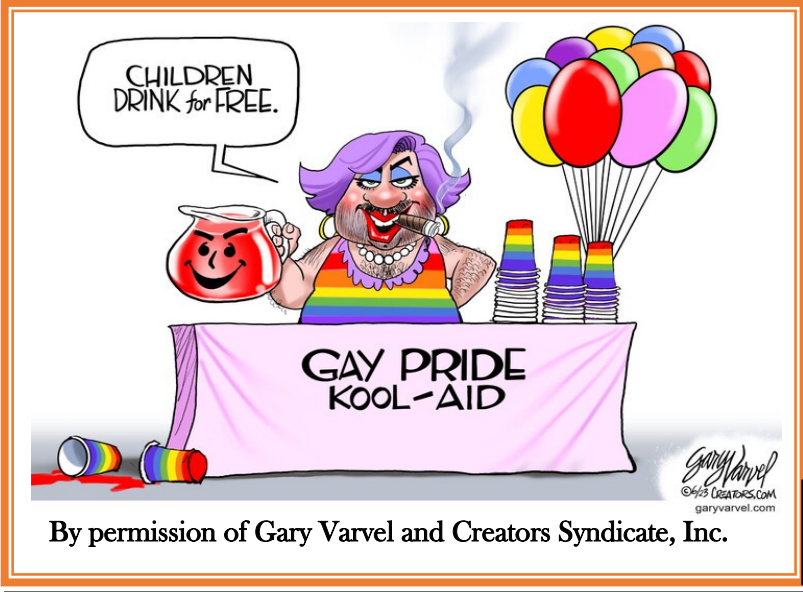
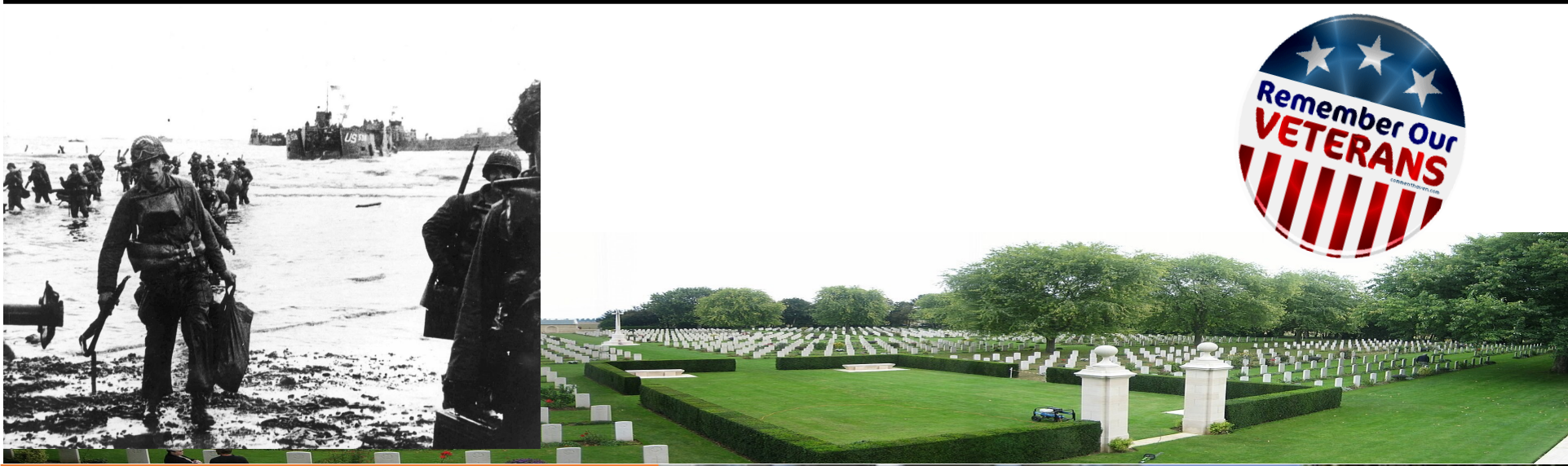

On June 2, Haaland banned oil, gas and mineral leasing within 10 miles of the Chaco Canyon site for 20 years, an action strongly opposed by Navajo communities and government leaders.

Navajo Nation President Buu Nygren and other tribal leaders, in addition to locals, have argued that Haaland's action will harm low-income Navajo citizens who depend on revenue from leasing their allotments within 10 miles of Chaco Canyon mainly to fossil fuel companies.

