INDIAN CITIZENSHIP ACT OF 1924

June 2, 2024 will mark the 100th Anniversary of U.S. citizenship for the American Indian people.

The Indian Citizenship Act of 1924, (43 Stat. 253, enacted June 2, 1924) was an Act of the United States Congress that granted U.S. citizenship to the indigenous peoples of the United States.

While the Fourteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution defines a citizen as any persons born in the United States and subject to its laws and jurisdiction, the amendment had previously been interpreted by the courts not to apply to Native peoples.

The act was proposed by U.S. Representative Homer P. Snyder (R-NY), and signed into law by President Calvin Coolidge on June 2, 1924. It was enacted partially in recognition of the thousands of Native Americans who served in the armed forces during the First World War.

Even Native Americans who were granted citizenship rights under the 1924 Act may not have had full citizenship and suffrage rights until 1948 because the right to vote was governed by state law. According to a survey by the Department of Interior, seven states still refused to grant Indians voting rights in 1938. Discrepancies between federal and state control provided loopholes in the Act's enforcement.

States justified discrimination based on state statutes and constitutions. Three main arguments for Indian voting exclusion were Indian exemption from real estate taxes, maintenance of tribal affiliation, and the notion that Indians

The text of the 1924 Indian Citizenship Act reads as follows:

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That all non citizen Indians born within the territorial limits of the United States be, and they are hereby, declared to be citizens of the United States: Provided That the granting of such citizenship shall not in any manner impair or otherwise affect the right of any Indian to tribal or other property.

were under guardianship or lived on lands controlled by federal trusteeship.

By 1947, all states with large Indian populations, except Arizona and New Mexico, had extended voting rights to Native Americans who qualified under the 1924 Act.

Finally, in 1948, the states withdrew their prohibition on Indian voting because of a judicial decision.

DEBATE

Although some white citizen groups were supportive of Indian citizenship, Native Americans themselves were divided on the debate. Those who supported it considered the Act a way to secure a long-standing political identity.

Those who rejected it were concerned about tribal sovereignty and citizenship. Many leaders in the Native American community at the time, like Charles Santee, a Santee Sioux, were interested in Native American integration into the

larger society but adamant about preserving the Native American identity. Many were also reluctant to trust the government that had taken their land and discriminated so violently against them.

The irony is that for 50-years, from 1924 to 1975-76 the Government had a “Termination Policy” designed to end the existence of the American Indian people since the practice of “genocide” had failed and was no longer politically acceptable.

However, the Government was not without other alterities such as the establishment of Blood Quantum's as the criteria for Federal Recognition as an American Indian. Many tribe viewed this as “Political Genocide” but were powerless against the Government and the Tribes that supported it.

However, this all changed with the passage of P.L. 93-638 the Indian Self Determination and Education Act on 1975–76 which allow the tribes to establish their own membership criteria and many other things.

Now, the supreme court with a majority of anti-Tribal Justice's will be ruling on a case that challenges the relationship between the tribes and Government as racial not political.

Given the anti-Indian voting record of the current court the “Indian Termination Policy” may have reached its goal.

However, my view is that had the issue of “Race” and/or the “Political Relationship between the American Indian Tribes and the United States Government, which is in reality one issue, been included in the courts decision Roberts and Kavanaugh would have sided with Thomas and Alito. Hopefully Barrett will side with the Tribes in Maverick Gaming LLC.


What is the justification today?



American Indians were not citizens until June 2, 1924. And even then many were not allowed to vote in many States until the early 50's.

Even to this day tribal leaders must gain permission from the Government to use their tribal lands.

Government Control of the Indian Reservation prevents prosperity and maintains the dependency.



Manifest Destiny

"The Justification for the Genocide and Annexation of Indian Land"

Manifest Destiny had devastating and fatal consequences for the Native Americans, since continental expansion implicitly meant the occupation and annexation of Native American land, sometimes to expand slavery and the Government supported murdering of the Native people.

This ultimately led to armed confrontations with many of the tribal groups of native peoples and the systematic killing and removal of Indian people from their home lands.

