N. Scott Momaday (Kiowa) February 27, 1934 * January 24, 2024 Inspired Native Americans to 'write our own stories' “A World Famous Rez Kid”

Literary giant and Oklahoma native N. Scott Momaday died Wednesday, Jan. 24 at his home in Santa Fe, New Mexico, publisher HarperCollins announced.

He was 89. (A month short of his 90th birthday)

A member of the Kiowa Tribe of Oklahoma, Momaday was the first Native American writer to win the **Pulitzer Prize for Fiction**. He earned the prestigious prize in 1969 with his novel “House Made of Dawn,” regarded as a breakthrough work in contemporary Native American literature.

“Throughout his life, N. Scott Momaday stayed closely connected to his Kiowa ancestry and sought to bring a sense of connection and understanding between that world and the world of his white brethren,” said Oklahoma Historical Society Executive Director Trait Thompson in an email to The Oklahoman.

“Using his amazing gift of storytelling, he brought to life the struggles of Native people across the country, made all the more real by his experiences growing up on reservations in New Mexico and Arizona.”

“I want the Indian to remain an Indian and appreciate what that means. We are living in a time when identity is critical. We talk about an identity crisis — and everybody seems to have it — but the Indian in a special way has had an identity crisis from the time of contact,” Momaday told The Oklahoman in a 2012 interview.

“That’s really the problem. ‘How do I enter the modern world but remain my Indian self?’ ... One does that by identifying himself, by defining himself and not allowing himself to be defined.”

TRIBES SUE BIDEN ADMINISTRATION OVER PERMITS FOR HIGH-VOLTAGE TRANSMISSION LINE



Two Native American tribes and the Center for Biological Diversity sued the Biden administration over a high-voltage transmission plan they say violates federal laws protecting cultural sites.

In the lawsuit, the **San Carlos Apache Tribe** and the **Tohono O’odham Nation** called for Bureau of Land Management (BLM) approvals of permits for the SunZia high-voltage transmission line to be thrown out.

The plaintiffs filed the suit over the approvals issued last year in the U.S. District Court for the District of Arizona.

The tribes, joined by the Center and Archaeology Southwest, claimed the Interior Department issued the Limited Notices to Proceed for the transmission line in violation of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and the Administrative Procedure Act. They allege the bureau did not properly analyze the SunZia project’s effects on sites of historic and cultural significance to the tribe, nor did they consult with tribal communities.

Bill Aims to Make Social Security Benefits Tax-Free

For many retirees, Uncle Sam gives with one hand and takes away with the other. But that could soon change. A bill introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives would exclude Social Security benefits from being classified as federally taxable income starting in 2025.

These 11 states will continued to tax Social Security benefits in 2023 and are expected to do the same in 2024: Colorado, Connecticut, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Rhode Island, Utah and Vermont.



John Fetterman and Joe Manchin decline to back resolution supporting a 2-state solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict

- Sen. Brian Schatz is sponsoring an amendment affirming support for a two state solution in Israel.

- Just two Democratic senators didn't sign on: John Fetterman and Joe Manchin.

- A spokesman for Fetterman said the resolution *should “include language stipulating the destruction of Hamas”*

On Wednesday, (Jan. 24, 2024) Democratic Sen. Brian Schatz of Hawaii released an amendment to a forthcoming

national security bill that affirms US support for a two-state solution to the Israel-Palestine conflict.

In a rare show of unity on the issue — which has increasingly become a source of division within the Democratic Party — nearly every single Democratic senator signed onto the amendment.

The only two who did not were Sens. John Fetterman of Pennsylvania and Joe Manchin of West Virginia.

On July 21st, 1979 Jay Silverheels, became the first Indigenous Native to have a star commemorated on the on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. Harold Jay Smith, was a full-blooded Mohawk, born May 26, 1912 on the Six Nations Indian Reservation in Ontario, Canada. He excelled in athletics, most notably in lacrosse. In 1931 he was among the first players chosen to play for the Toronto Tecumsehs, where he earned the nickname "Silverheels". And in 1997 he was inducted into the Canadian Lacrosse Hall of Fame as a veteran player. In 1938, he placed second in the middleweight class of the Golden Gloves tournament. This led to his working in motion pictures as an extra and stuntman in 1937.

