### Indian Gaming Association Announces the Sudden Passing of Chairman Ernie Stevens, Jr.

Washington, D.C. – The Indian Gaming Association (IGA) is deeply heartbroken to announce the sudden passing of our beloved Chairman, Ernest L. Stevens, Jr., who suddenly left us today, September 26, 2025.

Chairman Stevens dedicated his life to Indian Country. For more than two decades, as Chairman of IGA, he never wavered from the mission of advancing tribal government gaming and strengthening tribal sovereignty. Under his leadership, IGA became one of the most powerful and respected voices in Washington, D.C., tirelessly championing the rights of tribal nations and protecting the integrity of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act.

Jason Giles, Executive Director of IGA said, *“Our IGA Board and staff are stunned and saddened by Chairman Stevens passing. Out of respect for his wife Cheryl, his lovely family and the Oneida Nation, we will issue a full tribute at the appropriate time. Please send your prayers to the Stevens family”.*

*“Ernie Stevens, Jr. was more than a chairman; he was a warrior, a statesman, and a champion for all of Indian Country,”* said Giles, *“His vision and commitment built bridges across tribal nations, Congress, and federal agencies, ensuring that tribal gaming remained a cornerstone of tribal self-determination and economic growth. His legacy will be unmatched, and his voice will echo for generations to come.”*

During his tenure, Indian gaming revenues grew from \$11 billion in 2000 to a record-breaking \$43.9 billion in 2024, making Tribal Government Gaming the largest segment of the U.S. gaming industry. This extraordinary achievement is a direct reflection of Chairman Stevens’ strategic vision and steadfast advocacy, working in lockstep with tribal leaders nationwide to foster the Indian gaming industry, ensuring that gaming revenues continued to fund schools, healthcare, infrastructure, and economic development across Indian Country.


Chairman Stevens leaves behind not only a record of policy victories and economic achievements but also a legacy of unity, dignity, and relentless commitment to the next generation of tribal leaders. He believed deeply in the sovereignty of tribal governments and in their ability to shape a prosperous future for their communities.

IGA honors Chairman Stevens’ memory by continuing the work he devoted his life to defending tribal sovereignty, empowering tribal governments, and celebrating the strength of Native nations. Chairman Stevens always believed his greatest accomplishment and legacy was his family.

We extend our deepest compassion to his wife Cheryl, Children Brandon, Ernest III, Margaret, Maria and Lois and his 20 grandchildren during this time of great loss and will carry forward his mission with the same strength and dedication that defined his life’s work.

## The U.S. economy is running even hotter than previously thought, and GDP growth could reach 4% in Q3

Meanwhile, third-quarter growth is shaping up to be hotter. Durable goods orders for August jumped more than expected, according to data released on Thursday. And the personal income and spending report on Friday showed consumption remained healthy in August while also topping forecasts.

Given that consumer spending represents over two-thirds of the U.S. economy, the gains more than offset weakness in housing, which remains buffeted by high home prices and mortgage rates

The [Atlanta Fed’s GDP tracker](#) now puts third-quarter growth at 3.9%, up from an earlier estimate of 3.3%, citing the consumption data and a narrower trade deficit in August.

Growth may not stop at that lofty rate. Stephen Brown, deputy chief North America economist at Capital Economics, said in a note on Friday that the income and spending data should further ease fears that the U.S. is on the cusp of a sharp slowdown.

