A member of the Soboba Band of Luiseño Indians, Burton was raised on the reservation and continues to live there during his sport's off season. The North American Indigenous Athletics Hall of Fame honors and recognizes the indigenous sport cultures of 27 countries of North America by recognizing outstanding leadership and achievement in individual and team athletics. By honoring and celebrating the empowered journey of the annually inducted individuals and teams, the hope is their stories may inspire future generations to follow their dreams in athletics and life. Burton currently plays in the French FFBB league for Orchies NM1 Basketball. Averaging 21.8 points, 11.6 rebounds and 4.1 assists, he is ultimately highly ranked with 30+ efficiency.

Biden regresses, outrageously calls Maryland's first black governor 'boy' in speech

Dennis Prager: Twelve hundred synagogues desecrated Judaism this past Shabbat

This past Shabbat (Sabbath) was a dark day in American Jewish history. Once again — this time within Judaism — the rule that the Left destroys everything it touches was exemplified.

Twelve hundred American synagogues participated in "Repro-Shabbat." "Repro" is short for "reproductive rights." The idea, which originated with a left-wing organization called the National Conference of Jewish Women (NCJW), was to have as many synagogues as possible promote the idea that Judaism supports a woman's right to abort the child

she is carrying at any time in her pregnancy and for any reason, that the human fetus is never a human being — even five minutes before it is born — and that it has no innate right to live.

That this is the position of the American Left is a given. That it is counter to science and to common decency is also a given — as is most of what the Left stands for: "Men give birth"; sexual identity is "nonbinary"; young children should attend drag queen events; a person's sex or "gender" is not a biological fact, but a subjective feeling; men who say they are women must be allowed to compete against women in sports and be placed with women in women's prisons; young girls who say they are boys and want their breasts surgically removed should have their

breasts removed; boys and girls as young as elementary-school age who say they are not a boy or a girl must have this belief "affirmed" by schools, psychotherapists, physicians and society; and schools are duty bound *not* to inform these children's parents if their child identifies as the opposite sex at school and is treated as such there. These are among the many examples of left-wing nihilism.

And these are the positions of the NCJW. What is more disturbing, however, is that the NCJW and 1,200 synagogues regard the left-wing view of abortion — that it is never immoral — as the position of Judaism.

How the Native American population in the US increased 87% says more about whiteness than about demographics

Circe Sturm, Professor of Anthropology, The University of Texas at Austin

The Native American population in the U.S. grew by a staggering 86.5% n 2010 and 2020, according to the latest U.S. Census – a rate demographers say is impossible to achieve without immigration.in numbers

Birth rates among Native Americans don’t explain the massive rise. And there certainly is no evidence of an influx of Native American expatriates returning to the U.S.

Instead, individuals who previously identified as white are now claiming to be Native American.

This growing movement has been captured by terms like “pretendian” and “wannabe.”

Another way to describe this recent adoption of Native American identity is what I call “racial shifting.”

These people are fleeing not from political and social persecution, but from whiteness.

I spent 14 years researching the topic and interviewing dozens of race-shifters for my book “Becoming Indian.” I learned that while some of these people have strong evidence of Native American ancestry, others do not.

Yet nearly all of the 45 people who were interviewed or surveyed for the book believe they have Indigenous ancestry and that it means something powerful about who they are and how they should live their lives. Only a tiny – but troubling – number makes blatantly fraudulent claims to advance their own interests.

Federal judge rules state's school-choice funds can be used for religious schools

Must reimburse parents denied tuition benefits

Vermont must reimburse parents denied state tuition benefits based on their decision to send their children to a religious school, per a settlement approved by a federal judge Thursday.

Under the settlement, the state is prohibited from continuing to deny parents access to tuition based on a school’s “religious status, affiliation, beliefs, exercise, or activities,” and residents of districts that previously denied funds on this basis must be reimbursed. District Judge Christina Reiss cited the Supreme Court’s rul-

ing last summer in Carson v. Makin, a case that similarly found Maine could not exclude religious schools from its tuition program without violating First Amendment religious liberty protections.

Vermont’s town tuitioning program, like Maine’s, exists to help educate children in rural areas where public schools may not exist or cover all grade levels. Where the district has no available option in a town, it pays to send students to a private or public school of the parent’s choice.

Backlash hits ‘absurd censorship’ of classic Roald Dahl children’s books to remove ‘offensive’ language



Following “sensitivity readers” making hundreds of edits to author Roald Dahl’s classic children’s books, novelist Sir Salman Rushdie and actor Brian Cox are leading an angry protest against “absurd censorship” by “woke” publishers engaging in blatant “McCarthyism.”

