In unprecedented move, Rincon withdraws from California tribal gaming compact

The North County tribe will now work directly with the National Indian Gaming Commission for casino regulation

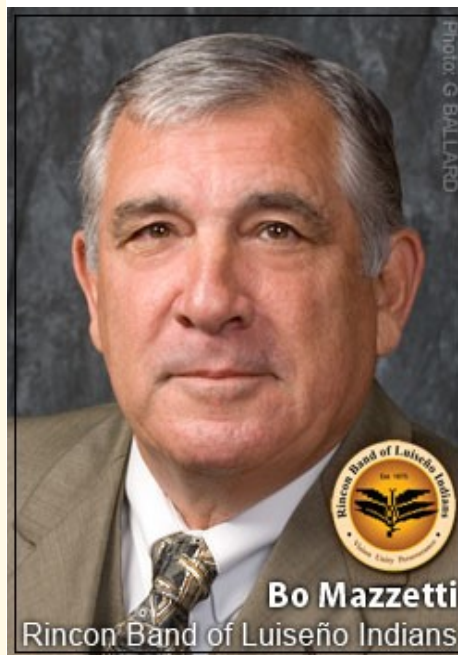
A 500-member tribe in northern San Diego County has become the first in California to opt out of state oversight of its gaming operations in favor of federal supervision.

The move by the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians ends nearly two decades of legal wrangling rooted in the way California assesses regulatory costs. It could also herald the beginning of the end of the state's hold on some tribal gaming operations, which last year paid nearly \$67 million in a state fund to regulate tribal gaming.

That money funds staff at the California Gambling Control Commission, Bureau of Gambling Control, Office of the Attorney General and Office of Problem Gambling.

Rincon Chairman Bo Mazzetti said the transfer of regulatory duties is less about the funding dispute and more about moving toward increased tribal sovereignty for Rincon and other tribes throughout the state.

The U.S. Department of the Interior announced Thursday (*Jan. 12, 2023*) that it has given new names to five places that previously included a racist term for a Native woman.

The renamed sites are in California, North Dakota, Tennessee and Texas, completing a yearlong process to remove the historically offensive "S-word" from geographic names across the country.

"Words matter, particularly in our work to ensure our nation's public lands and waters are accessible and welcoming to people of all backgrounds," Interior Secretary Deb Haaland, Laguna Pueblo, said in a statement. She called the word "harmful."

Haaland, who took office in 2021, is the first Native to lead a Cabinet agency.

In September, the Interior Department announced its final vote on proposals to change the names of nearly 650 sites that contained the word. The agency conducted an additional review of seven locations, all of which were considered unincorporated populated places. Five of those were changed in Thursday's announcement.

Chinese donors funneled millions into university running Penn Biden Center during Biden presidency: report



The University of Pennsylvania, which runs the Penn Biden Center in Washington, D.C., where classified documents were recently discovered from Biden's time as vice president, has received millions from unnamed Chinese donors since Joe Biden became president, a new investigation found.

The university took \$14 million from unnamed contributors in China and Hong Kong and \$2.4 million from unnamed contributors in Saudi Arabia since 2021, the Washington Free Beacon first reported in a review of government records. Another \$1 million was given to the university by a donor in the Cayman Islands to fund the Penn Wharton China program, according to the report.

The money donated amid the Biden presidency adds to the \$61 million Chinese donors have given the university between the years 2017 and 2020, according to previous Free Beacon reporting. [Continue Reading @ Fox News](#)

California panel estimates \$569 billion in reparations is owed to black residents

The nine-member panel concluded that black Californians whose ancestors were in the US in the 19th century are due \$223,200 each due to housing discrimination practices utilized from 1933 to 1977, the **New York Times** reported.

The work of the Reparations Task Force, which was created by legislation Gov. Gavin Newsom signed in 2020 — and the potential payouts — represent the largest reparations effort in recent history.

“We are looking at reparations on a scale that is the largest since Reconstruction,” Jovan Scott Lewis, a professor at the University of California, Berkeley, who is one of the nine members, told the Times.

Burgess Owens slams San Francisco's \$5 million reparations plan: 'Condescending, counterproductive, illogical'

Rep. Burgess Owens, R-Utah, is criticizing a proposal from a San Francisco committee on reparations after it proposed that the city pay \$5 million to each longtime Black resident.

The San Francisco African American Reparations Advisory Committee released a draft report in December with recommendations for how the city can address reparations, as it advises the city government.

