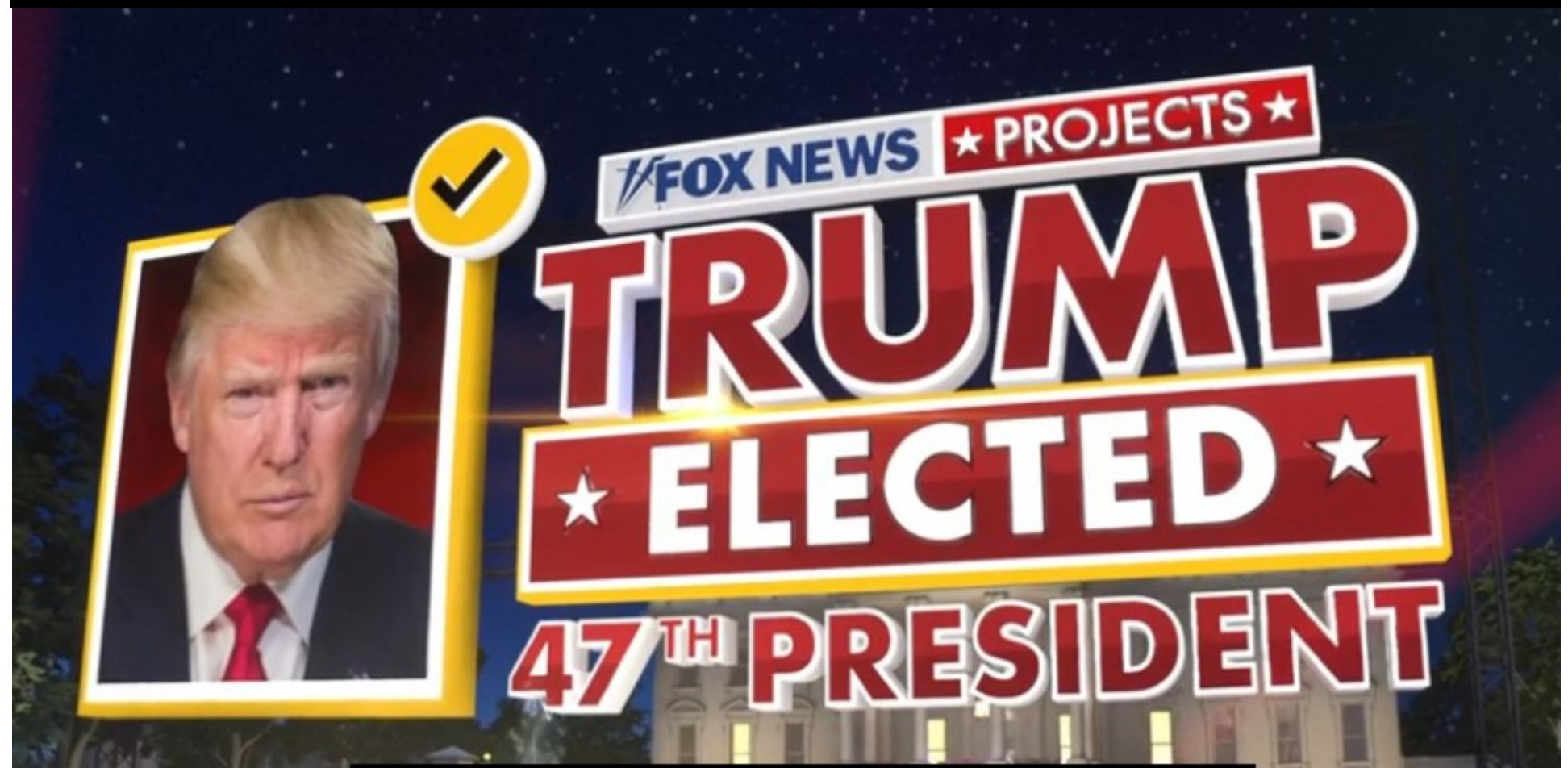
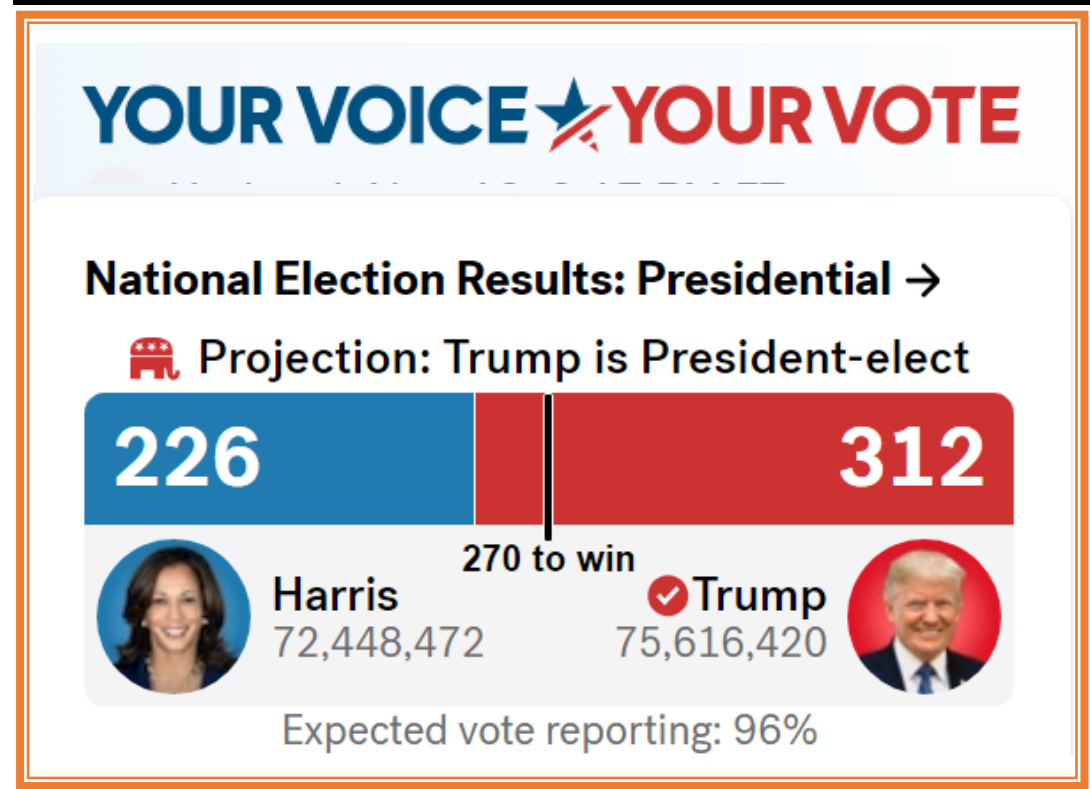

