## Official Recession Definition

During a recession, the economy struggles, people lose work, companies make fewer sales and the country's overall economic output declines. The point where the economy officially falls into a recession depends on a variety of factors.

In 1974, economist Julius Shiskin came up with a few rules of thumb to define a recession: The most popular was two consecutive quarters of declining GDP. A healthy economy expands over time, so two quarters in a row of contracting output suggests there are serious underlying problems, according to Shiskin. This definition of a recession became a common standard over the years.

The National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER) is generally recognized as the authority that defines the starting and ending dates of U.S. recessions. NBER has its own definition of what constitutes a recession, namely "a significant decline in economic activity spread across the economy, lasting more than a few months, normally visible in real GDP, real income, employment, industrial production, and wholesale-retail sales."

The NBER's definition is more flexible than Shiskin's rule for determining what is a recession. For example, the coronavirus could potentially create a W-shaped recession, where the economy falls one quarter, starts to grow, then drops again in the future. This would not be a recession by Shiskin's rules but could be under the NBER's definition.

In simple English; the definition of a Recession is when to value of the dollar is less today than it was yesterday and the individual worker's wages don't go up.

## What Causes Recessions?

There is more than one way for a recession to get started, from a sudden economic shock to fallout from uncontrolled inflation or a manufactured inflation. These phenomena are some of the main drivers of a recession:

- **A sudden economic shock:** An economic shock is a surprise problem that creates serious financial damage. In the 1970s, OPEC cut off the supply of oil to the U.S. without warning, causing a recession, not to mention endless lines at gas stations. The coronavirus outbreak, which shut down economies worldwide, is a more recent example of a sudden economic shock. (*Shutting down our domestic oil production is one hell-a-va shock, you think?*)
- **Excessive debt:** When individuals or businesses take on too much debt, the cost of servicing the debt can grow to the point where they can't pay their bills. Growing debt defaults and bankruptcies then capsize the economy. The housing bubble in the mid-aughts that led to the Great Recession is a prime example of excessive debt causing a recession. (*\$32 Trillion in National Debt*)
- **Asset bubbles:** When investing decisions are driven by emotion, bad economic outcomes aren't far behind. Investors can become too optimistic during a strong economy. Former Fed Chair Alan Greenspan famously referred to this tendency as "irrational exuberance," in describing the outsized gains in the stock market in the late 1990s. Irrational exuberance inflates stock market or real estate bubbles—and when the bubbles pop, panic selling can crash the market, causing a recession.
- **Too much inflation:** Inflation is the steady, up-

ward trend in prices over time. Inflation isn't a bad thing per se, but excessive inflation is a dangerous phenomenon. Central banks control inflation by raising interest rates, and higher interest rates depress economic activity. Out-of-control inflation was an ongoing problem in the U.S. in the 1970s. To break the cycle, the Federal Reserve rapidly raised interest rates, which caused a recession. (*The current inflation rate is at 8.6% and climbing over a 40-year high*)

**Too much deflation:** While runaway inflation can create a recession, deflation can be even worse. Deflation is when prices decline over time, which causes wages to contract, which further depresses prices. When a deflationary feedback loop gets out of hand, people and business stop spending, which undermines the economy. Central banks and economists have few tools to fix the underlying problems that cause deflation. Japan's struggles with deflation throughout most of the 1990s caused a severe recession.

**Technological change:** New inventions increase productivity and help the economy over the long term, but there can be short-term periods of adjustment to technological breakthroughs. In the 19th century, there were waves of labor-saving technological improvements. The Industrial Revolution made entire professions obsolete, sparking recessions and hard times. Today, some economists worry that AI and robots could cause recessions by eliminating whole categories of jobs.

