Indian Nation 2023: Complacency?

The **Occupation of Alcatraz** (November 20, 1969 – June 11, 1971) was a 19-month long protest when 89 Native Americans and their supporters occupied Alcatraz Island. The protest was led by Richard Oakes, LaNada Means, and others, while John Trudell served as spokesman. The group lived on the island together until the protest was forcibly ended by the U.S. government.

The protest group chose the name **Indians of All Tribes (IAT)** for themselves. IAT claimed that, under the Treaty of Fort Laramie between the U.S. and the Lakota tribe, all retired, abandoned, or out-of-use federal land was to be returned to the Indigenous peoples who once occupied it. As Alcatraz penitentiary had been closed on March 21, 1963, and the island had been declared surplus federal property in 1964, a number of Red Power activists felt that the island qualified for a reclamation by Indians.

The Occupation of Alcatraz had a brief effect on federal Indian Termination policies and established a precedent for Indian activism. Oakes was shot to death in 1972, and the American Indian Movement was later targeted by the federal governments DOJ and FBI's illegal COINTELPRO operation.

It is not my intent to minimize the extraordinary advancements the Tribal Nations have made since they were "Legally" allowed to manage their own affairs under the authorization of P.L. 93-638, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Act of 1975.

My reference to **"Complacency"** is meant to serve as a reminder that not everyone within the U.S. Government system respects or acknowledges Tribal Sovereignty or Tribal Treaties with

the U.S. Government. The most recent examples is the **supreme court ruling in Oklahoma vs Castro-Huerta** is a glaring example of their **political and racial bias**.

It is also troublesome at best, bazaar is probably more accurate. The ruling was based on what appeared to be some kind of medieval channeling, time travel or cross-century mind reading, **absolutely bazaar**.

Not only did they undermine **Chief Justice Marshall's 1832 supreme court ruling in Worcester v Georgia** they completely disregarded **P.L. 280** which was passed by congress in 1953 and has been amended over the past 70-years to strengthen the jurisdictional rights of the Tribal Governments in keeping with the Marshall ruling in 1832. **Now, if that's not enough cause for concerns**, Justice Karnaugh wrote the opinion of the court stating that if congress would have wanted the tribes to have rights over jurisdiction they would have passed legislation as such. **AGAIN, BAZAARI!**

Tribal Governments are still fighting to protect their Tribal Rights to exist within the boundaries as provided by Treaties, Indian Laws and federal Court Rulings.

Recently, before the supreme court was **Brackeen v Haaland** which challenges the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 that the legislation is based on **"Race"** and that the **"Political Relationship between the American Indian Tribes and the United States Government,"** is not valid. Once again the court made it's ruling on subjectivity as opposed to law. The issue of race and the political relationship between the two governments were not addressed. The tribes were appeased, viewing it as a win while the real challenge has yet to be decided.

Another legal challenge to Tribal Sovereignty working its way through the federal courts is **Maverick Gaming LLC v United States**, a case challenging the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act on the ground of equal protection, stating that **tribal status is based on race**. Basically the challenge is identical to **Brackeen v Haaland**.

Maverick Gaming LLC v United States, are also challenging the ruling in **Morton v Mancari**, a case that gave hiring preference to American Indians and Alaska Natives in the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the Fifth Amendment.

Tribal status as a political classification is affirmed by treaties, the United States constitution and several case laws including **Morton v Mancari**.

My concern with the court is with the **political and racial bias of the conservative GOP majority of the supreme court justice's** regarding the American Indian Tribal Governments Sovereignty, Jurisdiction and Treaty Rights and their willingness to ignore the laws and precedence established over the past 500 years and guaranteed in the U.S. Constitution for 247-years and hundreds of federal court rulings.

However, the resent ruling by the **supreme court in Oklahoma vs Castro-Huerta** is a glaring example of **their political and racial bias**.

My basic instincts and due diligent is to insure there are no extenuating circumstances involved. In effort to accomplish this task I would develop a legal plan of activities, objectives and goals to conduct a comprehensive review of justices, family, friends and business associates for any links to gaming or ventures with tribal interest for any conflict of interest. I would share all finding with congress, Department of Interior and Department of Justise

Under federal relocation efforts that began in the 1950s, thousands of Native Americans left reservations to look for opportunities in Los Angeles and San Francisco. In 1969, activists occupied a decommissioned federal prison on Alcatraz Island for nearly two years, claiming it as Native American land. Tribes started holding bingo games in in the late '70s to generate revenue, leading to a dispute and ultimately a Supreme Court ruling that states didn't have the authority to regulate gaming on Indian lands—effectively green-lighting casino development on Native American land.