Billed variously as Harold Smith and Harry Smith, before taking the name Jay Silverheels. He appeared in low-budget features, mostly Westerns, and serials before landing his much loved and iconic role as Tonto on national TV from 1949 until 1957 along with two movies. In the early 1960s, he was a founding member of the Indian Actors Workshop, in Echo Park, Los Angeles. Where Native actors refine their skills. Today the workshop is still a well established institution. Silverheels died on March 5, 1980, from stroke, at age 67, in Calabasas, California. He was cremated at Chapel of the Pines Crematory, and his ashes were returned to the Six Nations Reserve in Ontario.

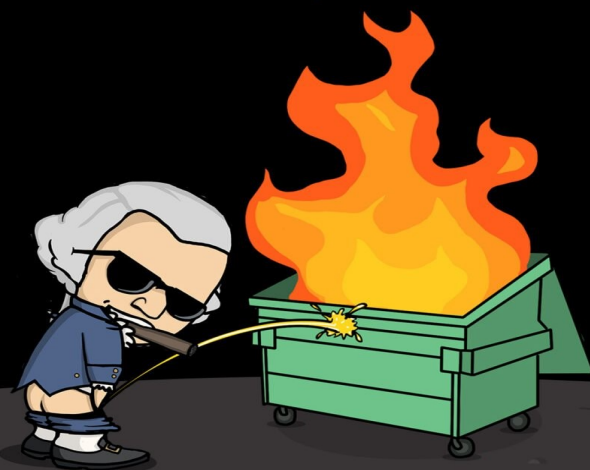

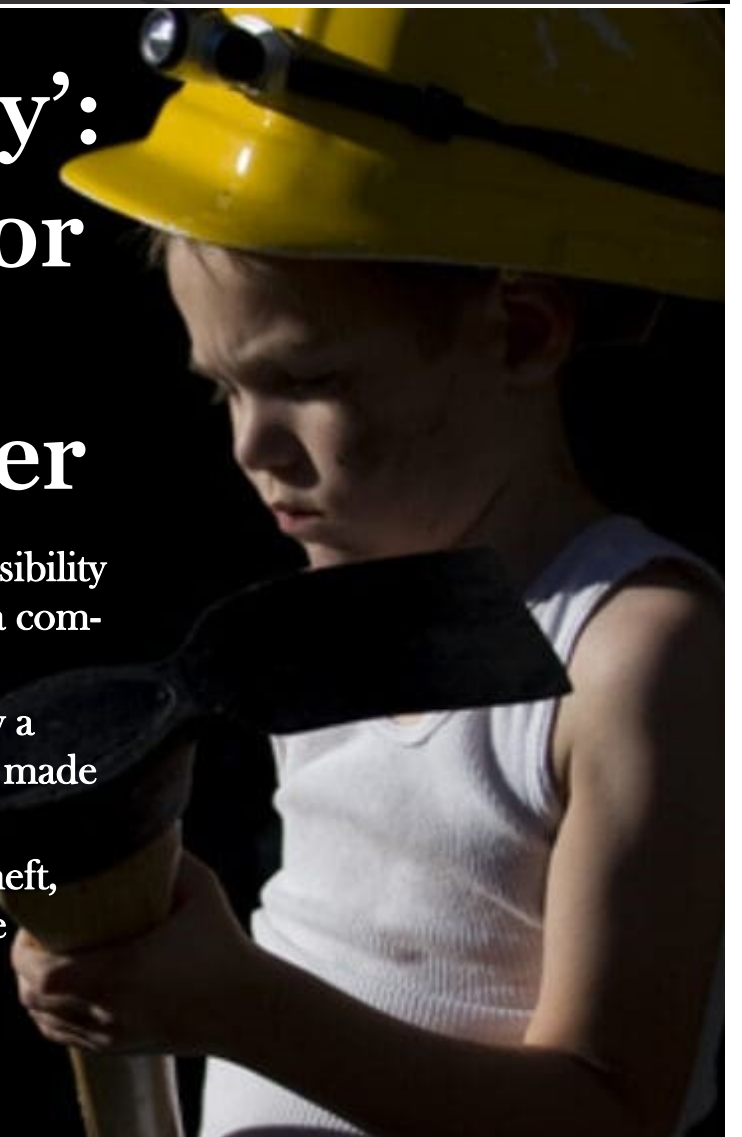
‘He’ll be your boss one day’: Commies decry child labor in America’ at sight of young kid behind a register