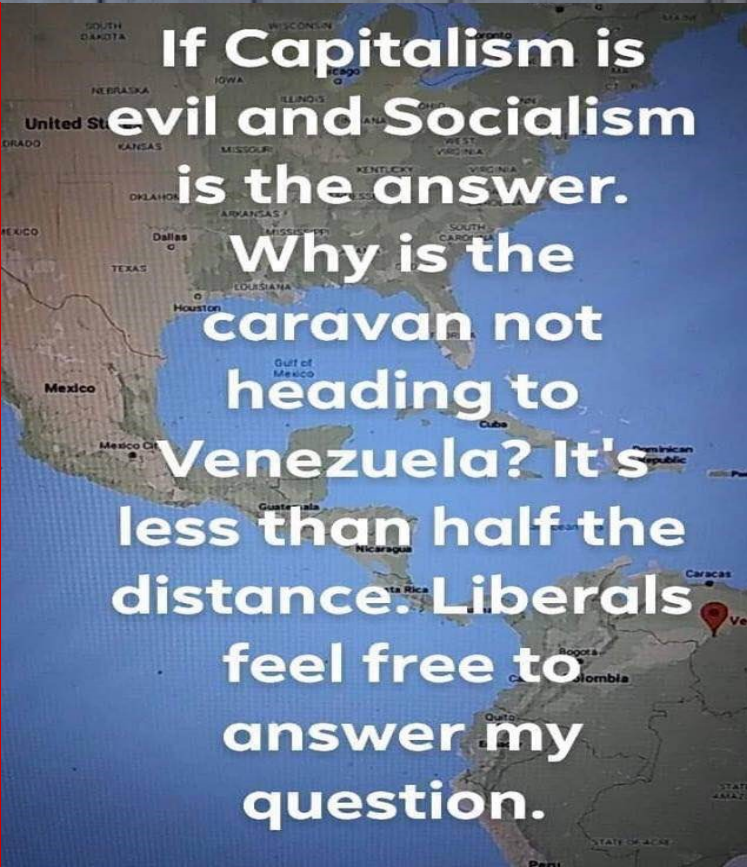
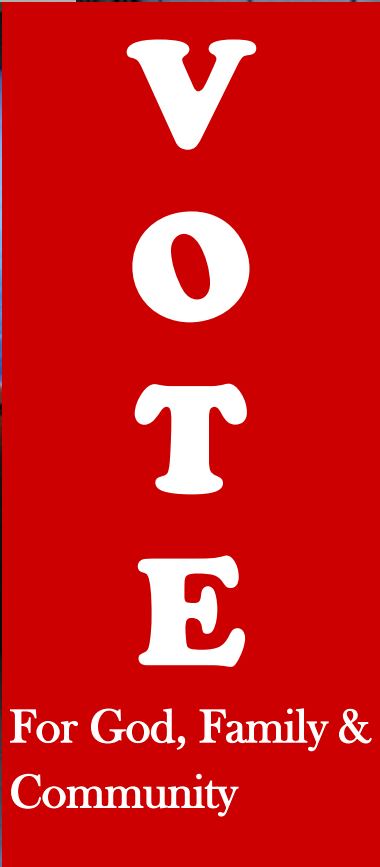
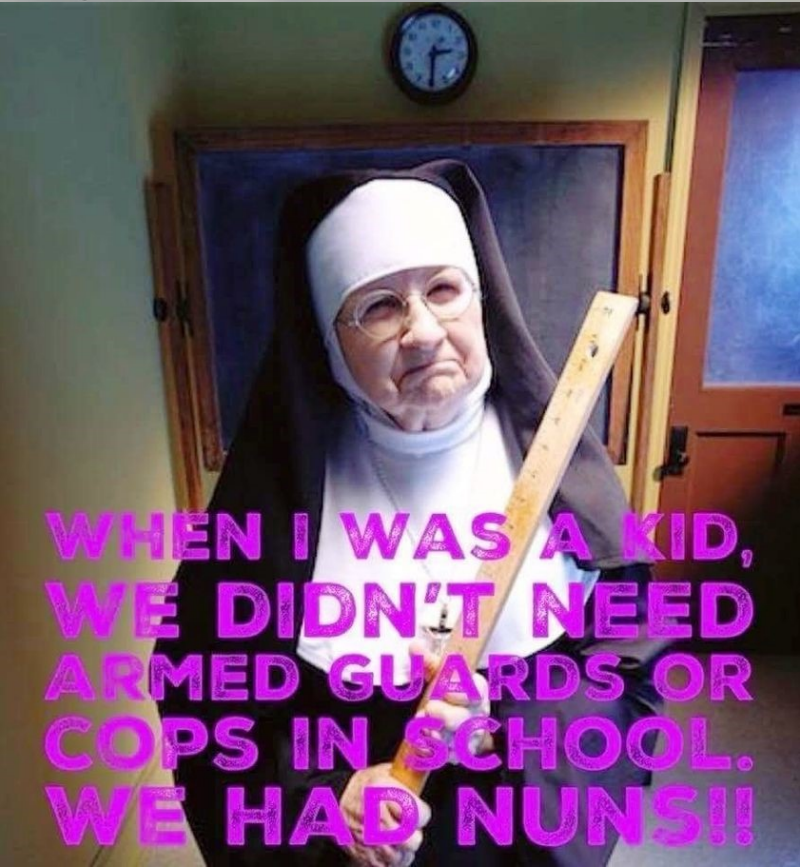
More California hypocrisy or Just plain Stupidity!

# The left's 'shut up!' strategy is working, tragically

A cultural bomb has imploded in America, something palpable, where people wonder aloud if this is what falling empires look like, or where your parents and friends that are older than you say things like, *"I feel bad for the younger generations"* and *"I am just glad I am older, so I don't have to see how bad it gets."*

It is clear. *"Things are bad, worse than bad, they are crazy,"* and it seems some older generations have taken up *"dying before things get worse"* as a strategy.

The racial and cultural chaos is the culmination of years of often politically motivated efforts by educators, the media and Democrats incessantly beating the drums that America is irredeemably racist, male and – above all, white.

It is almost as if labeling everyone that disagrees with you a bigot, a racist, a fascist or, after January 6th, a terrorist and an extremist is problematic to the long-term health of public discourse in a country.

Andrew Breitbart tried to warn of the goal of political correctness: *"What the left has stood for with political correctness is to try to get those with whom they disagree to shut up,"* he said before his death in 2012.

Regrettably, the silencing works. The left teaches conservative America to shut up, and we largely oblige.

Shut up! Do not speak at your kid's school board meeting, lest you wind up on an FBI watchlist.

Shut up! At work, climbing the corporate ladder of your woke/ESG-following job, do not risk getting fired.

Shut up online! You will get censored, shadow-banned or flagged.

Conservatives hand the left the political discourse in classrooms, workplaces and online – then expect logic to prevail in the voting booth.

The result is steadily moving the needle in the culture war in one direction.

The result is Noella – the world's youngest trans model.

The media are currently writing glowing articles on "her" like she is some reincarnation of Jackie Robinson, breaking the color barrier, just because people did not want to be mean or labeled a bigot.

Noella is 10.

The left's strategy has remained the same: label, blacklist, make those that dissent untouchable.

President Joe Biden took it a step further when speaking in Maryland in late August. *"It's not just Trump, it's the entire philosophy that underpins the – I'm going to say something, it's like semi-fascism,"* he said.

In early September, his account tweeted *"MAGA proposals are a threat to the very soul of this country. The agenda represents an extremism that threatens the very foundations of our republic."*

Big Tech, Big Media and Democrats now work in concert to silence conservatives – for sharing a true Hunter Biden story, for implying we should not vaccinate the youth, for saying outlandish things like we should not transition teenagers, or for bitterly speaking out in anguish after your son was killed in Afghanistan.

They imply that fascism – authoritarian rule and the merger of state and private sector – is manifesting in the form of MAGA.

The media shamelessly cosigning Biden's hateful claims unchecked, celebrating Noella or constantly searching for the next white "hate crime" – regardless if it's true or not – has resulted in a scenario where we've devolved as a society along racial or cultural lines.

