# Woke Biden Cancels 9/11

The architect of the 9/11 attacks and his fellow defendants **may avoid the death penalty** because federal prosecutors in President Biden’s Justice Department are considering plea agreements.

As of May 2023, the United States is **holding** 30 detainees at Guantanamo Bay in Cuba. In May 2014, former President Barack Obama notoriously released 5 terrorists in exchange for U.S. Army Sergeant Bowe Bergdahl who disgracefully deserted his post in Afghanistan to join enemy members of the Taliban. Bergdahl pleaded guilty in 2017 to charges of desertion and misbehavior before the enemy, but a federal judge voided the conviction in 2023.

Among the 30 detainees at Guantanamo, there are **five** prominent al-Qaeda members who face terrorist charges related to the 9/11 attacks. Khalid Sheikh Mohammed, who was known by at least 50 pseudonyms, is considered “the principal architect of the 9/11 attacks,” according to the 9/11 Commission Report. He is a Pakistani extremist terrorist who was a member of Osama bin Laden’s organization.

A letter was sent to several of the families of 9/11 victims that says military prosecutors and defense lawyers are exploring plea deals. The case has been held up for over a decade due to delays and legal disputes, including legal ramifications regarding the enhanced interrogation techniques used, including waterboarding.

Mohammed was initially captured in March 2003 and he was transported to secret CIA prison sites in Afghanistan and Poland where he was interrogated by U.S. operatives. He was waterboarded 183 times in CIA custody to obtain information about terrorist attacks. In December 2006, Mohammed was transferred to military custody at Guantanamo Bay detention camp.

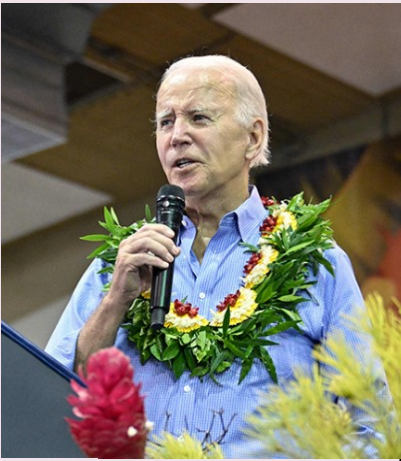

## Shoplift bill gives thieves a green light

California is undergo-ing a retail-theft crime wave. In Los Angeles a mob of 30-plus criminals stole nearly \$100,000 in handbags from a Nordstrom store on a re-cent Saturday afternoon. This is a huge problem that endan-gers store employees and cus-tomers. The city doesn’t know what to do, so it’s setting up a “task force.”

We’re skeptical a new com-mittee will do much to stop these coordinated attacks, which have plagued other Cali-fornia cities as well — and may have their roots in state poli-cies that have reduced penal-ties for theft. Unfortunately, state lawmakers aren’t taking the problem seriously and ac-tually are about to pass a bill that amounts to an invitation to shoplift.

Senate Bill 553, by Sen. Dave Cortese, D-San Jose, ostensi-bly is a measure to protect em-ployees from workplace vio-lence.

The main aspect of the bill — and one that has sparked a Capitol protest by gas-sta-tion owners — is troubling. It forbids non-security employ-ees from confronting an active shoplifter.

The legislation would also impose costly regulatory bur-dens on business owners, who

already are struggling to deal with the situation.

It would require them to provide training sessions for dealing with shoplifters, main-tain a log of various encoun-ters and offer wellness refer-als for employees.

Retailers already train their employees, so we fail to see how more paperwork will help.

Its requirement for “active shooter” training is unlikely to help. As the California Cham-ber of Commerce noted, this is “not something most busi-nesses (or public entities) are ever going to be equipped to handle” and will mainly “re-quire businesses to keep more records of these events.”

Obviously, employees can-not be expected to confront a mob that’s ransacking the store, but the net result will be giving wannabe shoplifters the green light to steal with im-punity.

Not every store can afford a full-time security guard. Just as the smash-and-grab flash mobs coordinated their efforts via social media, so too will shoplifters learn online which stores lack guards.

If lawmakers can’t figure out how to confront the retail-theft wave, they should at least not make matters worse.

# Soboba Tribal member becomes certified Master Gardener

As a Soboba Cultural Garden Specialist, Eloyd Rodriguez has enjoyed sharing its harvests with his Tribal community but also likes to distribute information about planting, growing, and maintaining a variety of crops. Since the formal establishment of the Soboba Cultural Garden in 2018, he has been working closely with members of the UCCE Master Gardener Program, exchanging ideas and collaborating on different projects to learn from one another.

