Another thing we all partake in as member of the human race in general is that we seem to spend a lot of precious time identifying and researching distant relatives regardless of how many generation in the past they may have achieved fame and/or fortune.

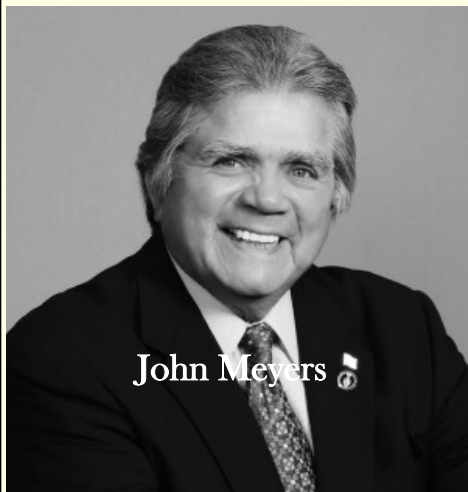
And in the absents of that we turn to those that we have associated with, met, seen in person or obtained an autograph or photo with them. Why we do this or why it matters in beyond my comprehension nor do I really care to know.

However, I find it interesting in knowing three people that I call friends that have famous family members that I what to share as I find them memorable. I present them in the order I became aware of them.

First is John Meyers. John is a tribal member of the Santa Rosa Band of Cahuilla Indians, So. California.

He is Ret. U.S. Army Colonel and lives in South Carolina. John and I attended elementary and high school together in San Jacinto, CA, and graduated in 1959.

He would tell me about his **"Uncle Jack,"** but I really didn't give it mush though.

However, years later I was reading a magazine and low and behold there was a full spread article on **John "Chief" Meyers** proclaiming him as one of the greatest major league baseball catchers.

The article centered on why he was-

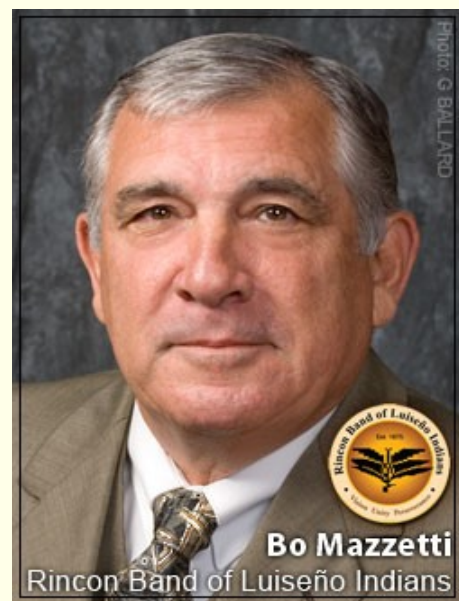

n't in the Baseball Hall of Fame. To be eligible for the Hall of Fame he had to have played 10-years in the major leagues and he only played 8-years. While still in his prime he joined the U.S. Marine Corp in 1917 during WW I and never returned to the majors.

He played on the early Giants teams under manager John McGraw and was the primary catcher for Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson. Meyers hit over .300 for three straight years as the Giants won three straight National League pennants from 1911 to 1913. .

He played in four World Series, the 1911, 1912, and 1913 Series with the Giants, as well as the 1916 Series with the Robins. Overall he was a catcher for the New York Giants, Boston Braves, and Brooklyn Robins from 1909 to 1917.



The second one is Bo Mazzetti. Bo is a tribal member of the Rincon Band of Luiseno Indians and is currently the Tribal Chairman.

He earned his BA degree at Cal Poly in Engineering. He is a U.S. Navy veteran and is a licensed building contractors and water well digger. He lives on the Rincon Indian Reservation.

Pedro "Pete" Calac (May 13, 1892 - January 30, 1968) **Bo's great uncle, his paternal grandmother's brother.** Pete Calac was also a tribal member of the Rincon Rez. Is said to be one of the greatest professional football players of all time.

On November 16, 1908 at the age of 15 Pedro "Pete" Calac left the Rincon Indian Reservation with only a third-grade education to the Carlisle Indian School located across the country in Carlisle, Pennsylvania.