When a political game changer and "habitual line stepper" emerged in the form of Donald Trump – a man who would point directly at the media "elite" and call them fake news – journalists and Democrats did not change strategy when it came to coverage; they simply doubled down.

In April 2021, Columbus police arrived at a home to find 16-year-old Ma'Khia Bryant attempting to stab Shai-onta Craig. Officer Nicholas Reardon essentially saved another woman's life when he shot Bryant.

In the immediate aftermath, James tweeted out a picture of Reardon from the scene with the caption *"You're next #accountability"* to his 52 million followers.

After January 6th, James referenced the

Ku Klux Klan – and used the moment to present one of – that blacks are being systemically hunted in America, tweeting: *"DO YOU UNDERSTAND NOW?... you still won't be judge, looked at crazy, chained, beaten, hung, shot to death cause of the color of your skin!!!!"*

The man who christened the cover of Sports Illustrated as "The Chosen One" at 17 years old. *"2 AMERIKKKAS we live in and it was at FULL CAPACITY LIVE IN DIRECT yesterday in our Nations CAPITAL AT THE CAPITOL!"*

Between his ongoing NBA career, his two decades with Nike and his media/movie empire, James is the first actively playing billionaire, with a "B."

LeBron James of the NBA, where the average player will earn \$7.5 million – more than four times in one season of playing basketball what an average wage earner in this country might earn in a lifetime.

He is the closest thing America has to royalty and he has been since before he famously scored his first Hummer in high school. His nickname and his twitter handle are @KingJames.

He often describes an America or Jim Crow Era neither he nor I have ever seen.

When white high school senior 17-year-old Ethan Liming was beaten to death in June near the basketball courts outside of James' I Promise School, allegedly by three African American males, James does not inject race or inflammatory rhetoric to the conversation, nor does he post pictures of the subjects.

Shortly after the Buckeyes beat the fighting Irish, Netflix announces on Twitter that former President Barack Obama – whom the company has partnered with in a multimillion dollar deal – has just won an Emmy for Outstanding Narrator for the company's "Our Great National Parks."

Obama adds it to a list of awards that includes two Grammys, a Nobel Peace Prize and two terms as president of what used to be the most powerful country in the world.

He is celebrated. And LeBron James could not be more right – and more wrong – about the "two Amerikkkas."



## Eric Metaxas: 'Silence' of American churches echoes 1930s Nazi Germany

### 'We are going down precisely the same path'

About 3,000 of the approximately 18,000 Protestant pastors in Germany in the 1930s openly supported Adolf Hitler, and about the same number ended up opposing his tyrannical rule.

But it was the vast majority of ministers, about 12,000, who chose to remain silent – arguing it wasn't their place to engage in politics – who enabled the Nazis to "crush the heroic 3,000" who stood up against the dictator, points out Eric Metaxas in his new book *"Letter to the American Church."*

*"That is the nightmare – that they thought it would be safe,"* Metaxas said in an interview with James Robison on the "LIFE Today" television program.

The pastors, Metaxas said, decided: *"We won't take a posi-*

*tion. We don't want to be political. We'll just keep our nose down, preach our little stuff on Sunday morning, and when we leave this building, we're going to bow to the authority of the state."*

Metaxas contends the American church today mirrors the silence of the German church before the Holocaust.

If church leaders, he said, don't learn the lesson of the 1930s, *"we are going down precisely the same path."*

*"And people say, 'I can't believe it, I can't believe it.' Trust me when I say that the Germans didn't believe that that future was even possible. But it happened, and we are no different than the Germans,"* he said.

Metaxas is the author of a best-selling book about German Lutheran pastor Dietrich Bon-

hoeffer, who boldly opposed the Nazi regime and was executed for participating in the famous "Operation Valkyrie" plot to assassinate Hitler.

In the *"Letter to the American Church,"* Metaxas explained to Robison, arose from his realization that *"the silence of the church in Germany that led to the satanic evil of the Nazis and the Holocaust is exactly the same as the silence of the church in America today."*

Without question, he said, that silence will lead the nation *"to horror unimaginable, unless we repent, unless we cease being silent."*

*"I cannot think of a more urgent message,"* he said. *"I beg people, I beg people to take what I am saying in this book seriously, because, of course, it's not me talking."*

He said he humbly posits that God is trying tell the American church exactly what he told the German church through Bonhoeffer.

Metaxas, on his radio show, recently had a discussion with author and journalist Naomi Wolf in which they compared the behavior of the nation's ruling educated class during the pandemic to the passiveness of Germany's highly civilized and educated population in the 1930s.

The Nazis had a phrase which covered all abuses by the State: "Für Ihre Sicherheit"

... "It's for your safety"

Wolf, who was in Metaxas' graduating class at Yale, said their classmates "are the worst offenders."

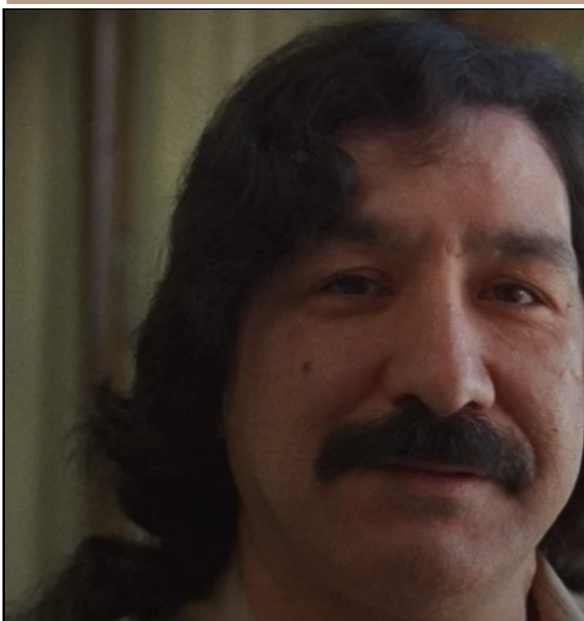
*"Right now it's really red state and purple state America, and working people who are being super brave and telling their neighbors, trying to resist – the police officers, the fire fighters, taking action against these coercive mandates, trying to bring some truth to the discussion,"* said Wolf, a Rhodes Scholar with a doctorate from Oxford University who was a political consultant for Bill Clinton and Al Gore.