“There is a lot of trial and error in the Soboba garden,” Rodriguez said. Working with UCCE Master Gardener Thurman Howard and others over the years and sharing information, he said the connection was there and felt it was advantageous for Soboba to get involved with the program to gather even more knowledge that would ensure continued success.

After learning more about the UCCE program through this relationship to get the Soboba Cultural Garden to optimum condition, Rodriguez became interested in pursuing his certification to become a UC Master Gardener himself. His current role as the Soboba Cultural Garden Specialist enabled him to pursue endeavors such as the certification process, which took him a little less than a year to complete.

*“I have been taking classes here and there since*

*working with the garden and was able to get my heavy equipment operating license,”* he said. *“I have been taking whatever classes that I come across, always trying to learn more about what we didn’t know and refreshing what we already do know.”*

Some of the topics included in the mandatory training classes covered irrigation, weed science, plant propagation, invasive plants, plant pathology and pollinators.



*“There are a lot of classes offered and 100 volunteer hours required, which is broken down into different approved community service activities such as speaking engagements, etc.,”* Rodriguez said. *“There are different venues for participation as well, and you can be involved around your schedule, so this was very helpful.”*

He was especially excited that the Botanical Garden at UCR was on the list of volunteer work that counted towards his certification. *“I always found it very interesting, so I was excited to finally get there to see it in person and work on the gardens there,”* he said

University of California Master Gardeners are trained volunteers from all walks of life who share objective research-based knowledge on all aspects of home horticulture with county residents after receiving 50 hours of training from University of California academics and external practitioners. Master Gardeners share this knowledge primarily by conducting workshops and demonstrations; disseminating gardening literature at public service events; addressing inquiries received through garden phone and email hotlines; identifying pest problems at plant clinics; and contributing to the UC blogs and newsletter.

The headline in Christianity Today's analysis of the hit song "**Rich Men North of Richmond**" blares: "**Oliver Anthony's Viral Hit Doesn't Love Its Neighbors.**" The sort of people who read Christianity Today, however, should be asking themselves if they love **Virginia resident Oliver Anthony**, who wrote and sang it.

In one of the most stunning passages of the Bible, Jesus tells the para-

ble of a man robbed, stripped, beaten, and left for dead on the road. A priest and a Levite both pass by, but when a Samaritan saw the bleeding man, "**he had compassion**" (Luke 10:33).

The lesson is that such compassion is the embodiment of a **love for God** that encompasses heart, soul, strength, and mind. The lesson hits home today because it's so easy to relate to the priest and the Levite. It

is hard to muster compassion for those we don't know. Harder still for those we outright disdain.

In his prophetic book "**Coming Apart**," Charles Murray argues: "**Our nation is coming apart at the seams—not ethnic seams, but the seams of class.**"

If the past 10 years haven't borne the truth of that claim, it's evident in the responses to Anthony's massive hit.

There are those for whom his tune is the battle cry of a generation, an anthem for the age in which we are reckoning with the results of 50 years of globalization and financialization. And there are those who insist Anthony's diagnosis is ignorant, his grievances are misdirected, and he just needs to bootstrap his way up the income ladder.

We are all aware of the devastation, loss of so many lives and the Political Blame Game, but most of us don't get a first hand look at any of the thousands of individual stories from the people that experienced this tragedy. Yes, the news outlets feed us sound bits to enhance the drama, which in my view is distasteful at best.

I would like to share a little note I received from a friend that lives on the Inland of Maui, Hawaii. Janna (Livesay) Hoehn and grew up in Hemet, a small town in Southern California. She comes from a very large extended and well known family in our rural community. I am also from the same area. I grew up on the Soboba Indian Reservation near the small Cities of Hemet and San Jacinto.

About 15 years ago Janna became involved with the **Vietnam Wall of Faces Project**, which was to collect a photograph of the 58 thousand plus whose names are engraved on the **Viet Nam Memorial Wall**.

Living in Hawaii, she made her first task to collect the photographs of the Hawaiian Natives killed in Viet Nam. This didn't take her long since the Hawaiian community is a close knit families.

And, although I didn't meet Janna until about 12 years ago, I knew many of her relatives. In fact one of her uncles, Ronnie Beavers was a

softball playing and beer drinking buddy.

Anyway, short story shorter, Janna contacted me and explained what she was doing and we set up a meeting at the Barona Resort & Casino in San Diego County.

I invited a few other veterans, which like myself were a little apprehensive of her proposal. At first blush it looked like a scam. As the old metaphor goes, **"Never Judge a Book by its Cover,"** that also goes for a beautiful lady with a great proposal.

