## ‘Thank you, President Trump’: Newly elected Speaker McCarthy praises former president for being ‘all in’

Newly minted House Speaker Kevin McCarthy (R-Calif.) praised the “all in” involvement of former President Donald Trump with some thoughts on and gratitude for his lasting influence over the party.


Shortly past 2 a.m. Saturday, (January 7, 2023) after McCarthy had secured the votes to be elected speaker on the 15th ballot, he spoke with the press inside the Capitol offering his thanks to some of those Republicans who helped get him there.

In addition to those like Reps. Patrick McHenry (NC) and French Hill (AR) who had backed him on each vote, the



speaker offered gratitude for those who negotiated in good faith like Reps. Chip Roy (TX) and Scott Perry (PA).

However, McCarthy emphasized his thanks for Trump as he offered a glimpse at what had been happening behind the



scenes throughout the week with the president.

“But I do want to especially thank President Trump. I don’t think you should doubt, anybody should doubt, his influence. He was with me from the

We have to focus on the economy. We’ve got to focus, make our border secure. We’ve got to do so much to do, and he was a great influence to make that all happen.”

## New law forces doctors to serve CDC first, not patients

California’s descent into totalitarianism progressed further Sunday as the new year meant new laws went into effect, including one that left acclaimed Dr. Jay Bhattacharya saying now “*California doctors serve the CDC over their patients.*”





California steps up efforts to stem violence against Native Americans as state prepares to enact new Feather Alert system

**COARSEGOLD—Feather Alert** – a public notification tool to combat an all too deadly epidemic –Missing and Murdered Indigenous People—will be available in January to help law enforcement quickly notify the public about the disproportionate number of missing Native Americans and enlist their aid for timely leads to locate victims and prosecute suspects – and today tribal leaders and others gathered to learn how the system will work and provide their input for effective implementation.

Assemblymembers James C. Ramos (D-Highland), Joaquin Arambula (D-Fresno) and Esmeralda Soria (D-Fresno) and representatives from the California Highway Patrol, the Department of Justice and local and tribal law enforcement participated in the almost day-long roundtable discussion to learn and ask questions about the Feather Alert authorized by AB 1314 which Ramos authored earlier this year.

The California Highway Patrol would activate the alert at the request of local law enforcement, and it would work much like an Amber Alert.

Ramos said, “I am gratified that the governor approved this bill to help stop the violence afflicting California’s Native American communities. The Feather Alert will aid law enforcement and families in getting the word out quickly when a Native individual is missing or endangered by alerting the public in a broad and effective manner. Creating an alert or advisory system was a top recommendation from tribal leaders in May to highlight this issue.” Ramos also noted that California, the state with the greatest population of Native Americans in the nation, is also among the states with the highest rates of reported cases of Missing and Murdered Indigenous People.

### Feather Alert Criteria

To activate the Feather Alert, the following criteria that must be met:

- Missing person is an indigenous woman or an indigenous person.
- Investigating law enforcement agency has utilized available local and tribal resources.
- Local law enforcement agency determines that the person has gone missing under unexplained or suspicious circumstance.
- Local law enforcement agency believes that the person is in danger because of age, health, mental or physical disability, or environment or weather conditions, that the person is in the company of a potentially dangerous person, or that there are other factors indicating that the person may be in peril.
- Information is available that, if disseminated to the public, could assist in the safe recovery of the missing person.

A [report](#) by the Sovereign Bodies Institute indicated only nine percent of murders of indigenous women in California have ever been solved. At a [May 4 hearing of the Select Committee on Native American Affairs](#), which Ramos chaired, tribal leaders urged legislators to take more urgent action to stem the tide of unsolved cases and provide more immediate support when suspected abductions or other acts of violence occur against California Indian people who suffer a disproportionate number of those crimes. Among other recommendations, witnesses at the hearing called for more immediate notification to the public and enlisting the aid of news outlets to help locate possible victims. This year, California joined Washington State and Colorado in enacting similar notification systems.

