## The #1 killer of Americans ages 18-48 Lawmaker calls it 'Weapon of Mass Destruction'

What heroin and cocaine were in times gone by, the recreational drug of choice, it's now Fentanyl, a powerful opioid described by some as 100 times stronger than morphine.

It mostly comes out of Mexico to the U.S., after being made of products that mostly come from China.

But it's being battled by law enforcement, lawmakers and more, because it's now the No. 1 killer of people ages 18-48, and one father who lost a son to the epidemic is calling it a weapon of mass destruction.

One of the most recent arrests by law enforcement in its crusade against Fentanyl came just days ago in Watsonville, California, where suspects Alberto Galvan, 26 and Joscelyn Torres-Leon, 24, are facing charges of possession of Fentanyl for sale.

It had been at virtually the same time that lawmakers in New Mexico were moving to cut down on the drug's death toll.

The plan in New Mexico, where fatal overdoses have reached record numbers, would allow the possession of Fentanyl test strips and let the state Department of Health decide what supplies drug users need to reduce the spread of diseases.

In the state in 2020, officials reported 304 fentanyl overdose deaths between January and November, a 135% increase over 2019. Unintentional overdoses account for numerous deaths and test strips could save those who don't know Fentanyl is in the drug they're using.

And a report from MSN revealed Fentanyl now, according to the Centers for Disease Control, is the predominant killer for those Americans ages 18-48.

*"In the past two years, deaths from Fentanyl have significantly exceeded deaths from COVID-19*



*for this age group,"* the report said. *"The overdoses cut across gender, race, socioeconomic status and geography."*

The report continued, *"And it's a trend we must address. Congress should swiftly deploy resources to support young people contending with drug addiction. Boosting funding for treatment centers and ensuring equitable geographic access to these centers should be a top priority this year."*

James Rauh, the founder of Families Against Fentanyl, told Fox News that the crisis has seen deaths from the drug double in 30 states just since 2019.

He said the nation needs to declare the drug a *"weapon of mass destruction"* because it is, in fact, an *"existential threat"* to the nation's security.

Rauh lost his son to a Fentanyl overdose several years ago, and told "America's Newsroom," "We need to shut off this material at its source, and a WMD designation would be an all-of-government response in order to shut off the supply of the precursors and the Fentanyl coming into the United States.

*"It'll give us tools that we're not using, and it would be a very effective means to end this terrible devastation that's happening to our young adults and to our country as a whole. This material is an existential threat to our national security,"* he said.

Also, Alaska, Colorado, Louisiana Mississippi, California and Texas saw their numbers quintuple over that time.

Rauh described the drug's impact on his son, who died in 2015.

*"He didn't have a chance. It was a dose that would have killed hundreds of people, was sent over by Chinese nationals through the mail,"* Rauh said. *"The Chinese are supplying the precursors to Mexico, and Mexico, shipping this in unbelievable quantities."*

He warned, *"The quantities are so alarming that it's indicative of stockpiling. Their Fentanyl deaths have doubled and the whole nation just about in two years, which is a terrible sign...This is a poisoning of our children, our families."*