All she wanted was our support as American Indian veterans for her to search out the photographs of the 232 American Indians whose names are engraved on the **Viet Nam Memorial Wall**.

And low and behold after almost a decade of pure tenacity, she collected the 232 photograph. And on top of that as she traveled the Nation she added the search for photos of hard to find photos of non-Indian and in one case she traveled to **Puerto Rico** on her mission.

Did I mention that her travel, lodging and meals were on her own dime! So much for a scam.

I knew Janna lived on Maui and read a posting on Facebook asking if anyone had heard from her during the first few days of the fire. I send a text and email to her and got no answer.

### IN THE EYE OF THE INFERNO A SHORT NOTE FROM JANNA



*Ernie, sorry I couldn't get back to you... here is a little of what happened. Whew what a 3 weeks!*

*Thank you, first day in 20 days having internet... It is devastating what happened to our little town. I don't know how they can ever come back from this... however, Hawaii is a strong state and everyone sticks together!*

*Thanks for your concern... so grateful to have electricity after 18 days. We were fine however Richard had gone to the dentist on the other side of the island.... and I didn't see him again for 3 days, I wasn't worried as we have rental property, thought he would go there, however, we had no cell service so he had heard our sub-*

*division was evacuated and didn't know where I was...*

*Well, I didn't know they evacuated so I was at home.... closed up the house because of the smoke, I couldn't see the fire that was a half mile from our house..... glad I didn't know as I would have panicked.*

*So for 3 days I hand watered about 4 acres of our property so everything wouldn't die, as the sprinkler system wasn't working... I didn't know I was in danger so I just carried on as usual.*

*Richard finally convinced the National Guard to let him through, poor guy slept in his truck for 2 nights..... we have been in clean up mode, the wind was about 120-130 mph.... tore up a lot of our landscaping.... thank God we had water all along...and now internet.*

*Yeah... !! I feel so bad for the families that lost loved ones and their homes.... over 2000 homes/structures burned... I pray they can build some new housing soon.*

*Thanks for your prayers and contacting us. The devastation is unbelievable, so incredibly sad.*

### 'Bet they all know their pronouns though': Maddening revelations grow surrounding Maui officials

Controversy is brewing in Maui over the questionable response from local officials to the wildfires wreaking havoc across the island.

Primarily at issue is water, or the lack thereof.

On Aug. 10th, the West Maui Land Company sent a letter to the Hawaii Commission on Water Resource Management (CWRM) deputy director M. Kaleo Manuel complaining about a delay in diverting water to fill the reservoirs that were being used by local firefighters to battle the flames.

*"According to the letter, although the initial fire was contained at 9 a.m., there were reports of fallen power lines, fierce winds, outages and low reservoir levels, prompting the company to reach out to the commission to request approval to divert more water from streams so it could store as much water as possible for fire control,"* as reported by the Honolulu Star-Advertiser.

*."Instead of approving the request, CWRM asked the company whether the Maui Fire Department had requested permission to dip into the reservoirs and directed it to first inquire with the downstream user to ensure that his loi and other uses would not be impacted by a temporary reduction of water supply."*

*Here is M. Kaleo Manuel, the Hawaii water official who refused to release water resources and let landowners fight the Maui fire, explaining his "philosophy" about water:*

As seen above, Manuel appears to be an environmentalist who worships water. Whether or not he's actually responsible for the water delay remains unclear, though Hawaii Gov. Josh Green, a Democrat, appears to believe he is.

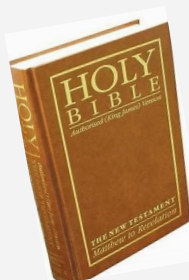

Bassist Oscar Pettiford's mother was Choctaw, and his father was half-Cherokee. Vocalist Kay Starr's father was a full-blooded Iroquois.

Another name to add to that list is Russell "Big Chief" Moore from the Pima (Akimel O'odham) tribe who grew up in the Gila River Indian Community just south of Phoenix, Arizona. He had a 50-year career that extended from the mid-1930s with Lionel Hampton's big band to two tours with Louis Armstrong to playing for East Coast socialites in Lester Lanin's Orchestra.

An exhibit at the Musical Instrument Museum in Phoenix that commemorated Arizona's statehood centennial in 2012 recognized Moore as one of the state's foremost musicians as well as marking the 100th anniversary of his birth in 1912. His horn is now on display at the National Museum of the American Indian in New York City, which is located in the Alexander Hamilton U.S. Custom House in Lower Manhattan. Artist Philip Stein, whose work decorates the back wall of the Village Vanguard in Greenwich Village, did an oil painting of "Big Chief" that adorns the 1973 album, Pow Wow Jazz.