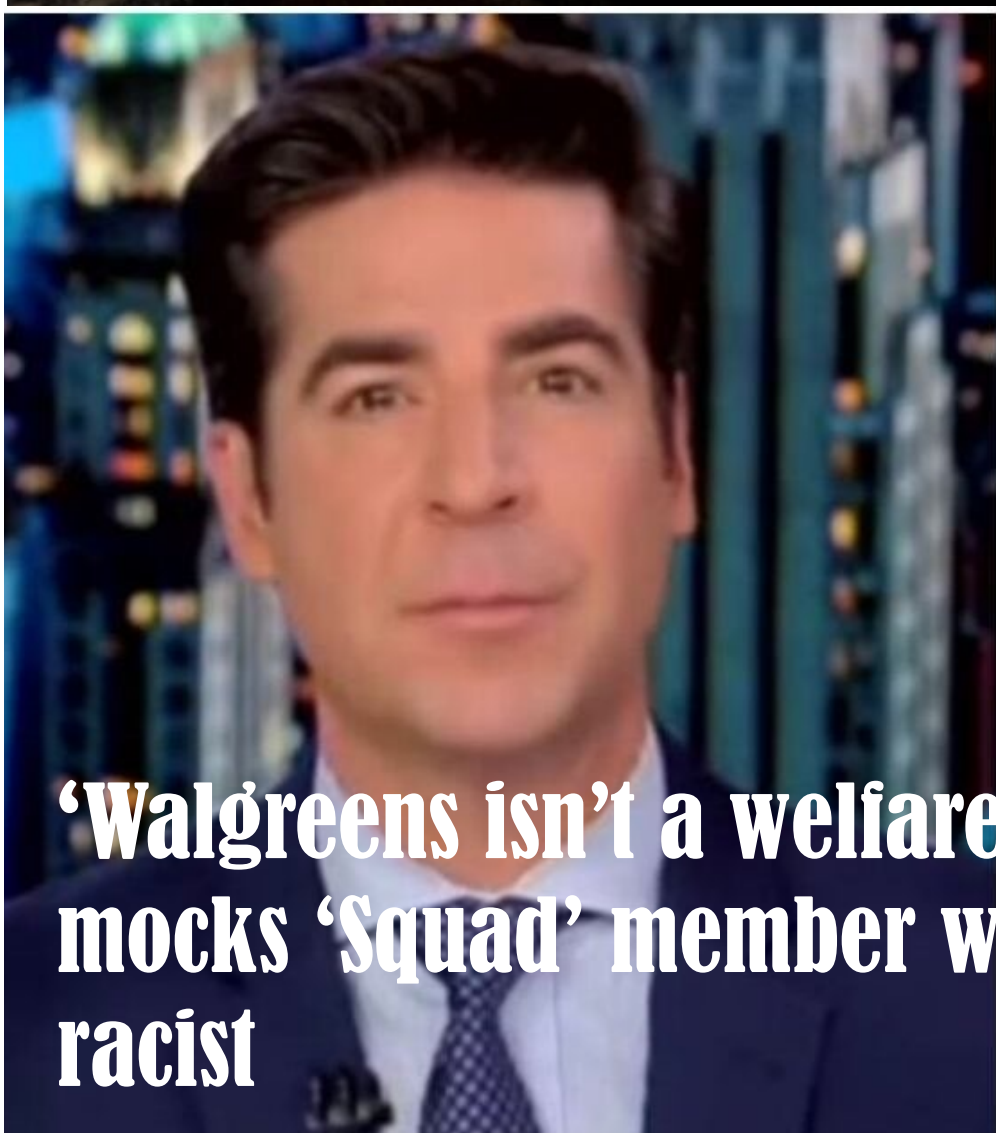

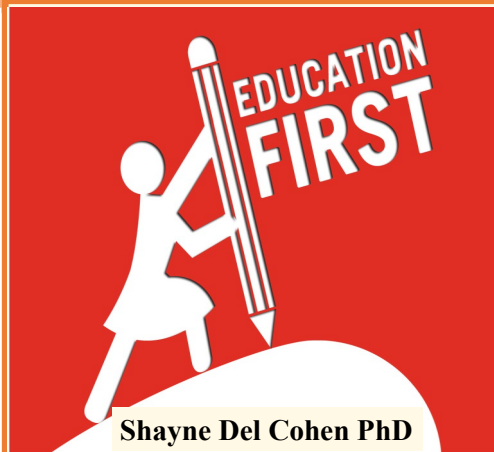

"The Age of Information" Where are the workers?