Wolf's grandmother lost nine siblings in the Holocaust.

*"It's our classmates, our cultural demographic, if you like, who are colluding, overwhelmingly – and our institutions,"* she said.

## 46 years behind bars. What else do you want?

Former federal judge: Leonard Peltier remains a casualty of this Countries cruel and lawless war against American Indians

Leonard Peltier’s name has become a story that reflects other stories. One narrative describes Peltier as America’s longest political prisoner, serving more than 46 years in a federal maximum security prison.

In that telling, Peltier has become a humanitarian and a 78-year-old Turtle Mountain elder who has been incarcerated for far too long.

There is a long list of people, tribes and organizations that have called for Peltier’s freedom. The former prosecutor in the case. Members of Congress. Amnesty International USA. Pope John Francis. The Dalai Lama. The National Congress of American Indians. Dozens of tribal nations, including Peltier’s own tribe, the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians. And, as of this month, the Democratic National Committee.

That’s one version. A contrary account casts Peltier as the lead character for the crimes committed by the American Indian Movement during the Wounded Knee era, including internal community violence, and he is described as a remorseless murderer.

That last story is still promoted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation on its website. But Peltier is not in prison for murder. The government could not justify a murder case, so it switched gears and today

Leonard Peltier is Inmate #89637-132 serving at the United States Penitentiary, Coleman, in central Florida, on charges of “aiding and abetting” the murder of federal officers, plus a seven-year sentence for an escape attempt.

Indeed Peltier has already served a longer sentence than most principals in murder convictions. There is no way to look at the evidence and come away with any conclusion other than Peltier is being punished for crimes that could not be proven beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.

Kevin Sharp is a Nashville attorney, and former U.S. District Court judge, who is representing Peltier pro bono with a petition to President Joe Biden calling for clemency. That petition questions the role of the United States government saying “the FBI redoubled their efforts to secure a conviction,” including dropping other charges, so that the “weight of the Federal Government could be directed against Leonard Peltier.”

One of the problems is that even if guilty, Peltier has overserved.

*“He’s overserved any sentence he should have,”* Sharp said. *“You got your pound of flesh. If that’s what you wanted, you got a guy who was there and you, he’s now 78 years old, and he’s got 46 years behind bars. What else do you want? Except for him to die. And we stopped talking about him that way, but that’s the worst thing that can happen*

*because now you don’t start, stop talking about him. Now you’ve got this guy that you allowed to die in prison. It gets louder, not softer.”*

Over the years the government first said Peltier shot the agents. Then later the prosecution switched the story to *“we don’t know who killed the agents, but we know Leonard was there,”* Sharp said.

*“Okay. Congratulations. There were 40 other people there with weapons. There were lots of other people there that day. There were 150 agents there. One of them killed Joe Stuntz, a 21-year-old Native boy. We don’t know who killed him. We know it was one of the agents that they never went to figure it out. So those are the facts that we know. And if that case was tried today, there is no way it stands.”*

Sharp said the Peltier’s trial would not stand scrutiny today. *“There aren’t even two sides,”* he said. *“We know that the witnesses were intimidated. We know that witnesses were threatened. We know that affidavits knowingly false affidavits were submitted to the courts. We know that when the trial took place and the prosecutor said, we only have this one piece of evidence, this shell casing, this ties Leonard to, to this shooting. We know now that they knew that wasn’t true. And we only learned years later after his conviction, that there had been a ballistics test that showed it wasn’t his weapon.”*

In the White House petition Sharp argues that Peltier *“remains a casualty of this country’s cruel and lawless war against American Indians his continued incarceration, moreover, is a constant reminder to Native communities that they are disposable in the eyes of the U.S. government and unworthy of the most basic protections afforded by our Constitution.”*

It’s the failure of basic constitutional protections that power Sharp’s message: He left the federal bench because of what he saw as structural issues in the criminal justice system.

*“I was forced because of mandatory minimums to sentence a young man to two life sentences,”* Sharp recalled. *“It was very frustrating to me because in order to become a federal judge, you’re vetted and investigated by the FBI, vetted and investigated by the White House, the Department of Justice, the Senate Judiciary committee, and they have their own investigators all for one reason ... and that’s to satisfy themselves that you have the intellect and the temperament and the judgment to rule on these most important items in our country and that is dealing with somebody’s liberty.”*

Sharp sent Chris Young to prison. And that crossed a line for him. So after six years as a federal judge, Sharp shifted gears and set out to defend justice. *“That*

*led me to the Trump Oval Office and working with Kim Kardashian to help free this young man. His name was Chris Young ... and Chris is free today. We actually were able to secure clemency.”*

It was in that context that Sharp became interested in Leonard Peltier.

He received a package from Connie Nelson, the former wife of Willie Nelson. *“And I sat down with this package and it was the trial transcripts from Leonard’s trial,”* he said. *“It was newspaper articles, court opinions, photographs, and I just started going through it and I am sucked in.”*

Sharp saw holes in the government’s story. *“It was easy for me to see what happened, the misconduct by the prosecutors, by the investigators, the rulings by the court that would never stand today because the standard of review is different. All of that was easy for me,”* he said. *“What then has sucked me in for years since I first opened that package is the ‘why?’”*

*Why are there so many constitutional violations? What was going on? What led to this point?*

*“It was the context. That’s what sucked me into this and has aggravated me, has, you know, made me angry, made me sad, made me confused. ‘What are we doing? And why are we here? And that’s why Leonard Peltier is so important.’*

*This isn’t about people with guns on Pine Ridge, you know, South Dakota on June 26th, 1975. That’s part of it. But the real story is the why. And as, as one of the courts said in one of the court opinions, the United States government needs to take responsibility for what happened there that day.”*

Sharp said there is no way that Peltier’s trial would meet today’s minimum standards of justice.

