Understanding the Debate on Reparations for Native Americans

Native American reparations are designed to remedy the U.S. government's historical treatment of indigenous tribes, ranging from monetary compensation to land redistribution and recognition of cultural rights.

Human rights: The U.S.'s treatment of indigenous tribes not only violates civil rights but also international human rights. Even prospective development of reparations requires creating protections against the systems that enabled the US's atrocities against indigenous peoples, informed by international law.

American values: America's founding legitimacy rests on popular sovereignty and

liberal values-values that the US's territorial expansion and conquest of indigenous tribes violated. Reparations reflect the U.S.'s commitment to secure these values once again.

Compensation for Boarding School Policies: The policy of indigenous child separation constituted a cultural genocide. Many records from the boarding schools are still not public. In order to help heal those targeted by the boarding school policies, reparations entail truth commissions like the Truth and Healing Commission

A national American Indian Police Service shall be establish under the U.S. Marshall Office or ????. Tribal ID shall be certified by a centralized center.

Land rights: Tribes need to have full authority and clearly defined jurisdiction of tribal lands. Education, water, mineral, remove restrictive regulations and the resources provided to bring it to fruition.

However, **the focus of tribal leaders will most likely be on strengthening the tribal dependency on the federal government as opposed to meaningful self determination.** By this I mean that they will seek to increase the annual budget which is based on tribal population. Yet, they have failed to recognize the recent ruling of the Bureau of Labor Statistics changing the criteria for determining American Indians, Native Alaskans and Native Hawaiians in the next census. Currently, it has reduced the labor force count by 60% & funding as well. This was done under the Biden Admin.

Pastor Jack Hibbs warns Christians may need to 'pack up and get out' of California over AB 495

A popular California pastor is warning Christians they might have to flee the state if lawmakers pass a controversial bill that would allow nearly any adult to take custody of a child without alerting parents.

Pastor Jack Hibbs of Calvary Chapel Chino Hills warned his congregation last week about Assembly Bill 495, which supporters claim would expand child welfare protections by legally recognizing caregivers and providing children with access to family services without unwanted disruptions.

Titled the Family Preparedness Plan Act of 2025, the bill would expand the definition of a "caregiver" to include

"nonrelative extended family members," defined as "any adult caregiver who has an established familial or mentoring relationship with the child, or who has an established familial relationship with a relative of the child." In turn, any "caregiver" would be allowed to take custody of a child by merely handing over a signed "affidavit" to school or child-care staff.

"There's no requirement in the bill for the school to ask you if it's OK for them to take John out of school," he told his congregation. "It allows an individual to obtain a new form that comes with the bill; they fill it out, and they can name a child.



... The bill does not require a background check for this man, requires no ID, no driver's license, no nothing. There's no requirement in the bill for the school to call you, to ask you if it's OK if John takes your daughter out of school."

A majority of voters believe former President Barack Obama's national security team schemed and lied in pushing the false "Russiagate" scandal to undermine the legitimate election of President Donald Trump, and now want them prosecuted for it.

In the latest Rasmussen Reports survey shared with Secrets, 54% of likely voters said it is likely that Team Obama "committed serious crimes in manipulating intelligence." Only 41% of respondents disagreed.

On top of the loss of exempt status, Sharpton will have to pay 30 years worth of back taxes.

