Burton: "I've Had A Lot of Experience"

Joseph is an enroll member of the Soboba Band of Luiseno Indians

Just elected **MVP** of the season in National 1, Joe Burton once again makes his mark on French basketball. Currently at BC Orchies, the American pivot finds a second youth and the pleasure of playing and sharing. With a strong history, this player is a profound humanist with an innovative vision of his sport. Maintenance.

Joe Burton is a 32-year-old American basketball player. He made his NCAA (*college sports*) debut for Oregon with the Beavers. It was in 2013 that the pivot decided to join Europe with a first experience in Denmark, in Aalborg. This experience will allow him to reveal himself with nearly 22 points average on the season. After a jump to the Netherlands, Burton joined Evreux, his first French club, in 2015. Everything follows for him, since he has a dantesque season, punctuated by a playoff final and the MVP title, his first. Over the course of the Pro B, the American will land in Pro A in 2019, on the side of Roanne. With

stops in Kosovo or Finland, Joe Burton ends up joining the BC Orchies this year, in National 1. He spoke about his choice, his life experiences and his vision of basketball.

Can you tell us about your childhood in Soboba and what does it mean to you?

JB: I grew up on the Soboba Reservation in southern California. Conditions have improved since I was there, which is a good thing. Because in fact, we always want to improve it for the next generations to come. Growing up there was good because I had a lot of life experiences there. I come from a sporty family, we played a lot outside. They instilled in me and passed on this tradition that makes the person I am today. Besides, my teammates asked me questions about my origins, so I explained to them this culture that is in me. I am proud to be a "Native American".

Democrats ignore criminals, blame car companies for skyrocketing auto thefts

Democrats have found a new culprit to blame for skyrocketing auto thefts on their watch: car companies. Several Democratic politicians have ignored criminals and reprimanded manufacturers for increasing vehicle thefts, signaling a blueprint that may continue in other areas in attempts to deflect criticism of themselves and their policies.

Minnesota Attorney General Keith Ellison has pointed fingers at Kia and Hyundai for a spate of car thefts, going as far as to open an investigation into the manufacturers over whether they had omitted "industry-standard, anti-theft technology" on some of its automobiles.

"Kia and Hyundai vehicles might as well have a giant bumper sticker that says 'steal me' on them," Ellison said in early March.

The IRS is hiring special agents prepared to use 'deadly force' if needed and is paying up to \$95,000

The Internal Revenue Service is hiring special agents who shouldn't be afraid of using "deadly force." Criminal Investigation, the law enforcement branch of the IRS, is looking for agents across the US who can combine "accounting skills with law enforcement skills to investigate financial crimes," according to a job posting on its website.

"Special Agents are duly sworn law enforcement officers who are trained to 'follow the money.'" These agents investigate financial crimes, money laundering, tax-related identity theft, and terrorist financing efforts. They are the only IRS workers who are permitted to carry and use firearms.

DOJ, federal agencies pour hundreds of millions into Soros-linked group accused of trying to 'nullify the law

FIRST ON FOX - A far-left non-profit accused of siding with criminals for its work to deplete the justice system while working inside local prosecution offices is nearly entirely funded by federal government agencies, including Department of Justice.

The Vera Institute of Justice - a Soros-linked nonprofit - has received \$290 million from the federal government over the last 12 months alone for its work in immigration - to help illegal immigrants avoid deportation - and the criminal justice system. If its current contracts are extended for the next four years, disbursements could reach over \$1 billion.

"We work to transform the immigration system because many of the problems that we see in the criminal

legal system are just the same in the immigration system. And by transform, what I mean is to shrink both of those systems," Vera Justice's president, Nick Turner, said.

Vera funds radical-left agendas in prosecution and law enforcement offices around the country. Fox News Digital found they advocate to defund the police, they partner with district attorney offices to artificially manipulate "racial disparities" in prosecution decisions for criminals and openly state their mission is to demolish what they deem to be a "racist" system.

“Bottomless Pinocchio:” Biden’s ‘highly misleading’ deficit claim hammered by fact checker

The Washington Post’s supposed “fact-checker” actually performed his job for a change this week and fact-checked President Joe Biden’s latest glaring lie.