Cox, who has worked previously with the Royal Shakespeare Company, called the sanitization of Dahl’s works a form of “woke culture” which seeks to reinterpret everything.

Rushdie has paid a heavy price for free speech

himself. He was stabbed and lost sight in one eye for defending free speech and attacking radical Islam in New York last year. He called the edits to the books “absurd censorship.”

Puffin, the publisher of the books, has employed “Inclusive Minds,” a collective of progressive editors who have instituted politically correct changes such as no longer referring to Augustus Gloop as “fat.” They have changed the genders of other characters, and words such as “mad” and “crazy” have been removed.

“I really do believe [these books are] of their time and they should be left alone. Roald Dahl was a great satirist, apart from anything else. It’s disgraceful. It’s this kind of form of McCarthyism, this woke culture, which is absolutely wanting to reinterpret everything and redesign and say, ‘oh, that didn’t exist.’ Well. it did exist. We have to acknowledge our history,” Cox told Times Radio in an interview.

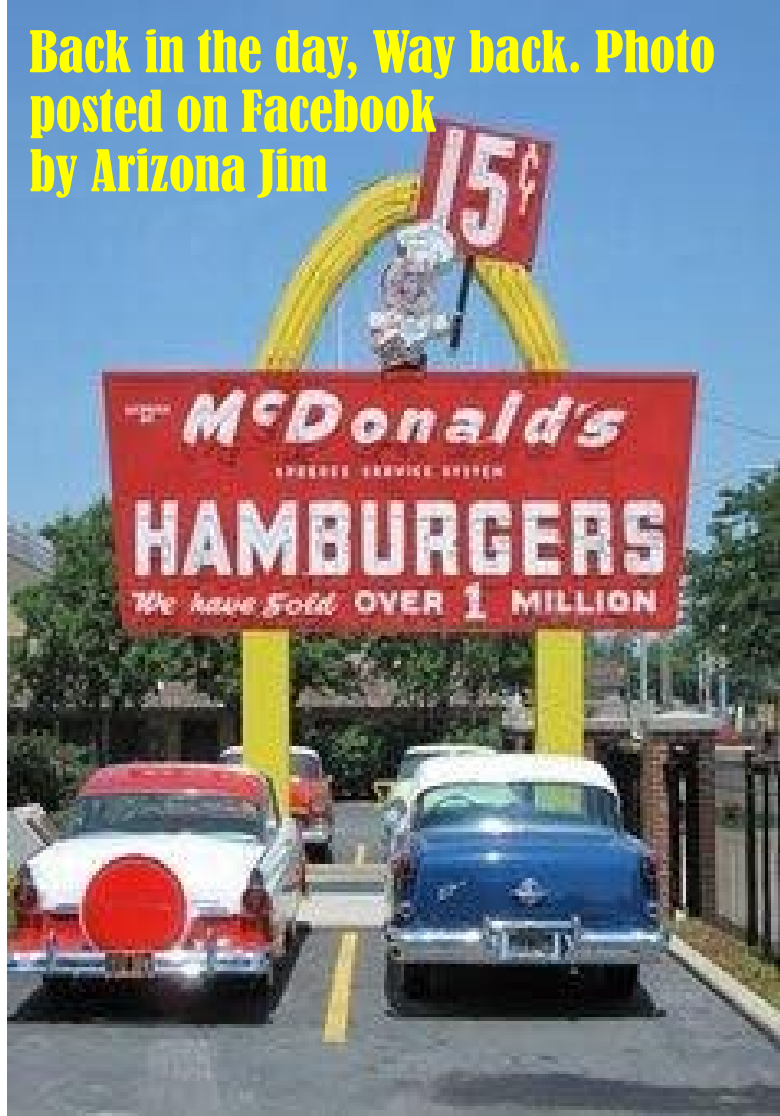
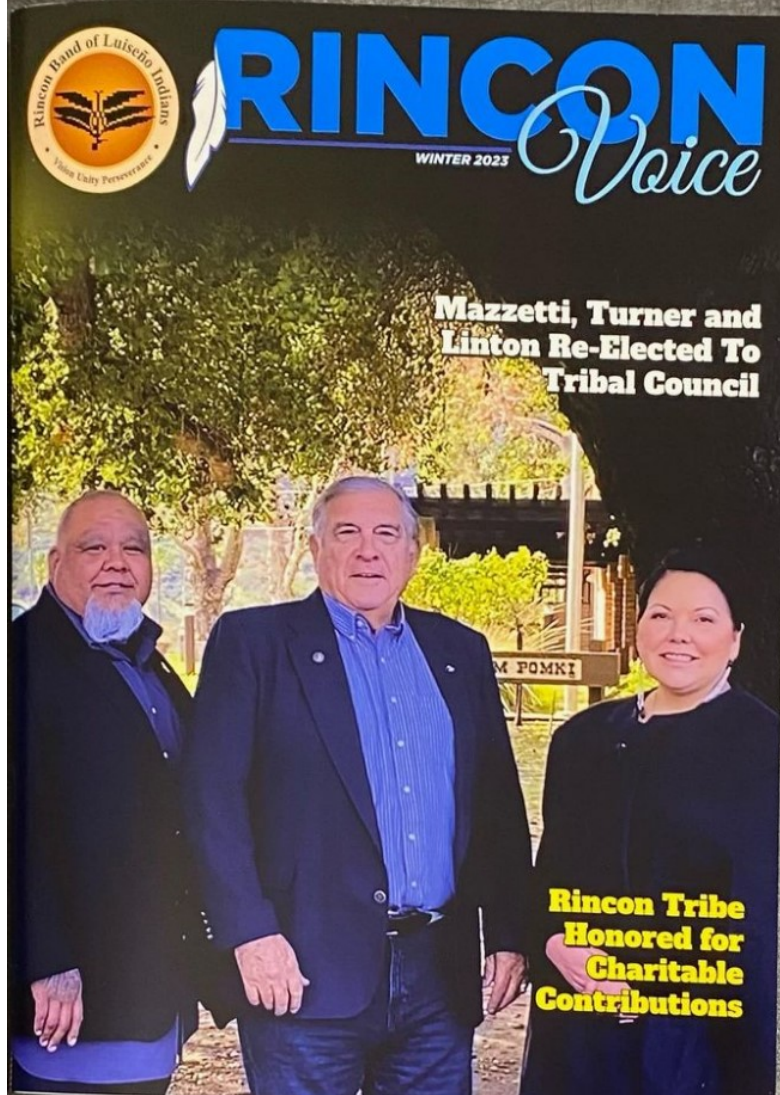
Biden makes surprise visit to Ukraine, Trump makes plans to go to Ohio – that says everything!