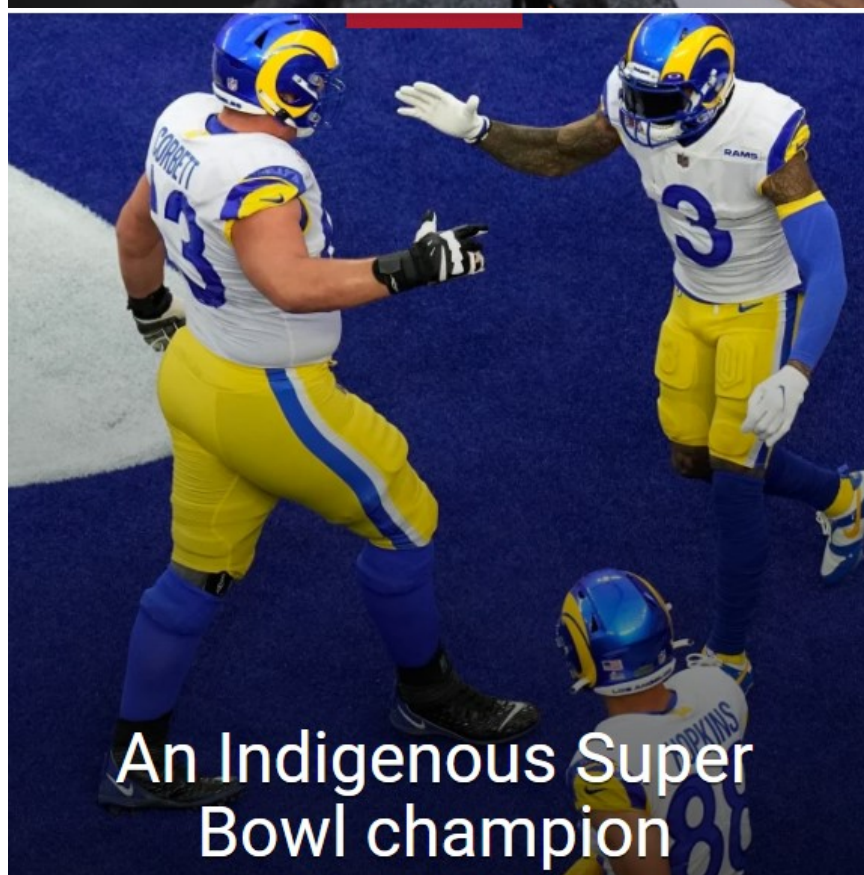

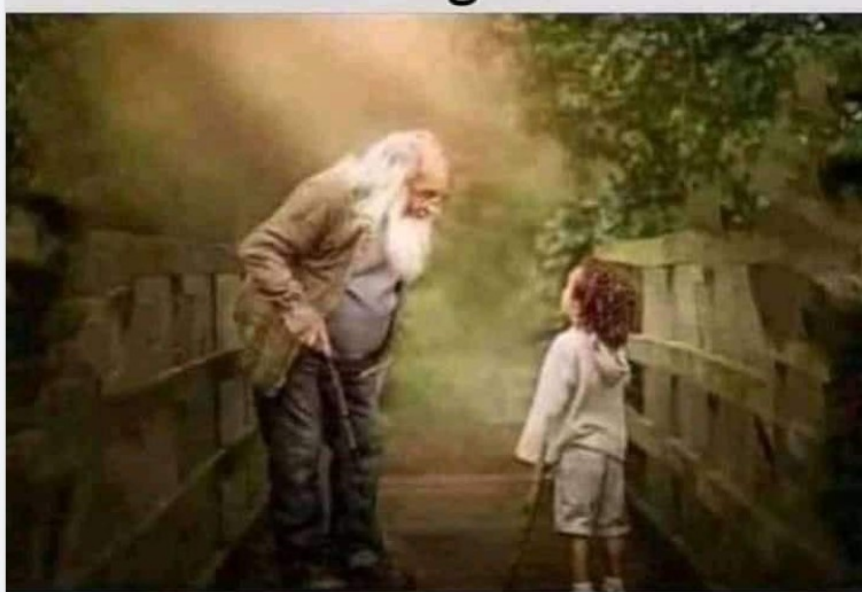

Ernie Stevens, Jr. is Chairman of the National Indian Gaming Association (NIGA) out of Washington, DC. Serving in his 11th consecutive two-year terms. Stevens serves as Chairman and National spokesman for the Indian Gaming industry working with Tribal Leadership in shaping policy initiatives that have the potential to impact the industry.

Stevens served as elected Councilman for the Oneida Nation from 1993 to 1996. His career in Washington, DC began in 1995 as the First Vice-President of the National Congress of American Indians. He serves as a board member of the National Center for American Indian Enterprise Development, Nike N7 Foundation, Center for American Indian Youth, and Native American Graduate Center.

In 2008, Stevens was inducted into the National Indian Athletic Association Hall of Fame. In 2012, he was inducted into the Boys & Girls Club Alumni Hall of Fame. In 2013, he was inducted as Lifetime Member of the American Indian Higher Education Consortium's Alumni Association. In 2015, Stevens was inducted into the American Gaming Association Gaming Hall of Fame, and has received several national accolades.

Ernie's boxing career started in his teens. At 16, along with boxing icon Louie Askinette, he co-founded the Soaring Eagle Boxing Club in Oneida in 1975. His accolades include 4-time State Heavyweight Champion in 1976, 1977, 1978 & 1979. He is also a two-time National Indian Heavyweight Champion out of Carson City, NV in 1977 & 1978. In 1977, he was 17 years old fighting seasoned men to win the Championship.

Stevens received an Associate Degree from Haskell Indian Junior College, 1983, a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from Mount Senario College, 1996 and a Masters in Management from the University of Phoenix, 2021. Stevens is married to his wife and best friend of 43 years, Cheryl. Together they have 5 kids and 17 grandchildren.

## Ramos hosts legislation to ban use of ‘S-word’ as geographic name in CA

**SACRAMENTO, CA**—A bill to prohibit the use of the word “squaw” for geographic features and place names in California by January 1, 2024 has been introduced by Assemblymembers **James C. Ramos (D-Highland)**, *the first California Native American elected to the state legislature* and Cristina Garcia (D-Bell Gardens), chair of the California Legislative Women’s Caucus.

*“AB 2022 would ban the use of the S-word and establish a process for renaming locations with that offensive racial and sexist term which began as derogatory word used against Native American women. It is an idiom that came into use during the westward expansion of America, and it is not a tribal word. For decades, Native Americans have argued against the designation’s use because behind that expression is the disparagement of Native women that contributes to the crisis of missing and murdered people in our community,”* Ramos stated.