In 1986 the 8th U.S. Court of Appeals found that the government had failed to disclose evidence favorable to Peltier. This is what’s known as a “Brady violation” and it’s enough to require a new trial. But in Peltier’s case the rule was ignored.

The district court *“held that the October 2, 1975, teletype, evaluated in the context of the entire record, would not have affected the outcome of the trial and that, therefore, Peltier was not entitled to relief.”*

Or consider the story of a self-proclaimed racist juror. Three women in Fargo slipped a note to the trial judge, Paul Benson, that said they were friends with the juror and she told them that she was really prejudiced against Indians. The judge asks her about the statement. *“Yep, I said it. But I told you when you were asking me questions that I would set any prejudice I had. I’d be fair.”* The judge says, *“Thank you very much.”* And the trial continued on and Juror Number 10 voted “guilty.” That fact

alone would be enough to reverse a trial.

*“If that happened today, he gets a new trial,”* Sharp said. *“So it’s those things that drive me crazy. When I talk about, look, I, I believe in the Constitution, those are all constitutional violations. We get a new trial.”*

The government’s prosecutors changed their theory in 1985 – after Peltier’s conviction. As the prosecutor Lynn Crooks told the appeals court, *“we can’t prove who shot those agents.”* Thus, Peltier was not actually convicted of murder instead he’s been in prison since 1977 on *“aiding and abetting”* the murder of federal officers.

James Reynolds, a former prosecutor in the case, has called for clemency. In a letter to the president, Reynolds wrote that with the benefit of hindsight *“I have realized that the prosecution and continued incarceration of Mr. Peltier was and is unjust. We were not able to prove that Mr. Peltier personally committed any offense on the Pine Ridge Reservation.”*

One other story told about Peltier is not directly related to his aiding and abetting conviction – and that’s the tie to the Anna Mae Aquash murder investigation.

The American Indian Movement at first blamed the FBI for Anna Mae Aquash’s murder in February of 1976. But later information surfaced that she was murdered by AIM because she was suspected of being an informer. Aquash’s family said Peltier was involved and was aware of her killer. Two former AIM members, Arlo Looking Cloud and John Graham, were convicted of killing Aquash.

Sharp points out that Peltier has never been charged in connection with Aquash.

In a statement this week, Thalia Carroll-Cachimuel, executive director of the International Leonard Peltier Defense Committee, said *“there has been an extraordinary volume of misinformation spread regarding Leonard Peltier. Leonard Peltier’s conviction and perverse length of his incarceration are emblematic of the racist mistreatment of American Indians by law enforcement that existed throughout Indian Country for decades. If there is evidence that has never before been produced, then we encourage its unveiling if the true motive is justice. If the motive is simply to support Mr. Peltier’s unjust imprisonment, the bar must be set much higher.”*

Peltier’s petition for clemency will be up to President Biden. Just this month a resolution enacted by the Democratic National Committee said the party’s platform already says the president should use clemency *“to secure the release of those serving unduly long sentences.”*

And, in Peltier’s case, *“given the overwhelming support for clemency, the constitutional due pro-*

*cess issues underlying Mr. Peltier’s prosecution, his status as an elderly inmate, and that he is an American Indian, who suffer from greater rates of health disparities and severe underlying health conditions, Mr. Peltier is a good candidate to be granted mercy and leniency; and ... it is highly appropriate that consideration of clemency for Mr. Peltier be prioritized and expedited, so that Mr. Peltier can return to his family and live his final years among his people.”*

Peltier’s petition says the time for clemency is now because his health is fading. *“Leonard suffers from a variety of ailments, including kidney disease, Type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure, a heart condition, bone spurs in his feet, a degenerative joint disease, constant shortness of breath and dizziness, and painful injuries to his jaw. A stroke in 1986 left Leonard virtually blind in one eye,”* the clemency petition says. “Prison doctors advised Leonard that *the condition required surgery, but the maximum-security prison where he is incarcerated does not have the capacity to treat the condition. Leonard’s physical condition is dire, and he cannot physically defend himself in prison, let alone threaten anyone with harm.”*

South Dakota state Rep. Ruth Buffalo, Mandan Hidatsa Arikara, brought the resolution forward at the September DNC meeting. She said it started with a coordinated message from a variety of state legislators and the North Dakota Democratic-Nonpartisan League Party. That was followed by a similar call from the Native American caucus of Native American state legislators. All that built toward the DNC resolution.

Buffalo represents Fargo in the legislature, the city where Peltier’s trial originally took place. She said has heard from constituents *“regardless of party affiliation”* supporting clemency because of the constitutional violations.

*“One thing that has kept us going is so many of us unfortunately have relatives and loved ones who are currently in the criminal justice system or who have thankfully made it out of serving time behind bars,”* she said. And so Peltier’s long prison time is *“something an issue that definitely hits home for many of us.”* She said. *“Peltier should come home.”*

*“I know there’s so many people who have been praying since the seventies for Leonard’s release,”* Buffalo said. *“And so we know that there’s many grandmas and elder women at Turtle Mountain who pray for Leonard on a daily basis.”*

*“This whole case is a reflection of injustice,”* she said, *“and it must be resolved in order to heal communities.”* She said: *“Leonard’s release is one sure way to make sure that we are on a path towards healing.”*

November 9, 2022 the Supreme Court will hear arguments and then decide the future of Indian Child Welfare Act.



On August 12, 2022, five American Indian Tribal Governments filed a brief with the U.S. Supreme Court in *Brackeen v. Haaland* defending the constitutionality of the Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA).

