Henry A. Kissinger was the 56th Secretary of State, a respected American scholar and Nobel Peace Prize Laureate who helped create the post-World War II world order and led the U.S. through some of its most complicated foreign policy challenges.

With his distinct German accent, sharp wit, voluminous writings and belief in the peacemaking power of realpolitik, Dr. Kissinger was one of the most influential foreign policy and national security practitioners of the post-World War II era and remained active in national security for more than 70 years. From the age of 20, when he joined the U.S. Army, to nearly his death, Dr. Kissinger continued to travel to Washington to offer testimony on U.S. national security strategy.

Friday marked the 68th anniversary of arguably the most well-known act of defiance of the civil rights movement when on Dec. 1, 1955 42-year-old Rosa Parks was arrested for refusing to abide by segregation laws aboard a Montgomery, Alabama bus.

Ramping up the victimhood rhetoric, Missouri Rep. Cori Bush (D) commemorated the anniversary with a quote from Parks' biography and an "asinine and narcissistic" self-comparison that stirred social media.

ICE agent warns that 'terror groups like Hamas' are already in the US thanks to open border

A former Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agent said Wednesday that Hamas and other terrorist groups are already in the United States thanks to the flood of migrants crossing the southern border.

The radical Islamic terrorist group carried out a deadly terrorist attack on multiple locations in southern Israel on Oct. 7, killing over 1,400 people, including at least 30 Americans. The agent said he interviewed members of Hamas apprehended while trying to cross the border.

"We currently turn a blind eye to literally millions of people crossing this border including terror groups like Hamas," Tom Feeley, a former director of ICE Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO) in New York, told "Fox and Friends" co-host Lawrence Jones



The rite of passage is traditionally attended by Scout Snipers past and present.



He is the third American Indian to ever serve as a U.S. Senator in the 243 year history of the nation. He was preceded by Charles Curtis from Kansas 1915-29 who later served as Vice President from 1929-33 under Hoover. Ben Nighthorse Campbell serve from Colorado served from 1993 to 2005.



Those under 20 do not remember when there was no Internet. Men went to the moon with less technology that is contained in even flip phones.



Elders tend to plan based on their experience. Youth have the exuberance of unencumbered experience and lack of barriers.

The first step then is to do visioning with each group together. An easy way to find some platform of consensus is to pick a topic and have everyone write down three goals for the future about that topic. Collation of those slips of paper will generate some common ground. That topic (or topics) should provide the beginning ground.

The elders are honor bound to give a history of that subject, complete with former successes, failures, obstacles and unintended consequences. The youth should articulate their vision of what they would like to see in the future as well as the tools, policies and procedures they need to get there.

Then, together, planning can start. Whether the final product in a vision statement, a proposal, a desired program, suggested legislation, etc., it should reflect the total chronology of the community

Repeat this exercise over and over on all topics and soon you will have "Stepping Stones to the Future" that honor seven generations past and provides seven generations hence with a legacy of true tribal self determination but, more importantly, a community that has the "buy-in", united in purpose with strength that cannot be compromised.

The five nonprofits that compose Arabella Advisors' network, including the Windward Fund and the New Venture Fund, do not have to disclose the source of their funding. The five nonprofits also make grants to each other in some cases, making it more difficult to identify the origins of the money, according to the Capital Research Center.

After Congress passed the Civil Rights Act of 1866 – establishing citizenship for newly emancipated slaves – Presiden Andrew Johnson vetoed it, voicing concern that it was "*made* to operate in favor of the colored and against the white race."