The allotments date back to the 1900s, when the government awarded them to Navajo citizens as a consolation when the tribe's territory was downsized.

"To totally disregard those local communities – it's unfair," Nygren told Fox News Digital in an interview Saturday. *"There's no need to celebrate putting people into poverty, to celebrate undermining the Navajo Nation's sovereignty, undermining everything that comes into working with tribes, in this case, Navajo Nation."*

"You can't pound your chest on going after people in poverty," he said. *"I don't know who would want to celebrate that. Personally, I think that's, I don't know, you got to not*

have a heart if you're going to put people that are already impoverished in third-world-country conditions and barely have enough to pay for gas, food, laundry, the daily necessities – to put them into an even tougher situation. To totally disregard those local communities."

The slow-motion trainwreck everyone sees coming

As the federal government strives to contain financial market turmoil, the next risk looming over the nation’s banks is in plain sight: the \$20 trillion commercial real estate market.

Some \$1.5 trillion in mortgages will come due in the next two years, a potential time bomb as higher interest rates and spiraling office vacancies push down property values.

And because 70 percent of bank-held commercial mortgages sit on the balance sheets of regional and smaller lenders, a write-down in commercial loans could spell big trouble for the financial system and spill over into the larger economy just as the 2024 presidential campaign gets underway.

With the country careening toward a possible recession, the financial system is especially vulnerable to shocks as the turbulence sparked by the collapse of three regional banks showed. Adding a commercial real estate market slide to the mix would be particularly perilous. It’s a concern that’s top of mind for policymakers in Washington — even as they acknowledge there’s not a lot they can do to fend off a crisis.

“Am I worried? The short answer is yes,” Sen. John Kennedy (R-La.), a senior member of the Senate Banking Committee, said in an interview. *“The long answer is hell yes.”*

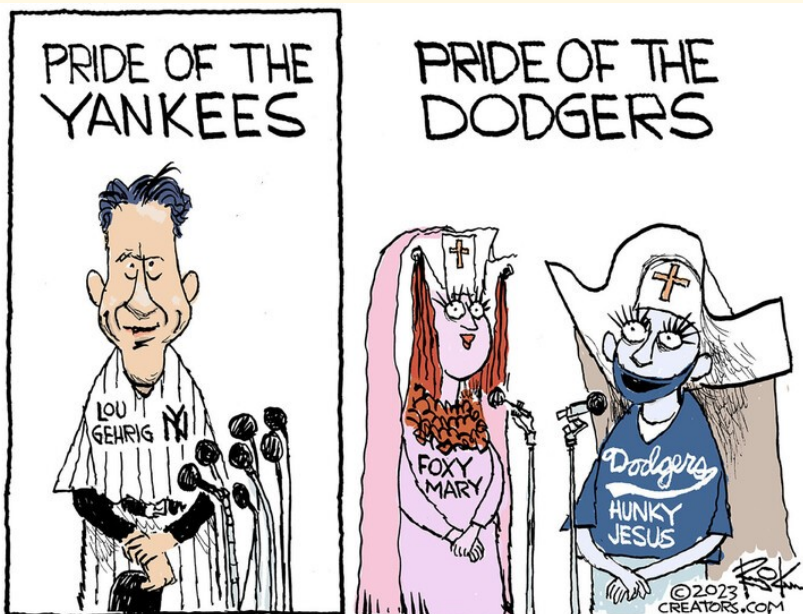

A CORRUPT 'PROGRESSIVE REFORMER' GOES DOWN IN FLAMES.

Back in 2021, President Joe Biden fought hard to win Senate confirmation for Rachael Rollins to become the U.S. attorney in Massachusetts. Rollins was the district attorney of Suffolk County, which includes Boston, and she had become notorious by pledging not to prosecute many crimes. Early in her term, she published the "Rollins Memo" that listed 15 crimes in which the "default is to decline prosecuting" – that is, in which her office would not allow its attorneys to prosecute unless a supervisor gave special permission.

Here is the list: 1) Trespassing, 2) shoplifting, 3) larceny under \$250,

4) disorderly conduct, 5) disturbing the peace, 6) receiving stolen property, 7) minor driving offenses, including operating with a suspended or revoked license, 8) breaking and entering into vacant property, 9) wanton or malicious destruction of property, 10) threats excluding domestic violence, 11) minors in possession of alcohol, 12) drug possession, 13) drug possession with intent to distribute, 14) resisting arrest when the only charge is resisting arrest, and 15) resisting arrest if other charges are on the list of non-prosecutable offenses.

