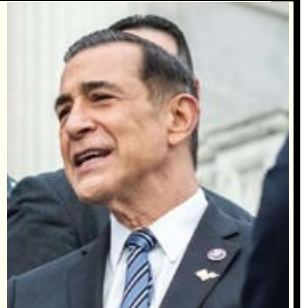

## Over 23 million immigrants eligible to vote in 2024: report

Over 23 million legal immigrants who are now U.S. citizens are eligible to vote in the 2024 presidential election, according to a new report.

Published by the American Immigration Council, the report notes that of the 23,775,184 immigrants turned naturalized U.S. citizens who live in the U.S., 23,053,019 are eligible to vote.

Moreover, there are an additional

13,336,047 immigrants who are eligible for naturalization and may therefore soon be able to vote as well.

*“As more immigrants naturalize and become eligible to vote, they continue to gain political power. The number of immigrant voters is only projected to rise in the next decade, and in some states, foreign-born voters are already capable of deciding elections,”* the report states.

Based on the U.S. population size, it appears immigrants will for the time being continue to account for 1-in-10 of all eligible voters in 2024.

Keep in mind all these numbers refer to LEGAL immigrants. Regarding illegal migrants, Congress passed a law in 1996 barring them from voting in federal elections. However, they may still vote in state and local elections, depending on the jurisdiction’s laws.

*“[T]here were over 25 million noncitizens living in the U.S. as of 2020. That included approximately 12 million permanent residents and 2 million temporary residents who were in the country with legal permission, as well as approximately 11 million immigrants who resided in the country without legal permission,”* Ballotpedia further notes.

Hoover investigated both of the Kennedys assassinations which the findings in both investigations were questionable at best. I’m not excluding that the CIA was involved. What I am saying is on face

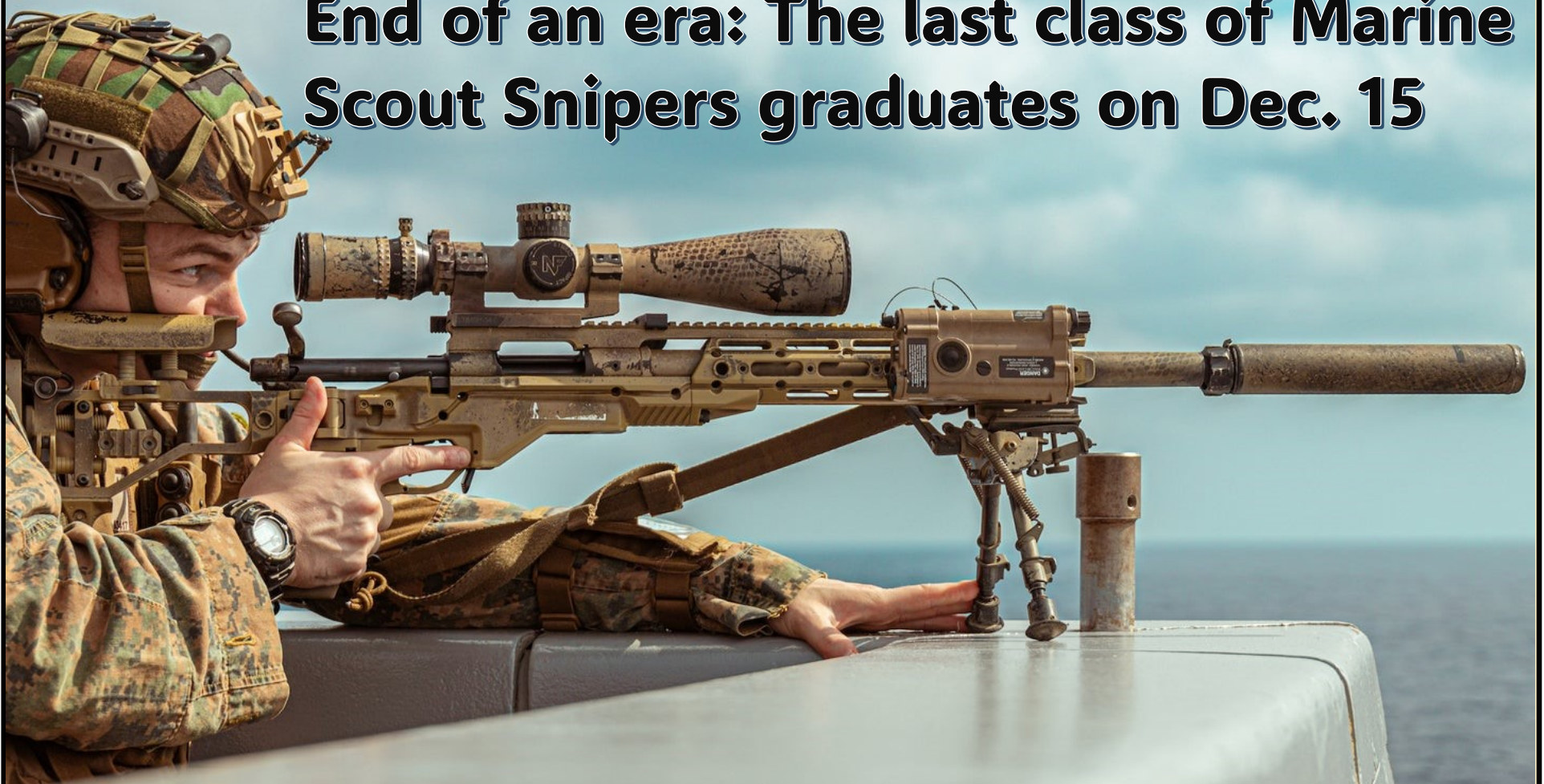
value Hoover and Johnson benefited.