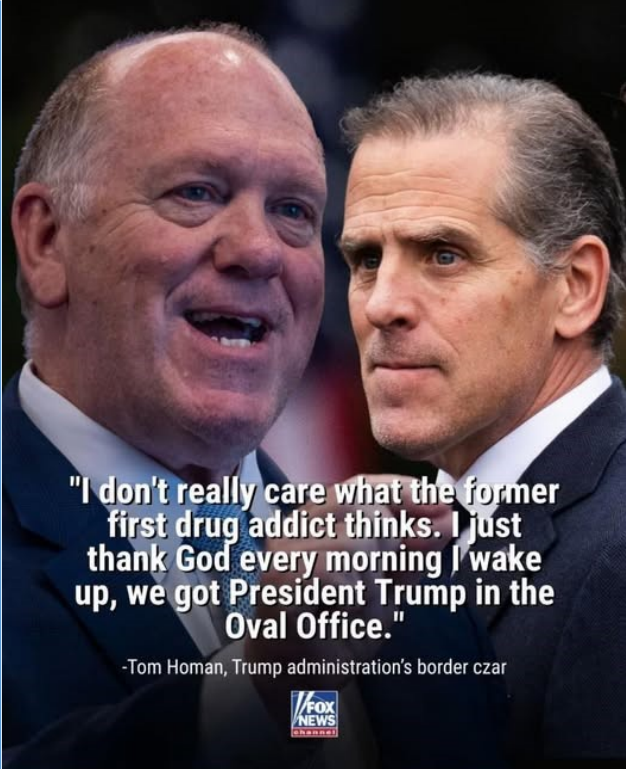

Supreme Court may deal Democrats a huge blow to ever taking House back

The U.S. Supreme Court is poised to consider a major challenge that could reshape how voting maps are drawn, potentially giving Republicans a significant advantage in upcoming elections.

The justices agreed Friday to expand a Louisiana case and weigh arguments about whether the 1965 Voting Rights Act still justifies creating districts specifically designed to elect Black or Hispanic representatives. The case will examine whether racial considerations should play a role in redrawing electoral maps.

A ruling that limits the application of the Voting Rights Act could have effects on congressional and local legislative districts across the country, particularly in the South. A decision that limits race-based districting could benefit the GOP, helping it recover the one seat it lost in Alabama and Louisiana due to court-ordered redistricting in the last election cycle. It could also open the door for Republicans to pick up additional seats in other Southern states where district lines have been drawn with racial considerations in mind.

Currently, the U.S. House includes 11 majority-Black and 31 majority-Hispanic districts, according to a Bloomberg News analysis of 2022 data. Republicans expanded their Senate control in the last election, winning 53 seats compared to the Democrats' 45, with two Independents caucusing with the latter. Republicans currently hold an eight-seat majority in the House, a margin that includes vacancies created by the recent deaths of three Democratic lawmakers.

Trump outsmarts leftist judges in scheme to boot Alina Habba with slick move, now she's top prosecutor

An attempt by a group of judges to stop President Donald Trump from appointing Alina Habba as New Jersey's top federal prosecutor has failed thanks to a clever, last-minute move by the president.

Habba, Trump's former lawyer, was appointed interim U.S. Attorney for New Jersey by the president in March for a term meant to last 120 days, meaning up until Friday, July 25th.

Trump, meanwhile, withdrew Habba's U.S. Attorney nomination and instead appointed her First Assistant U.S. Attorney.

Here's where the trick took place: Ac-



cording to the Vacancies Reform Act (5 U.S.C. § 3345), if and when the position of U.S. Attorney becomes vacant, the First Assistant automatically becomes U.S. Attorney.

And so by appointing Habba as First Assistant, Trump effectively made her U.S. Attorney. Voila! Habba celebrated the move with a scorching tweet.

"Donald J. Trump is the 47th President," she tweeted. "Pam Bondi is the Attorney General. And I am now the Acting United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey. I don't cower to pressure. I don't answer to politics. This is a fight for justice. And I'm all in."

Appeals court rips Obama-appointed Judge's legal abuse against Trump admin

Obama-appointed Judge James Boasberg exceeded his authority when he threatened the Trump administration with criminal contempt, an appeals court found on Friday.

In a 2-1 decision, the D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals sided with the Trump administration, tossing Boasberg's order finding probable cause for contempt over the administration's decision not to turn planes around.

Boasberg claimed administration officials violated a March 15 temporary restraining order (TRO) directing them not to remove alleged members of a foreign gang to El Salvador by sending out planes that same day. He initiated contempt proceedings even after the Supreme Court tossed his initial TRO in a 5-4 ruling in April.