Funding stalled for federal Native diabetes program

WASHINGTON - Federal funding expires at the end of the year for a program that has reduced diabetes among Native Americans. Congress has yet to act, leaving providers and patients worried.

Diabetes is especially prevalent among Native Americans. In Arizona, 27% of Indigenous adults have been diagnosed with diabetes, compared to 10% of the White population, according to 2021 data from the Center for the Future of Arizona.

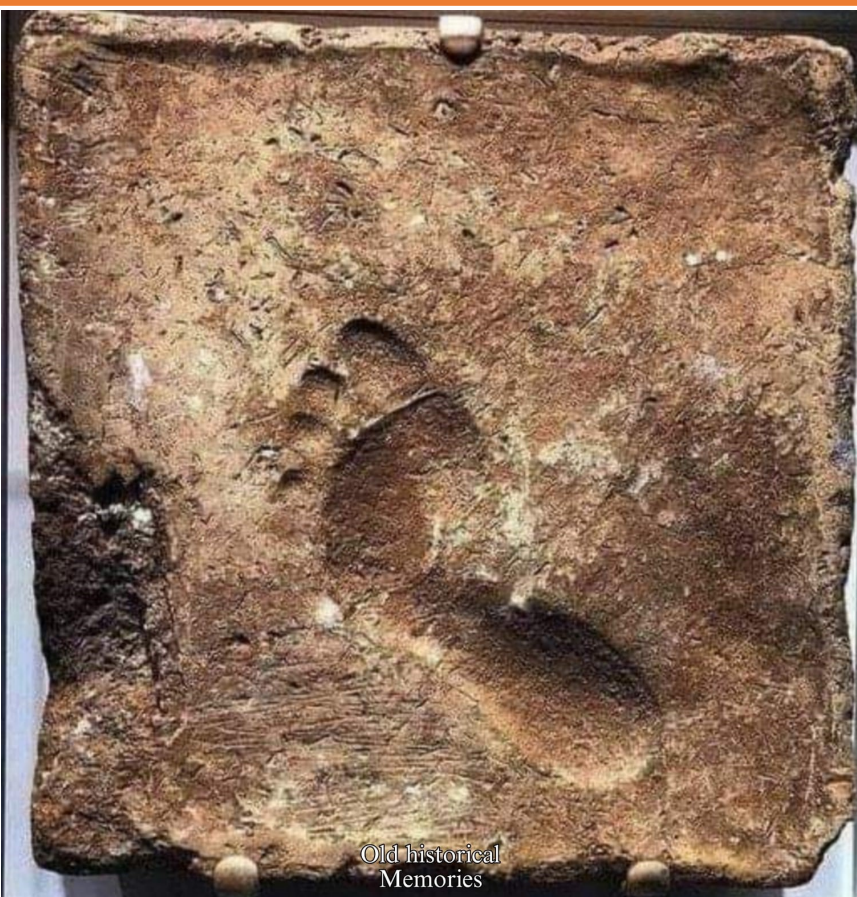
"It would be very devastating to many tribal communities if the program wasn't renewed, and it would be a huge loss for public health," said Caitrin McCarron Shuy, government relations director at the National Indian Health Board, a group that advocates on behalf of tribal governments.