Parents speak out against school canceling honors classes in the name of equity: 'It's not working'

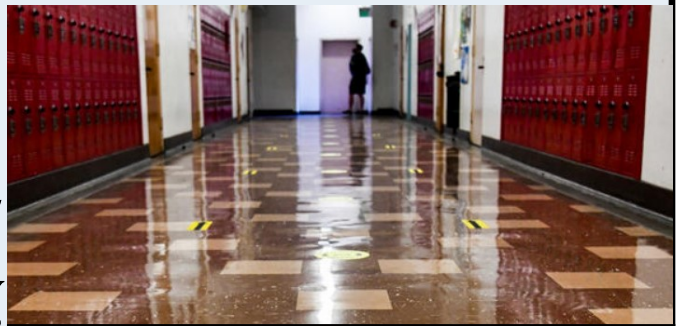
Parents at a Los Angeles area school district spoke out at a Tuesday school board meeting against the administration's decision to eliminate honors classes in the name of racial-equity because they didn't enroll enough Black and Latino students.

Earlier this school year, the Culver City Unified School District (CCUSD) replaced honors classes at Culver City High School with a one-size-fits-all approach that officials said would give students of all races an equal education, the Wall Street Journal reported. Many parents attended the school board meeting to ask the CCUSD

administration to reinstate honors classes, which they laid out in a two-page resolution.

"I have a child in the high school," one mom told the school board. "It is too easy in his classroom. They say, 'Mom, they say it's equity, they say that's the reason and therefore it's okay.' I want my child to be challenged."

"We are immigrants," she added. "My family are immigrants. We came to this country to have a better life, a better education, to get out of poverty ... we want to be able to give them a better education ... because this is why we chose Culver City."

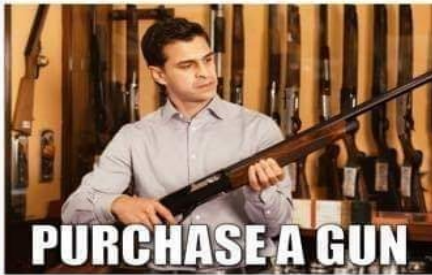

Turmoil in courts on gun laws in wake of justices' ruling

WASHINGTON (AP) — A landmark U.S. Supreme Court decision on the Second Amendment is upending gun laws across the country, dividing judges and sowing confusion over what firearm restrictions can remain on the books.