Boasberg told Chief Justice John Roberts during a judicial conference in March that he, along with other colleagues, was concerned "that the Administration would disregard rulings of federal courts leading to a constitutional crisis," according to a memo reported by the Federalist.

Only 14 years after almost the entire Choctaw population was forcibly relocated in the Trail of Tears, the tribe donated \$170 (over \$5,000 today) to victims of the Potato Famine in Ireland, creating a bond between the two peoples that lasts to today.

In 1847, still reeling from the trauma of the Trail of Tears—a forced relocation that claimed thousands of lives—the Choctaw Nation learned of the devastating Potato Famine in Ireland. Despite their own hardship, Choctaw leaders gathered in eastern Oklahoma and raised \$170 (equivalent to over \$5,000 today) for Irish famine relief. The donation was sent through U.S. relief committees to Ireland, and even at the time, it was recognized as an extraordinary act of empathy and solidarity from a people who had so recently endured immense suffering themselves.

This gesture sparked a lasting connection between the Choctaw and Irish peoples. In 2017, the town of Midleton in County Cork unveiled the “Kindred Spirits” sculpture—nine soaring stainless steel feathers arranged in a circle—to honor the Choctaws’ generosity. Ireland has since established scholarships for Choctaw youth, and during the COVID-19 pandemic, Irish citizens raised funds for Native American communities in a symbolic act of “paying it forward.” The bond forged in compassion continues to inspire cross-cultural friendship and mutual respect nearly two centuries later

Eva Geronimo Godeley, born on September 23, 1889, was the beloved daughter of Zi-yeh and the renowned warrior Geronimo. Despite his fierce reputation, Geronimo showed tender love for his daughter, often seen carrying Eva in a stroller or indulging her requests during shopping trips.

In 1897, the artist Eldridge Ayer Burbank painted both Geronimo and Eva, noting how kind Geronimo was to his young daughter. Eva’s life, though tragically short, was filled with love and family. She passed away from tuberculosis on August 10, 1911, just shy of her 22nd birthday.

Emily Chihuahua Tee, born on July 5, 1889, was another remarkable woman in this photo. She was the daughter of Ilth-gozey and Chihuahua. Emily’s life was also marked by love and resilience. After the death of her first husband, she remarried and continued to build her family. Sadly, Emily passed away on March 30, 1909.

These stories remind us of the rich and complex histories of the people behind the names we often hear in history. They were not just warriors or leaders but also fathers, daughters, and wives who lived, loved, and endured.

Meet the Native American tribe that beat the Trump administration in court -- for now * [Read More @ ABC News](#)

It's a temporary victory for an Indian tribe whose history has been partially shaped by broken promises from the United States. But temporary or not, Thursday's (Aug. 7, 2025) order put the Miccosukee -- a small tribe of less than a thousand members -- in the middle of the most high-profile use of an environmental law to challenge the [Trump administration](#).

On Thursday, the environmental groups and tribe successfully convinced a federal judge in Miami to block any further construction at the site for two weeks...

U.S. District Judge Kathleen Mary Williams has divorced the case from any arguments about the allegedly inhumane conditions at the camp, focusing solely on the environmental impact of the site on the Everglades and the endangered animals that call it home. The Miccosukee's lawyers are set to present evidence this week in federal court about how they say the tribe would be harmed.

What if I told you Geronimo's wife escaped slavery, walked over a thousand miles, and killed a mountain lion with her bare hands--and still wasn't the most famous warrior in her tribe?

History rarely remembers the women who endured its harshest chapters—but the Apache never forgot Tze-gu-juni.

Born around 1847, she was struck by lightning during a thunderstorm that killed her mother and sister. She survived. Later, captured during the 1880 Mexican massacre at Tres Castillos, she was enslaved and sent to Mexico City. Her captors called her Huera—Spanish slang for a pale woman—though she was simply different from the others, with striking features and a fire in her eyes.