He never returned to live on the Rez,, but did visit his family and friends,

Bo told the AIR that when he was a kid Pete was visiting and gave him an old leather football helmet that folded up. He said that over the years it got lost.

Pedro "Pete" Calac attended Carlisle Indian School prior to becoming a professional football player.

He played in the Ohio League and during the early years of the National Football League. Over the course of his 10-year career he played for

the Canton Bulldogs, Cleveland Indians, Washington Senators, Oorang Indians and the Buffalo Bisons.

At Carlisle, he played competitive football. In 1914 and 1915 and was captain of the football team.

Calac had never played football and had no knowledge of the game. As he recalled in Robert W. Wheeler's book, ***Jim Thorpe: World's Greatest Athlete.*** that the other players took an interest in him because of his large size. It was then that he met Jim Thorpe and soon became life long friends and would later play professional football with the Canton Bulldogs and the Oorang Indians.

World War One and the US Army: After finishing his studies at the Carlisle Indian School and West Virginia Wesleyan College, Pete returned to Rincon for a visit with his family and friends. While home in Rincon he enlisted in the U.S. Army.

He served with the 91st Division, known as the ***"Wild West Division,"*** in France and Belgium during World War I.

He was said to have returned from the war without a scratch. He later stated that ***"I guess I dug in too much".*** However, in article by the Professional Football Researchers Association, Calac was reported to have suffered career threatening wounds during the war but was back at the top of his game by 1922.

A Calac's Legacy: Grantland Rice, Dean of the American Sportswrit-



ers, once wrote, ***"I believe an All-American, All-Indian Football team could beat the All-Time Notre Dame Team, the All-Time Michigan Team, or the All-Time anything else. Take a look at a backfield like Jim Thorpe, Joe Guyon, Pete Calac and Frank Mount Pleasant***

And third is Geoff Herrin an enrolled citizen of the Cherokee Nation in Oklahoma. Geoff earned his BA degree from the University of San Diego at La Jolla, California in Bio-chemistry. He attended one year of medical school of which he later said was not for him.

He is a Certified Microsoft and Cisco Computer Technician and has worked for the Southern California Tribal Chairmen's Association, Inc.

(SCTCA) for the past 20 years.

Geoff's great aunt was married to Micky Mantle who needs no introduction or over view of his achievements with the New York Yankees. Although Mantle was not an American Indian he was still Geoff's great uncle.



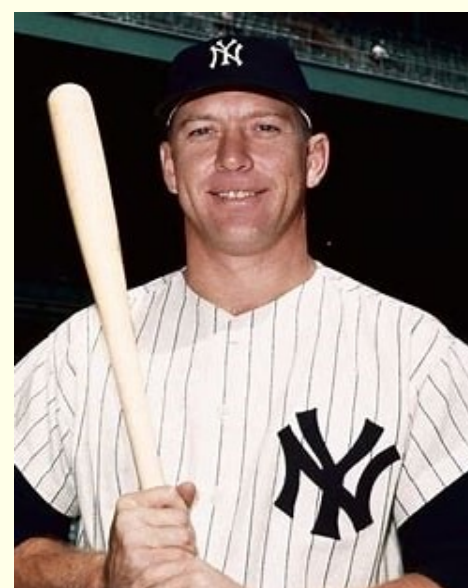

Mantle played his entire Major League Baseball (MLB) career (1951-1968) with the New York Yankees, primarily as a center fielder. Mantle is regarded by many as being one of the best players and sluggers of all time.

As a rookie he was predicted to be a combinations of Babe Ruth and Joe DiMaggio, which was more in jest but he came close.

He was voted the American League (AL) Most Valuable Player three times and was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1974.