Cherokee Nation Principal Chief Chuck Hoskin, Jr., Morongo Band of Mission Indians Chairman Charles Martin, Navajo Nation President Jonathan Nez, Oneida Nation Chairman Tehassi Hill, and Quinault Indian Nation President Guy Capoean issued the following statement:

*"The United States Congress passed the Indian Child Welfare Act 44 years ago. In the decades since, Indian Child Welfare Act has continued to receive strong, bipartisan support while being repeatedly upheld in both state and federal courts."*

*"Our brief filed today outlines not only the tremendous benefits that Indian Child Welfare Act has brought to the health and safety of children, but also*

*demonstrates how the law adheres to the Constitution and the principles of tribal citizenship dating back to America's founding."*

**The Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 (ICWA) ((Pub.L. 95-608, 92 Stat. 3069, was enacted on November 8, 1978)**

National child welfare experts and advocates regard Indian Child Welfare Act to be the gold standard of child welfare laws because, when properly followed, it delivers better outcomes for children and their families.

But if those attacking Indian Child Welfare Act are successful, they would not only dismantle a law that is central to our sovereign interests in protecting our children but also create chaos and instability throughout the country by overturning the basic framework of Indian law and the political nature of tribal citizenship.

On November 9, 2022, the Supreme Court will hear arguments and then decide the future of Indian Child Welfare Act.

*"We are confident that the court will rule on the side of Indian Child Welfare Act, of the Constitution, of history, of child welfare experts, of states, and of children and families. To do otherwise, the court would be ignoring decades of precedent, overriding congressional authority, and putting our tribal children's safety at risk. We stand with hundreds of tribes across the nation in defending Indian Child Welfare Act in court and look forward to once again seeing its constitutionality upheld."*

In the brief, the tribes explain why Indian Child Welfare Act remains critical

and relevant today, noting that a "mountain of evidence – from 1978 to today – shows that Indian Child Welfare Act provides an essential buffer against practices that continue to yield the unwarranted removal of Indian children" and that "Indian Child Welfare Act is based on a simple idea: When Indian children can stay with their families and communities, Tribes and children alike are better off."

Over 500 American and Alaskan Native Tribes, 60 tribal organizations, 87 different members of Congress, 23 states, and a county with the largest child welfare system in the country filed amicus briefs that defend ICWA's ability to encourage tribal-state and tribal-federal relations, as well as emphasize ICWA's effectiveness in practice in state contexts.

## Helping America to Understand Tribal Sovereignty

American Indian Reporter interview with Chairman Daniel Salgado, Sr.,

Daniel Salgado, Sr., Tribal Chairman Cahuilla Band of Indians shares a photo op with Dr. Mehmet Cengiz Öz, known professionally as Dr. Oz, is a Turkish American television presenter, author, politician, professor emeritus, and retired cardiothoracic surgeon.

He is the Republican nominee in the 2022 United States Senate election in Pennsylvania and is the first Muslim candidate to be nominated by either major party for U.S. Senate.

When Chairman Salgado was asked why he was meeting with Dr. Oz, he said, that one of the objectives of the California Gaming tribes is to educate local, state and federal policy makers on the American Indian Tribal Rights, Laws and Sovereignty.

Why Dr. Oz? He's not ever a member of congress nor does Pennsylvania have any

recognized American Indian Tribes. *"It doesn't matter, Salgado said, "if he's willing to listen to us, we'll talk to him, we don't set any limits on who or when we will meet with. When we have the opportunity to share our history and explain our Treaty rights we're in it."*

*"Gaining has given the Tribal Governments a great opportunity to actively participate in the political process and make our voices heard in halls and chambers of congress."* He added. *"Not ever Indian Tribe has a casino as the general public is led to believe."*

How extensive the Tribal public awareness initiative will be implemented after the Sports Betting vote is over in California on November 8 has not been determined.

*"There is defiantly a need to continue these lines of communication."* Chairman Salgado said.



## Ute Indian Tribe call's Biden's Camp Hale – Continental Divide National Monument declaration an unlawful act of genocide

On October 12, 2022 President Biden designated a new National Monument in the middle of the Ute Indian Tribe's traditional homelands without tribal consultation and including the tribe in the management of these lands. The tribe and its elected leaders were even excluded from the event taking place on their homelands. Surrounded by forests, mountains, and towns named after the tribe and its leaders,

President Biden met with other tribes from the area, but did not include the Ute Indian Tribe and its Uncompahgre Band who sustained these lands long before the founding of the United States.

**The Camp Hale – Continental Divide National Monument** is within the homelands of the Ute Indian Tribe's Uncompahgre Band.

The United States forced the Uncompahgre Band off these valuable lands in 1880. Today, the United States was back to further dispossess the Band from its lands by designating a monument without fully including the tribe.

The Ute Indian Tribe Business Committee condemned the White House's actions. *"They moved forward with a monument on our homelands without including us. They talk about tribal consultation, but their actions do not match their words."* The Business Committee stated, *"We cannot support a monument on our homelands that does not include the tribe."*

The Ute Indian Tribe learned about plans for the Monument just days ago. Concerned about management of their traditional homelands, the tribe's elected leaders were quickly summoned for a call with the White House.

Few details were shared and there was little time for the tribe to share its knowledge and history of the area. Instead of fully engaging the Ute Indian Tribe and its Uncompahgre Band in designating the Monument, the White House rushed forward with its own priorities.

The tribe will fight to protect its lands and resources in the area, including cultural resources and burial sites of the tribe's ancestors. While the White House took credit for protecting tribal burial sites, the Business Committee commented, *"It is a disgrace to our ancestors to exclude the tribe in the care and protection of these burial sites. We are shocked that 200 years later, nothing has changed. This unlawful action by the President today is a desecration of our ancestors that remain buried on our homelands. Many of these Ute ancestors passed on seeking to protect these lands from further encroachment and others left us as part of the forced death march at the*

*hands of the United States as we were moved out of Colorado at gunpoint. The Ute Indian Tribe will not stand by to accept further genocidal tactics that continue to be perpetuated against our people and our ancestors that came before us. The United States President is doing what the United States has always done and we will use all lawful measures at our disposal to stop this."*

In an era where the Administration and Congress are desperately seeking tribal wisdom, ecological knowledge, and co-management to hold back the impacts of global warming and increasing drought, the President and the Administration are pursuing their own priorities and not listening to the needs of Indian tribes.