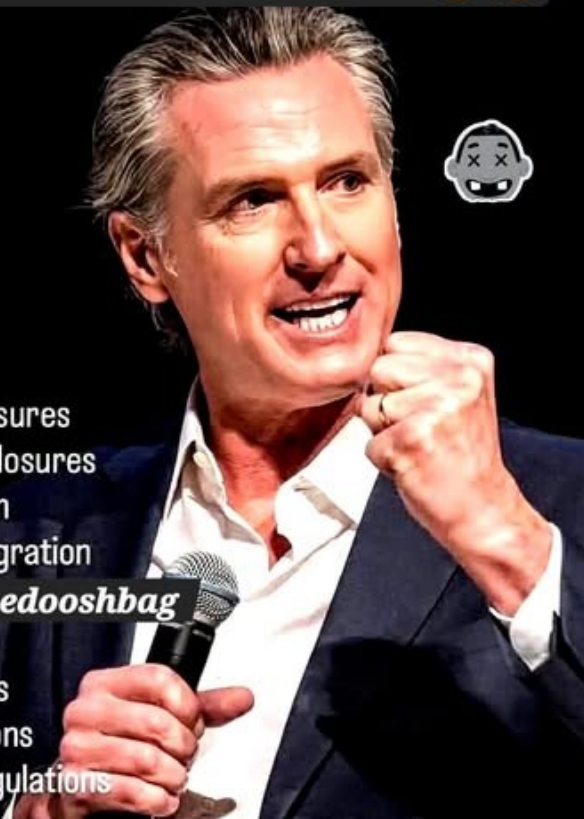

of nine counts related to mortgage fraud allegations. She pleaded guilty on Monday to 18 counts of conspiracy to commit wire fraud, mail fraud, and tax violations. The fraudster received the bare minimum sentence of 18 months after swindling thousands of dollars in donations to pay for her lavish personal expenses.

A Black Lives Matter fraudster who scammed donors out of thousands to fund her own extravagant lifestyle has been sentenced to just 18 months in prison. Monica Cannon-Grant (pictured) was federally charged alongside her husband, Clark Grant, in 2022 for 27 counts of 18 fraud-related crimes connected with her nonprofit.

The 44-year-old scammer agreed to a plea bargain in exchange for a dismissal

Cannon-Grant's husband was killed in a motorcycle crash in Easton, Massachusetts in March 2023. The couple operated the nonprofit Violence in Boston Inc. in 2017 with the stated purpose of 'improving the quality of life and outcomes of individuals from disenfranchised communities.' The nonprofit raised over \$1 million and received nearly \$60,000 in pandemic relief funds to provide meals for underprivileged people, according to the Boston Globe.

