During World War One an estimated 95% of the Nations Tribal adult males served in the military. Their gallant service was recognized since they were not American citizens they were not obligated to serve. This was the primary reason for the granting of American citizenship.

However, not all Tribal leaders supported granting of American citizenship for many reasons of which the

Many Tribal Leaders opposed "The Indian Citizen Act" for a number of reason but the most prevalent was the fear of loosing their cultural identity. Another reason was that the bill disregarded previous treaties between the Indian Tribes and the United States, specifically the 1784 Treaty of Fort Stanwix, the 1789 Treaty of Fort Harmor, and the 1794 Treaty of Canandaigua. Others were reluctant to trust the government that had taken their land and discriminated so violently against them.

Other groups Tribal Leaders supported American citizenship because of the "guardianship" stabeing taken advantage of by non-indigenous the Bureau as a threat to their authority. Americans for their land. They advocated that the government had an obligation to supervise and protect Native citizens.

Indian Citizenship Act

The Indian Citizenship Act of 1924 declared: all non citizen Indians born within the territorial limits of the United States be, and they are hereby, declared to be citizens of the United States.

Due to a new emissions reduction program, gas prices in California are predicted to increase by 50 cents (40p) per gallon.

The forecast suggests a rise of 47 cents per gallon in 2025 and 52 cents in 2026, not accounting for the 58 cents per gallon existing gas tax in the state.

A white Buffalo has been born 4/25/24 in Kansas. For those who don't know the prophecy of the White Buffalo Woman, it is the most significant prophecy of the Lakota people, others like Comanche and Navajo also see it as a sign of things changing in the world and better times coming. Even the National Bison Association says that it is indeed a rare event, about 1 in ten million chance.

A symbol of Hope, and honoring that which is sacred, this is a reminder to Pray and remember your relationship with the Creator, just as the White Buffalo Woman taught the Lakota people to pray with the 7 sacred ceremonies over 19 generations ago. And if the prophecy is true, many major changes this year will lead us to a better relationship with the Earth, with each other and with the Great Spirit in the sky!!





On May 13, 2024, the California Tribal College Board of Regents voted Dr. Juliet Maestas to serve as the next President of the California Tribal College. Dr. Maestas is a member of the Hoopa Valley Tribe and a descendant of the Yurok Tribe. She received her Education Doctorate from California State University Sacramento. Her research includes Tribal Culture Endurance and Postsecondary Aspirations among Rural reservation California Native American high school students. She holds a Masters in higher education leadership from California State University Sacramento and a bachelor's degree in Native American studies from the University of California Davis. Congratulations and Welcome Dr. Maestas!

Over a dozen homes on the Navajo Nation now have electricity after Salt River Project crews helped connect them to power lines.

"The absence of roads, dust carried by the winds, and the adjustment to high altitude all contribute to the complex conditions," Alex Apodaca, a lineman at SRP, said in the release.

And if this isn't enough to shake your head in disbelief and discuss, the supreme court recently ruled that a 186 year old treaty did not provide for an adequate domestic water system for the Navajo people, because the court didn't view "Drinking water" as a basic need.

On June 2, 1924, the American Indian people were granted American citizenship. As you read this, you might think we, the Tribal folks would be celebrate 100 years as American citizens. However, although a great majority are proud of our citizenship its been a rocky road.

We can thank President Nixon for ending the "Indian Termination Policy & allowing the Tribes self-Governance." President Reagan for supporting Indian Gaming, the 184 Home Loan Program and Tribal Rights. And, President Trump for allowing American Indian Veterans to use the Veterans Home Loan program on the Reservations and approving tribal oil, gas and coal development.