For five years, she lived in chains. Then, with nothing but a single knife and a blanket, she escaped with a few other Apache women. Together, they began an unimaginable journey—1,300 miles through desert and danger, guided only by survival.

When a mountain lion lunged for her throat, Huera wrapped her blanket tight and fought back. It tore her scalp from her head, but she didn't stop. She drove her blade into the lion's heart and lived. Her companions reattached her scalp using cactus thorns—and mountain lion saliva.

Still bleeding, Huera pressed forward.

Months later, battered but alive, they returned to San Carlos. The community was stunned. She became a shaman, a translator, and a figure of quiet strength among the Chiricahua. Her face bore the scars of survival, but she never wore them with shame.

Her second husband, the great warrior Geronimo, called her "the bravest of Apache women." And yet, outside of her people, the world barely remembers her name.



Marilyn Hume is a White Mountain Apache Weaver who specializes in Basket weaving burden baskets, tobacco baskets, and Apache pitch-covered water vases (known as "tus").

Marilyn is renowned for her dedication to preserving traditional basket weaving and other cultural practices. Born on March 11, 1956, in Cibecue, Arizona, Marilyn learned the art of basket weaving as a child, sitting alongside her mother, who emphasized the importance of this tradition as both a cultural practice and a potential livelihood.

Marilyn's mother, in turn, had been taught by her grandmother, a woman of extraordinary resilience and history, who lived to the remarkable age of 113 and shared stories of her time during the era of Geronimo.

We've all hear it. Who's on First?



“Those councilpersons don’t know what they’re doing! What the H is going on?”

On the other side, elected/appointed officials think their detractors don’t understand their legal/contractual constraints of their budget. So many constituents look at the total amount of money to be spent but do not know the restrictions or parameters therein. If the purpose is unspecific, the discussion of how it will be spent or the priorities of the “**funding group**” will reveal their priorities (often not seen/heard by the elected council).

The task of the group is to develop and present the program and budget within a state amount of time. In presenting the challenge, the first piece of information should be the source of the income. .Is this earned income? grant? contract? In presenting the challenge.

If it is earned income, what is the source? How was/is it obtained? Is it automatic? Is it a fixed amount or does it fluctuate from a variety of factors? Are there any restrictions on spending this revenue?

The task of the group is to develop and present the program and budget within a state amount of time

Is this a contract or grant? What is the difference between the two? How was it obtained? Is it a “one-shot” project



or something that can be renewed? Again, are there any restrictions on spending?

Some heads will be spinning at this point but it is only the beginning.

Good programming and administration start with a clear purpose or statement about that which the funds will be used..

If the funding has been obtained through contract or grant, there usually is a proposal that has preceded the award. This must be viewed by the group to determine if it is still relevant or applicable. It is important to note that in accepting the contract or grant, the signing official verifies compliance with the funding agency. There is an opportunity to renegotiate or change some of the original proposal if conditions have changed, the award amount is smaller than that proposed, personnel has changed, etc., before the signature is on the line.

This process should generate knowledge that every funding agency is different. It is critical to know their funding calendar and process as well as reporting and other requirements..

It is also important to know if this funding is the result of an old (mature) source (ie, treaty or historical lease/royalty) or a “new” idea or practice to determine any obligations of the project. Again, this a good insertion point to determine some o the interests amongst group participants.

Group participants should gain understanding that unless the tribe runs on one solo source of income generated by the tribe, there is not just one pile of money to distribute. There are many silos of different shapes and sizes with which to become acquainted.

There are budget terms with which the group may be unfamiliar. Administrative costs, in-direct costs, cost sharing head the list. With personnel costs may come social security, ESD (employment security), insurance and other fees depending on the tribe’s fiscal policies and practices. Accounting, audits, consumables v. equipment costs, communications and other office support costs are all areas of a budget to be analyzed.

