

## Chairman Bo Mazzetti, Champion of Aboriginal Tribal, Water & Veterans Rights, entered eternal life on May 1, 2025

Over the years, Bo was a highly successful business man as a water well digger and building contractor. And like many of us he had to divide his time between earning a living, family and tribal business. This was during the Tribal BC days. (Before Casinos.)

I met Bo in 1968-69 during a joint tribal leaders meeting at the Pauma Indian Reservation to discuss the formation of a centralized Tribal Chairman's organization. A fairly new concept since many of us were not aware of the labors of the Mission Indian Federation.

The results of that meeting were the founding of the Southern California Tribal Chairmen's Association, Inc., the All Mission Indian Housing Authority, Indian Health Services and the San Luis Rey Water District. Back in the day we were young, fearless and knew everything, but thanks to our fathers (Ernest Sr., and Max) we very quickly learned to listen to our elders, learn and to pick and choose our battles.

However, we often miss the point and paid the prices. The learning curve can not only be extreme, it can also be expensive. One must understand that during these times we were literally fighting for our Tribal Rights. Alcatraz, AIM and grassroots. It was a new beginning.

Over the years I have had the honor of meeting some of the supreme Tribal Leaders of the 20th and 21st centuries and have had the opportunity to work with several of them. Bo was one of the most prominent. Others include former U.S.

senator Ben Nighthorse Cambell, Anna Sandaval, Wendell Chino, Banning Taylor, Anthony Pico, Leroy Elliott, Rupert Costo, Denis Banks, Katherin Siva, Ernie Stevens Sr., David Resling, Joe Carillo and Adam Castello. Castello is most likely the least known as he provided the leadership for the Mission Indian Federation for 33 years, from 1920 to 1953 when he died.

Bo provided a political blueprints for the future tribal leaders at every level of government from the Tribal Council to the County, State and Federal Government. His approach was simple, stay focused, make friends at every level and gain the support from the non-tribal community. It works, the proof is in his unbelievable success and far reaching influence. One great example is the California Tribal Chairperson's Association, Inc., (CTCA) which he organized that consist of 89 of the 109 Federally Recognized American Indian Tribes located in the State.

Although Bo an I remained life long friends we had our differences on issues yet, we maintained our respect for each other's views. My friendship with Bo Mazzetti was one of the longest and most meaningful over the past 56 years.

Our bond was the vision that our people would come together as one to bring about our freedom from Federal Government oversight and tribal sovereignty would be a reality.


May God bless you my friend and thank you, **you made a BIG difference!**

Bo was born and raised on the Rincon Indian Reservation. An original "REZ DOGG."

He attend local public schools in Escondido CA. Upon graduating high school he enlisted in the U.S. Navy during the height of the Viet Nan War. Upon completing Basic Training he became an underwater demolition team member which was later renamed as "Navy Seals." He was a strong advocate for veterans rights.

After his discharge from the Navy he enrolled at Cal Poly Pomona and earned his BA degree.

To appreciate his educational accomplishments one must understand that during the 1960's and 70's the America Indian student drop out rate was at between 94% to 97%.



But he didn't stop there, thankfully.






### With new grants, ND tribes can elevate their tourism game



Tourism generates \$3 billion annually in North Dakota but tribal officials say direct spending from visitors does not always reach their areas. Now, a new grant program aims to help Native American tribes promote their sites.

Gov. Kelly Armstrong recently signed a bill which sets aside \$100,000 for North Dakota's five tribal nations to share for tourism-related projects.

Kiera Fox, acting tourism director for the Mandan, Hidatsa and Arikara Nation, said it might not seem like a lot of money but it is a foot in the door. She noted her team can use it to improve signage and other needs, while promoting their history in a culturally-appropriate way.

"We get to tell our stories with our own voices," Fox explained. "Reeducate a little bit, correct some of those misconceptions everybody has about Native Americans."

She pointed out the MHA Nation is off the beaten path. More visibility with signs might convince drivers to take a detour and check out sites, including a local museum and the Crow Flies scenic overlook. The bill sailed through the Legislature with minor opposition; however, the final sum is lower than the proposed \$500,000.





- Have a minimum 2.5 out of 4.0 GPA.
- Submit a current class schedule and transcript.
- Attend an accredited institution seeking an Associate's Degree or higher.
- Provide essays described in the application that show the student's connection to their Tribal Nation and Native Country.

The California Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP) recently announced that the Yurok Tribe was selected to receive a \$26.4 million grant to build the urgently needed Yurok Tribal Health and Wellness Center.

## Johnny Unitas Cut before the season even began

They told him he wasn't smart enough. They didn't even let him take a single snap in practice. Imagine that – standing there day after day, helmet in hand, heart pounding in your chest, knowing deep down you could change the game if only someone would give you a chance.