The last class of Marine Scout Snipers is scheduled to graduate on Dec. 15, marking the end of the 0317 MOS and a long tradition of producing some of the deadliest snipers on the battlefield.

The last HOGs night will take place the night before, aboard Camp Geiger in North Carolina.

Marine scout sniper candidates are initially called Professionally Instructed Gunmen, or PIGs, but once they graduate from the course, they are called Hunters of Gunmen, or HOGs.

The HOGs night, a tradition for all scout sniper graduates including legends like Carlos Hathcock and Charles “Chuck” Mawhinney, is where scout snipers gather around a bonfire to receive their HOGs tooth, a 7.62 bullet on a 550 cord necklace. The rite of passage is traditionally attended by Scout Snipers past and present.

Jonathan Taylor is the executive vice president and COO of the USMC Scout Sniper Association. He served as a Scout Sniper from 2006 to 2013, deploying three times to Iraq and once to Afghanistan. He’s helped put together the HOGs night for years, helping to attract celebrity guest speakers and getting invites out to as many scout snipers as possible.

“It’s usually just a smaller group with the gradu-

ates and then a few, you know, a few stragglers here or there. This one is scheduled to be big,” Taylor said. “We’re already getting emails from people. I think they are planning for 50 at the HOGs night, but that’s just off the top of the head of the staff NCOIC. I would say it’s closer to 60 to 70.”

He grew up in Hollywood California and graduated from Hollywood High School. His father was part of the “Indian Relocation Program” in the early 50’s and 60’s.

The photo on the right pictures U.S. Senator Markwayne Mullin from Oklahoma. Mullin is a citizen of the Cherokee Nation and the only American Indian serving in the U.S. Senate.

He is the third American Indian to ever serve as a U.S. Senator in the 243 year history of the nation. He was preceded by Charles Curtis from Kansas 1915-29 who later served as Vice President from 1929-33 under Hoover. Ben Nighthorse Campbell serve from Colorado served from 1993 to 2005.

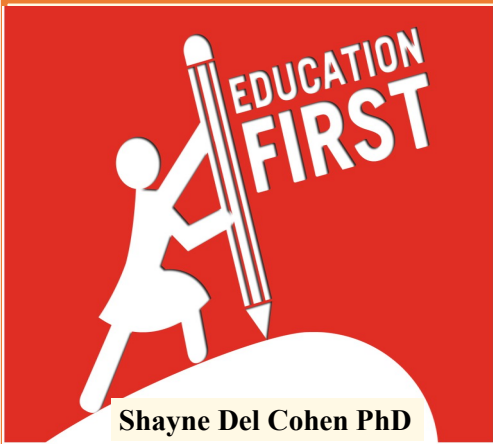

**“ There have always been generation gaps”**



Although there are some remote reservations that may lack a few modern innovations, most persons under forty do not remember a time without electricity, clean water systems and housing that engendered “green snot”.