Top congressman: Evidence Biden released migrants with Chinese military ties into U.S.

House Homeland Security Committee Chairman Mark Green possesses evidence that some Chinese migrants that crossed the southern border illegally and were released into the U.S. under the Biden administration are connected to the Chinese Communist Party and China's People's Liberation Army (PLA), he told the Daily Caller News Foundation during a press conference Wednesday.

The intelligence came directly from a Border Patrol sector chief, Green told the DCNF. Border Patrol has seen a roughly 393% increase in illegal Chinese migrants at the southern border, with 9,711 Chinese migrant encounters recorded between October 2022 and April.

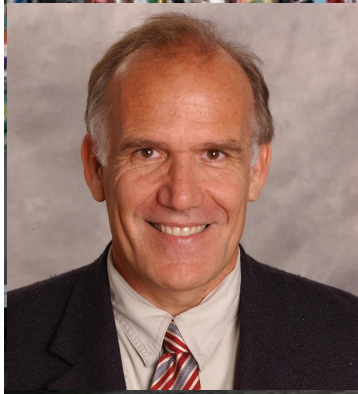

Conservatives and traditionalists are often exasperated at the ongoing woke cultural revolution in their midst.

How can America be turned upside down, as it is, when there is little public support for the things happening around us?

They don't see much backing for the current border policy and illegal immigration, yet it continues.

Conservatives feel that most Americans reject the trend of biological men dominating female sporting events.

They fear American jurisprudence has become now vastly weaponized and warped.

Certainly, former President Donald Trump will be more likely indicted by a politicized New York City prosecutor for supposedly overvaluing his net worth over a decade ago than would be a current violent street criminal clubbing a subway commuter.

In 2020 torching a federal courthouse or massing at the White House grounds, in efforts to get at the president, earned either few arrests and little or no jail time. In 2021, if one entered the Capitol and illegally paraded around like a buffoon, he could get a five-year prison sentence.

Traditionalists feel that sky-high energy prices, out-of-control urban crime, a depressed economy, high interest rates, and a politicized FBI, CIA, Justice Department, and Pentagon are all needlessly self-created messes.

How then did these extremist policies that have little popular support become institutionalized?

Conservatives, by their nature and unlike the Left, are more inclined to accept existing institutions rather than to radically alter or destroy them.

They were asleep at the wheel in 2020, when left-wing-funded lawsuits radically transformed Election Day in many states into a mere construct.

Some 70 percent of the electorate in key precincts voted by mail or early, with far fewer ballot audits or authentication.

UC Berkeley panned for hiring ousted San Francisco DA Chesa Boudin as 'Criminal Law & Justice Center' director

The University of California, Berkeley, School of Law was panned by critics after announcing Wednesday it tapped ousted San Francisco District Attorney Chesa Boudin as the founding executive director of its new Criminal Law & Justice Center.

Boudin, the progressive prosecutor who faced a shocking defeat in a recall election nearly a year ago after being viewed as soft on crime, land-

ed the new job across the bay to spearhead the new center, which the university said "will be a research and advocacy hub to boost Berkeley Law's public mission in the criminal justice arena." It will "help foster research collaboration among faculty members and others, enhance law students' training and practice opportunities, and strengthen connections between the university and the outside world."

"A lifetime of visiting my biological parents in prison and my work as a public defender and district attorney have made clear that our system fails to keep communities safe and fails to treat them equitably," Boudin said in a statement. "I'm thrilled to join the nation's premier public law school and engage with brilliant scholars and students to drive meaningful change by elevating the lived experience of those directly impact-

Boudin's parents were members of the far-left militant terrorist group the Weather Underground. Boudin's father, David Gilbert, was convicted of felony murder in connection with the infamous Brinks' heist in 1981, which left two police officers and a guard dead. His mother, Kathy Boudin, was also convicted and paroled in 2003 (she died in 2022)

Crowd goes crazy over DeSantis response to heckler who called him a 'f—ing fascist'



Gov. Ron DeSantis (R-Fla.) received a thunderous standing ovation in South Carolina on Friday from those attending a speech where he shut down a radical leftist heckler who called him a “f*king fascist” over his policies that protect children in the Sunshine State.

Residents of the liberal city of Oakland, California, have had it with the level of crime they have had to endure in their community.