In designating the Monument, the President and his Congressional supporters reverted to discredited federal policies of "chief making" by attempting to pick and choose between tribes and tribal leaders.

The President also violated his own directives on government-to-government consultation. In a January 26, 2021 memorandum to federal agencies, President Biden wrote:



*"My Administration is committed to honoring tribal sovereignty and including tribal voices in policy deliberation that affects tribal communities. The Federal Government has much to learn from tribal nations and strong communication is fundamental to a constructive relationship."*

Today's actions violate the President's commitment which was based on more than two centuries of a nation-to-nation relationship, federal trust responsibility, and treaties and agreements between the United States and Indian tribes.

The Ute Indian tribe opposes the designation of a new National Monument without full participation of the tribe in protecting and managing its homelands. It is an act of genocide to attempt to erase the history and connection of the tribe to these lands.

Business Committee Chairman and Uncompahgre Band Member Shaun Chapoose commented *"We've tried to work with this Administration, but time after time they refuse to address the real issues tribes are facing."* He continued, *"Even on our traditional homelands, they refused to work closely with us. These new*

*monuments are an abomination and demonstrate manifest disregard and disrespect of the Ute Indian Tribe's treaty rights and sovereign status as a federally recognized Indian Tribe. If it's a fight they want it's a fight they will get."*

The Business Committee called for the President to take action to restore and protect the tribe's current homelands in Utah. *"While the President is out here in Colorado on our traditional homelands, his Administration is refusing to address ongoing attacks on our current homelands in Utah. First they took our lands in Colorado, and now they won't address our lands at home."*

For almost two years, Secretary Deb Haaland and Assistant Secretary for Indian Affairs Bryan Newland have not addressed the tribe's request for restoration of lands within its Uncompahgre Reservation, making up the eastern half of its Uintah and Ouray Reservation. Secretary Haaland and Assistant Secretary Newland have refused multiple requests from the tribe to resolve this issue. Section 3 of the Indian Reorganization Act (IRA) provides all the authority they need to take action and secure the tribe's homelands.

Meanwhile the tribe's Uncompahgre Reservation has been under attack ever since it was established in the 1880 Agreement and Act of Congress and an Executive Order in 1882. First, the Reservation was opened to non-Indian settlement and stockmen, and later, the Secretary of the Interior administratively transferred management of these lands to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). Today, the BLM manages about 1.8 million acres within the Uncompahgre Reservation for the benefit of the Federal government and the state of Utah.

*"That's not right,"* the Business Committee continued. *"Nothing is being done to secure our Reservation homelands where we live and work. Indian reservation homelands must be protected and secured above all else! Every day, BLM and the State take more and more of our resources. Resources that we reserved to provide for future generations of our tribe. The President must take action to restore and secure our Uncompahgre Reservation homelands."*

Despite Interior's past actions, lands within the Uncompahgre Reservation are eligible for trust restoration under the IRA. The tribe's lands should be restored to trust status the same as other Ute bands who were a part of the 1880 Agreement and Act of Congress.

Congress never disestablished the Uncompahgre Reservation and never took title to the tribe's lands. The 10th Circuit Court of Appeals has repeatedly held that Reservation was never disestablished, and the U.S. Supreme Court has refused to review these decisions.

In one of these decisions in 1985, the full 10th Circuit Court of Appeals found that allotment of the Reservation *"doesn't disturb the ownership of the land by the tribal group."*

The Ute Indian Tribe is pressing the Administration on the importance of restoring and protecting tribal homelands and including the tribe in the protection of its ancestral lands and resources. Under the 1880 Agreement and Act of Congress, the tribe was forced to build a new life on its Reservation in Utah. The tribe's homes, communities, and businesses are now in Utah. Securing and protecting the tribe's current homelands should be a priority for the Biden Administration.

The Ute Indian Tribe is calling for Congressional hearings and oversight of Secretary Haaland and Assistant Secretary Newland's failure to address tribal priorities and protection of tribal reservation homelands. The Business Committee commented, *"We hear all these headlines about actions for Indian tribes, but where is this Administration on securing our homelands, increasing law enforcement to protect our communities, protecting our waters, and defending our lands and resources in federal court."* The Business Committee continued, *"All too often the Secretary and Assistant Secretary are chasing their own priorities and not the priorities of Indian tribes. Or, even worse, they are often sitting on the wrong side of the table and not fulfilling the President's commitments and solemn trust responsibility to Indian country."*

The Ute Indian Tribe notes that the Administration's actions within a number of federal agencies violate the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP) which requires that governments avoid any action *"which has the aim or effect of*

*dispossessing [indigenous peoples] of their lands, territories or resources;..."*

Endorsed by President Obama in 2010, the tribe has repeatedly met with the White House and Administration Officials seeking actions consistent with UNDRIP.

In particular, the tribe has asked the Administration to adopt a tribal consultation standard of Free, Prior, Informed Consent for any actions impacting tribal communities and tribal resources. The White House and the Administration have refused to recognize and uphold this international law principal as other developed nations with large indigenous populations, such as Canada, have sought to do. Failing to abide by this international standard casts a cloud on the United States and diminishes its standing among the world's governments.

The Business Committee concluded, *"The President's actions today in declaring these National Monuments in the manner he did is a national disgrace. The United States cannot move forward without acknowledging and accepting its past and taking meaningful action to address these issues with our tribal homelands now. Unless and until this happens, the United States will always have this deplorable history hanging over it as a black cloud and will never be able to advance to a position of a nation with moral and legal legitimacy, which will forever limit its standing in the world community. Only on this basis can we have a true nation-to-nation relationship that allows us to work together to sustain our lands and resources for our future generations."*



### About the Ute Indian Tribe

The Ute Indian Tribe resides on the Uintah and Ouray Reservation in northeastern Utah. Three bands of Utes comprise the Ute Indian Tribe: the Whiteriver Band, the Uncompahgre Band, and the Uintah Band. The tribe has a membership of more than three thousand individuals, with over half living on the Uintah and Ouray Reservation. The Ute Indian Tribe operates its own tribal government and oversees significant oil and gas deposits on its 4.5-million-acre Reservation. The Tribal Business Committee is the governing council of the tribe.

