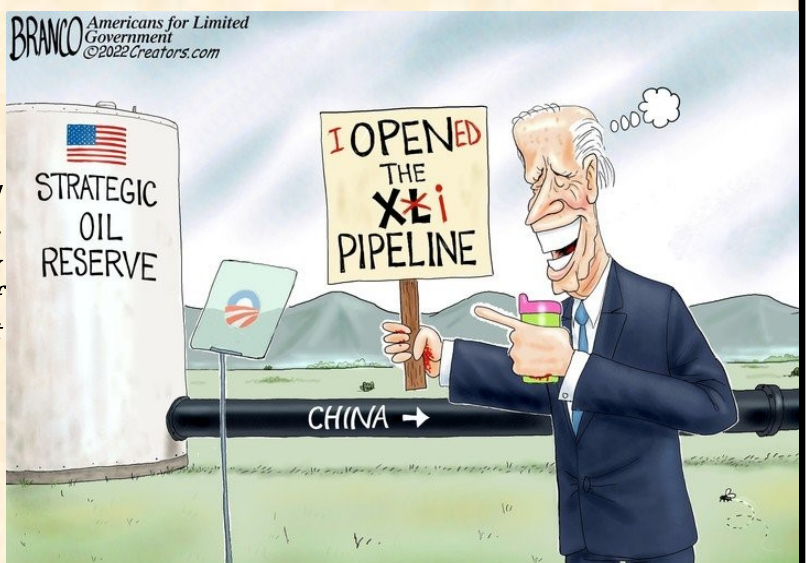
Power the Future founder Daniel Turner pointed out, *"We were assured Biden was releasing this oil to America so it could be refined for gasoline to drive down prices at the pump. So right off the bat, they're just lying to the American people."*

"What they're saying they did and what they did are not remotely related."

He also highlighted Hunter Biden's links to Sinopac.

The report explained, *"Biden campaigned heavily against the oil and gas industry in 2020, promising to 'end fossil fuel.'"* He went on to cancel the Keystone XL pipeline and implement a moratorium on new gas leases on federal land during his first month in office.

Biden's energy secretary, meanwhile, is working with left-wing activists who want to eliminate fossil fuels, and in late October, House Oversight and Reform Committee Democrats pushed top oil executives to produce less gas due to climate change.

Turner charged, *"This is disturbing on multiple levels. To start with, the president told us he was releasing these reserves to lower the price of gas nationally. And then you find out that he, through Secretary Granholm of the Department of Energy, is selling them around on the world market and selling them to the communist Chinese. So, 'A,' we're selling our strategic raw materials, our strategic reserves to the communist country [that's] our adversary. And then you find out one of the companies that was brokering this deal — one of [its] top investors is, of course, Hunter Biden."*

He continued, *"So... the president's reprobate crack-head son is invested in a company that is buying our strategic reserves, while we're paying more than \$5 a gallon at the pump. We had an impeachment hearing about a phone call with Donald Trump and President Zelenskyy. IRS packing serious ammunition, now Republicans look to ban it

Congressman: Agency shouldn't be 'emptying Glock clips on our fellow Americans'

The Internal Revenue Service has been up to some questionable stunts in recent years, like the time during Barack Obama's presidency that officials there targeted Christian and Tea Party groups because of their names, and wouldn't let them register.

That effectively prevented them from commenting on Obama's run for a second term, of course, and the government later paid millions for its misbehavior.

But now several members of Congress have a larger concern about the IRS: the fact that it buys thousands of rounds of ammunition every year.

Just the News says the plan from GOP Reps. Matt Gaetz, Marjorie Taylor Greene, Jeff Duncan and Paul Gosar would, effectively, disarm the tax agency.

Specifically, it would prohibit the IRS from acquiring any ammunition.

The bill itself seems pretty comprehensive, stating, *"Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Internal Revenue*

Service may not acquire (by purchase or otherwise) any ammunition..."