Those under 20 do not remember when there was no Internet. Men went to the moon with less technology that is contained in even flip phones.

Cell phones, total service wristbands are common; drone photography and jet-pack travel are seen tools everyone will have. Covid impacted world society, leaving major imprints, some good, some bad.

Zoom (and others) evolved to be a major source of meetings; we gained transparency as one could now attend meetings that were geographically hard to reach but now we are learning anywhere in the world was open to all (who had electronic access).

Access to information - any information - became available to all age groups in almost every corner of the globe. Like any technological advancement, it has its pluses and minus eons of electrons that fly around the world providing almost instant access to a query. “Knowledge” is available to anyone, any age, anywhere.

My concern in Indian Country is that historically, so much has been written about “Indians” and we know a lot of it has been false. Early settlers learned that if they cried “Indians committing depredations” they would get cavalry and federal funds. Forced relocation of tribes cost the loss of libraries of knowledge by those descendant's of



ancestors who had learned to thrive in areas for thousands of years.

Politically, a line here, a line there, insertion of a word like may instead of shall has cost communities loss of valuable land and other resources. Poor legal representation often resulted in court decisions that may have been archived without exhibits, etc., that again, tell “the other side of the story.

And so a generation gap grows in which older generations that are not techie savvy have to reach across a chasm to generations that may have instant access to information but not the critical thinking skills to determine what is correct and what stretches the truth.

Kudos here to the State of California for recently passing legislation (which the Governor signed)

Many skills imbued into “the greatest generation” and “baby boomers” are now obsolete. Generations X, Y and Z operate in a vastly different worldwide world.

Yet the historical challenge of tribal leadership has always been the health, safety and well-being of the Tribe. The futuristic challenge of tribal leadership will always be the health, safety and well-being of the Tribe.

Thus the generation gap must be mitigated by a mutually respectful exchange of viewpoints and knowledge on many topics.

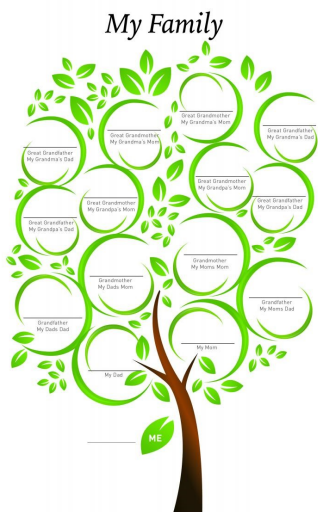
Elders tend to plan based on their experience. Youth have the exuberance of unencumbered experience and lack of barriers.

The first step then is to do visioning with each group together. An easy way to find some platform of consensus is to pick a topic and have everyone write down three goals for the future about that topic. Collation of those slips of paper will generate some common ground. That topic (or topics) should provide the beginning ground.

The elders are honor bound to give a history of that subject, complete with former successes, failures, obstacles and unintended consequences. The youth should articulate their vision of what they would like to see in the future as well as the tools, policies and procedures they need to get there.

Then, together, planning can start. Whether the final product in a vision statement, a proposal, a desired program, suggested legislation, etc., it should reflect the total chronology of the community

Repeat this exercise over and over on all topics and soon you will have “Stepping Stones to the Future” that honor seven generations past and provides seven generations hence with a legacy of true tribal self determination but, more importantly, a community that has the “buy-in”, united in purpose with strength that cannot be compromised.

# Biden cabinet secretary’s daughter works for activist group tied to liberal dark money juggernaut



Interior Secretary Deb Haaland’s daughter works for an anti-fossil fuel activist group connected to a sprawling liberal dark money network.

Somah Haaland, a member of the Laguna Pueblo tribe and daughter of Deb Haaland, is a communications coordinator for the Pueblo

Action Alliance (PAA), a New Mexico-based activist group advocating for “indigenous solutions as means to dismantle and eradicate white supremacy, capitalism, imperialism, hetero-patriarchy and extractive colonialism” that has drawn scrutiny from some elected Republicans for its engagement on land use policy, according to its website.

