



Nobel Prize Winning Scientist Gets 'Canceled' For What He Just Said About Climate Change



Esteemed physicist Dr. John Clauser, who holds multiple degrees from the California Institute of Technology and Columbia University, won Nobel Prize in Physics in 2022.

As a scientific expert, Clauser does not believe there is a man-made global warming crisis. This doesn't sit well with left-wing climate activists.

"I don't believe there is a climate crisis," Clauser explained. "The world we live in today is filled with misinformation. It is up to each of you to serve as judges, distinguishing truth from falsehood based on accurate observations of phenomena."

"In my opinion, there is no real climate crisis," Dr. Clauser continued. "There is, however, a very real problem with providing a decent standard of living to the world's large population and an associated energy crisis. The latter is being unnecessarily exacerbated by what, in my opinion, is incorrect climate science."

Those who deny global warming often face extreme ridicule and are subject to censorship and "cancelation." In 2022, a peerreviewed study from climate experts was **published** showing several unsubstantiated claims about "apocalyptic" climate change appearing in the mainstream media.

Wray lied about not targeting Catholics Read More @ Washington Examiner



FBI Director <u>Christopher</u> Wray has forfeited all grounds for confidence in his integrity. He was caught this week in yet another falsehood, this time about an infamous memo targeting "traditionalist" Catholics, which appears to mean those who hew to orthodox doctrines and unmodernized liturgies. Wray must be made to clean up his act or clean out his office.

The memo, produced by the FBI's Richmond field office, said the bureau should particularly monitor "traditionalist Catholic" people, such as those who prefer the Latin Mass, as potential purveyors of

"violent extremis[m]" who may need to be targeted for "threat mitigation." It assumed traditionalist Catholics are particularly prone to becoming domestic terrorists. This is false and defamatory, and the specter of law enforcement targeting a faith community raises serious First Amendment concerns.

In his July 12 testimony to the House Judiciary Committee, Wray insisted that the memo was merely "a single product by a single field office."

Wray consistently acts as though the purpose of his job is to serve the FBI, up to and including defending or concealing indefensible FBI behavior. His job is to serve, and to have the FBI serve, the public and its duly enacted laws. This should mean firing all FBI staff who instead serve themselves and their ideological allies.

The late great Dr. E.V. Hill was once asked if he thought Jesus was Caucasian as depicted in paintings. This was his reply:





Illegal Chinese Biolab Uncovered In California, What They Found Is Deeply Disturbing



Central CA Fresno County

A Chinese-linked company was found running an unlicensed California biolab that contained at least 20 potentially infectious diseases, including coronavirus, HIV, hepatitis, and herpes.

The warehouse was discovered by local and federal agents in Fresno County. The illegal and unlicensed laboratory was full of lab mice, medical waste, and hazardous materials.

Federal agents interviewed a man named Xiuquin Yao who was running a company at the warehouse called "Prestige BioTech." Yao served as president of the company.

The company was registered in Nevada, but the owners used "empty offices or addresses in China that could not be verified," according to court documents filed in the case. Prestige Bio-Tech was not licensed in California.


Tribe fights to preserve California coastline and its own culture Monterey Bay National

AVILA BEACH/TPAXTU, Calif. - When Violet Sage Walker stares out at the calm waters butting against the shoreline of her hometown, she sees what was once the largest northern village of the Chumash people, who fished from traditional canoes in the open water, viewed sea creatures as their ancestors and believed in a "Western Gate" farther south where their spirits went after they passed away.

"All that is where we all lived," Walker, one of the leaders of the Chumash tribe, said recently.

That coastal California shoreline and the water it touches are at the center of a reclamation movement led by the Indigenous Chumash tribe to revive and restore its heritage, culture and land. There are about 10,200 people with some Chumash ancestry left, according to the Census Bureau. Their effort is part of a nationwide "land back" movement by Native Americans to reclaim sacred sites. The Biden administration has established national landmarks for Native peo-<u>ple</u> and appointed the first Native American to a Cabinet secretary position, Interior Secretary Deb Haaland. Haaland, as well as other members of the Biden Cabinet, has **spoken in favor** of a Chumash marine sanctuary **p**roposal.

NCAA approves changes to softball illegal pitch, obstruction rules

It will no longer be illegal for softball pitchers to have both feet off the ground at the same time according to <u>changes approved</u> by the NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel. The illegal pitch rule was one of several changes adopted by the panel for the 2023-24 season. Others include changes to the obstruction rule, video replay, and park configuration for new fields.

Beginning with the upcoming season, a pitcher is still prohibited from replanting her foot after pushing off the rubber. However, she can lift both off the ground because the panel determined that no advantage is gained by having both feet in the air while delivering a pitch.

George Soros bankrolls mysterious institution looking to flip Texas to **Democrats, records show**

Financier George Soros is almost singlehandedly bankrolling a mysterious Texas entity working to build up progressive infrastructure across the Lone Star State in attempts to elect more Democrats, records reviewed by Fox News Digital show.

According to Federal Election Commission filings released Monday, George Soros's Democracy PAC II has provided \$750,000 to the Texas Majority PAC during the year's first half. Meanwhile, the Texas Majority PAC's state filings show that the group raised \$752,040 during that time, meaning Soros has financially propelled the group.

Texas Majority PAC has maneuvered in the shadows, and virtually no information about the group is available online. Texas incorporation records show it registered in December 2022.



Its website doesn't appear in search engines like Google but can be found at texasmajoritypac.com. Even so, there are sparse details about the entity on its site.