Just the News explained, *"The bill arrives following Gaetz's discovery that this year alone the IRS has spent \$725,000 on ammunition. Odd timing, he says, considering the nationwide shortage of ammo and Biden administration's stated animosity toward gun rights."*

He told Fox News recently, *"Here's the Biden plan: Disarm Americans, open the border, empty the prisons - but rest assured, they'll still collect your taxes, and they need \$725,000 worth of ammunition, apparently, to get the job done."*

At American Military News, a report said Gaetz also cited the Railroad Retirement Board and other federal agencies for stockpiling ammo.

"Call me old-fashioned, but I thought the heaviest artillery an IRS agent would need would be a calculator. I imagine the IRS in green eyeshades and cubicles - not busting doors down and emptying Glock clips on our fellow

The real and expansive events of MMIW are told by a cast within an illusory Native community in California.

Gift of Fear is a RISE and On Native Ground project based upon factual events that deal with choices, risks, justice and healing through fictionalized characters. It is an independently financed, fast-paced, action-packed story about a feisty Indigenous teen who fights to achieve justice. But more, it is a film with a social issue message relevant for a mainstream audience.

Native American youth ranged from grades 3rd to 12th from Fall River, Alturas, Surprise Valley and Fort Bidwell and included: Nick Wilson, Dream Gali, Angela Villarreal, Jada Go Forth, Hope Gali, Heaven Maes, Matthew Urban, Samira Go Forth, Haylistorm Gali, Brodie Mudron, Delayna Townsend, Izlee Townsend-Brown, Bella Frago, Haywee Saterstad, Berthea Townsend, Dylan Mudron, Betty George, Ta-Tsa Preston, Naiyeli Maes, Saige Townsend-Brown, Harley Frago and Randi Urban. Staff were Lisa Craig, Paul Cason, Cassandra Gali and Dr. April Lea Go Forth.

RISE and On Native Ground have two decades of collaboration with Native youth and communities. Their creative and audience-appealing prevention films have screened on PBS stations, the FNX channel, Native conferences and film festivals across the globe.

Both organizations were founded on a need for our younger generation to find meaningful learning strategies and to own a positive focus through culture and community. Film sets were adult workplaces with valid concerns for child actors that demanded formal regulations to the industry.

All twenty RISE youth were screened for entertainment work permits, and supervised on set by a Placer County theater/studio teacher and RISE staff throughout their performances.

The cast includes Northern California people from Pit River, Maidu, Miwok, Hoopa, Yurok, Karuk and Nisenan Nations, and will star many Native actors of Yaqui, Mohawk, Quechan, Apache and Lakota heritage.

Lead roles in the film are members of the SAG AFTRA guild and include **Laura Vallejo** of *American Crime Story*, *The Ranch* and *S.W.A.T.*; **Michael Horse** from *Twin Peaks*, *Passenger 57* and *Call of the Wild*; and **Justin Johnson Cortez** with credits of *911 Lonestar*, *Splitting Up Together* and the new *Walker: Independence*.

Another key character is played by professional MMA Brown Belt fighter, **Kola Shippentower Thompson**, who has established a self-defense and safety training for women called the Wisawca Project.

Youth had pivotal roles and speaking parts during a full week of fight choreography, a jiu jitsu tournament and group home scenes. While none are launching into a film career, a few secondary students were identified by producers Katy Dore, Drew Gardella and Jack Kohler for natural talent and skill that would bring them success in the industry.

Production concluded on June 26, 2022 with a climatic scene between the actual REDrum Motorcycle Club and Rollin’ Ranflas of Stockton, shot on location at the historic Auburn Courthouse, in Auburn, CA. Most of the

locations were in Auburn and Lincoln over span of eighteen-days.

An opening scene on location at historic grinding rocks in Lincoln was filmed last October, and used as a “teaser” in hopes of gaining sponsorship for production and distribution of the 110-minute film. LA school district training teachers to ditch ‘white’ concept of ‘merit’ and ‘individualism’

College professor Erec Smith, the co-founder of the nonprofit Free Black Thought organization, is giving the CRT-obsessed and “nightmarish” Los Angeles Unified School District a failing grade for allegedly indoctrinating teachers with the notion that merit and individualism are somehow connected to “whiteness.”