PAA is a fiscal project of the Southwest Organizing Project (SWOP), a group that has received more than \$1.5 million since 2020 from funds managed by Arabella Advisors, a for-profit company that oversees a vast dark money network aligned with left-of-center organizations and causes.

In 2022, the Windward Fund, a nonprofit operating as part of the

Arabella network, gave SWOP \$150,000 after giving it more than \$136,000 in 2021 and \$70,000 in 2020, according to the Windward Fund’s tax filings. The New Venture Fund, another nonprofit leg of the Arabella network, gave SWOP \$282,000 and \$425,000

in 2021 and 2022, respectively, after giving SWOP more than \$467,000 in 2020, according to the New Venture Fund’s tax filings.

Arabella Advisors-managed funds have also supported other organizations that advocate for a bevy of left-wing political causes, such as campaigns pushing for oil divestment and less stringent criminal sentencing, according to Influence Watch. The five nonprofits that compose Arabella Advisors’ network, including the Windward Fund and the New Venture Fund, do not have to disclose the source of their funding. The five nonprofits also make grants to each other in some cases, making it more difficult to identify the origins of the money, according to the Capital Research Center.

After Congress passed the Civil Rights Act of 1866 — establishing citizenship for newly emancipated slaves — President Andrew Johnson vetoed it, voicing concern that it was “made to operate in favor of the colored and against the white race.” But lawmakers overrode his veto, enacting one of the nation’s first building blocks of an equal society. Now, 157 years later, the law has become central to the legal battle over what is fair and equal when it comes to race in the workplace. In recent years — and especially since the Supreme Court overturned race-conscious college admissions in June — the Reconstruction-era law has emerged as a critical tool for conservatives intent on dismantling race-specific programs that promote “diversity, equity and inclusion,” or DEI.