As mentioned in the previous column, in addition to the availability of "substitutes" for the nation's classrooms, there is a national worker shortage.

Since the 2000 dawn of the Age of Information, the need to redefine "labor" is omnipresent.

For centuries, labor was basically provided by slaves - persons who did all the physical activities required to complete tasks enhancing the owner's lifestyle. From household chores to building roads and edifices, slavery was a major construct of social and economic life throughout the world.

With "The Age of Industrialization", machinery began to displace areas of human labor. From the cotton gin and steam engine to the invention of refrigerators, vacuum cleaners, and so many other wonders, such as plumbing systems, electric lights and cars, traditional roles began to dissipate. The US (and other countries) had major economic

upsets (ie Civil War) as person power was supplanted by labor-saving machinery.

One result was the "Labor Movement" where old guilds and new associations asserted rights to working and living conditions, compensation for time performing a function, a place at the bargaining table, etc. for their compatriots.

We are now a quarter of a century into "The Age of Information". Where are the workers? One reads of layoffs, but many industries are stymied with "talent" shortages.

Healthcare, renewable energy, tourism/gaming cannot be filled with traditional workforce because traditional workforce planning and training no longer fits the new work models.

Not only simple "computerization" but Artificial Intelligence is the tool of the epoch. Just as any "invention", ie from fire to printing,

has good and bad, to say nothing of unintended consequences, it is here and aspires to get more and more done.

Workplace demographics have also shifted. "Millennials" tend to have different values and expectations (and, dare I say, worries) different than those of their labor generation parents and grandparents. They are "digital natives" whilst some of us are technological Luddites.

Skill sets for jobs have changed. (An undocumented statistic says skill sets have changed 25% since 2015 and this stat is expected to double by 2027.)

There is no "time off" for learning... we constantly have to learn on the job to adapt to new software and automation to get a set of responsibilities done.

One futurist says, "*The workplace of the future is a human-centered, tech-enabled experience that thrives*

on automating, innovating and creating a culture of belonging."

The last word, belonging, is the key.

It inherently implies there will be no generation gap within an office or organization. Does your human resource personnel recognize this? What are you doing to enhance the understanding and ability of older staff to deal with these new tools while instilling community values and practices into the younger generations? Leadership must reflect innovation and inclusion.....a challenge.

Hopefully you are taking a look at the broad spectrum of your tribal community for the next decade, evaluating the Community needs for service personnel and the kind of skills needed, as well as analyzing the markets around your area to determine industry/talent needs so that community members may find credible employment beyond the community.

DEADLY DAYS

Today is International Holocaust Remembrance Day, which falls on the day the Nazi death camp at Auschwitz was liberated. Auschwitz was just one of more than 850 camps, but it was the largest.

Today is International Holocaust Remembrance



LIBERATION

The children in the photo were liberated from the camp in 1945 by Russian forces. It is estimated about 230,000 children were deported to Auschwitz and only 700 were liberated.

60,000 prisoners were marched out of the camp as Russian troops approached, leaving about 2,000 nearly dead adults and some children behind.

Auschwitz had a staff of about 5,500, and close to 12% (789) were brought to trial in Poland. There were 673 prosecutions, 23 resulting in executions.

Auschwitz was preserved as a museum beginning in 1947.

CAMPS BY AREA IN WORLD WAR II EUROPE

The first Nazi concentration camp was Dachau, in southern Germany. It was built in 1933 just after the Nazi Party rose to power and its political opponents, homosexuals, Jehovah's Witnesses and those classified as "dangerous" were imprisoned there.

Most of the camps shown in the map at right were forced labor camps near industrial plants.

It is estimated that more than 9 million people were killed in the camps while the Nazis were in power. By the end of the war, there were 20 main concentration camps and six extermination camps, with Auschwitz being the most deadly.