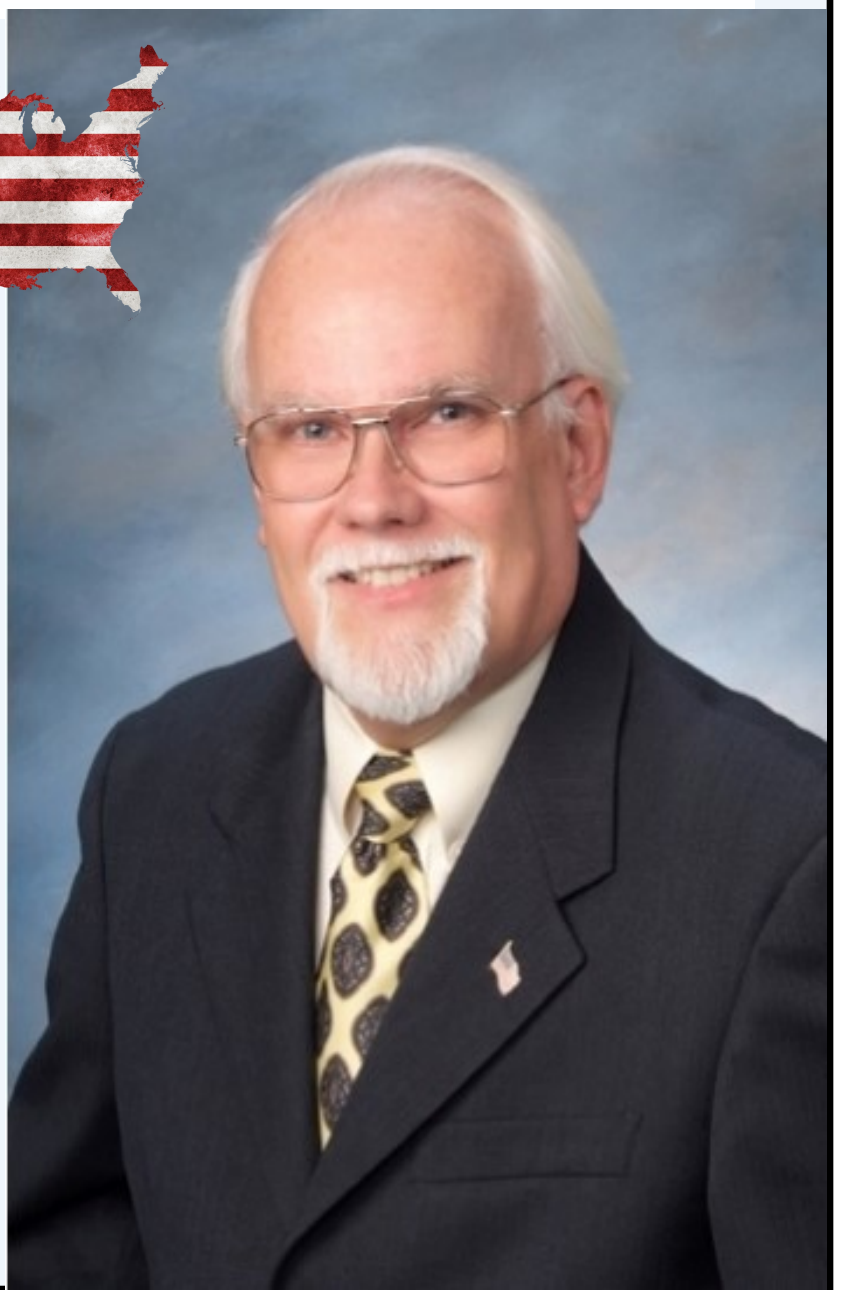
He served as Board President from 2011 to 2013, and again in 2018 and 2022. He previously served as Vice President and Board Treasurer.

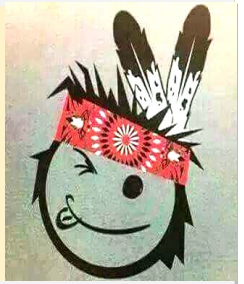

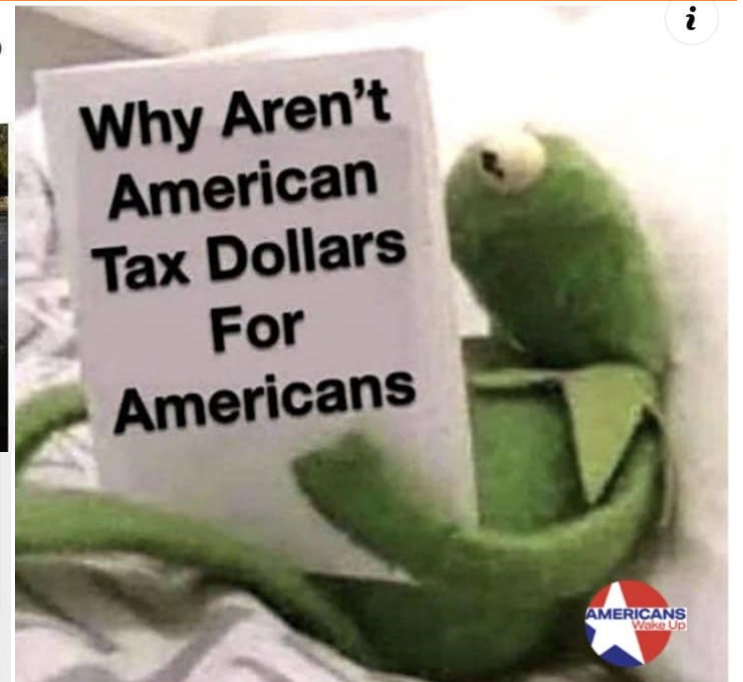