More than 500 residents and business owners showed up this week for a community meeting during which they shared harrowing stories and demanded change.

“I’m Louise, and I’m the owner of Studio Naga, a small martial arts school at 59th and San Pablo,” said another resident who told the panel that she emails “everyone” she can “every week” about her problem.

“I have a person who is mentally deranged [and] is living ten feet from the door of my business who has threatened me multiple times, who has threatened

other people, who defecates on our property, on our business,” Louise said. “And I’m being told by MACRO [the Mobile Assistance Community Responders of Oakland] that they can’t do anything. I’m being told by the police that there’s got to be something in the middle.”

“Because as women have said,” she continued, “I don’t want to have to get threatened with sexual violence when I go to work. I don’t want my children to see this as a normal behavior from an individual on the street.”

“He’s been naked,” Louise said. “He’s masturbated in front of them. He’s urinated in front of them. And there’s nothing, I’m told, the police can do.”

In many ways, freedom of speech is vanishing in America, with "equity" demands, "pronoun" orders and requirements for not just political, but gender, racial and other correctness.

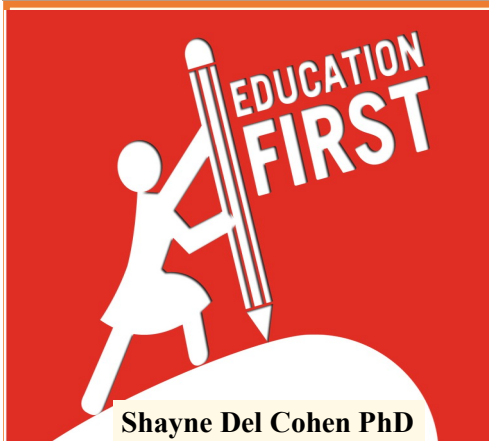

“Will AI tell your story?”



There are several news themes that are strangely convergent.

The first is the statistics regarding US history and civics scores hitting all-time low among eighth graders. I don't know why this is so shocking as many districts to not have them in their high school curriculum at all and whatever is offered at a younger age does not provide the information or critical thinking skills.

Tribal communities well know that *“the other side of the story”* or just mention of their ancestors' experience and journeys often is never presented, or if mentioned, often contains a skewed point of view and sometimes outright misinformation.

Tribal leadership well knows that it needs to prepare youth to take their place on councils, committees and tribal institutions for survival.

A person aspiring to council-ship (*Tribal Leadership*) not only needs to know tribal history and heritage, but constitutional development, the art of by-laws and procedure, etc., etc

Most tribal people have a better knowledge of American government because they have had to deal with it every day for their lifetime. Recent naturalized citizens tend to have greater cognizance as they have had to study and be tested on it for citizenship. The general citizenry cannot even tell what the Second Amendment says, nor the context in which it was developed.

The seeming fear of being “woke” has caused several jurisdictions to reverse their curriculum collections, wiping out years of efforts on behalf of tribes to have their story included in discussion.

The second news buster is AI (artificial intelligence). The debate rages: Is it good or bad? Is it something of which to be scared? Will it takeover our lives? As with many electronic or computer technologies, the answer is not a simple yes or no.

Obviously a budget saver is the ability to have basic information and services provided over the phone with a pre-programmed voice that can answer basic questions.

The controversy has been elevated to consider the writing of letters, term papers (even thesis) magazine articles, television sitcoms and a plethora of other word-driven functions within our functional and entertainment world.

Debates rage over the idea that AI might be able to out-think its human counterpart while others put forth the fact that a computer can arrange and analyze data much quicker.

As with any new tool, fire being a prime example, society's adaptation and/or assimilation of the resource must be measured and thoughtful.

My fear is like the one I had when GPS took over maps. If there was an incorrect line or labeling on an existing map that was absorbed into

“the system”, that mistake could often cause a tribe to lose a legal right. Be vigilant.

Early projects often did not have many items to draw upon. The internet certainly changed that. But how many tribes were in possession or had access to all the maps available?

Artificial intelligence draws upon the world's written library. It does have some ability to discern incorrect information, but only if that subject has been controverted (in volume) elsewhere. So tribes that have not corrected any written records or shared alternative information may soon read an AI prepared text that will not please them.

On the positive side, AI may be able to take the recorded bits of information from a tribal language, meld it with geographic and biological information of prior eras and come up with additional knowledge.