When Russell was 11 years old, his father passed away, and he was sent to live with relatives in Blue Island, Illinois. His Uncle Bill and Aunt Mary taught him to play several instruments and encouraged him to study all types of music, which led to his love of jazz and the trombone. At the age of 17, he ran away to Chicago, and according to Dr. Andrew Darling, an archeologist who has made an exhaustive study of Big Chief's life, lived on the street, often sleeping in a casket in a burned-out casket factory. One evening when he was standing outside the Sunset Café, he heard Armstrong for the first time.

Moving to Los Angeles, Russell worked with Lionel Hampton's big band in 1935 and then jobbed around the country with territorial bands, including one led by New Orleans trumpeter Oscar "Papa" Celestin.

He joined Armstrong's last big band in 1944 When the band appeared in the movie New Orleans with Billie Holiday, the only tuxedo the producers could find to fit the 250-pound trombonist was one belonging to the equally-rotund character actor, Sydney Greenstreet. On the Hello Dolly album that featured tunes from the movie, Armstrong can be heard saying, "Take it, Big Chief" as Russell soloed on his favorite tune, "Someday You'll Be Sorry."

After the Armstrong band broke up in 1947, Moore worked with some of the top jazz musicians of that period, was in the house band at Jimmy Ryan's, shared the stage with Charlie Parker and Miles Davis at the International Paris Jazz Festival in 1949, toured Europe, recorded with Sidney

Bechet, and performed at inaugural balls for Presidents Kennedy, Johnson and Nixon as well as at a wedding reception for Prince Charles and Diana.

He rejoined Armstrong in 1964, replacing Trummy Young, and did a world tour with the sextet.

Having lived the good life, his weight had ballooned to 350 and traveling became difficult, which led to his departure from the group. He settled in Nyack, New York with his wife and two children, led a Dixieland band, and played with the Lester Lanin Society Band. In 1982, he was honored as a "First American in the Arts" at the Kennedy Center and received the only standing ovation of the evening after playing his composition, Wounded Knee Chant.

During the last 25 years of his life, he devoted considerable time "for my people," saying "Almost all Indians have a natural musical talent. Every Indian school boy and school girl should think about the study of music. It is a way-of-life and a useful and productive one. Music is a source of revelation and a means of understanding one's self and one's fellow man." For several years, a free Russell Moore Music Fest was held at the Gila River Indian Community south of Phoenix.

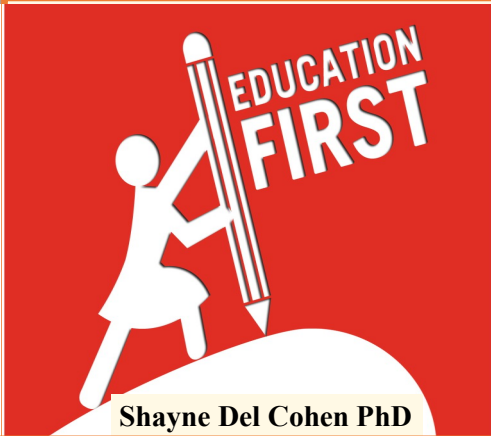

My “Journal” ([shaynedel.com](http://shaynedel.com)) was rooted in the tribal library, archives and museum movement. That initiative was - and is - rooted in an impetus to save, retain, and share valuable tribal knowledge as well as to provide tribal communities with the best access to the same from other tribal, non-tribal, and emergent cultures and knowledge

The internet created a now quarter-century revolution in how information is accessed, stored and shared. The volume and value pf Indigenous knowledge is not a secret and is venerated in many circles but not in others. The technology of the times has facilitated the ability of tribes to participate in many forms of education and communication; the politics of the times is putting a serious damper into this.

This column has discussed my con-

cerns about the recording of incorrect information in maps and other like documents as well as the constant need to review and correct (if needed) tomes and manuscripts containing dubious information. As in GPS and block chain systems, information is absorbed and combined with “mistakes” ..... which will be harder and harder to correct, particularly if there is no “techie whiz” who knows how to correct this.

Besides “mistakes” there are legitimate differences of opinion or interpretation of events. Sadly, we seem to be in a climate lacking encouragement of quality discourse or “two-source” reporting.

Actions of suppression are operative in many quiet corners. Below is a short extract from a program proposed by MoveOn in direct defiance of what is happening in Flor-

ida (and encouraged in other states). While there may be only one (*American*) “indian” book on the list, others are sure to follow.