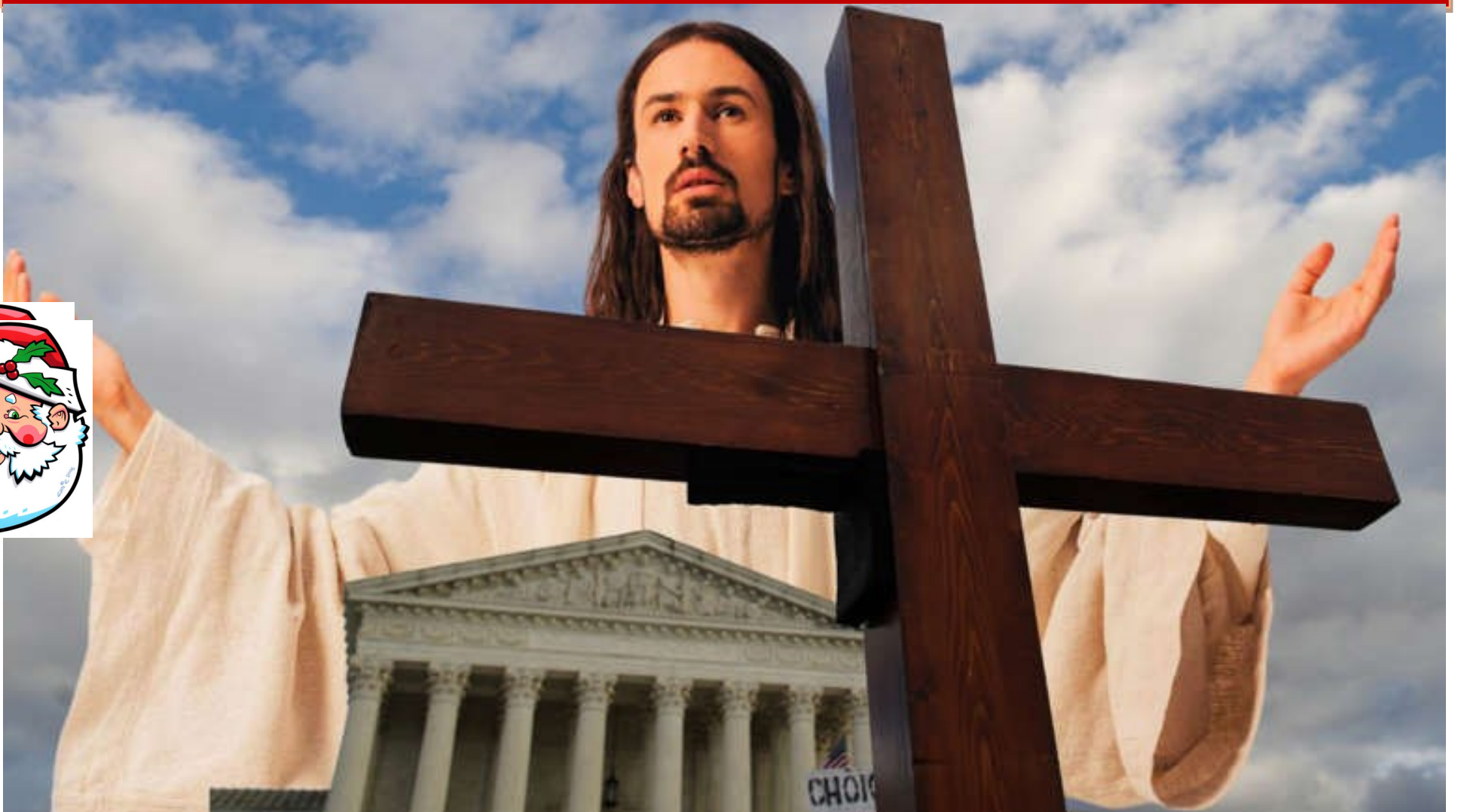

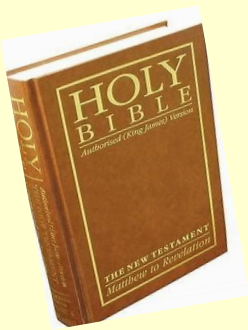

## Judges toss lawsuit targeting North Dakota House subdistricts for tribal nations

BISMARCK, N.D. (AP) — A federal three-judge panel in North Dakota has dismissed a lawsuit brought by Republican district officials who alleged that the consideration of race was unconstitutional in the creation of state House subdistricts that included ones encompassing tribal nations.

The lawsuit filed early last year by the two GOP legislative district officials targeted the two sub-divided districts the Legislature drew in 2021, which included subdistricts for the Fort Berthold and Turtle Mountain Indian reservations. The lawsuit alleged that the “racial gerrymandering” was a violation of the equal protection clause.

The ruling issued Thursday by U.S. District Court Chief Judge Peter Welte, Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals Judge Ralph Erickson and U.S. District Court Judge Daniel Hovland granted

motions for summary judgment made by the state and the Mandan, Hidatsa and Arikara Nation, and denied the plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment, dismissing the case.

The judges said the state “*had good reasons and strong evidence to believe the subdistricts were required by*” the federal Voting Rights Act.

The plaintiffs will discuss their next steps, including a possible appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court, attorney Bob Harms told The Associated Press.

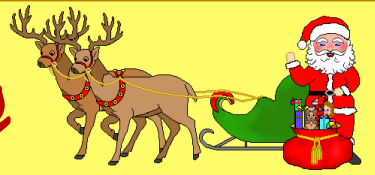

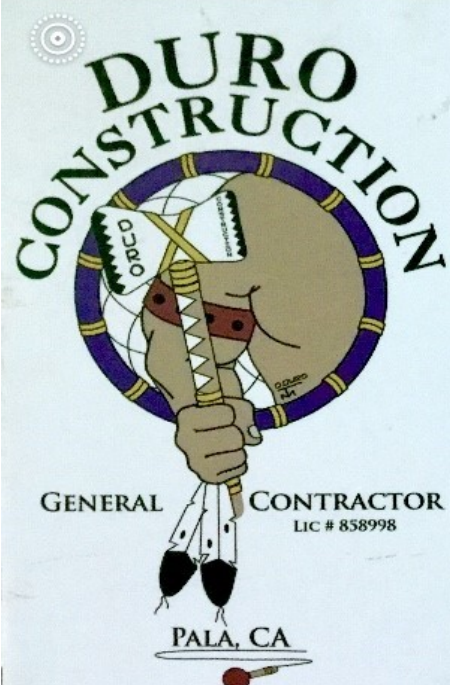