AUSCHWITZ CONCENTRATION CAMP

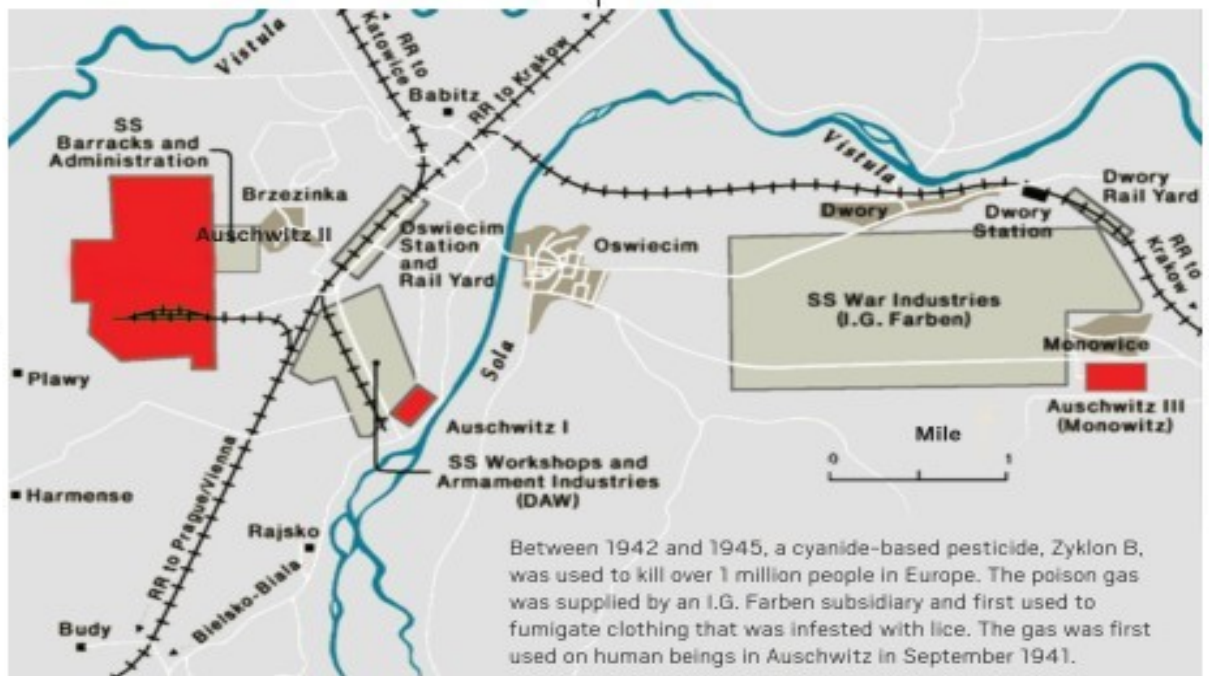
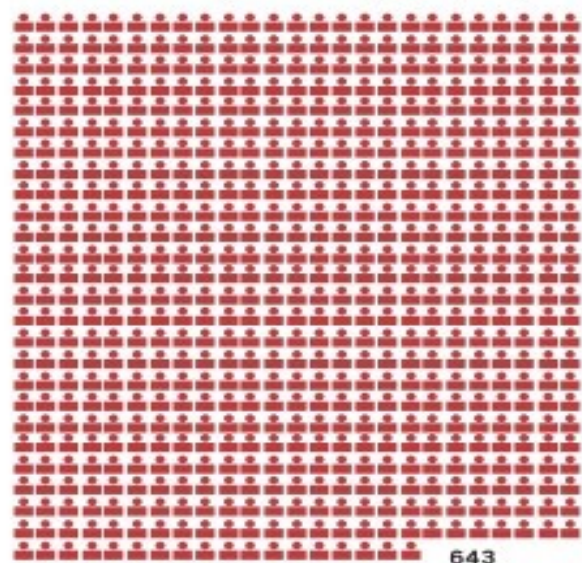
Auschwitz was the largest camp established by the Germans. It actually was a series of camps, including concentration, extermination and forced-labor camps.

Auschwitz I The main and first camp established.

Auschwitz II (Birkenau) was the killing center at Auschwitz. Trains arrived at Auschwitz-Birkenau almost daily with transports from every German-occupied country in Europe.

Auschwitz III Established to provide forced laborers for nearby factories.

The Auschwitz camps were open from May 1940 to January 1945 with an estimated 1.1 million people killed during that time. That's an average of this many people per day:



DEATH TOLL

At least 1.1 million Jews were killed in Auschwitz. Other victims included 70,000 to 75,000 Poles, 21,000 Roma (Gypsies) and about 15,000 Soviet prisoners of war.

THE LAST EXECUTION

Rudolf Hoess, an SS officer, was the commander of Auschwitz. He perfected gassing methods and confessed to murdering more than 1 million people. He was sentenced to death in Poland, although Poland had abandoned the death penalty. He was the last person to be executed in the nation. He was hanged at Auschwitz on a short-drop gallows near the camp's Gestapo on April 16, 1947.