*Florida Governor Ron DeSantis officially entered the 2024 presidential race, and we want to make sure that voters across the country know exactly who he is.*

*To achieve this, we want to create a "Banned Bookmobile," fill it with books that DeSantis has banned from schools in Florida, and drive it around the state handing those books out, for free, in highly trafficked areas that will attract media attention.*

*And if we have the funds, we'll take it on tour, following DeSantis to his campaign stops across the country, giving out banned books, hosting events with authors and advocates, and making sure the press covers it as much as possible."*

I would encourage every reader to create a “suggested reading list” that they feel essential for their children to be exposed to presenting tribal culture and heritage, legal and political histories for emergent leadership to absorb, and for their neighbors to learn and appreciate the wealth of knowledge “next door” to them.

Past this list, ensuring that such books/media are present in duplication in your library. Should you not have a library, archive or museum, a dedicated reading corner in Council Chambers, a clinic waiting room, etc., to say nothing of an on-line bibliography on your websites and social media.

And, of course, this Journal would be delighted to share your recommended list with the other readers. That is our “bookmobile”.

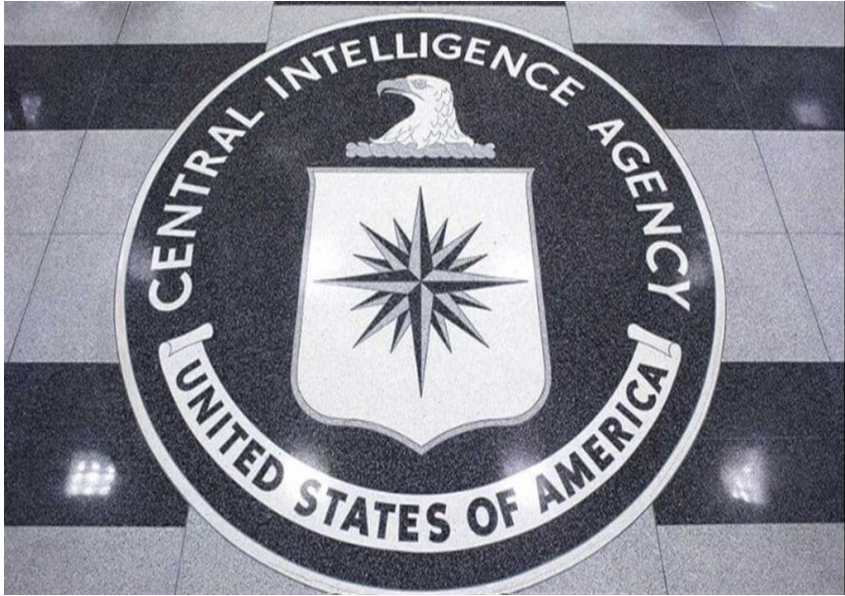

**CIA BUSTED – Dozens of  
women identified so far!**

At least two dozen women have come forward with complaints of sexual abuse at the CIA, with many alleging that the nation’s top spy agency has engaged in a campaign to prevent them from speaking out.

This week a CIA officer trainee who forced himself on a female colleague in a secluded stairwell was convicted in a Virginia court, an incident that led to more women who experienced similar treatment coming forward, a major public relations problem for yet another one of America’s toxic federal institutions.

“There are harassers everywhere and bosses that try to cover them up,” said a Washington, D.C. attorney who is representing some of the women who have filed complaints over their experiences.

“But the whole nature of intelligence work – the culture of secrecy and people working under assumed names – really elevates the chilling effect of retaliation and isolation that victims feel,” Kristin Alden said.

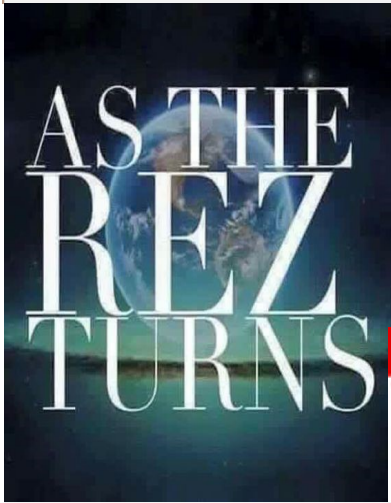

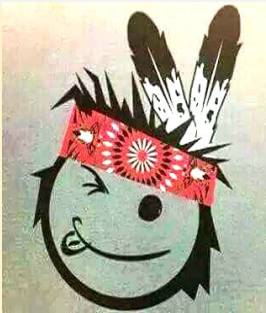
