EXCLUSIVE: A watchdog group filed two federal lawsuits against the Biden administration Monday, alleging it has violated federal law by not sharing communications involving Interior Secretary Deb Haaland's daughter.

Protect the Public's Trust (PPT), a non-profit watchdog organization, asked a federal court in the lawsuits - one filed against the Department of the Interior (DOI) and the other filed against the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) - to compel the two agencies to comply with its information requests. On Jan. 2, PPT filed information requests with the DOI and BLM, asking for communications with Haaland's daughter Somah and top agency officials.

The information requests, filed under the Freedom of Information Act which requires the federal government to publicly share certain documents, communications and information with the public, came after a Fox News Digital report revealed Somah Haaland had lobbied federal lawmakers on hot-button oil and gas leasing issues over which her mother has oversight.

"Her daughter's activism and lobbying efforts certainly have the potential to create the perception in the minds of the public that Secretary Haaland could be conflicted on issues under her authority," PPT Director Michael Chamberlain told Fox News Digital. *"Further complicating matters is the participation of an organization that claims Somah Haaland among its leadership in the protest that turned into a riot at the Interior headquarters."*

Both senators are up for re-election next year in states President Donald Trump easily won in 2016 and 2020. Democrats now control 51 of the

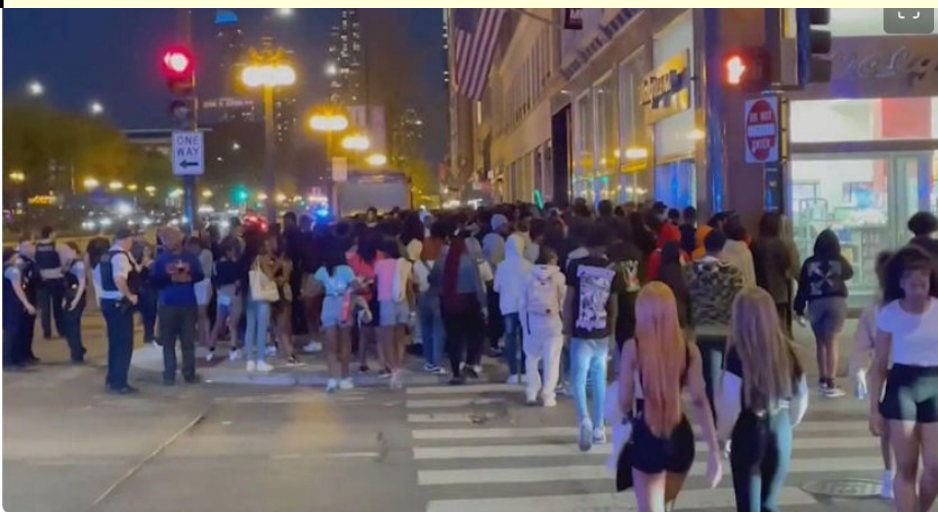

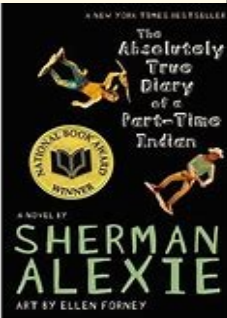

MY VIEW by Ernie C. Salgado, Jr., First, just to be clear I don’t support the banning of books. However, I so support the censoring of reading material for children from birth to ages 16-17 depending on their maturity.

That said, the only book on the list above that I have read or will want to read is Sherman Alexie’s **Part-Time Indian**. Granted it is a bit colorful, emotional and brutally honest, which best describe the content of the book.

Based on my experience of growing up on the Rez, he did an excellent portrayal of daily life and intergenerational trauma on the Rez without the “Rose colored glasses.”

During the late 40s into the 50s and 60s any individual economic upward mobility was based on learning a trade. Higher education was not a consideration in those days.

In the early 50s the Bureau of Indian Affairs launched the Indian Relocation Program. Hundreds of young Indian men and women were relocated in large cities through out the Nation to learn a trade with the expectation of finding meaningful employment.

Many were unable to meet the challenges of the training, the cultural change and demands

of the work place. Still others found success and embraced the creation of the “**Urban Indian Communities**,” through out the Nation.

Even though Alexie’s is a generation younger than I, the Rez life he describes is frighteningly similar to the one I experienced as a youngster. Life on the Rez is tough and brutal at times, **but it’s home.**

In way of example, Sherman suffered from “**Water on the brain**,” which in most communities would earn him a pass or special considerations at a minimum. But, not on the Rez, he was nicknamed “**Hydro-Head**,” and afforded no special considerations or accommodations.

Almost everyone on the Rez has a nickname of which they have no say in the selection process, it just happens.

Again, his story is real and maybe that is the reason for it to be banned. I recommend it as a must read if you’re interest in a people that have survived over two hundred years of government oppressions that continues to this day.