The United States continues to this day, the practice of recognizing only limited land rights of indigenous peoples.

In a policy formulated by Henry Knox, the Secretary of War, to expand into the west through the taking of Native American land by purchase, treaties or force.

The Federal Government was the only one allowed to purchase Indian lands, the individual States were excluded. And the majority of the Treaties were never honored.

The national policy was for the Indians to join American society with the intent for them to become "civilized", which meant no more wars with neighboring tribes or raids on white settlers or travelers and a shift from hunting to farming and ranching.

Advocates of the American Indian civilization programs believed that the process of settling native tribes would greatly reduce the amount of land needed by the Indian

tribes resulting in making more land available for homesteading by white Americans.

Thomas Jefferson believed that while American Indians were the intellectual equals of whites, they had to live like the whites or inevitably be pushed aside by them.

Jefferson's belief, rooted in Enlightenment thinking, that whites and Native Americans would merge to create a single nation did not last and he began to believe that the natives should emigrate across the Mississippi River and maintain a separate society, an idea made possible by the Louisiana Purchase of 1803.

In the age of manifest destiny, this idea, which came to be known as "**Indian removal**", gained ground.

Humanitarian advocates of removal believed that American Indians would be better off moving away from whites.

Historian Reginald Horsman argued in his influential study **Race and Manifest Destiny**, racial rhetoric increased during the era of manifest destiny.

White Americans increasingly believed that Native American ways of life would "**fade away**" as the United States expanded. As an example, this idea was reflected in the work of one of America's first great historians, Francis Parkman, whose landmark book **The Conspiracy of Pontiac** was published in 1851.

Parkman wrote that after the British conquest of Canada in 1760, Indians were

"destined to melt and vanish before the advancing waves of Anglo-American power, which now rolled westward unchecked and unopposed". Parkman emphasized that the collapse of Indian power in the late 18th century had been swift and was a past event.

The termination of the Indian culture, language and religion was the policy of the U.S. Government.

In an effort to accomplish the "**Indian Termination Policy**" children were forced from their homes and placed in government run boarding schools across the Nation where they were forced to learn the "**White Ways**." The government still continues to operate many of these schools today.

The "**Indian Termination Policy**" was ended by President Richard M. Nixon's Indian Self-Determination Act 1975. However, the American Indian Tribes continue to be under legal challenges to their Treaty Rights to existence in a Government to Government relationship with the U.S. Government. The relationship has been recognized as "Political" and not "Racial".

Ben Nighthorse Campbell


The National Native American Veterans Memorial opened its doors to the public on Veterans Day in 2020. This museum honors the contributions of the Indigenous community and would not have been erected without the support of former Colorado senator Ben Nighthorse Campbell. When Campbell was elected in 1992, he was the first Indigenous American to serve in the Senate in over 60 years and the only Indigenous American in Congress. Beside being a former congressman and a member of the Northern Cheyenne tribe, Campbell is a Korean War vet, former Olympian, rancher, and jewelry designer.

Charles Curtis (January 25, 1860 – February 8, 1936) was A member of the Kaw Nation in Kansas. He served as the Senate Majority Leader from 1924 to 1929. Curtis served as the 31st vice president of the United States from 1929 to 1933 under Herbert Hoover.

Currently, Markwayne Mullin an enrolled member of the Cherokee Nation is serving as the U.S. Senator for Oklahoma. All three belong to the Republican Party.



Unearthed 14,000-Year-Old Settlement May Require Revising History Of North America Recent



Oral stories hold significant historic value as they represent a unique and invaluable means of preserving and transmitting cultural, historical, and social knowledge from one generation to the next. But just how much credence should we put into oral stories? Without a written record, how can their information be authenticated?

While the members of the Heiltsuk Nation rejoiced at the archaeological findings, scholars were forced to take another look at the accepted theory of how humans arrived in North America. But if they didn't come to Canada via the Bering Land Bridge, how did modern humans travel to North America?