While California wasn't technically a slave state, the draft proposal contends that reparations would "address the public policies explicitly created to subjugate Black people in San Francisco by upholding and expanding the intent and legacy of chattel slavery."

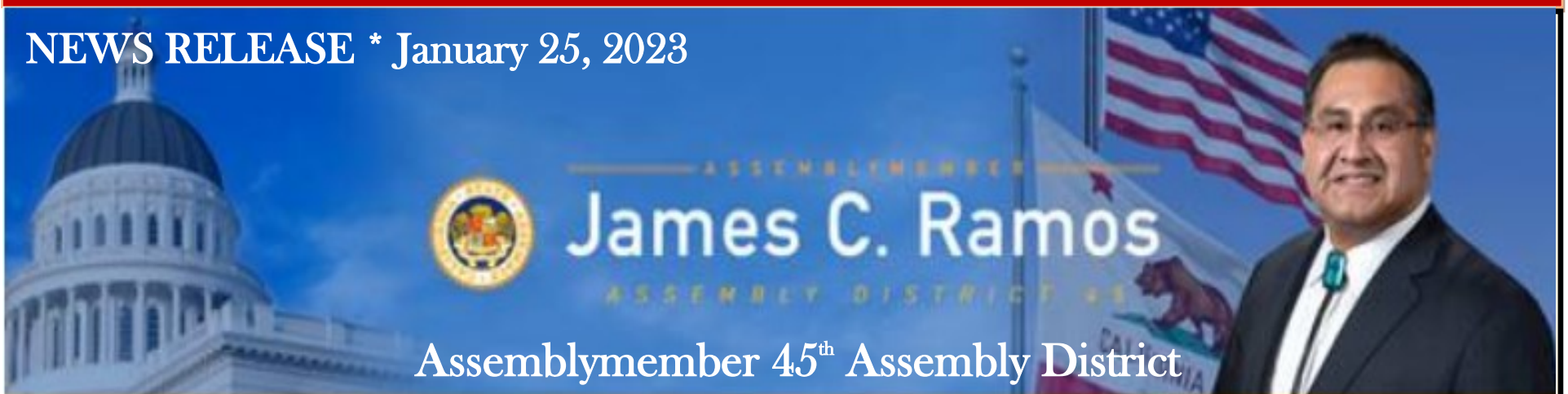

Tribes and lawmakers celebrate historic appointment of Ramos as first Native American named leader of powerful Rules Committee

SACRAMENTO—Tribal leaders, lawmakers, and guests celebrated the historic appointment of the first California Native American to serve as chair of the powerful Assembly Rules Committee in the more than 170-year history of the Legislature. Assemblymember James C. Ramos (D-San Bernardino) became the first California Native American elected to the Legislature in November 2018.

Assembly Speaker Anthony Rendon named Ramos as Rules chair this past December. Rules has primary jurisdiction over matters relating to the business of the Assembly, including assignment of bills to committees, staffing and other house procedural duties.

The Assembly Rules chair also serves as chair of the Joint Committee on projects covering both the Assembly and Senate.

In his remarks, Ramos recounted the wars of extermination carried out against Native Americans by state and federal governments. *“As Native Americans, we are no longer facing governors calling for wars of extermination against us. But we continue to battle wars of ignorance, of inequity, and not-so benign neglect because too many times—for too many people—we are invisible.”*

Rendon also reflected on the painful past of Native Americans in the state and country. He said, *“The ongoing trauma of that past continues but so does a fierce determination to preserve the diverse Native American culture, traditions, and languages and continue as stewards of this place they call home.”*

Rendon added, *“This history brings us here tonight – to reflect on the past, celebrate the present, and*

commit to a more equitable and brighter future for all in the Golden State.”

Wilton Rancheria Tribal Chairman Jesus Tarango said, *“We stand here today in the rotunda of California’s Capitol, a state that once advocated for the widespread extermination of Indigenous people and placed bounties upon our heads. How far have we come that we now have a strong, dedicated and outspoken representative of our people?”* He continued, *“To say that Assemblymember Ramos’s work in the legislature is groundbreaking is an understatement but he knows his work is not done, and that is why this appointment is so significant.”*

Attending the event were tribal chairpersons from around the state including Jesus Tarango, Wilton Rancheria; Erica Pinto, Jamul Indi-

an Village; Joe James, Yurok Tribe; Isaiah Vivanco of Soboba Band of Luiseño Indians; Charles Martin, Morongo Band of Mission Indians; Glenda Nelson, Enterprise Rancheria; Andrew Alejandre, Paskenta Band, Nomlaki Indians; Janet Bill of Picayune Rancheria of Chukchansi Indians; Neil Peyron, Tule River Indians; Octavio Escobedo III from Tejon Indian Tribe and Vice Chairman Johnny Hernández, Jr, San Manuel Band of Mission Indians.