'We are in a war': California church must pay \$1.2M in fines over draconian Covid restrictions

Thanks to an extraordinary ruling by a California judge, a church based out of Santa Clara County must now fork over \$1.2 million in fines to the county for refusing to abide by the county's draconian masking and social distancing orders.

The ruling comes after years of Calvary Chapel San Jose being fined for not abiding by the county's strict COVID rules. Instead of taking the fines sitting down, the church sought to challenge the county's COVID rules in court. But sadly for the church, Santa Clara County Superior Court Judge Evette Pennypacker has ruled against them.

"It should appear clear to all — regardless of religious affiliation — that wearing a mask while worshipping one's god and communing with other congregants is a simple, unobtrusive, giving way to protect others while still exercising your right to religious freedom," Pennypacker's ruling reads, according to the [San Francisco Chronicle](#).

Unfortunately, Defendants repeatedly refused to model, much less, enforce this gesture. Instead, they repeatedly flouted their refusal to comply with the Public Health Orders and urged others to do so 'who cares what the cost,' including death," it continues.

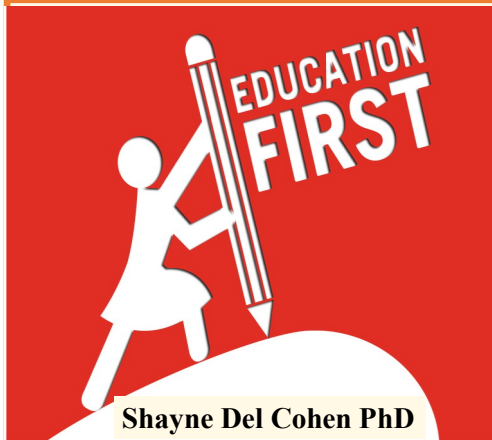

“Technology, Change, Traditions & Adaptation“



On one level, the physical world around us is changing quickly.

The public discussion(s) of climate change and Covid have contributed to dramatic changes in the way some things are done and/or what different responses manifest in different societies.

Downturn in consumerism, supply chain challenges, in -person meetings and much schooling on-line with Zoom. The mitigations have provided some “good” and some “bad” results.

Researchers all over are proposing new products or use of old ones.

Picking on just one example, a group at UC Santa Barbara proposed cultivating seaweed as a potential strategy for capturing nutrient pollution in marine environments. Runoff from farms, yards, to say nothing of paved concourses, deliver excess nutrients results in low-oxygen “dead zones”. Seaweed would appear to produce more oxygen and absorb excess nutrients as well as have potential as a carbon sink.

Seaweed is also seen as bio-fuel, fertilizer, animal feed and food industry accouterment.

The implication of this one, tiny little movement is vast for sea-shore tribes or those with marine resources.

It calls for community members with skill and certification in biology, chemistry, agronomics, hydrology, marketing, supply chain logistics and/or culinary arts.

Are you ensuring that your little people are getting the foundations in the basics that will enable them to master these topics and be able to serve the community as new opportunities present themselves? And will tribal policies/procedure be “updated” to reflect the realities of new technologies, land and natural resource use?

The prior example is part of the future.

With the appointment of Deb Haaland as Secretary of the Interior and Zach Duchenaus as the Administrator of the Department of Agriculture’s Farm Service Administration plus President Biden’s Executive Order regarding traditional practices, there is more focus on taking care of the soil and listening to nature.

Foraging - eating local with wild plants is not new to those who lived off the land for centuries. But tragically, assimilation has subdued that knowledge and many tribes are scurrying to recover it and put into practice.

Education in this area has engendered websites and classes all over

the country as more people reconnect with the natural environment.

At the United Tribes Technical College in Bismarck, Linda Black Elk, a life-long forager, has taught food sovereignty based on the lessons of her grandmother who said, “You’re not home if you don’t know the plants. Getting to know them and really feeling at home, feeling connected to a place, is really important.”

Ms. Black Elk continues, “it’s not just a fun hobby to us. This is literally our life. This is the stuff that sustains and has sustained our ancestors. We look at this stuff as the food that feeds us spiritually as well as physically.”

She counsels learning only five plants to start; learning them well enough to identify by season, all the while building a relationship with the natural world.

Another area now commanding discussion and action is “regenerative farming”.

Colonization, US policy and “conventional agriculture” (synthetic fertilizers, herbicides and pesticides) destroyed many of the traditional ways of stewarding lands, seed care and planting methodologies.

Regenerative farming is really managing agriculture from an Indigenous perspective, recognizing one-

self as a steward, not exploiter, not a controller of the land.

Climate change activists have come to see the wisdom in lessening the norms of industrialized/mechanized ag, reduction of pesticides and concentrating on the whole ecosystem.

Food sovereignty above food security needs educators who will not only learn and practice local production but who will educate customers and the general public who want to learn the benefits of buying local product.

Besides the traditional knowledge, community members with videography and electronic communications systems skills are needed to facilitate instruction and public relations.