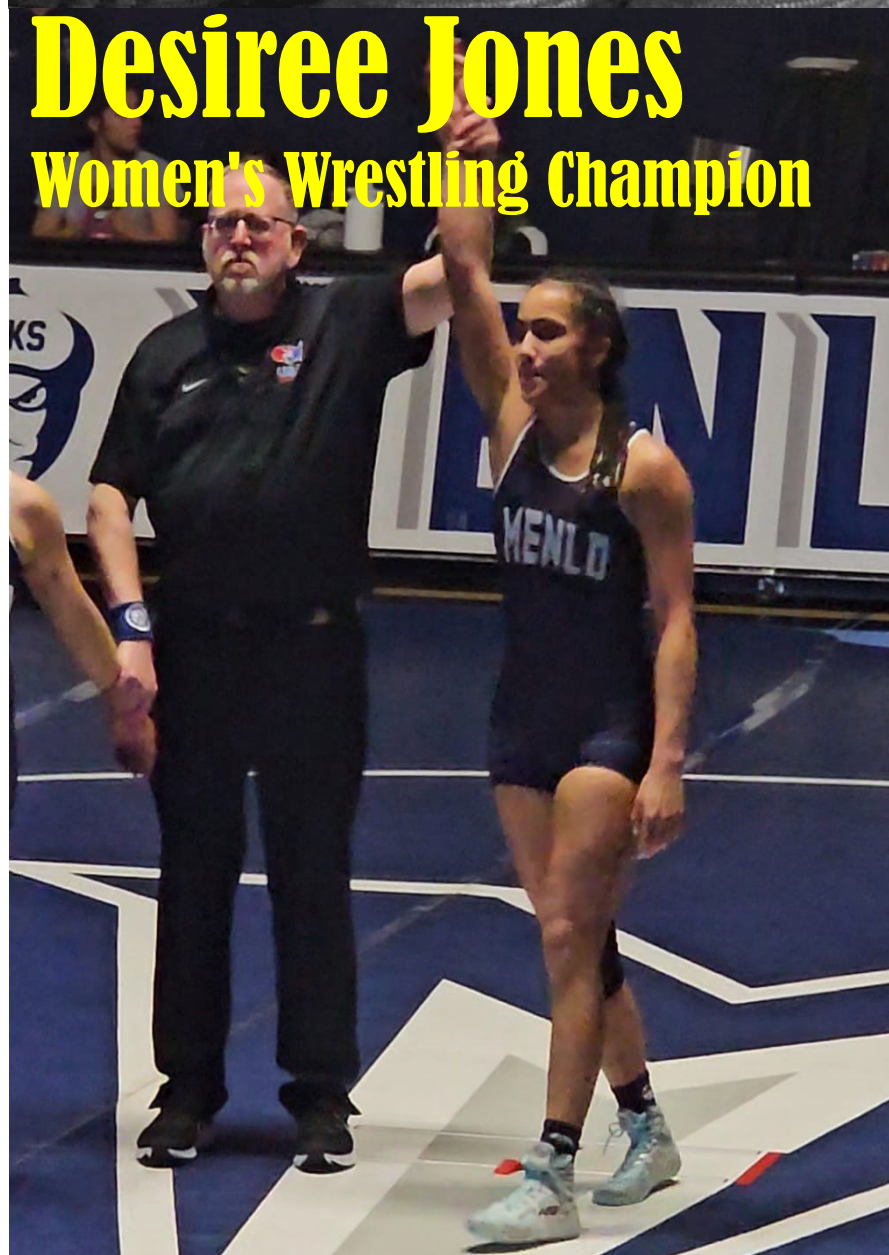

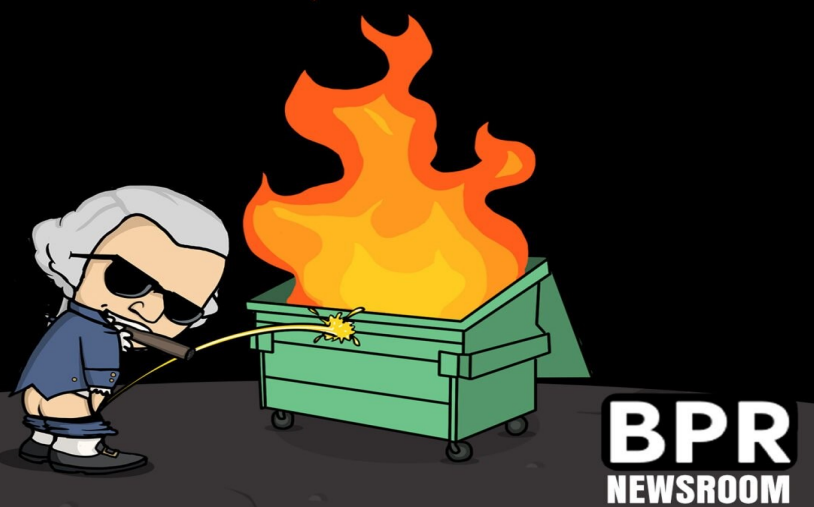

Ramos announces 2024 bill package

SACRAMENTO— Assemblymember James C. Ramos (D-Highland) announced his 2024 bill package that deals with issues ranging from public safety to youth homelessness to education to mental health services.