A California bill, AB 957, passed earlier this year requiring foster parents to agree to interpret a child's “health, “best practices for providing safety, and welfare” to care for LGBTQ+ youth,” “include a parent's affirmation of the child's gender identity” for the purpose of custody disputes.

California Democrats are now considering a bill that would cause parents to lose their children in custody disputes if they do not favor pushing them into irreversible sex changes. It can only get worse from there.

The California bill currently being considered in the legislature would include *“a parent's affirmation of the child's gender identity”* as a tenet of the health, safety, and welfare” of a child in a

custody dispute. The bill is being pushed by state Sen. Scott Wiener, who is behind most of the terrible gender-based policies in California. **Wiener introduced the “sanctuary state” law** for child sex changes and led the push to lessen the penalty for intentionally exposing people to HIV, which he claimed was an LGBT issue.

The bill is coauthored by Assemblywoman Lori Wilson, who is also pushing a bill to mandate

that foster parents promise to help children get irreversible sex changes. Wilson used the example of a 7-year-old who *“is talking about having the potential to say ... being able to articulate that they believe that they are not the same gender as they are biologically, then it should be affirmed.”*

Cravens wrote in the email. *"[W]e would also ask to have an extension of time before the records are produced so that we can have time to review them and assess whether we'll have to file suit to protect them from disclosure."*

Far-right 'Moms for Liberty' listed as a hate group for first time

Moms for Liberty, the far-right parental group known for protesting at school board meetings, has been identified by the Southern Poverty Law Center as a "hate group" for the first time ever.

Moms for Liberty, which recently said it knows liberal groups are spying on its activities because it's doing the same thing to them, is among 12 parental groups added to the SPLC's list of hate groups, according to [USA Today](#).

"The Southern Poverty Law Center is for the first time labeling Florida-headquartered Moms for Liberty and 11 other right-wing 'parents' rights' groups as extremist groups in its annual report, released today," USA Today wrote.

"Moms for Liberty and the other organizations are being designated as 'anti-government extremist groups,' based on longstanding criteria, explained SPLC Intelligence Project Director Susan Corke. Corke said the grassroots conservative groups are part of a new front in the battle against inclusivity in schools, though they are drawing from ideas rooted in age-old white supremacy."

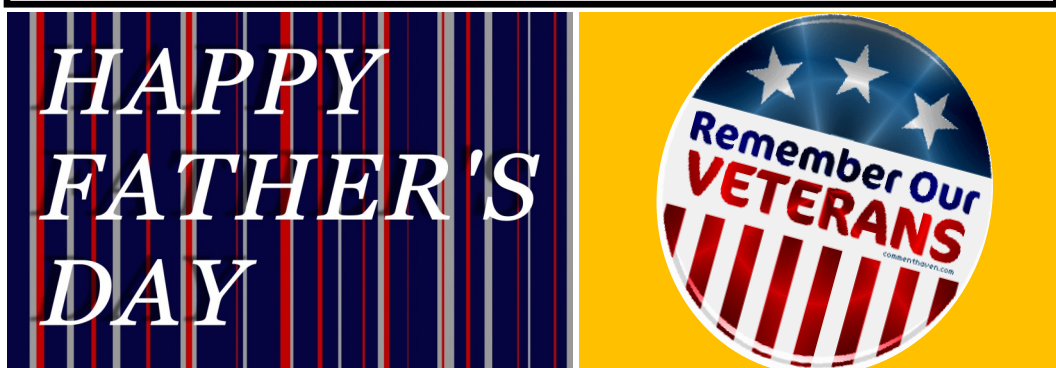
Biden & ATF just created 29 million felons

In a national revolt that rivals the Boston Tea Party, all but a handful of gun owners targeted by President Joe Biden have decided to protest the administration's sweeping rule to regulate one of the most popular and freely owned firearms ever made.

The owners of just 0.6% to 1% of AR-15-style pistols have complied with a May 31 deadline set by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives to register their firearms. By failing to do so, the owners of an estimated 20 million-40 million guns could face 10 years in prison, a \$10,000 fine, or both.

If you take the median number of guns in use, said John Lott Jr., president of the Crime Prevention Research Center, "you are still talking about 29 million people who are technically committing felonies at this point."

If you live in California, how much you pay for electricity will soon be tied to much you earn. A state law passed last summer requires the California Public Utilities Commission, or CPUC, to approve a pricing structure that incorporates a flat fee with a sliding scale based on income. Currently, Californians pay for the energy they use and the cost of upgrading the grid, settling lawsuits related to wildfires and providing assistance to low-income customers is built into the per-kilowatt-hour price.’