‘Mind-blowing’: Even mobster ‘Sammy the Bull’ can’t believe latest Hunter Biden plot twist



A notorious mobster says evidence in the Biden family influence-peddling investigation is “mind-blowing” and he can’t believe “no action” has been taken against those who are committing “treason” against our nation.

Salvatore “Sammy the Bull” Gravano, a former underboss in the Gambino crime family, joined on Thursday Fox News’s Jesse Watters on “Primetime” to discuss the latest allegations against the President’s son, Hunter Biden.

Watters opened the segment with a reminder about a \$40,000 personal check that, according to Oversight Committee chair James Comer (R-Ky.), came from laundered Chinese money and “landed” in Joe Biden’s bank account.

The White House dismissed the payment, claiming it was simply the repayment of a loan.

Gravano has admitted to being involved in 19 murders and was the second-in-command of the Gambino Family when former boss John Gotti ran the criminal organization.

“And now we have proof that they lied,” Watters said. “A money-laundering investigator blew the whistle.”

In 2018, the investigator was “flagging Hunter Biden’s accounts like crazy,” he reported, in response to “unusual” and “erratic” activity involving several large-sum wire transfers.

Though Hunter called the millions of dollars a loan and began sending the money out, the investigator noted that “no loan agreement document” was submitted and his company “does not currently have any investment projects at this time,

which raises further concerns as millions in fees are being paid but does not appear to have any services rendered.”

“That’s bank lingo for ‘bribe,’” Watters stated.

“It’s mind-blowing,” Gravano said.

“I don’t understand how the country is just sitting back listening to these things and no action is being taken.”

“If you want my opinion, there are so many guys I know who would go for 20 to lifetime sentences for this kind of stuff,” he continued, “and when it comes from the President, Vice-President, and people like that, it’s beyond theft — it’s treason to a country.”

The crimes the Biden family is being accused of are “disgusting,” according to Gravano.

Urban Native Elders Health and Social Needs Are Not Being Met, New Survey Finds

A first-of-its-kind study released this week revealed that Native elders living in urban centers face food scarcity and many who have health conditions take care of their grandchildren.

The first ever Native Urban Elder Needs Assessment Survey was administered nationally to understand the needs of urban American Indian and Alaska Native Elders and raise awareness about the population.

The survey, conducted by the National Resource Center on Native American Aging (NRCNAA), sought to gain insight into the current health and social needs of the Native elder population.

In total, 1,020 urban Elders from 41 states, ages 55 and older, were surveyed from March 2021 to November 2022. Respondents reported on social and health issues, including general health, frequency of health screenings, memory and dis-

ability, alcohol and tobacco use, healthcare access, social activities, and other factors related to health and well-being.

Collette Adamsen, the director of the NRCNAA and associate director of the Center for Rural Health, said the organizations hope the study empowers tribes and Native American organizations with the necessary information to identify existing needs and address them through planning efforts, policies, and resources.

“Our Native urban population is underrepresented in national data sets, which is key to identifying and addressing the needs of this population,” Adamsen said. *“If there is no data to justify the needs, then Native urban Elders are left out of the conversation, especially when it comes time for the allocation of resources and funding.”*



Native American Hair Discrimination Echos Centuries Of Cultural Erasure

Who would consider a 1,000-plus year-old hair-style to be a passing fad? The concept sounds ridiculous at face value. Long hair, braids, plaits, and twists existed in the Americas long before any European arrival, and are some of the most enduring cultural touchstones across the continent’s near-600 distinct tribal nations. It’s an undeniable and obvious reality — or rather, it should be.

Discriminatory policies and practices targeting Native American schoolchildren and workplace employees are far too widespread across the country, effectively acting as tools of forced cultural assimilation that, for many, are all too familiar echos of the United States’ now-infamous, government-sanctioned violence against its Indigenous population. Institutions often disguise restrictive, heritage-stripping rules as dress codes, using sweeping, exclusive language to sanction hair cutting and shaving. In one recent, high-profile instance, a Waccamaw Siouan first grader was told to chop his long hair, couched as a stand against “faddish” styles.

As the conversation around hair-based racial justice grows, many are ready to illuminate just how marginalized and outright policed Native American hair remains in the U.S.

MY VIEW By Ernie C. Salgado, Jr.:

Discrimination comes in many forms and unless you have been on the receiving end, it’s difficult to verbalize the emotional trauma scars it leave o your sole. The deep feeling of humiliation, pain and anger.