But Johnny Unitas? He was brushed aside like a footnote in Pittsburgh, just another kid chasing a dream too big for the world around him to understand. The Steelers had four quarterbacks and room for three. Johnny was the odd man out. Walt Kiesling, the coach, had made up his mind – and there was no undoing it.

Cut before the season even began, Johnny found himself back in Pittsburgh, not as a rising star, but as a newly married man with a family to feed and no prospects. He strapped on a construction helmet instead of a football one, taking any job he could find to keep the lights on. But the fire inside him? It didn't flicker. On weekends, he'd lace up his cleats, pulling a crumpled jersey over his head, and play for a ragtag semi-pro team called the Bloomfield Rams. Quarterback. Safety. Punter. Six bucks a game. Six dollars to keep a piece of his soul alive.

Then, almost like a whisper from fate, a chance came knocking. In 1956, his teammate from the Rams, Jim Deglau – a steelworker with calloused hands and dreams not so different from Johnny's – had a tryout lined up with the Baltimore Colts. At the last second, Deglau asked Johnny to tag along. They didn't even have enough money for the gas. Friends pitched in a few dollars here and there, betting on a kid Pittsburgh had already written off.


Even then, doubt loomed. Deglau later recalled how Johnny's uncle tried to talk him out of go-

ing. "What if the Colts say no?" he warned. "It'll ruin you with the others too." But Johnny went anyway, heart pounding, head high. It was the kind of decision you don't make with your head – you make it with your gut, with every bruised part of you that refuses to quit.

The Colts saw what the Steelers never did. They signed him, snatching him away just before the Cleveland Browns could get their hands on him. It wasn't glamour at first – his debut was a nightmare: two passes, no completions, one interception. When he finally got real playing time after an injury to starter George Shaw, his first pass was picked off and taken back for a touchdown. His next play? A fumbled handoff. Two disasters in two plays. Most men would've cracked. Packed it in, called it fate. But Johnny wasn't wired that way. He shook it off like dust on his boots, rallied the Colts to upset Green Bay, and even toppled the mighty Cleveland Browns later that season. By the end of his rookie year, he had thrown nine touchdowns, completed over 55% of his passes – a rookie record – and started a streak that would etch his name into history: 47 straight games with a touchdown pass.

By 1957, Johnny Unitas was no longer just surviving – he was soaring. As the Colts' full-time starter, he threw for 2,550 yards and 24 touchdowns, leading Baltimore to their first winning season ever. They didn't just win; they fought, clawed, and believed – and Johnny was the heartbeat of it all. By season's end, he held the Jim Thorpe Trophy in his hands, crowned the NFL's Most Valuable Player.

And then came 1958. The year everything



changed – not just for Johnny, but for football itself. The Colts clinched the Western Conference under his steady hand, and in a cold, electric December showdown, they faced the New York Giants for the NFL Championship. The nation watched, breathless, as Johnny orchestrated a masterpiece. The game was knotted at 17-17, a deadlock dragging into sudden death overtime – the first in NFL history.

And when it mattered most, Johnny was unbreakable. He drove the Colts down the field with a surgeon's calm, leading to Alan Ameche's dive into the end zone, sealing a 23-17 victory. That game wasn't just a win. It was a turning point. The moment football went from a gritty pastime to a national obsession. And at the center of it all, there was Johnny Unitas – the kid nobody wanted, hoisting the dreams of millions on his shoulders, proving once and for all that sometimes, the smartest man on the field is the one nobody saw coming.

## Brit Hume says he's mystified why Democrats attack Trump 'on an issue in which he's clearly succeeding'

Brit Hume warned Democrats on Fox News Monday (April 28, 2025) against making immigration a central campaign issue, saying President Donald Trump is clearly succeeding where former President Joe Biden struggled.

During an appearance on "Special Report with Bret Baier," Hume discussed Trump's first 100 days in office. Hume said he was confused why Democrats keep attacking Trump on an issue in which he's "clearly succeeding."

"If the Democrats were smart, they'd wait and see which ones he's able to catch and which ones he's able to succeed on and which ones he isn't.

That process, because there's so many of them, are bound to have some failures, because there always are. But to attack him on an issue in which he's clearly succeeding, I don't quite understand."

Democratic Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker blasted his own party Sunday (April 27, 2025), accusing Democrats of being too weak against Republicans and wrongly blaming 2024 losses on issues like immigration and transgender rights. Hume described the contrast between Trump's border policies and Biden's.

"We need to secure our border. We need to

keep and attract hard-working, tax-paying, law-abiding people. And give them a path to citizenship. It's interesting he chooses that. And that's what President Biden said. We can only do so much," Hume said. "We need Congress to act. And yet you look at these numbers on the southwest border, Bret. It's night and day. I don't think I was picking issues for the Democrats to try to come back at Trump on."

Beyond immigration, Hume said Biden's broader record remains shaky, whereas Trump succeeded.