Ramos added that more than 100 places in California contain the S-word. The United States Department of the Interior has ordered the term *“erased from the National landscape and*

*forever replaced”* on the almost 700 sites using the name on federal lands. Montana, Oregon, Maine and Minnesota have already banned the word’s use.

Garcia commented, *“The sad reality is that this term has been used for generations and normalized, even though it is a misogynistic and racist term rooted in the oppression and belittling of Indigenous women. AB 2022 begins to correct an ugly and painful part of our history by removing it from California’s landmarks; it’s the least we can do to help our indigenous women heal.”*

AB 2022 defines a geographic feature as any location or publicly owned structure in the state such as navigable water, parks, local roads, bridges and publicly owned buildings. A place is defined in the proposal as a natural geographic feature or street, alley, or other road within the jurisdiction of the state or political subdivision of the state.

**State and local government** bodies shall identify geographic features and place names within their

jurisdictions and report those locations or features to the California Advisory Committee on Geographic Names. The Committee would be charged with working with those bodies and the Native American Heritage Commission to recommend replacement names.

AB 2022 is sponsored by the American Civil Liberties Union CA.

Corporal, Ira Hamilton Hayes, (Pima) and five other U.S. Marines were photographed on February 23, 1945 by Joe Rosenthal.

Three of the six Marines depicted in the photograph, Sergeant, Michael Strank, Corporal, Harlon Block, and Private First Class, Franklin Sousley were killed in action over the next few days. The three surviving flag-raisers were Corporals Rene Gagnon, Ira Hayes, and Harold Schultz.

Hayes was born on January 12, 1923 at Sacaton on the Gila River Indian Reservation in south central Arizona. He died on January 23, 1955 at the age of 32.

- Ross was the great-granddaughter of Cherokee Nation Chief John Ross and grew up in the Cherokee Nation capital of Tahlequah, Oklahoma.
- She earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics in 1928 and a master's degree in 1938.
- During WWII, she was hired as a mathematician by Lockheed and worked on the P-38 Lightning, one of the fastest airplanes at the time.
- In 1952, she joined Lockheed's top-secret Advanced Development Projects division, commonly known as Skunk Works.
- She worked on the cutting-edge Agena rocket project and on preliminary design concepts for flyby missions to Venus and Mars.
- When asked about women entering the space program, Ross said that women would make "wonderful astronauts" but added that she'd "rather stay down here and analyze the data."

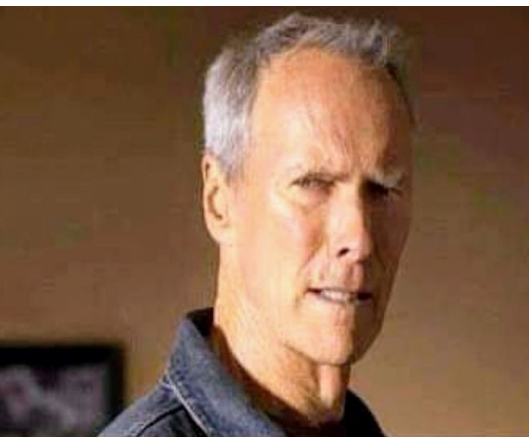
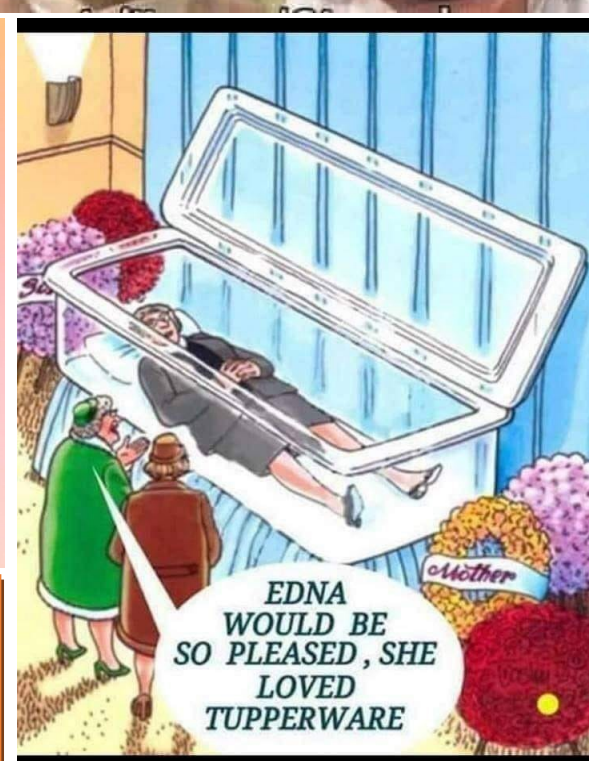