The unexpected fact-check was published Friday (April 28, 2023) in response to something the president had said three days earlier at the North America’s Building Trades Unions event.

“As a matter of fact, my first two years in office I’ve lowered the deficit by a record \$1.7 trillion. Lowered the deficit – the debt,” the president had said.

Fact-check: FALSE!

In his fact-check, the Post’s Glenn Kessler not only called out this lie, but he also complained about how often the president has repeated the lie.

“[A]s we have documented before, Biden’s talking point is highly misleading – worthy of Three Pinocchio’s. Yet he keeps saying it over and over. By our count, at least 30 times since June he’s taken credit for reducing the budget deficit by \$1.7 trillion,” Kessler wrote.

“Why is this significant? Readers may recall that during Donald Trump’s presidency, we established a new category, the Bottomless Pinocchio, to account for false or misleading statements repeated so often that they became a form of propaganda.

“A statement would get added to the list if it had earned a Three or Four Pinocchio’s rating and been repeated at least 20 times. By the end of the Trump presidency, 56 claims made by Trump had qualified,” he added.

And since the president has repeated the deficit lie “over and over” again, Kessler decided to award him with a Bottomless Pinocchio as well.

To be clear, this isn’t the first time the president’s received a Bottomless Pinocchio.

“We’d previously given Biden a Bottomless Pinocchio for claiming – without any evidence – that he’s traveled 17,000 miles with Chinese president Xi Jinping. He’s still saying that line, most recently during a speech to the Irish parliament on April 13,” Kessler noted in his fact-check.

And so he’s only received two Bottomless Pinochios thus far, despite his presidency being littered with lie after lie after lie ...

And even though the underground water level was at approximately 150 feet they would not allow the tribe to drill down to it even though the funding was available.

The reason for their actions was to force the tribe to cede their water rights to the EMWD so they could use the tribe money to develop a domestic water system and allow the tribe to buy it's own water back. Needless to say, the tribe refused.

So, in addition to living in dire poverty the Soboba people suffered without water for over 40-year.

However, In 1991 as Tribal Chairman I signed the law suit agreement against the U.S. Government for "Negligent," after over 55-years of litigation. Yet, no one was held accountable for the evil of withholding water from the Soboba people, which is a crime against humanity.

Soboba is not alone in the struggle to protect their tribal water rights. Currently the Navajo tribe is before the supreme court with a water right claim dating back to the mid 1800. And several tribe have gained access to the policy making body for the Colorado River water.

Many southern California tribe have also been battling local, state and the federal government over their water rights.

In short, the U.S. Government is not a friend to the American Indian Tribes.

And, to those that profess that we lost the war, no we didn't, we agreed to live in peace and signed Treaties with the U.S. Government and British representative prior to 1776 which are recognized in the Constitution, however, we are still fighting to get the Government to honor them.

As a tribal elder I have been blessed to have had the opportunity to experience a broad range of employment from an agriculture field laborer and fruit picker, construction worker, bail bondsman and bounty hunter as well, a Master Barber (My trade since 1960), boxed for the Golden Gloves heavyweight championship in 1962 and lost.

Trained as a professional horse back stunt rider and attended Jay Silverheels AKA "Tonto" acting school in 1967. Was the CEO and GM for a number of organizations, entrepreneur, business management consultant and earned an MBA on the way.

From 1975 to 2015 I served as the Executive Director of Ahmim Education, Inc., a 501(c)(3) non profit American Indian Organization.


Over the years I have been privileged to serve as the Tribal Chairman and Council for my tribe and many other boards and commissions to improve the quality of life for our people.

I have been an activists for tribal right and self governance my entire life. It was served at the kitchen table along with the pinto beans, rice, tortillas and my grandma's chilli.

I am a strong supporter of the basic traditional values of the Mission Indian Federation which includes Self Determination, individual rights and Tribal Self Governance.

I am a veteran as were my father and brother Richard "Dumbo."

And, along with my brother Bobby "RJ" we were active participants in the American Indian Movement, (AIM) from the early days.