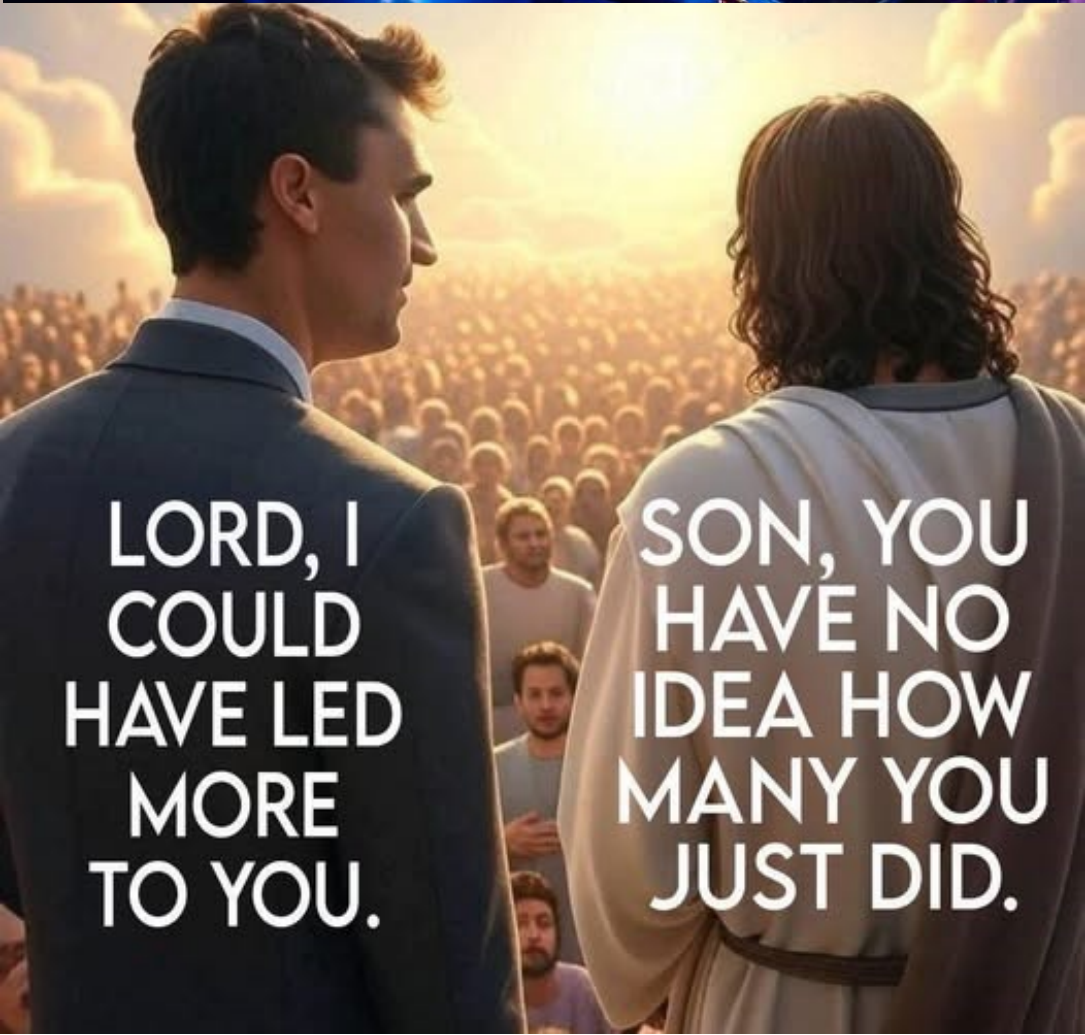

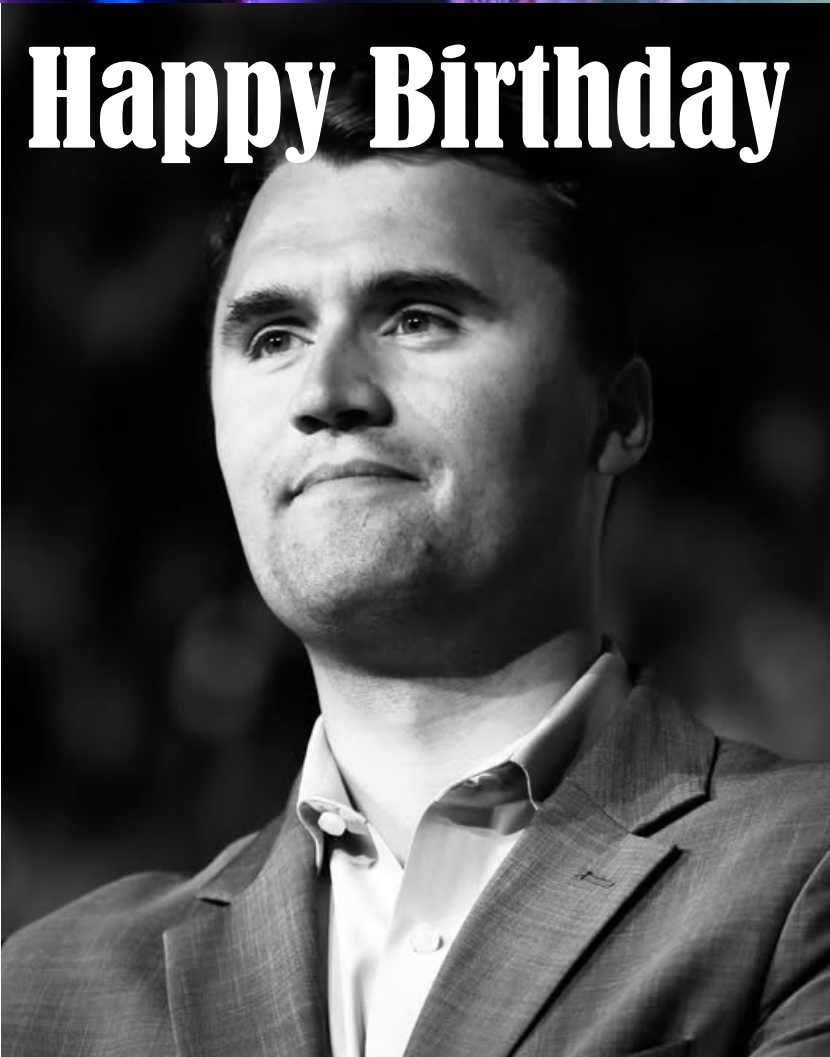

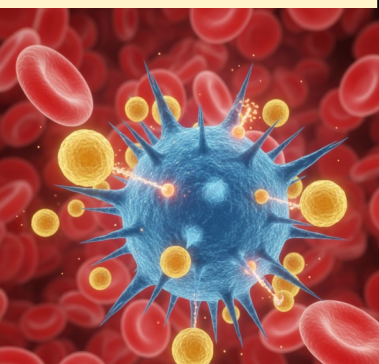

University of Florida Scientists Develop  
Groundbreaking mRNA Cancer Vaccine.

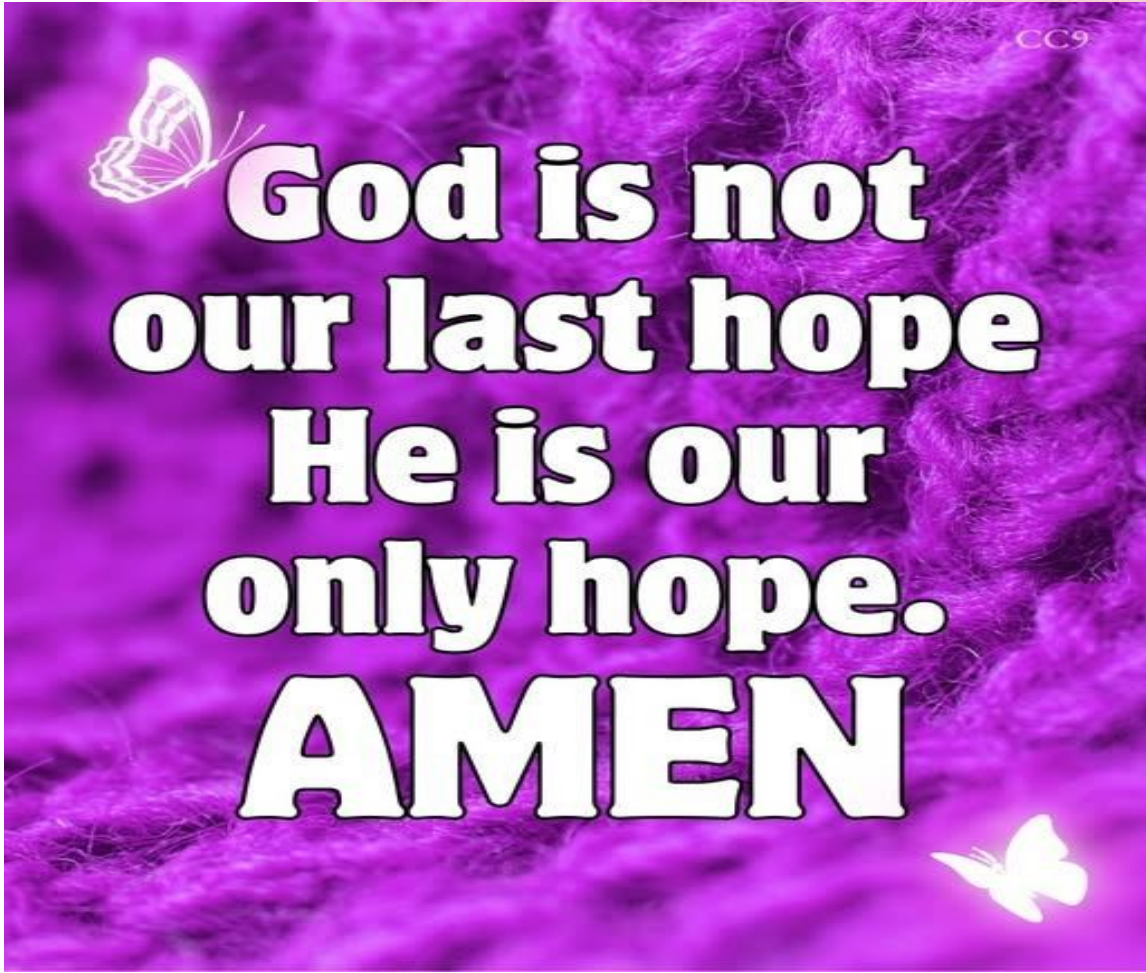
Scientists at the University of Florida have created an mRNA cancer vaccine that could revolutionize cancer treatment. Unlike chemotherapy, this vaccine trains the immune system to recognize and destroy cancer cells without harmful side effects.