“First of all, I want to thank God that these weren’t my teachers when I was a student,” Smith told “Fox & Friends” co-host Brian Kilmeade on Thursday morning in the video clip embedded above. “I would have nothing, I would have no success, I would be hopeless...merit is not an inherently ‘white’ concept, nor is individuality.”

Smith continued about the divisive and make-believe, oppressor-oppressed agenda: *“One needs to take seriously the Marxist origins of critical race theory, and the need for people to embrace group-think. If you want to enable group-think, you get rid of concepts like merit and individuality, things that can distinguish people, that can separate people from each other. That’s the first thing you do. And that seems to be going on right now.”*

Kilmeade suggested that the premise advanced by the school district seems to be that whites have it easier than minorities. *“For one, I do not want to live in a society without individuality. That is my nightmare,”* the scholar replied.

“We should be able to make choices about what we want to believe, how we want to spend our time and energy — that’s individuality and nothing more. It’s not a selfish lack of compassion.”

In general, “progressive” school districts and teachers’ unions around the country, many of which loved the COVID lockdowns, along with like-

bodied in public school curriculum, and there are also smart people who just happen to be underperforming test-takers or less-than-glib interviewees, reasonable people would agree that the solution to improving outcomes is not about replacing education with left-wing indoctrination that eliminates individual achievement.

the kind of world I want to live in,” he added.

In a sports analogy, Smith said *“you don’t start your least-skilled player because he didn’t have the opportunity to practice like everyone else. You give him the opportunities to practice. And you start your best players so that you can be a successful team. I want America to be a quote-unquote successful team. And in order to do that, we need merit and individuality,”* Smith concluded.

Smith’s group describes itself as *“a small group of scholars, technologists, parents, and above all American citizens determined to amplify vital black voices that are rarely heard on mainstream platforms.”*

Discrimination on the basis of race is illegal under Title VII of the U.S. Civil Rights Act along with a host of other federal, state, and local statutes and regulations.

According to Fox News in a report published on Tuesday, July 5, 2022:

“LAUSD required all employees to undergo ‘implicit/unconscious bias training’ guided by...a critical race theory (CRT) advocate and professor at the University of California, Los Angeles, prior to the 2021-2022 school year. The training materials, which were obtained by Fox News Digital through a California Public Records Act (PRA) request, instructed educators to work toward being ‘antiracist’ by challenging whiteness at school, which Howard argued exists in the concepts of ‘merit’ and ‘individualism....’ LAUSD mandated the training last May, saying in a memo that its goal was to create inclusive schools and to eliminate bias in the classroom.”

minded colleges and universities, appear to be also very enthusiastic about watering down basic standards in the name of equity.

Meanwhile, a generation or more of students in U.S. government schools lack basic reading, writing, and mathematics skills even as CCP-controlled, authoritarian China aggressively seeks to replace America as the world’s primary superpower, in part owing to their A-plus pupils.

While, for example, there is some degree of tedium and arbitrariness em-

If one particular group is missing out because another is supposedly benefiting from privilege, “then you give those students opportunities and you give them resources to compete. You don’t get rid of the concept of meritocracy. If it wasn’t for meritocracy, we’d have no ability to discern who is best for the job. And the fact that they literally think that the concept of the person who has the best skills gets the job is inherently racist could tell you everything about them,” Smith asserted.

“None of this makes sense, and it’s not

During the conversation, Kilmeade noted that inspirational civil rights icons Booker T. Washington and Frederick Douglass would never have accepted CRT-like dogma. *“They were gonna make their way anyway. And obviously, there were huge obstacles. I think we’re a country of equal opportunity, not equal outcomes, [CRT ideologues] want equal outcomes, which is gonna bring everything else down.”*

Survivor of Mao’s cultural revolution warns of public school indoctrination: ‘The country I love is becoming the country I left’

New Hampshire Republican candidate Lily Tang Williams knows firsthand the evil of communism and issued a dire warning that through indoctrination in schools, *“the country I love is becoming the country I left.”*