My views on abortion, blood quantum, disenrollment, gender identity, Socialism and the lack of Constitutional protection for the individual tribal members is as follows:

Abortion: It is self genocide, not to mention murder. Upon the first heart beat is a living person preparing to enter our world as we know it. And it is not your body. The living person with in your body must be protected and no one has an right to terminate that life.

Blood Quantum: It is self termination and reduces tribal membership to a "racial issue" as opposed to lineage.

Disenrollment: This is nothing short of a "Third World Country's" ploy to maintain power as well as short-sighted as it expedites the end time of the tribe.

Gender Identity: This along with the Pronouns, critical race theory, defund the police, transgender nonsense and all the other woke trash is nothing more than a well planned distraction as the Nation is systematically transformed into a "One World Order" of an Elitist controlled Government.

Up until 1976 the Tribal Governments were not even allowed to manage their own funds or make any decision without the approval of the U.S. Government or it's authorized representative with was the Department of Interior and its subsidiary, the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Even to this day the government controls all issues pertaining to tribal lands as it is held in "Trust" by the government on behalf of the tribes.

Please define Tribal Sovereignty for me. Yes, thank you. Yet, the majority of the tribes and American Indian people support the Socialist Democrats.

The only rational conclusion for the tribes to accept this oversight is protection from distrustful tribal member that may take control of the Tribal Government.

The loss of the tribal land base is one of the greatest fears of the tribal members.

This was a major concern for many of the tribal leaders during the early days of gaming when they had to waive their tribal sovereignty in order to obtain funding.

Maverick Gaming LLC v United States, a case challenging the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act on the ground of equal protection, stating that tribal status is based on race. Basically the challenge is identical to *Brackeen v Haaland*.

If the supreme court rule against the tribe on either one of them it's game over for the Indian Tribes.

I truly understand why the majority of the tribal folks support the Democrat Party. However, what they fail to understand is that the ideology of the Democrats is not the same as it was when our parents were alive.

When Ronald Reagan left the Party the Republican Party became the real Democratic Party. Granted the Republicans still have a lot of fools but Socialism is not in the best interest of the American Indian people if they are to ever break the chains of Government dependency.

The annual prize is awarded to or-

TULALIP INDIAN RESERVATION — Hundreds of Native Americans, many wearing traditional wooden caps unique to tribes in the Pacific Northwest, attended *The Road to Healing* on Sunday at the gathering hall on the Tulalip Indian Reservation, an hour north of downtown Seattle.



The event at the Tulalip Gathering Hall was the sixth listening session of the year-long tour of Native communities led by Interior Secretary Deb Haaland (Laguna Pueblo) and Assistant Secretary - Interior Affairs Bryan

Newland (Bay Mills Indian Community). The Road to Healing was launched last July by the Department of Interior to provide Native Americans affected by the federal Indian board school system an opportunity to share their experiences and the effects on their communities.

"I want you to know that I'm with you on this journey and I will listen," Haaland said in her opening remarks. "I will grieve with you. I will weep with you and I will feel your pain, as we mourn what was lost. Please know that we still have so much to gain. The healing that can help our communities will not be done overnight." **Read More @ Native News Online**

Oklahoma governor vetoes bill allowing graduation regalia


With one swipe of the pen, Oklahoma Gov. Kevin Stitt vetoed a bipartisan bill that would have allowed Native students to wear tribal regalia at graduation ceremonies.

The move drew a sharp response from tribal leaders – including leaders of the Cherokee Nation, where Stitt’s citizenship remains controversial – and civil rights advocates, who urged the legislature to override the veto.

“Should this bill become law, the proverbial Pandora’s box will be opened for other groups to go over the heads of local superintendents and demand special favor to wear whatever they please at a formal ceremony,” Stitt, a Republican who is enrolled with the Cherokee Nation, said in a statement to lawmakers announcing the veto. He noted that *“nothing in current state law prevents a school from allowing students to wear tribal regalia at their graduation ceremonies.”*

Tribal leaders and rights advocates, however, said the bill would have guaranteed that right, as several school districts in Oklahoma already do not allow it.

“When students choose to express the culture and heritage of their respective Nations to signify this moment in their lives, it is not to ‘demand special favor to wear whatever they please,’ it is to honor their identity,” Muscogee (Creek) Nation Chief David Hill said in a statement.