Cultural performances included a song by Yurok Chairman James, Kalte Crew of Wilton Rancheria and the Tuolumne Mewuk Dancers from the Tuolumne Mewuk Tribe, and the Intertribal Bird Singers led by Wayne Nelson.

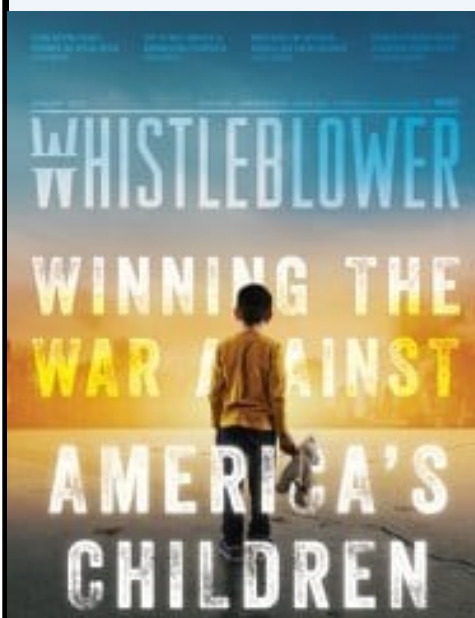

## GOP MOVES TO PROTECT MOUNT RUSHMORE FROM ACTIVISTS LOOKING TO RENAME IT OR TEAR IT DOWN

House Republicans this week proposed legislation aimed at protecting Mount Rushmore from being altered, renamed or demolished by activists who say the monument disrespects Native Americans.

The Mount Rushmore Protection Act would prohibit the use of federal funds to change, destroy or rename the Mount Rushmore National Memorial. The bill from Rep. Dusty Johnson, R-S.D., is a response to criticism that has grown since former President Trump visited the site in 2020.

*"Our nation's history is not without its flaws, but there is no doubt the faces on Mount Rushmore represent democracy, freedom and the great American experiment,"* Johnson said. *"Removing or changing Mount Rushmore will not change the past and will not move us forward as a country. ## Indigenous elders evicted and banished from Winnemucca Indian Colony without trial

**MY VIEW** By Ernie C. Salgado, Jr.: It’s been labled as “Disenrollment” and can be viewed as “Political Genocide.” In my humble opinion I view any tribal policies that limit individuals tribal status as erroneous and unjustifiable. This is third world mentality plain and simple. It is political viewed as “Legal” by the Supreme Court, but it may be the one issue that could bring about the demise of Tribal Sovereignty. The exploitation of Tribal Sovereignty by the shortsightedness of Tribal Leaders lends itself to fascism, dictatorship and tyranny, which will not withstand the political pressure of the dominate forces in the Nation.

The Winnemucca Indian Colony is an Indian Colony created by the 1916 executive order of Woodrow Wilson and an act of 1928 Congress for homeless Paiute and Shoshone Indians to live and work nearby the developing railroad and town in far northwest Nevada. While the history of the Colony is complex, it is undisputed that residents engaged in self-governance of their homelands until the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and others asserted involvement in the group’s affairs. The community has suffered from years of litigious disputes, harassment, and violence over who has authority over the Winnemucca Indian Colony. *See generally Winnemucca Indian Colony v. United States of America* wherein the elders could present evidence of the history, relations, rights, and customs allowing them to remain on the land they have occupied and lived on, some for generations. In November 2021, the disputed Interim “Rojo” Council filed the first case in the newly-created Winnemucca Tribal Court seeking the eviction of fourteen long-term Paiute and Shoshone elders and residents from their homelands. Attorneys from Nevada Legal Services and Water Protector Legal Collective have been representing these elders and residents. Attorneys, elders, and supporters alike believed that there would be a trial of the eviction claims in December 2022. On Friday, December 2, 2022, a hearing was held wherein the Winnemucca Tribal Court summarily evicted the elders and residents without a trial, banished several people, and found for the Tribal Council without giving the elders and residents the benefit of a trial. As the proceedings were going on, some of the elders and residents were excluded from the zoom hearing when the decision was announced.
