

DC City Council passes bill into law allowing illegal immigrants, other noncitizens to vote

The Washington, D.C. city council made it official on Monday, illegal immigrants and other non-citizens can now vote in local elections. The Democrat-run district that serves as the nation's capital went so far as to allow foreign diplomats to cast a vote.

That's according to various reports that the city council passed the Local Resident Voting Rights Amendment Act after a 30-day congressional review period ended - the GOP-led House pushed to block the D.C. law from taking effect but the Democrat-run Senate let the clock expire without taking action.

The law requires a person to be 18 and to have lived in D.C. for 30 days to be eligible to vote, providing they do not claim voting residence in any U.S. state or U.S. territory.

The extended Silvas family literally consist of hundreds of uncles, aunts and cousins living on the Soboba and poking and bumping wait until late in Morongo Indian Reservations.

He claims to have started playing basketball when he was 4-years old. But, mother, Dondi laughs and said her dad, B-Bop put a softball and glove in his crib when she brought him home from the hospital. A football and basketball followed shortly after.

Joseph remembers dribbling his basketball on the dirt road in the backyard at his home on the Rez. He said you never know where the ball is going to bounce back with all the rocks and what have you on the ground, but it help to keep me focused.

He said his grandpa, B-Bop built a small basketball court next the house for me to practice on.

Joseph's basketball success didn't happen over night, he put in the hours up-

However, because of his size at 6 foot 5 mad and unfocused. The opposing coach would normally have one or two of his starting player start talking trash, the second quarter he would send in a low level player to force you into pushing back and getting fouled out or losing your temper and fighting and getting tossed from the game.

To prepare Joseph mental for this undesirable part of the game his mother and grandfather enlisted him in a team based in the City of Compton which could rival any street basketball team in the County. At the age of 15 with two years of serious mental adjustment at a simi-professional basketball level, plaving against grown men he was ready. And the rest is history.

Once Joseph hangs up his jersey my prediction is that we are going to see an unprecedented sports revitalization in Indian Country. As his grandpa "B-Bop" said, "It's all about Basics."



Although Joseph goes half way around the world to play basketball, he lives on the Soboba Indian Reservation with his wife and two children. His home is a few step from where he grew up. When asked what he planned when he retired he said: "...return to Soboba; nothing beats the rez life."