Ramos stated, *“My legislative bill package tackles a range of issues important to the state as well as my constituents. As I enter my sixth year in the Assembly, I plan to continue the fight to address youth homelessness, mental health issues, retail theft, as well as the continuing crisis and tragedy of Missing and Murdered Indigenous People. We have a lot of work ahead of us to get these bills to the Governor, and I look forward to a productive session this year.”*

Ramos’s bill package includes:

AB 1772 would tackle retail theft and would require jail time from one year to three years for perpetrators convicted of a third misdemeanor for petty theft under the state’s \$950 limit. San Bernardino County Sheriff Shannon Dicus and San Diego District Attorney Sumer Stephan are co-sponsors of the bill.

AB 1821 would require California public schools to teach the true history of the Spanish Mission and Gold Rush Eras and the impact of those periods on California Native Americans. **The bill is co-sponsored by San Manuel Band of Mission Indians and Soboba Band of Luiseno Indians.**

AB 1863 would make changes to the year-old Feather Alert based on suggestions from California’s tribes and law enforcement. The Feather Alert was created in 2022 through Ramos’s bill, AB 1314.

AB 2108, The Luke Madrigal Act would require notification to family members, court appointed counsel, tribes and tribal representatives and the court of jurisdiction when a child or non-minor dependent is missing from foster care. **The bill is co-sponsored by the Alliance for Children’s Rights, California Tribal Families Coalition and Yurok Tribe.**

AB 2138 would grant tribal police officers peace officer status, authorizing them to enforce state law outside of the tribal lands in certain circumstances. This bill bridges the divide between local law enforcement and tribal police in many parts of the state, while promoting public safety in many

tribal communities. **AB 2138 is sponsored by the Yurok Tribe.**

AB 2478 mandates all state local and state correctional facilities to share mental health records amongst each other when incarcerated individuals are transferred between facilities. This bill ensures that there is a continuation of care established during a transition and allows correctional facilities to be accurately informed about an incarcerated individual’s mental health. **San Bernardino County Sheriff Shannon Dicus is sponsoring the bill.**

AB 2520 would require Continuums of Care to include youth-specific entry points, assessment, and prioritization scores, and youth appropriate housing and services. The bill is sponsored by the California Coalition for Youth.

AB 2601 would require appliances being replaced by the Energy Saving Assistant Program to be electric-efficient.

AB 2614 would amend the state water law section that requires that the state’s water resources be put to the greatest beneficial use to include tribal cultural water uses. This bill would also require local state water agencies to include tribal beneficial uses of water for their enforcement of the law. **AB 2614 is sponsored by the Shingle Spring Band of Miwok Indians.**

AB 2711 would revise school suspension and expulsion policies for drug-related infractions by requiring Local Education Agencies to develop public health approaches to support students in lieu of suspensions and expulsions to address underlying needs to prevent substance abuse among students. The California Alliance of Child and Family Services, California Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, California Youth Empowerment Network and Children Now are sponsoring the bill.

AB 3008 would revise the “government salary exception” to include salary and benefits received from a Native American tribal government employer. The bill is sponsored by the Fair Political Practices Commission.

AB 2948 would allow tribal children adopted through tribal court to continue receiving Adoption Assistance Program payments.

AB 3015 would allow Native American students who are members of

Benjamin Pachito Attorney at Law, is an enrolled member of the Soboba Band of Luiseno Indian located in So. California. He is a member of the extended Mojado family on the Soboba, Pala, Pechanga, Rincon and Pala Indian Reservations.