Sometimes, one will find that the administrative costs may exceed the amount available from the funder outweighs the value of accepting the funding. Other times this means finding another source of funding or entering into a cooperative situation with another entity in order to make the project fiscally sound. Alternatively, funding can be used to test an idea and estimate the cost of fully developing the project.

There are budget terms with which the group may be unfamiliar. Administrative costs, in-direct costs, cost sharing head the list. "What I saw on video is not the Cincinnati I know and love," Hamilton County Prosecutor Connie Pillich said. *"These charges hold those involved in the attack accountable."*

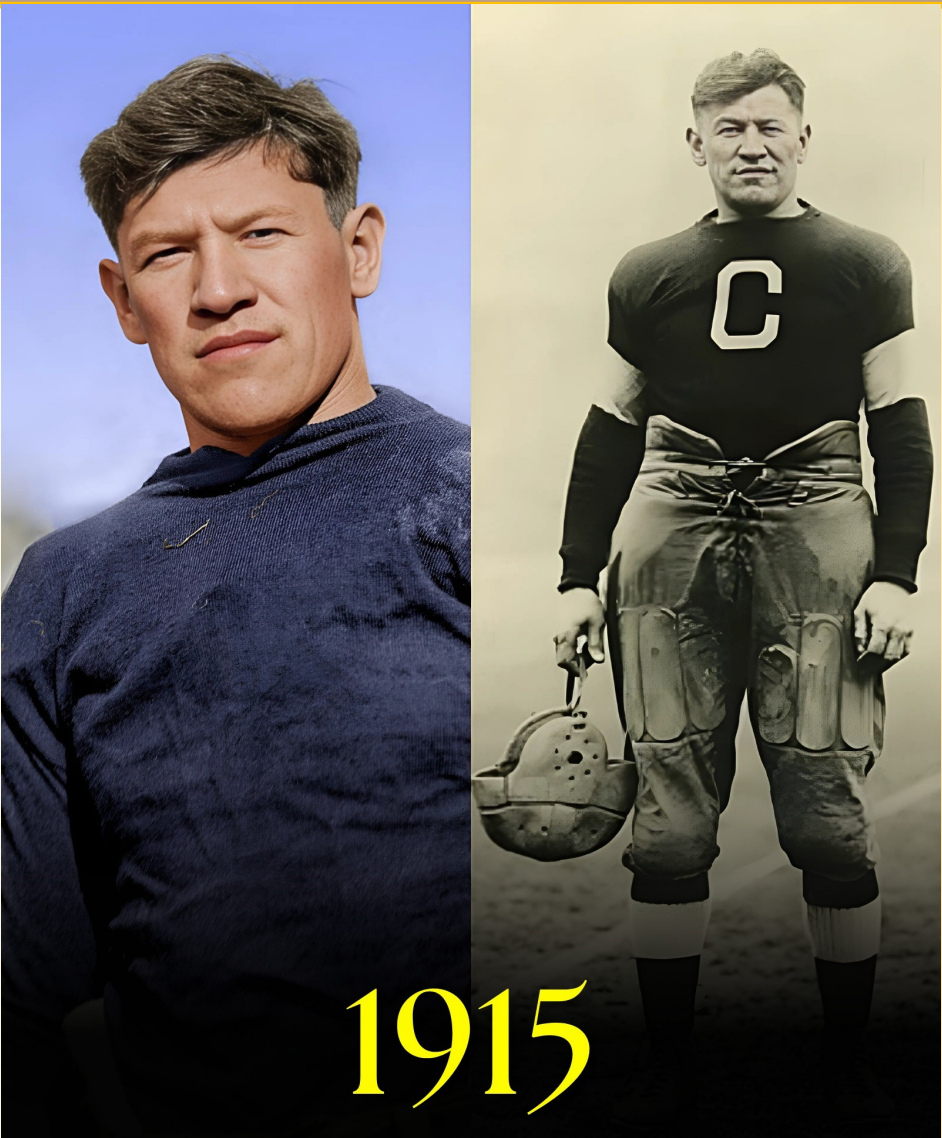

CALIFORNIA NOW LEADS THE NATION IN BOTH UNEMPLOYMENT AND HOMELESSNESS

Jim Thorpe



Just before the bitter showdown of 1915—Canton Bulldogs vs. their sworn enemies, the Massillon Tigers—a move was made that would forever ripple through the pages of football history. Canton’s general manager, Jack Cusack, knew his team needed more than just grit and game plans to triumph. They needed a legend. And so, he brought in the only man whose name could turn a regular Sunday into a spectacle—Jim Thorpe.

Thorpe wasn’t just an athlete; he was a phenomenon. A walking thunderstorm in cleats. Cusack signed him for \ \$250 a game—an enormous sum back then, but no one in Canton would question its worth. The moment Thorpe stepped onto the field, the town felt it. Crowds swelled. Eyes widened. The energy shifted.

He didn’t disappoint. Thorpe was raw force and elegant motion stitched together. As both star player and coach, he led the Bulldogs to unofficial world championships in 1916, 1917, and again in 1919. But his value extended beyond victories—he gave professional football legitimacy. He made people believe it was more than a novelty. He made them care.

By 1920, the sport was ready for a league of its own. When the National Football League was formed that year, it felt only natural that Thorpe—the brightest beacon of the game—would be named its first president. Was it symbolic? Of course. But it was also deserved. Because when people talked football back then, they spoke Thorpe’s name with a kind of reverence usually reserved for myths.

And myths tend to stretch over time. But not everything you hear about Jim

