The biggest 'Twitter Files' scandal has been overlooked 'The most egregious political scandal in recent history'

In the flood of information from Elon Musk's release of internal Twitter documents - the "Twitter Files" - both pundits and the public are missing "the most egregious political scandal in recent history," contends Washington attorney and political commentator Margot Cleveland.

The big story, writes The Federalist's senior legal correspondent, is that the FBI "interfered in the 2020 election by lying to tech giants about the Hunter Biden laptop story to induce Twitter, Facebook, and likely others to censor the story."

The bureau targeted the New York Post's Oct. 14, 2020 article - "Smoking-Gun Email Reveals How Hunter Biden Introduced Ukrainian Businessman to VP **Dad**" - presenting emails, text messages and videos countering Joe Biden's claim he never discussed with his son the family's business of selling access to the White House.

The first edition of the "Twitter Files," by independent journalist Matt Taibbi, showed Twitter censored the Post's story based on its "hacked materials" policy and suspending the paper's official account.

MRC Business, part of the conservative Media Research Center, found that Soros uses his charities to build relationships with news outlets and "activists media" organizations.

"The journalism groups Soros supports have the ability to mold public opinion on practically every continent and in many languages. They also insulate him from inquiry because reporters see him as an ally, not a target for investigation," MRC Business analysts Joseph Vazquez and Daniel Schneider wrote.

Each image has a strong and indelible imprint on our history and legacy.

Using the seamstress as an example, we see that they were essential for clothing production and related trades from the seventeenth century onward.

The next expansion was not initially dependent on technological developments, but on the pool of women workers, their expendability and cheapness to their employers.



The world evolved from an agrarian to an industrialized society causing all sorts of new scenarios. Instead of quietly starving -or thriving- on one's own plot of land within a small community, people moved to slums or fine neighbor-

Most persons are aware of what happened to the slaves on plantations and the economic shifts of the "industries" that were built on their labor: cotton, tobacco, turpentine, food items, etc. Readership hopefully understands and appreciates the impact of the "Relocation Programs".

And in the late 70"s, TERO (Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance) began to be adopted by many tribes.



Now we live in a different, emergent reality.

As the internet arrived in our lives around the turn of the 21st Century, I remember thinking that we would have to totally adjust our thinking on this topic.

Although there are vast areas where electronics have not taken over daily lives, remote home work became possible and given a great boost by the COVID conflagration. It is posible to work for a Boston-based company an live in Trenton, Missouri. It is possible for a tribe to contract with any fed agency (or corporation) needing data processing, creating manpower resource strictly within the reservation. From education to health care to entertainment - so many innovations are evolving. Wages are still an issue as evidenced by the strikes in vogue; even academic workers whose physical working conditions are those of which a field hand may have dreamt, have issues as do nurses, mental health workers, and on and on.



And on a wider scope, "microchips are the new oil - the scarce resource on which the modern world depends. Today, military, economic, and geopolitical power are built on a foundation of computer chips. Virtually everything from missiles to microwaves, smartphones to the stock market runs on chips. Until recently, America designed and built the fastest chips and maintained its lead to maintain its lead as the superpower.

But now America's edge is slipping, undermined by competitors in Taiwan, Korea, Europe, and,

> above all, China. As Chip War reveals, China, which spends more money each year importing chips than it spends importing oil, is pouring billions into a chipbuilding initiative to catch up to the US. At stake is America's military superiority and economic prosperity." (Chris Miller -Chip War: The Fight for the World's Most Critical Technology)

Feds launch investigation of anti-Semitism at Berkeley. 'Hostile environment' reported to the Office of Civil Rights

The Department of Education's Office for Civil Rights (OCR) announced that it is launching an investigation into the University of California Berkeley Law School due to concerns of anti-Zionism.

Gabriel Groisman, an attorney and partner at LSN Law, P.A., and Arsen Ostrovsky, an Israel-based attorney, and CEO of The International Legal Forum filed a complaint with the OCR on Nov. 18, according to the Cleveland Jewish News. The complaint came as a result of multiple student groups <u>adopting</u> Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions bylaws associated with the pro-**Palestine** <u>movement</u>, that banned pro-Israel speakers from their chapters.

The OCR agreed Tuesday (*December 13, 2022*) to conduct an official investigation into the "hostile environment" at U.C. Berkeley Law, according to the Cleveland Jewish News.