The vaccine activates the body's natural defenses, triggering immune responses to attack multiple tumor areas simultaneously. It also forces cancer cells to expose themselves by producing a protein, PD-L1, that alerts the immune system to their presence.

In preclinical trials on mice, the vaccine not only eliminated tough tumors but also prevented them from returning. If successful in human trials, this vaccine could offer a universal treatment for various cancer types, transforming the future of cancer therapy.

## Terry Savage: Setting priorities in light of the coming hard times

*“consumer spending is two-thirds of the economy, and it’s going strong.”* Consumers are about to hit a wall — and so is the economy.



Setting priorities is a luxury, whether you’re talking about time or money. It means you have choices about what to do or what to buy or what bill to pay first. Your choices might involve personal preferences.

Making responsible decisions involves tradeoffs, assuming you’re not in a position to have everything and do everything all at the same time.

But what happens when you can’t possibly do both important things? When you can’t be in two places at once? Or, even worse, when you can’t stretch your money to pay all your bills, much less set some aside for savings?

Millions of Americans are in that position these days. They’ve charged up their credit card balances and they can barely afford the minimum monthly payments. They are caught up in the “buy now, pay later” — aka, BNPL —syndrome, but now all of those “four easy payments” are coming due.

Since the industry gives few public tallies of outstanding balances on these plans, it’s hard to calculate the



snowball of BNPL debt. But several of those companies have sold stock to the public in recent weeks — and their stock prices soared.

Nearly 87 million U.S. consumers used BNPL services in 2024. And U.S. BNPL purchase volume in 2025 is estimated at about \$122 billion to \$175 billion, a year-over-year increase of more than 10%. That’s roughly 20% of the amount outstanding on credit cards. The snowball of debt is about to become an avalanche.

## A top economist has a simple fix for America's housing crisis

- A study from Moody's highlights the impact of the capital gains tax on the US housing market.
- Economists Mark Zandi and Cristian deRitis see it as an obstacle to unlocking more inventory.
- They say reforming capital gains tax for home sales could thaw a frozen housing market.

The latest data show that the US housing market may finally be starting to thaw, yet there's a simple reform that could be a lasting answer to America's long-running issue of housing supply.

Moody's economist Mark Zandi has issued a lot of stern warnings about the state of the US

economy lately, and now he's turning his attention to housing. In a paper published with fellow economist Cristian deRitis this month, he laid out why the capital gains tax on home sales is keeping throttling the supply of homes for sale, exacerbating the supply-demand imbalance that's been growing for years.

Zandi and deRitis' analysis centers on the market mismatch that the **capital gains tax** has caused, forcing older Americans to remain in their homes despite their desire to downsize.

*"For long-tenured homeowners, capital gains taxation creates transaction costs that can easily exceed \$100,000 on modest properties in high-appreciation markets,"* they said.