Public health experts credit the Special Diabetes Program for Indians, launched in 1997 with bipartisan congressional support.

From 2004 to 2024, the program has provided \$150 million per year in grants to tribal diabetes programs. Funding remained flat for two decades as inflation eroded the value of the allocation by 40%. The NIHB has pressed Congress to boost it to \$250 million per year.

"It's very difficult to run a program when you only have one-year reauthorization," she said. "Whatever Congress is willing to give us we will work with. However, we are definitely hoping for more funding."

FLASHBACK: Harris declined to intervene on behalf of native tribe push to protect sacred site from wind farm ☆ [Read More @ FOX News](#)

Harris served as California's AG from 2011 to 2017. California's Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) voted in 2013 to declare land used for the Ocotillo Express Wind Facility as a "sacred site" after hearing several hours of "emotional" testimony from local Native Americans who, according to East County Magazine, contended "that the U.S. Bureau of Land Management ignored their concerns and its duty to protect a clearly documented sacred site and cemetery in the fast-tracked approval process for the Ocotillo Express Wind Facility."

Tribal leaders at the time described the Ocotillo wind project as "utter



destruction," it's even worse when you find out that it was built on false claims by the developer, and with the assistance of the BLM. "violation of trust." Anthony Pico, Chairman, Local Native Americans argued that the wind facility was built on what is known as the "Valley of the Dead," which they claimed for over 10,000 years as a site where ancestral remains were buried. While some tribes supported the wind farm, the NAHC voted 4-0 to ask Attorney General Harris to explore legal options.

"It was heartbreaking to see this project desecrate such a historically and culturally significant landscape, and



DEI violates 14th Amendment

North Dakota could soon make history by becoming the first U.S. state to eliminate property taxes — a bold move that supporters argue will ease the financial burden on homeowners and open doors for first-time buyers.

However, critics warn this sweeping change could leave local communities struggling to fund essential services, forcing them to depend on an uncertain state solution.

Growing frustration with rising property taxes has fueled support for the measure, with advocates claiming it will provide long-needed relief and help make real estate more affordable.

The ballot question is straightforward, yet it carries serious implications: should North Dakota scrap property taxes altogether, fundamentally altering how local governments are funded?

By shifting this responsibility to the state, the measure would dismantle a primary revenue stream for counties and municipalities, raising concerns about how — and if — these services would continue unaffected.

RV Sales To Halt In California, Washington, Oregon, New York, Massachusetts And New Jersey As Climate Rules Take Effect



A new climate regulation from California is set to disrupt the RV industry, leading to the halt of diesel motorhome sales in several states starting next year.

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) has amended its Advanced Clean Truck regulations, which now require all vehicles over 8,500 pounds to be zero-emission vehicles. This stringent regulation will impact states like Washington, Oregon, New York, Massachusetts, and New Jersey, which often adopt California's emissions standards.

As a result, RV owners in these states will be unable to register diesel motorhomes that do not meet the new emission standards. This could significantly impact the RV industry, particularly for manufacturers and dealers specializing in diesel motorhomes.

California has been at the forefront of climate change initiatives, implementing various policies aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