Although he grew up in Florida and has reconnected with his tribal roots he is quickly learning how important family is within Indian Country. Hiles quote him in his article as saying "Every time I go back to Soboba, I seem to meet a new cousin," and is he in for a big surprise. Not a lot of Pachito’s but Mojado’s, Basquez’s, Barones’, Mesa’s, Arrietta’s, Modesto’s and Rhodes and all their extended families. Yes, the young man will be shaking a lot of hands.

He has one cousin that’s an up and coming actor, Robert Mesa who did a 2 or 3 year stint on Grey’s Anatomy.

His grandfather, Richard “Butch” Pachito a member of the Pauma of Luiseno Indians was the U.S. Army Heavyweight Boxing Champion at 5 ft 10in and 190 lbs, during the mid 50’s.

Many boxing experts believed that if he had half of Rocky Marciano’s power he could have been the worlds heavyweight champion because of his boxing skills.

I have yet to meet Ben, but based on his formal education and experience he appears to be on the fast track to a brilliant career.

Actress Irene Bedard

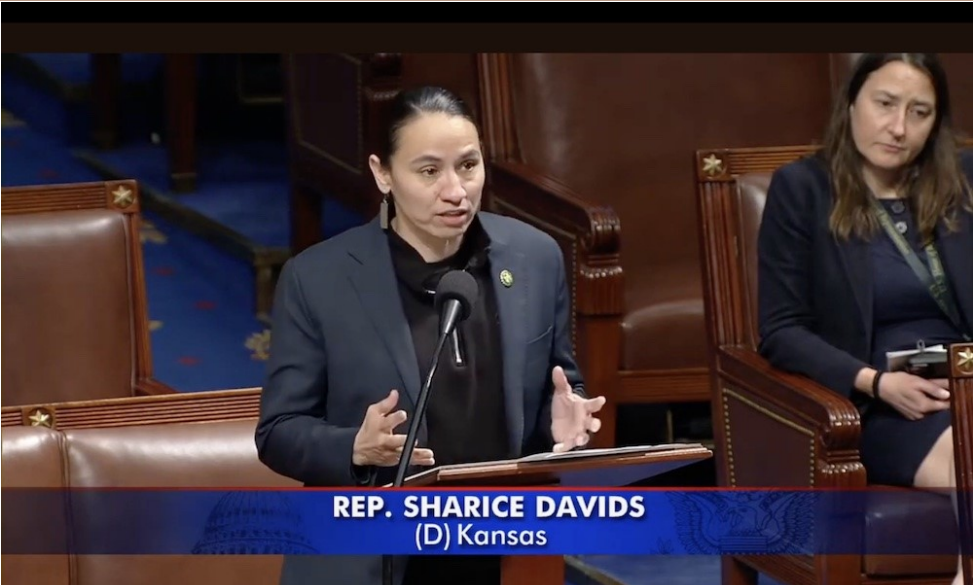
Actress Irene Bedard was born on July 22, 1967, in Anchorage, Alaska. Of mixed French Canadian, Cree and Inuit heritage, Bedard began her acting career in theater. She made her film debut in the cable TV film Lakota Woman: Siege at Wounded Knee (1994), for which she received critical acclaim. During the same period, Bedard appeared in the Disney feature Squanto: A Warrior’s Tale (1994). She achieved international stardom, however, when she landed the role of Pocahontas in the 1995 Disney feature of the same name. Subsequently, Bedard has nabbed starring roles in Smoke Signals (1998) and Into the West (2005). In recent years, Bedard has made more headlines for her personal life than for her acting after accusing former husband Denny Wilson of emotional and domestic abuse and asking for the public’s support in her legal battles with Wilson.