### Other California Public Alert Systems

In California, the Feather Alert joins these other special notifications overseen by the CHP:

- The AMBER Alert, which stands for America’s Missing: Broadcast Emergency Response is used when children age 17 or younger have been abducted. It has been in use since 2002.
- The Blue Alert, approved in 2011, notifies the public when a suspect in the assault or killing of a police officer remains at large and the search is active.
- The Silver Alert, used when elderly, developmentally or cognitively-impaired persons are missing and are determined to be at-risk. Adopted as the top priority of the California Senior Legislature in October 2011, it was enacted through SB 1047, legislation introduced by state Sen. Elaine Alquist (D-Santa Clara) and Sen. Lou Correa (D-Santa Ana). The bill was approved in 2012 and went into effect in 2013.
- The general endangered missing advisory is used when an individual is missing under unexplained or suspicious, and is believed to be in danger due to issues with age, physical and mental health issues, weather, being with a potentially dangerous person or other circumstances.

California Highway Patrol Commissioner Amanda Ray said, *“As a nationally recognized leader in missing persons alerts, the California Highway Patrol remains committed to safely locating missing individuals by combining community awareness and caretaking with the most current and up-to-date technology available throughout the State of California.”* She added, *“The passage of Assembly Bill 1314 provides law enforcement with additional resources to ensure the safe return of missing indigenous persons, and most importantly, improves collaboration and strategic partnerships across local, state, and tribal communities.”*

Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi Indians Chairperson Janet K. Bill said, *“California Assembly Bill 1314, establishing the Feather Alert for missing Native Americans, is the direct result of Indian Country’s call to action and our partnership with state legislators to begin to address the nationwide epidemic of Missing and Murdered Indigenous People. We as tribal people do not want to be known solely as another statistic but as the human beings we are - who deserve to be found, to be safe, and to be protected by our public safety systems.”*

*“As we look to the bill taking effect at the start of the new year, we are singularly focused as a collaborating partner with the State on ensuring that the Feather Alert will be implemented as the stakeholders intended - to serve as a powerful tool that will keep all Tribal communities safe. Mich Gayis (Thank you) to Governor Newsom, to First Partner Jennifer Siebel Newsom, and to Assemblymember Ramos for being forces of positive change, and for working to improve the lives of our Tribal Communities.”*


Chairman Joe James of the Yurok Tribe said, *“I sincerely thank Assembly Member Ramos for taking action to address the MMIP crisis in California. I am grateful for the opportunity to provide input on the implementation of the new Feather Alert system. Throughout the state, the new system will significantly improve outcomes in cases involving missing indigenous people.”*

Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians Chairwoman Regina Cuellar stated, *“It was incredibly rewarding to see the Feather Alert bill passed. We look forward to the work ahead to ensure successful implementation. We have the deepest gratitude for the commitment of Commissioner Amanda Ray and the men and women of the California Highway Patrol who are tasked with making certain that the tribal voice is heard. This consultation with tribes is an excellent example of the collaboration essential to successful outcomes. The Feather Alert would not have been possible without the hard work and dedication from everyone here today. Special thanks to Assemblymember James Ramos.”*

### AB 1314 Sponsors and Supporters

AB 1314 was sponsored by the Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians and the Tachi Santa Rosa Rancheria. In addition to the San Manuel and Yurok support, other supporters include the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians, Picayune Rancheria of the Chukchansi Indians, Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians, California State Sheriff’s Association, California Tribal Families Coalition, Los Coyotes Band of Cahuilla Cupeno Indians, Torrez Martinez Band of Desert Cahuilla Indians and Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation, California Consortium for Urban Indian Health and California Tribal Business Alliance.

The proposal received overwhelming bipartisan support in the legislature. Senators Lena Gonzalez (D-Long Beach), Monique Limón (D-Santa Barbara), Rosilicie Ochoa Bogh (R-Redlands) and Nancy Skinner (D-Berkeley) are also authors.

### “Labor & the technologies of the day.”



In my last missive, I mentioned how we now need to rethink and redefine how we think about labor.

While some still labor in the fields or assembly plants, much of the work is mechanized and now often run remotely through many of the technologies of the day.

**Witness ranch and farming operations**, like those of the Ak-Chin Community, where the principal farmer can sit in an air-conditioned office monitoring soil requirements, application of irrigation, etc. at a computer station.

**While we know many manufacturing sites** still contain less than desirable surrounding, the “clean” rooms of electronic and pharmaceutical factories are pristine. The sewing machine, the conveyor belt, the cotton gin and other like “new” machines lightened some of the load; production quotas/time performance only changed the stress.