Thorpe is exaggerated. Much of it is real—almost painfully so. He could run like wind chased by thunder, exploding downfield with speed and power that left defenders grasping at ghosts. He could sling a pass or snatch one from the air like it belonged to him all along. His kicks? Ridiculous. At halftime, just for fun, he’d boot field goals from the 50-yard line, then casually spin around and dropkick through the goalposts on the opposite side of the field. It wasn’t showing off. It was just Thorpe being Thorpe. He blocked like a wall of granite and tackled like a storm crashing into the shore. He didn’t just play the game—he overwhelmed it.

But his story isn’t just about what he did on the field. It’s also about where he came from—and how far he had to travel to be seen. Born in a one-room cabin in Oklahoma, Thorpe’s roots were a mix of French, Irish, and Sac and Fox Indian heritage. His Native American name was ***Wa-Tho-Huk*—“Bright Path.”** How fitting. Because from the shadows of poverty and prejudice, he lit his own trail.

At sixteen, his father sent him to the Carlisle Institute, a school for Native youth. There, sports became his language, his weapon, his sanctuary. And he didn’t just dabble—he conquered. Baseball. Basketball. Track. Lacrosse. Even ballroom dancing. Anything with movement and competition, Thorpe mastered. But it was on the Olympic stage in 1912 where he carved his name into the granite of immortality.

He won the decathlon and the pentathlon—two of the most grueling tests of athleticism. King Gustav V of Sweden shook his hand and declared, **“You, sir, are the greatest athlete in the world.”**

And for a moment, the world agreed. But the applause didn’t last.

Later, it was discovered Thorpe had once accepted money for playing minor league baseball—an unforgivable sin in the eyes of Olympic officials back then. His medals were stripped. His name smeared. The shame was public. The heartbreak, deeply personal.

But Thorpe never folded. He kept playing, kept fighting, kept shining. He played six seasons in Major League Baseball, a remarkable feat on its own. Yet even with all that, football remained his truest love.

And time, as it often does with legends, corrected its wrongs. In 1982—nearly

three decades after his death—his Olympic medals were finally restored. Too late for him to see, but not too late for the world to remember.

