



Willie Mays describing when, as a 17-year-old, faced Satchel Paige for the first time:

"It was 1948. Satchel had a very, very good fastball... but he threw me a little breaking ball, just to see what I could do, and I hit it off the top of the fence. I got a double. When I got to second, Satchel told the third baseman, 'Let me know when that little boy comes back up.'

Three innings later, I go to kneel down in the on-deck circle, and I hear the third baseman say, 'There he is.' Satch looked at the third baseman, and then he looked at me.

I walk halfway to home plate and he says, "Little boy.' I say, **Yes, sir?** because Satch was much older than I am, so I was trying to show respect.

He walked halfway to home plate and said, *Little boy, I'm* not going to trick you. I'm going to throw you three fast**balls and you're going to go sit down'** and I'm saying in my mind, 'I DOOON'T THINK SOOO.' If he threw me three of the same pitch, I'm going to hit it somewhere.

He threw me two fastballs and I just swung...I swung right through it.. and the third ball he threw, and I tell people this all the time, he threw the ball and as he let go he said, 'Go sit down.' This is while the ball was in the air. Yes, he struck me out with three pitches.





Joe Biden's 'sex' agenda crashes and burns for third time

Judge blocks attempt to erase biological women

For the third time in just recent weeks, Joe Biden's "sex" agenda has crashed and burned when it has faced a federal judge.

The newest rejection of his rewrite to the decades-old Title IX law that changes the definition of "sex" to "gender identity" or ideology, comes from a judge in Kentucky who, in his preliminary injunction, protected women in Ohio, Kentucky, Tennessee, Indiana, Virginia and West Virginia.

Biden's Department of Education has redefined "sex" from the 1972 law to include all sorts of alternative sexual ideologies, insisting that's what Congress meant when it approved a ban on discrimination against men or women in school activities at the time.

Biden's rules would force biological women to share private spaces, like showers and locker rooms, with gender-confused biological males.

"The radical rewrite of Title IX regulations eradicates privacy, safety, and fairness for biological women and girls. The lawsuits against forcing gender ideology in education have merit and the Biden administration's obsession with erasing women must stop," explained Liberty Counsel chief Mat Staver. Just days ago, a Louisiana judge granted a similar injunction for the states of Louisiana, Mississippi, Montana and Idaho, and a Texas judge ruled for his state earlier.







"Data governance remains an ongoing concern in Native communities. Almost all aspects of data about Indigenous people-from what is shared and where it is shared-are externally (i.e., non-Native) controlled, which often renders Indigenous peoples invisible from mainstream narratives.

This erasure has long resulted in inaccurate and usually stereotypic portrayals of Native Peoples hat mischaracterize them, justify their oppression, and ultimately deny them justice. A wagon train following the California Trail across Nevada during the 1860's. The Bartleson-Bidwell Party were the first wagon train to take the California Trail across Nevada in 1841. By 1869 there had been an estimated 450,000 people who had taken a covered wagon along the California Trail in Nevada. 