The high court's ruling that set new standards for evaluating gun laws left open many questions, experts say, resulting in an increasing number of conflicting decisions as lower court judges

struggle to figure out how to apply it.

The Supreme Court's so-called Bruen decision changed the test that lower courts *had long* used for evaluating challenges to firearm restrictions. Judges should no longer consider whether the law serves public interests like enhancing public safety, the justices said.

Under the Supreme Court's new test, the government that wants to uphold a gun restriction must

look back into history to show it is consistent with the country's "historical tradition of firearm regulation."

California police chief blasts state law blamed for sparking prostitution crisis: 'Needs to be repealed'

San Diego's police chief blasted a controversial new California law that cops blame for sparking brazen prostitution on the streets of cities across the Golden State.

The law that went into effect last month allows people to loiter with the intent of engaging in prostitution, Chief Dave Nisleit said - and that includes traffickers, sex buyers and sex workers.

"New state laws make recovering trafficking victims more difficult while emboldening their traf-



fickers,' Nisleit told reporters at a Tuesday news conference. "Your law enforcement officers are

fighting an uphill battle when it comes to human trafficking."

Local leaders in the San Diego area this week were celebrating a successful month-long investigation into human trafficking and prostitution that nabbed 48 arrests and identified 41 suspected victims of trafficking and sex exploitation. Among those rescued were children, including one girl who was only 13 years old.

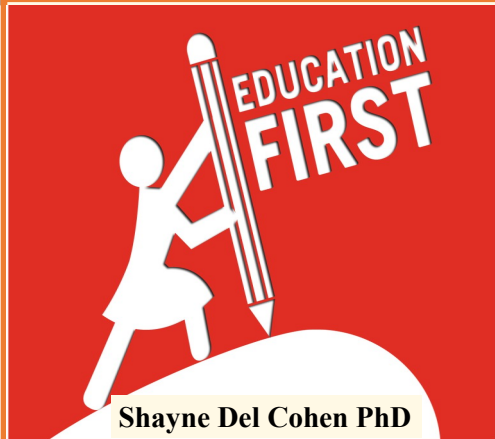

**“ChatGPT is the Inventor Spot-On?
Lots of Pros & Cons, Time Will Tell”**



The inventor of the web says we'll all have a personal ChatGPT-style assistant in the future



ChatGPT mania has gripped the globe in recent weeks, with the advanced A.I.-powered chatbot becoming world-famous and securing a \$10 billion investment from Microsoft. But coupled with developments in personal data storage, the technology can go so much further, according to inventor of the internet Tim Berners-Lee, who envisions everyone being able to have a ChatGPT-style personal assistant in the future. Berners-Lee, a British computer scientist who invented the world wide web in 1989, told CNBC's *Beyond the Valley* podcast in an episode released on Friday that his new startup envisions people having online "pods" where all of their personal data is stored. Berners-Lee cofounded Inrupt, a startup aiming to build web users a single login that can be used across different sites on the internet. As part of its work in developing that technology, Inrupt wants to store individual users' data in digital containers. These so-called pods would be able to grant websites or services access to some or all of an individual's personal information, from sleeping patterns to shopping preferences. [Read More @ Yahoo! VA hired hundreds of employees with drug-related criminal history, putting veterans at risk: watchdog

The Department of Veterans Affairs has hired hundreds and possibly thousands of people with criminal records to care for veterans, which a new report from the Government Accountability Office says is putting veterans at risk of harm. GAO's report said these employees have criminal histories involving felony possession of a controlled substance, which is also raising the chances of drug theft at the agency. GAO estimated that about 1,800 employees at the VA's Veterans Health Administration (VHA) likely have at least one felony conviction for possession of a controlled substance. That estimate is based on a statistical

analysis of a portion of the more than 12,000 VHA workers who show "indications" of prior convictions. When GAO did a deeper dive into 305 of those VHA employees, it found that in some cases, 50 of them had "one more controlled substance-related felony convictions." In some cases, those employees are hired and continue to work closely with veterans even after their past becomes known. In one case GAO uncovered, a current employee was convicted of felony distribution of cocaine in 1997. [Read More @ FOX News](#)