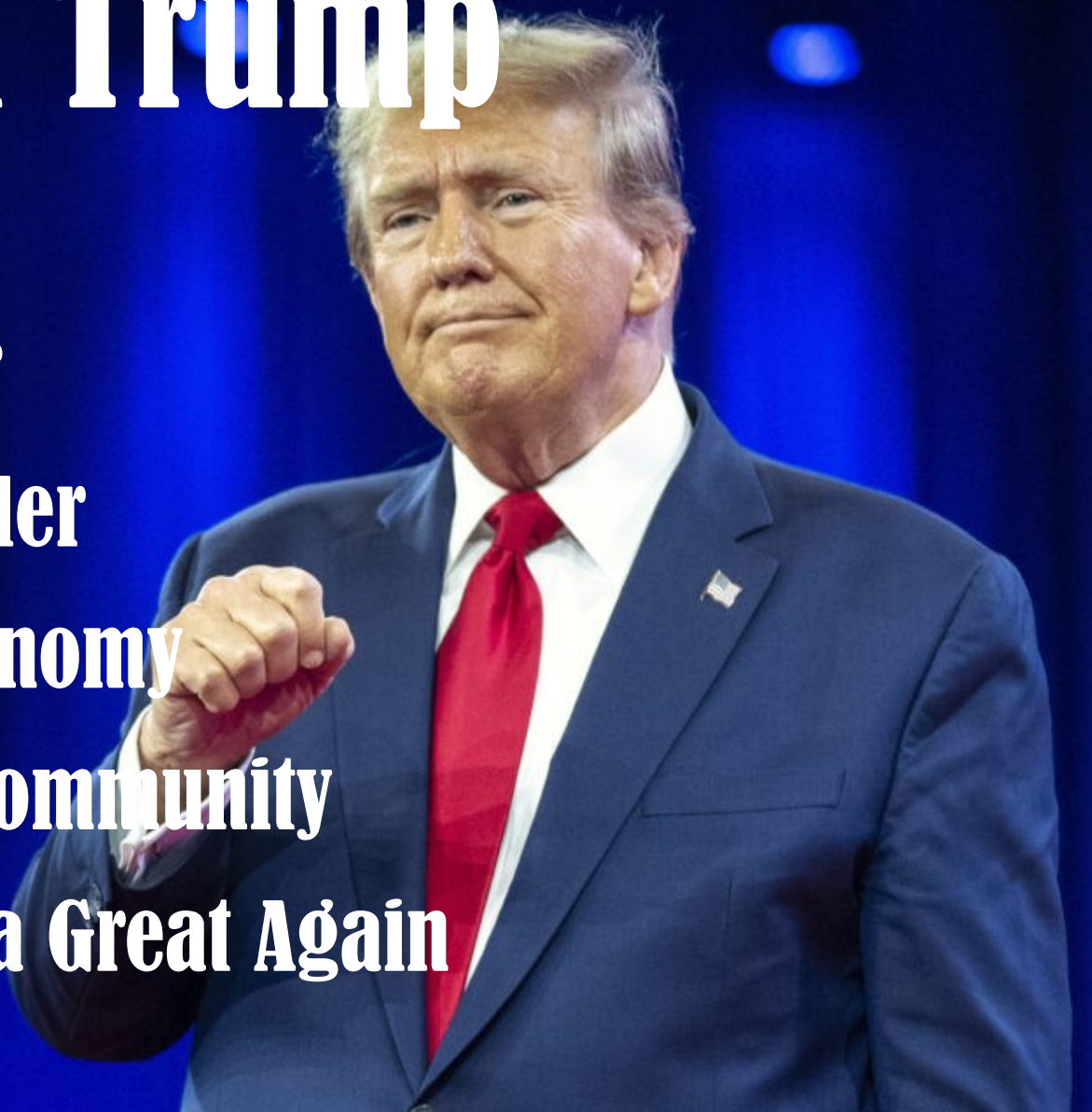

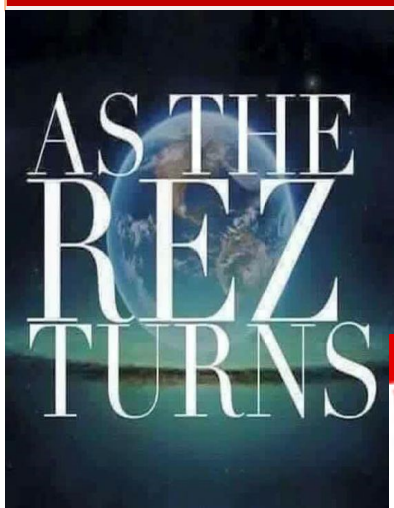