Tang Williams immigrated to the United States from China in 1988 after surviving Chairman Mao Zedong’s cultural revolution. In an interview with Fox News Digital, she detailed how the deliberate divisiveness that Mao had employed is now being replicated in American government schools in order to *“brainwash the children...to control [the] country’s future.”*

The congressional hopeful laid out how *“Mao used standard Marxist terms like oppressor versus oppressed”* and explained that, *“He actually divided all Chinese citizens — because we’re [of the] same race and have [the] same skin color — into Five Black Classes versus the Five Red Classes.”*

“Tragedy is where young people were brainwashed to say, I want to be Red Class, I’m going to denounce my family to turn them over to Red Guards, to the authorities, change last name and draw the line between me and my parents,” Tang Williams explained of the leader’s reign that led to the deaths of as many as 45 million people.

Now she sees a failure to properly educate on the evils of communism merged with the tenets

of critical race theory leading toward a destructive outcome for America.

“Our children in schools were not taught real history. When I go to school for past five years, educate them about horrors of communism and socialism, they don’t know the personal stories. They’ve never heard eyewitness stories. They just bought into whatever they were taught.”

“America is not systemic racist country...no baby is born racist, period. And I call this Marxist revolution because they know the traditional communism, Marxism would not work,” she argued as the class divisions are not supported by the American economy. *“But they use racism — slavery history — to attack destroying America. But look what they’re doing. All they focus on is people’s race and skin color.”*

“The radical left are the real racist because they want to separate people into different groups,” Tang Williams insisted. *“They want to separate people into different identity politics.”*

“All the communists know how to control the education — brainwash the children in order to control a country’s future,” she added. The cautionary tale of survivors like Tang Williams has not gone overlooked as leaders like Gov. Ron DeSantis have placed a focus on educating students on these issues.

“While it’s fashionable in some circles to whitewash the history of com-

munist, Florida will stand for truth and remain as a beachhead for freedom,” DeSantis had stated at the signing ceremony where he declared Nov. 7 Victims of Communism Day in Florida.

But DeSantis can’t be the only one pushing back against the indoctrination of the youth as the congressional candidate noted, *“The purpose is to destroy America, the only country that still stands for freedom, liberty [and] individual rights. So the communist-Marxist people have to create something for people to buy into in order to*

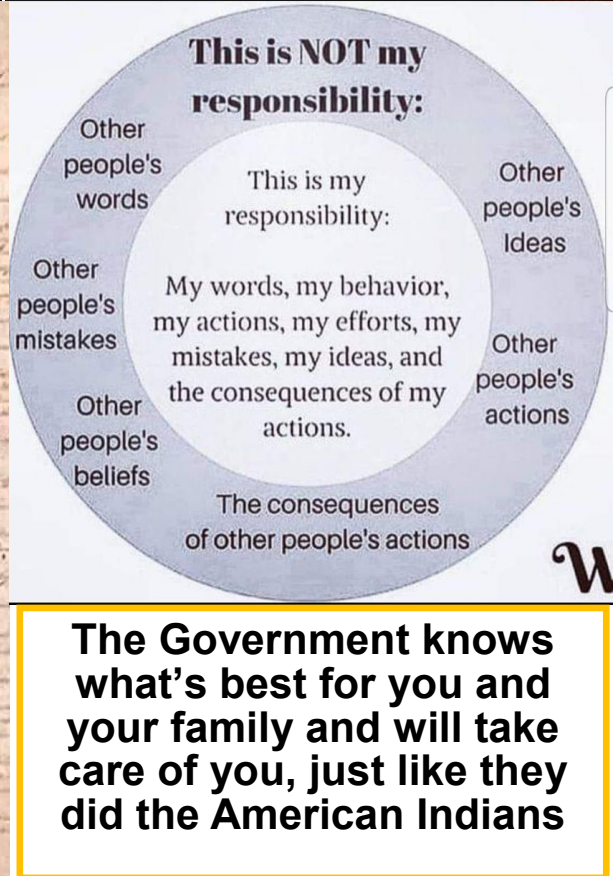