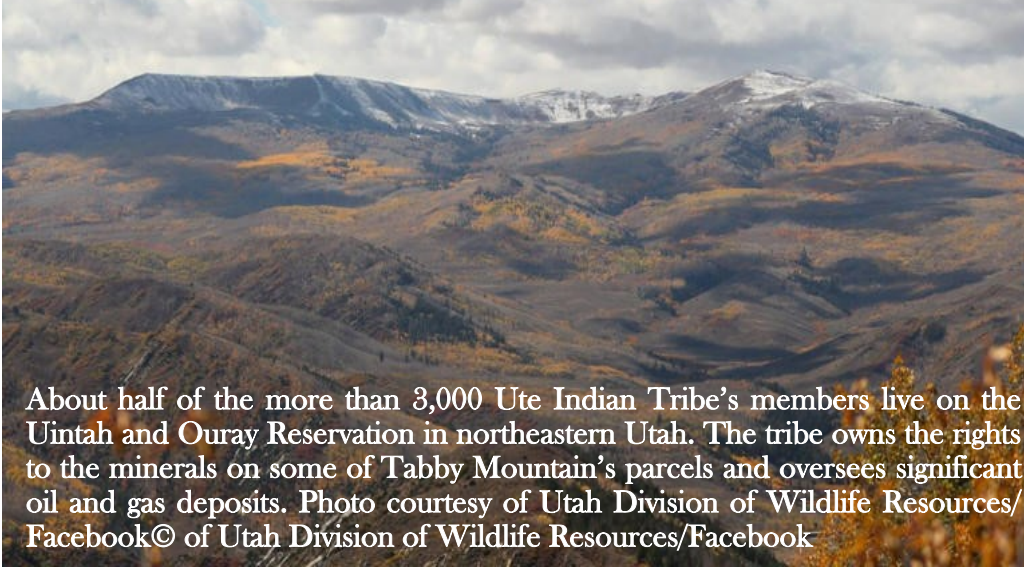
Under the new system, however, funds for these programs would come from "income-graduated fixed charges."

Proponents say the change is needed because, as energy prices continue to increase in the state, poorer households are seeing a bigger chunk of their paychecks going toward repairing California's aged energy infrastructure.

It's an unprecedented move: In an April blog post, energy economist Ahmad Faruqui said more than 170 investor-owned utilities nationwide incorporate a fixed rate – the median being \$10 and the highest \$40.

SALT LAKE CITY, June 6 (UPI) – The Ute Indian Tribe of the Ouray and Uintah Reservation has filed a lawsuit alleging Utah state agencies conspired to stop it from buying Tabby Mountain, a 28,500-acre piece of its ancestral land, even though it submitted the high bid of \$47 million.

The suit claims the defendants arranged in 2019 for the Utah Department of Natural Resources, which was the only other bidder, to submit a second bid that was higher than the tribe's but also a sham because the agency did not have enough money to make the purchase.

DNR and Utah School and Institutional Trust Lands Administra-

tion officers "immediately began working behind the scenes to try to figure out a way to stop the sale to Indians," the suit says.

"That behind-the-scenes response was quintessential discrimination based upon race, ethnicity, national origin and religion," the tribe alleges in the suit, which was filed in May in U.S. District Court in Salt Lake City.

If the sale had gone through, the tribe's intent was to allow its members to use the land for cultural and religious purposes and to hunt and trap there, according to the suit.

Relatives of Japanese Americans incarcerated in Amache find common threads with descendants of the Sand Creek Massacre — which occurred just 46 miles away — during annual pilgrimage

GRANADA, Colo. — Mitch Homma stood on the weathered concrete slab that is all that remains of the barracks where his father and his grandparents lived 80 years ago inside the barbed wire of the Granada Relocation Center, a euphemism later shortened to Camp Amache to designate one of 10 incarceration camps for Japanese Americans hastily erected in the wake of the 1942 attack on Pearl Harbor. (Correction: The Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, Hawaii was on December 7, 1941.)

“It’s about education, not just hey, we walked each other’s site and had ceremonies at each other site,” he said. “It’s more than symbolic. It’s a long-term education avenue that we need to journey down together. This won’t be the only time we come out. We’ll do it again after the next pilgrimage. “This is Step One.”