A team of archaeologists from the Hakai Institute, led by Alisha Gauvreau, conducted a dig on Triquet Island, located along the coast of British Columbia.

Gauvreau and her team uncovered fish hooks, spears, carved wooden tools, and flakes of charcoal. Amazingly, these artifacts date back to before the last ice age.

The evidence was undeniable. Gauvreau and her colleagues found proof of an ancient village ... the oldest known settlement in Canada and proof that the stories in the Heiltsuk Nation's oral traditions are accurate. Housty said, "Now we don't just have oral history, we have this archaeological information."

Gauvreau and her team think they know the answer to that question. *"The alternative theory, which is supported by our data as well as evidence that has come from stone tools and other carbon dating, is that people were capable of traveling by boat,"* she explained.

Senate confirms Sara Hill as a federal judge

WASHINGTON — The U.S. Senate on Tuesday confirmed the first Native American woman to serve as a federal judge for the state of Oklahoma, despite some Republicans' protest of her work as the top prosecutor for the Cherokee Nation.

Sara E. Hill, the Cherokee Nation's former attorney general, was confirmed as a U.S. District judge for the Northern District of Oklahoma in a 52-14 vote, joining just a handful of Native Americans appointed to lifetime judicial positions in U.S. history.

"When she served for the Cherokee Nation, obviously she had a perspective. She was the voice for the Cherokee Nation.



She's gonna speak for the Cherokee Nation," Lankford said.

We Are Well Beyond Hypocrisy

The abject narcissism of the insular Left is startling. They apparently believe the American public is amnesiac enough to forget what leftists once did, now that they're doing the utter opposite. And they assume we are to discount their hypocrisy and self-absorption simply because they self-identify as erudite and moral and assume their opponents are irredeemable and deplorable.

Impeachment

The Left is saturating the airwaves with outrage over the current House Republicans' impeachment inquiry. They allege that formally investigating Joe Biden's role in the family grifting operation is somehow a poor constitutional precedent, if not out-of-bounds entirely.

So we hear further arguments that it will be unwise to impeach a first-term president when he loses his House majority, that there is no reason to "waste" congressional time and effort when Biden will be automatically acquitted in the Democratically controlled Senate, and that the impeachment is cynically timed to

synchronize with president's reelection efforts.

All of these are the precise arguments many of us cited when Donald Trump was impeached in December 2019 (as his reelection campaign began, and immediately after being cleared of the 22-month, \$40-million-special-counsel Russian-collusion hoax).

The Democrats tried to remove an elected president over a phone call without a special counsel's report. So Trump was impeached only after the 2018 election led to a Democratic House majority, which went from eating up nearly two years of his administration in the Russian-collusion hoax straight into the impeachment farce. **There was no concern about the cost to the nation of putting an elected government into a continual state of siege.**

There is one difference, though, between the Trump impeachment and the Biden impeachment inquiry. Donald Trump was impeached because he accurately accused the members of the Ukrainian

government of paying Hunter Biden, with his zero fossil fuel expertise, an astronomical sum to serve on the Burisma board—as the costly quid that earned the lucrative quo from his dad Vice President Joe Biden.

No one now denies that Joe Biden got prosecutor Viktor Shokin fired by threatening to cancel legislatively-approved U.S. aid. Shokin knew about the skullduggery through which the Biden family eventually received \$6.5 million from Ukraine—and so Biden ensured his firing, and publicly bragged about it in performance-art fashion.

In sum, Trump had a perfect right as commander in chief to delay (he did not cancel) aid to Ukraine, to ensure that its government was not still paying off the Bidens for their lobbying efforts on its behalf.

It is also now clear that Biden serially lied about his ignorance of Hunter's shake-down operation. In fact, he was, as Devon Archer emphasized, **"the brand"** central to



Hunter's scheme to coerce money from foreign governments. Joe was proverbially, in Hunter's words *"the man sitting next to me"* and thus able to either punish or reward foreign interests, depending on the size of the checks they wrote to his various fronting family members.





Saul Alinsky’s “8-steps to Create a Socialist State”