Jim Thorpe wasn’t perfect. He didn’t live a fairy tale. But he lived a story that thundered through history. He was the bridge between the old world and the modern sports era—a man of many worlds, many gifts, and a fire that refused to dim.

Some legends fade. Thorpe? He still walks with us—on every field, in every impossible play, in every underdog who dares to rise.

Tulsi Gabbard releases damning reports with new evidence against Obama as promised

Director of National Intelligence Tulsi Gabbard is spilling all the secrets and things are not looking good for former President Barack Obama.

“LIE: The Obama Administration’s January ICA was an independent Intelligence Community product, produced with apolitical analysis. TRUTH: Obama ordered the Intelligence Community to create an Intelligence Community Assessment they knew was false, promoting a contrived narrative, with the intent of undermining the legitimacy and power of a duly elected President of the United States, Donald Trump.”

Summing up the thread, Gabbard accused the Obama administration of “knowingly” crafting the Russiagate hoax that plagued Trump’s first term in an attempt to “undermine the legitimacy and power of the duly elected President of the United States, Donald Trump.”

Five important cases the Supreme Court is set to decide this coming term

The Supreme Court recently upped the stakes for its next term by further calling into question the vitality of the Voting Rights Act.

The crucial future of voting rights is just one of the important issues set for resolution in the term that **starts in October**, with decisions expected by July. Though the justices have still been ruling on the so-called **shadow docket** over the summer, and they’ll add more cases to **the docket on a rolling basis**, here are five big ones already set for resolution this coming term.

While we never know exactly how the justices will rule until the opinions come out, they have laid the groundwork for another set of conservative victories.

Voting rights

Louisiana v. Callais was supposed to be decided last term. But the justices failed to rule **and instead pushed it** to the coming term. Notably, they added significance to an already significant redistricting appeal when they **issued an order** last week that set the stage for **additional gutting** of the landmark 1965 law on voting rights.

Transgender sports

One of the biggest cases this past term was **United States v. Skrmetti**, in which the Republican-appointed majority **upheld** a ban on gender-affirming care for minors. Fresh off that ruling, the justices **agreed to consider** whether transgender girls and women can participate in sports on girls’ and women’s teams. That sets up the possibility of two rulings against transgender people two terms in a row.

Campaign finance

Yet another hot-button issue that could further conservative interests is campaign finance. The justices **agreed to hear an appeal** from Republicans challenging campaign finance restrictions. The appeal came from the National Republican Senatorial Committee and others affiliated with the GOP, with support from **the Trump administration**.

Conversion therapy

The campaign finance case isn’t the only appeal claiming First Amendment interests that align with conservative goals. **Challenging Colorado’s ban** on so-called conversion therapy — attempting to change a minor’s sexual orientation or gender identity — a Christian counselor **brought the following legal issue** to the justices, which they agreed to consider: “Whether a law that censors certain conversations between counselors and their clients based on the viewpoints expressed regulates conduct or violates the Free Speech Clause.”

Abortion

The court that **overturned Roe v. Wade** in 2022 is also hearing an abortion-related appeal. It’s not directly about access to the procedure but rather is another First Amendment challenge.

It stems from a state investigation of an anti-abortion group over potentially misleading donors and potential clients about the health services it provides. The group wants to avoid turning over donor information and tried to pursue its claim in federal court. The justices **agreed to consider whether the group may do so or whether the matter must proceed in state court**.

A through line between this and other appeals this coming term, on top of the First Amendment connection, is that the case is being brought by the conservative Christian legal group **Alliance Defending Freedom**, which is also **behind the transgender sports and conversion therapy appeals**. The group has found success at the broadly like-minded Roberts Court.

Given that synergy, ADF’s success this coming term can provide a useful barometer of where the court is at. That the justices agreed to review these appeals in the first place is a decent indication.