In my youth I channeled all those frustration into a very powerful left hook and to an overly aggressive athletic competence with a seriously challenging attitude which caused many negative confrontations which I now view as unnecessary learning experiences.

As I matured and began to understand the motives behind racism, discrimination against religions, social status and just pure hate, I saw the foolishness and stupidity of it.

That said, I want to share an experience I had with discrimination of American Indian hair

styles. First, I want to be clear that I am an American Indian and an enrolled member of a federally recognized American Indian Tribe located in Southern California.

As a youngster my ambition were to be a professional baseball player and barber. At the ripe age of 12 my career as a barber was launched with an uncle as my mentor. By the time I was in high school I had a fairly good following but lacked business training and discipline.

In 1956 as a sophomore I gave my bother Bobby who was in the 8th grade and cousin Tony Bentiste in the 5th grade Mohawk haircuts. The next day they were expelled from school and I was call into the school superintendents



office for a scolding. I cut the strip of hair that gave the Mohawk its identity off Bobby and Tony so they could go back to school.

Most folks under 65 missed the heyday of open and acceptable racism and discrimination. Black people, Mexicans, American Indians and other ethnic groups faced racism. Poor white people were also discriminated against as well. And truth be told they still are being discriminated against by the elitist as the “White Privileged,” which is as bogus as climate change and makes about as much sense as Biden getting 80 million votes in the 2020 election.

To have a happy ending to my story I attended Barber College in San Bernardino and became a licensed professional Barber in February 1961 and a Master Barber in 1963.

December 29, 2023 marks the 133rd anniversary of the **Wounded Knee Massacre** on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, South Dakota in 1890.

Time should not diminish its memory, as it was only one of numerous acts of terrorism and genocide committed against our people.

Just as we celebrate Christmas in honor of the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ (*At least for many of us believers and not so politically correct folks*) and with the New Year right around the corner let us take a moment to remember and honor our people murdered at **Wounded Knee, South Dakota**.

On that infamous day, December 29, 1890 it is estimated that 275 Lakota Sioux men, women and children were murdered with hundreds more wounded and 25 U.S. soldiers killed and for no other reason than fear! Fear of the "Ghost Dance" was the reason given as if one could justify the incomprehensible murdering and maiming of so many innocent people. Why, because of the political policies at that period in time.

After all what more could the "Indians" want? The Government was going to take care of them as long as the rivers flow and the grass shall grow.

Again, 50-years ago on February 27, 1973, Wounded Knee, South Dakota became the center of national attention when the **American Indian Movement (AIM)** leaders, Denis Banks and Russel Means led an armed takeover and occupation of Wounded Knee.

The protest followed the failure of an effort of the Oglala Sioux Civil Rights Organization (OSCRO) to impeach tribal president Richard Wilson, whom they accused of corruption.

The armed occupancy of Wounded Knee which received national attention, ended after 71 days when Lawrence "Buddy" Lamont, a local Oglala

Lakota, was killed by a shot from a government sniper on April 26, 1973. He was buried on the site in a Sioux ceremony. A U.S. marshal was also shot and paralyzed.

After Lamont's death, tribal elders called an end to the occupation. Knowing the young man and his mother from the reservation, many Oglala were greatly sorrowed by his death. Both sides reached an agreement on May 5, 1973 to disarm.

Over 200 federal armed law enforcement were joined by local law enforcement and Wilson's private militia, *Guardians of the Oglala Nation* (GOONS).

With the decision made to end the protest, many Oglala Lakota began to leave Wounded Knee under the cover of darkness walking out through the federal agents lines.

Three days later, the siege ended and the town was evacuated after 71 days of occupation; Government agents took control of the town.

The stand at Wounded Knee electrified American Indians, who were inspired by the sight of their people standing in defiance of the government which had so often mistreated them.

Many American Indian supporters traveled to Wounded Knee to join the protest. At the time there was widespread public sympathy for the goals of the occupation, as Americans were becoming more aware of longstanding

issues of injustice related to American Indians.

AIM leaders Dennis Banks and Russell Means were indicted on charges related to the events, but their case was dismissed by the federal court for prosecutorial misconduct, and upheld on appeal.

With the support of the U.S. Government, Wilson stayed in office and in 1974 was re-elected amid charges of intimidation, voter fraud, and other abuses.

The rate of violence climbed on the reservation as conflict opened between the political factions during the following three years; *More than 60 opponents of Wilson's tribal government died violently during those years*, including Pedro Bissonette, director of the Oglala Sioux Civil Rights Organization. Traditional tribal members blamed Wilson's private militia, *Guardians of the Oglala Nation* (GOONS).