**Covid taught the world** a lot about modern production and supply chains. One only needs to visit an Amazon distribution operation to see how the age of information - and its appurtenant equipment - make a consumer's desire to have something a click of two away and delivery time, even from distant shores, is a lot faster than the Pony Express.



**Many worry about job replacement**, but the truth is that each of these mechanical/electronic tools needs someone to program them and to physically maintain or repair them, thus new job creation. Car mechanics now need knowledge of electronics, just as farmers and ranchers. Mail carriers carry elec-



tronic devices and if you look around you, almost every function of daily life requires electronic device use knowledge.

Those of us without “smart phones” cannot order an Uber, do electronic banking (*where many institutions have stopped issuing checks*), and a whole list of simple tasks that grows each day.

**Some ancients were afraid of fire**, many resisted electricity, cars and air travel and the Hopis (**rightfully**) denounced plastics. Yet tribal societies, known for their ability to adapt, have taken these tools to

of course, is the codes that produce it, the directions that manipulate it, and all that it can do in its particular setting.

**Obviously**, tribal policy makers and fiscal administrators need to have a basic knowledge of these emergent trends, no longer conjectures for the future but popping up daily.

**A quarter of a century into the age of information**, we have already seen how the earlier stumbling blocks have found resolution - incompatible systems now can talk to one another, language translation apps are everywhere, each engine are more sophisticated and it seems that everyone is walking around with a phone.

**There are still physical barriers** that bar some communities from internet access and there is still the gap created by economics as to the “haves” and “have nots”.

**But the purpose here today** is not to belabor these points but to determine the status of your community planning for not only access but some control over this necessary infrastructure of the 21st Century.

**Are the skills needed** to conceive, design, sell, install, maintain, repair and retire-without-loss-of-information these systems within your tribal community or will you be dependent on a stream of “here once; gone next” vendors?

**Has your education or economic department** done a census of your population to

determine if you can now - and forever - create and sustain this infrastructure?

**What skills are provided** to your population in each strata of education? (K-3; 4-8; 9-12; post secondary; continuing ed?)

**Do your economic development plans include education** units for each strata so that you have a competent and large labor force with appropriate skills?



**Are you creatively bringing elder knowledge into technology formats?** Conversely are you helping “non-techies” to see the future?

**More importantly**, are you including youth in your planning and decision making bodies so that their vision of the world to which they aspire is integrated with their education?



**Technological innovation** and the welfare of our country are tightly linked. If we want to shape and protect our future -avert the climate crisis, accelerate the transition to green energy, modernize America's crumbling transit system and infrastructure - we must creatively deploy technology and use it in an equitable way.

**How can we use tech** as a force for good? One way is to equip the government with the fiercest, sharpest tech talent.

Deceased Jan. 6th rioter Ashli Babbitt's mother, Micki Witthoeft, 58, was arrested by the U.S. Capitol Police while protesting her daughter's death this Friday, prompting mockery and insults from the "loving" left. ## Everybody missed it: Bombshell Huckabee announcement – Supremes could flip 2020, boot Biden

They 'purposely thwarted all efforts to investigate allegations of fraud'

Former Arkansas governor and Republican presidential candidate Mike Huckabee published a piece recently calling attention to the case *Brunson v. Adams* set to be heard before the U.S. Supreme Court this week.

What the plaintiff/appellant, Raland Brunson of Ogden, Utah, and his three brothers seek is nothing less than the removal of President Joe Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris from office, arguing members of Congress failed to fulfill their constitutional duty on Jan. 6, 2021 by not reviewing allegations of fraud in the 2020 presidential election.

## Libs of TikTok creator ends anonymity, slams trans grooming of kids

**'They're just evil. They're bad people. They're recruiting'**

Chaya Raichik, the conservative woman behind the hugely popular "Libs of TikTok" Twitter account that exposes "groomers" of innocent children using activist-teachers' own video recordings, has entered a new stage in her fight for American culture by revealing her face and identity to the world.

Eight months after being "doxxed" by a Washington Post hit-piece that revealed her name and exposed her private address, Raichik sat down for an hour-long interview with Tucker Carlson on his eponymous show on the Fox Nation streaming site. In the exchange, which aired Tuesday, (December 27, 2022) Raichik explained the powerful, dark forces that are leading many children (and their parents) down the road of transgenderism, which she said was part of a larger LGBT "cult."