So whether your community tends toward the traditional or the modern, there is opportunity for all to enhance their knowledge base and qualify for employment. The key is ensuring that individuals and tribal institutions have a clear idea of where they are headed, are vigorous in providing curriculum content, create opportunities for hands-on learning and have projected staffing needs for the community that are reflected in local educational opportunities.

Mr. Carlson, 53 years old, had been at the conservative news network for more than a decade. He emerged as an influential political voice during the Donald Trump era and became the highest-rated host in prime-time cable news, averaging 3.2 million viewers in the first quarter of this year, according to Nielsen.

In Wednesday’s (April 26, 2023) video on Twitter, Mr. Carlson said major topics that will define the country’s future, such as war, civil liberties, emerging science, demographic change, corporate power and natural resources, don’t get talked about

enough.

“Debates like that are not permitted in American media,” he said. “Both political parties and their donors have reached consensus on what benefits them, and they actively collude to shut down any conversation about it.”

DOJ watchdog Horowitz warns Congress of ‘concerning’ problems with FBI use of FISA

The Justice Department watchdog who unearthed serious problems with the FBI’s use of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act during the Trump-Russia investigation told Congress on Thursday (April 25, 2023) about “concerning” flaws with the bureau’s use of FISA powers.

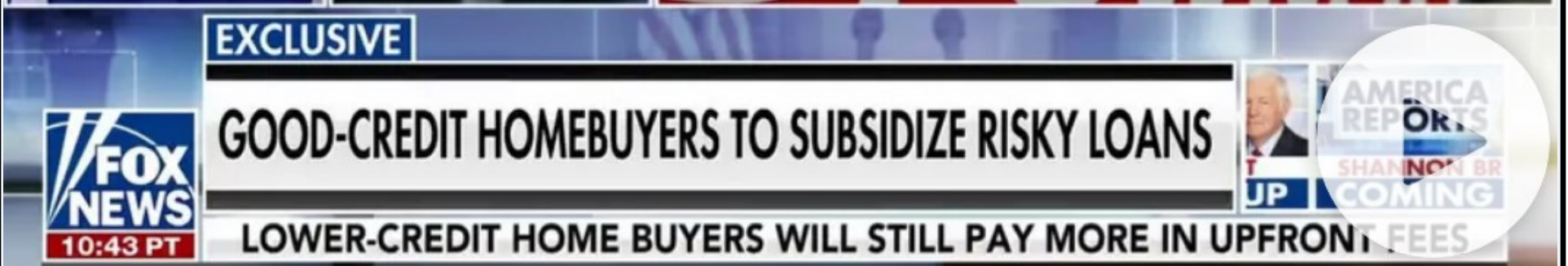

USD is suffering 'stunning collapse' as world's reserve currency, warns Eurizon SLJ Capital's Jen

(Kitco News) Markets need to pay closer attention to the de-dollarization trend since the greenback is losing its power as a reserve currency faster than many analysts are noticing, according to Stephen Jen, CEO and co-CIO of Eurizon SLJ Capital.

The dollar's loss of its reserve currency status accelerated last year when the greenback was used against Moscow as part of the sanction package after Russia invaded Ukraine. In 2022, the USD's share as a global reserve

currency fell at ten times the average pace of the past 20 years, Jen said in a report.

"The dollar suffered a stunning collapse in 2022 in its market share as a reserve currency, presumably due to its muscular use of sanctions," Jen wrote. *"Exceptional actions taken by the U.S. and its allies against Russia have startled large reserve-holding countries, most of which are from the Global South."*

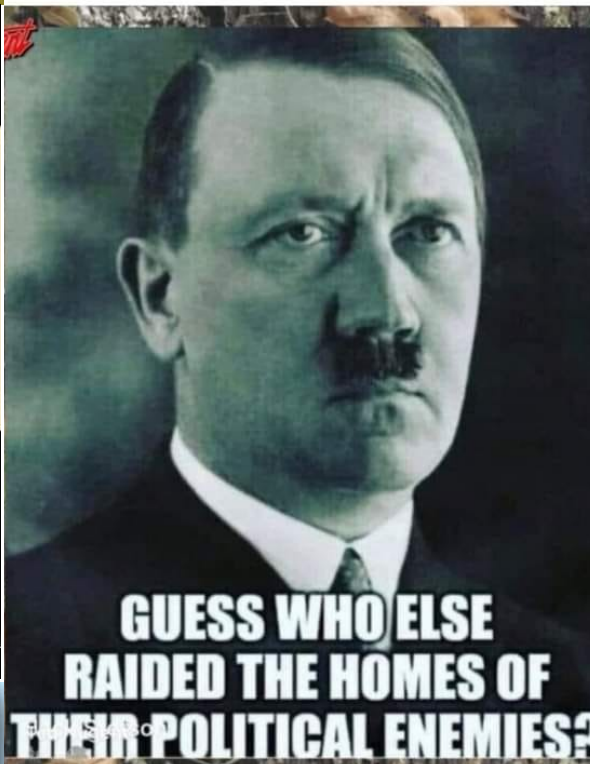