Shortly following the Wounded Knee standoff 21-year old Leonard Peltier, a young AIM leader was asked by traditional Indian people at Pine Ridge, to help protect them from being targeted for violence by Wilson's tribal GOONS. He went to their aid never to return home to his wife and children.

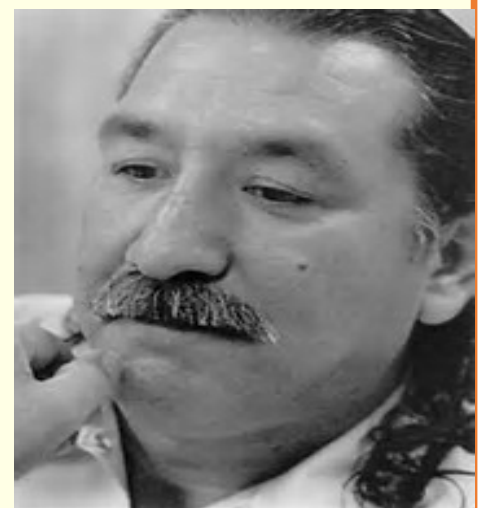
On June 26, 1975 two FBI agents in unmarked cars followed a pick-up truck onto the Jumping Bull ranch. The families immediately became alarmed and feared an attack. Shots were fired and a shoot-out ensued. More than 150 federal agents, GOONS, and law enforcement officers surrounded the ranch occupied by 40 traditional Indians.

When the shoot-out ended FBI Special Agents, Jack R. Coler and Ronald A. Williams and American Indian, Joseph Stuntz lay dead. Stuntz's death has never been investigated, nor has anyone ever been charged in connection with his death.

Leonard Peltier was convicted for the deaths of the two FBI agents killed during the shoot-out on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation.

He was sentenced to life in prison where he remains as many Tribal and non-tribal people believe as a political prisoner to this day.

Yet, 60 Oglala Sioux died at the hands of the GOONS after that infamous day and no one was ever investigated, charged or prosecuted. The FBI and GOONS prevailed.



Numerous doubts have been raised over Peltier's guilt and the fairness of his trial, based on allegations and inconsistencies regarding the FBI and prosecution's handling of this case.

Even former U.S. Attorney General, Ramsey Clark served *pro bono* as one of Peltier's lawyers and has aided in filing a series of appeals on Peltier's behalf. In all appeals, the conviction and sentence have been affirmed by the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals.

The sad irony is that 133-years after the December 29, 1890 Wounded Knee Massacre and 50-years since the 1973 armed protect on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, South Dakota very little has changed for the American Indians.

However, progress is being made as more tribes are getting involved in the political process but government dependency is hard nut to break.

Ghost Dance Founder, Wovoka (AKA Jack Wilson)

Wovoka (AKA *Jack Wilson*) was born in Smith Valley area southeast of Carson City, Nevada, around the year 1856. Quoitze Ow was his birth name.

From the age of eight until almost thirty he worked for a rancher in the Yerington, Nevada area, David Wilson and his wife Abigail, who gave him the name Jack Wilson for when dealing with European Americans.

David Wilson and his wife were devout Christian, and Wovoka learned Christian theology and Bible stories while living with the Wilson's.

One of his chief sources of authority among Paiutes was his alleged ability to control the weather. He was said

to have caused a block of ice to fall out of the sky on a summer day, to be able to end drought with rain or snow, to light his pipe with the sun, and to form icicles in his hands.



Wovoka claimed to have had a prophetic vision during the solar eclipse on January 1, 1889. His vision entailed the resurrection of the Paiute dead and the removal of whites and their works from North America. He taught that in order to bring this vision to pass the American Indians must live righteously and perform a traditional round dance, known as the "Ghost Dance", in a series of five-day gatherings. His teachings spread quickly among many American Indian peoples, notably the Lakota.

The Ghost Dance movement is known for being practiced by the victims of the Wounded Knee Massacre; Indian Agents, soldiers, and other federal officials were predis-

posed towards a militaristic posture when dealing with a movement that was so antithetical to their views and ideas.

Wovoka's preaching's included messages of non-violence, but two Miniconjou, Short Bull and Kicking Bear, allegedly emphasized the possible elimination of whites which contributed to the existing defensive attitude of the federal officials who were already fearful due to the unfamiliar "Ghost Dance" movement.