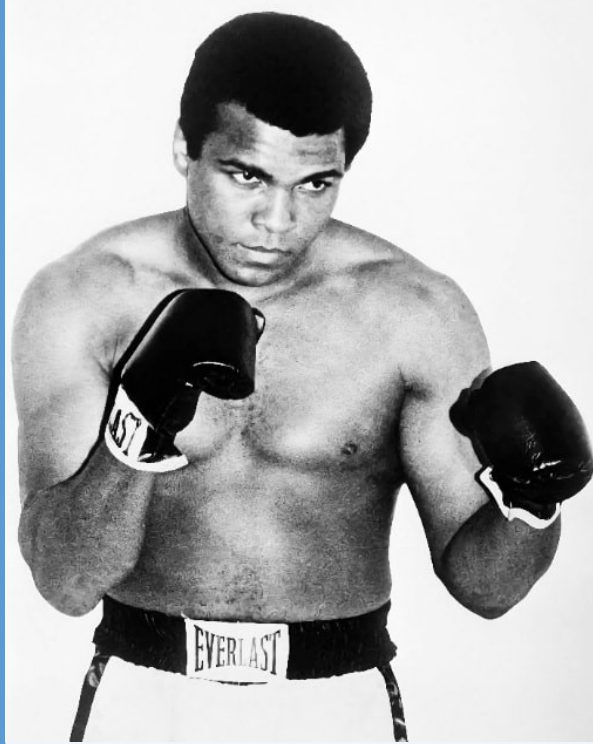
HOW QUICKLY WE FORGET. PLEASE READ

MY VIEW: History has a way of repeating it's self. In the late 1930's Winston Churchill warned the England Parliament of the treat of Adolf Hitler and was

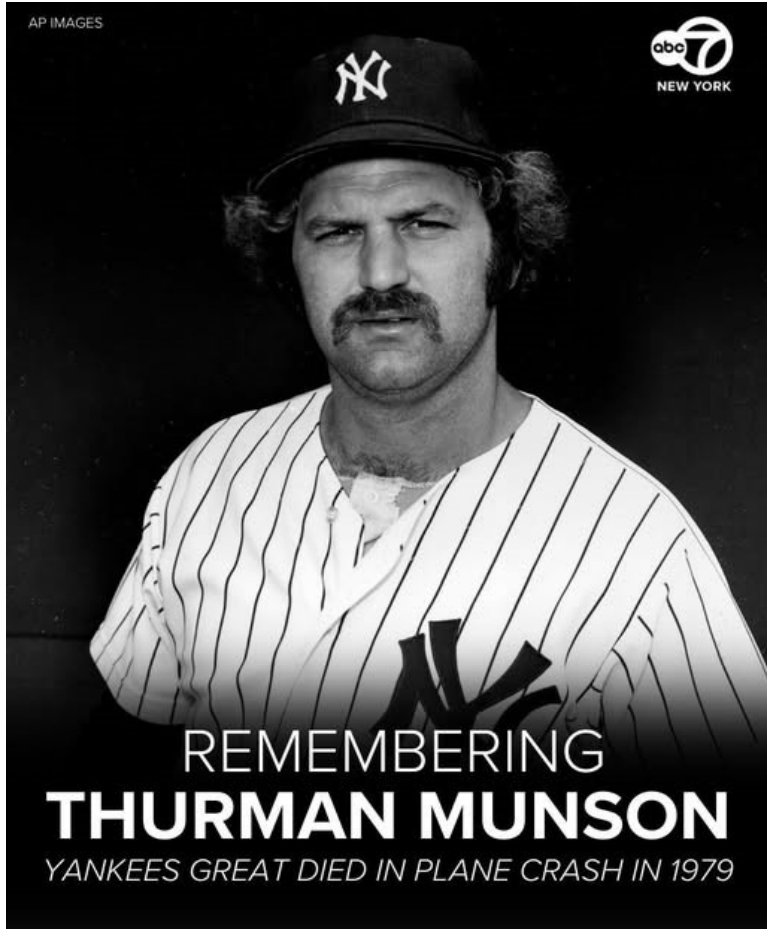