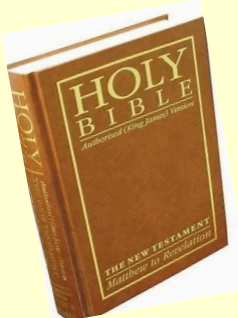
Wovoka died in Yerington on September 20, 1932 and is interred in the Paiute Cemetery in the town of Schurz, Nevada.

House Oversight Committee Chairman James Comer's Nov. 8 subpoena of Hunter and James Biden and Special Counsel David Weiss's Nov. 7 congressional testimony actually forced the networks to — very briefly — break out of their rut of refusing to report on Biden family scandals.

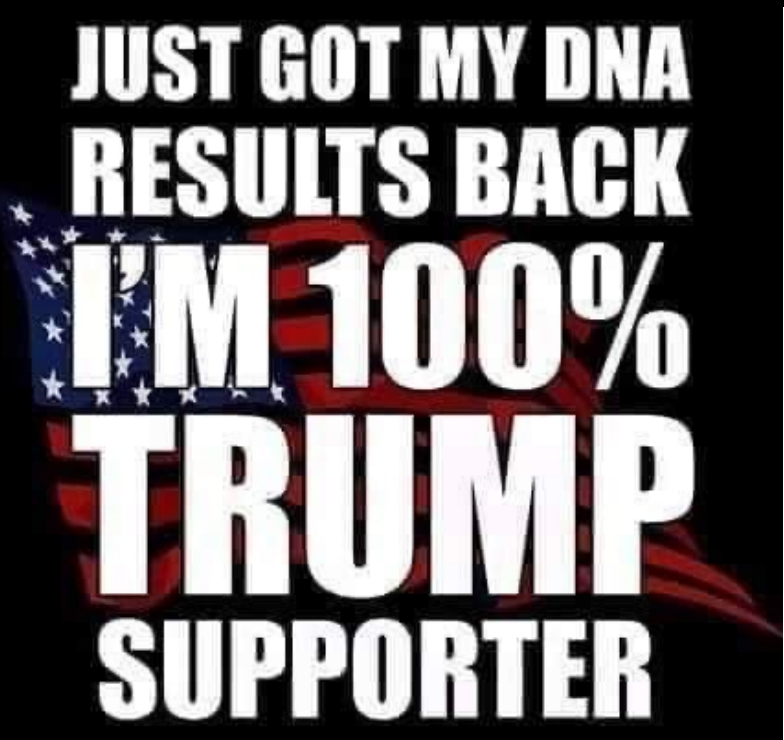

Judges toss lawsuit targeting North Dakota House subdistricts for tribal nations

BISMARCK, N.D. (AP) — A federal three-judge panel in North Dakota has dismissed a lawsuit brought by Republican district officials who alleged that the consideration of race was unconstitutional in the creation of state House subdistricts that included ones encompassing tribal nations.

The lawsuit filed early last year by the two GOP legislative district officials targeted the two sub-divided districts the Legislature drew in 2021, which included subdistricts for the Fort Berthold and Turtle Mountain Indian reservations. The lawsuit alleged that the “racial gerrymandering” was a violation of the equal protection clause.

The ruling issued Thursday by U.S. District Court Chief Judge Peter Welte, Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals Judge Ralph Erickson and U.S. District Court Judge Daniel Hovland granted

motions for summary judgment made by the state and the Mandan, Hidatsa and Arikara Nation, and denied the plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment, dismissing the case.

The judges said the state “had good reasons and strong evidence to believe the subdistricts were required by” the federal Voting Rights Act.

The plaintiffs will discuss their next steps, including a possible appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court, attorney Bob Harms told The Associated Press.

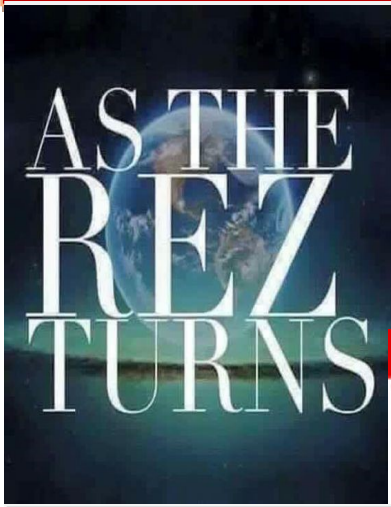

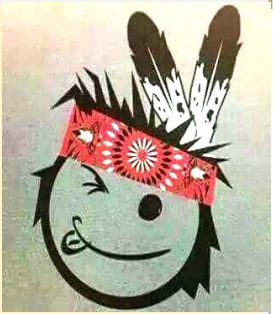