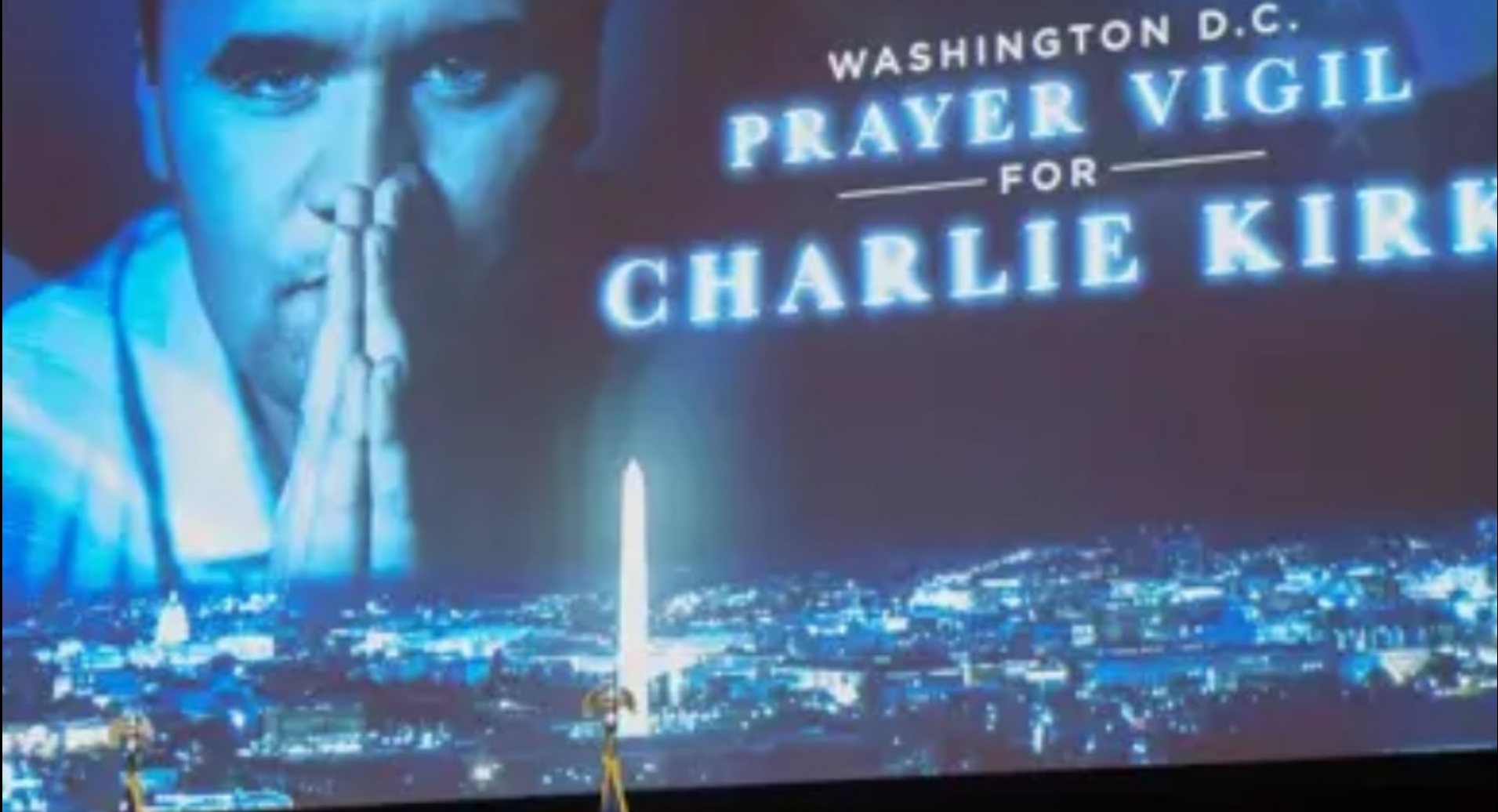

# Conservatives learned the wrong lesson from Charlie Kirk's murder

Conservatives aren't learning the right lesson from Charlie Kirk's assassination.

That's my conclusion after watching Kirk's funeral service on Sunday. It was a moving event, a powerful tribute to a young conservative who inspired millions of people with American ideals. If there was a common thread among the many speakers, it was that conservatives must do as Charlie did, and redouble our commitment to open, honest, and respectful debate.

But that's not the most important thing. It's even more essential that conservatives redouble our commitment to reclaiming the commanding heights of American culture. Why? **Because the Left has corrupted our culture to such an extent that it cost Charlie Kirk his life.**

**Don't get me wrong:** Conservatives should absolutely engage in debate. We have the benefit of believing the right things. Freedom. Family. Faith in God and

in America. Our ideas are inherently better than the Left's. All they have is faith in the power of government — and it's diametrically opposed to individual freedom and family life. In a fair debate, conservatives win.

**But we don't have a fair debate — not even close.** To the contrary, the deck is so far stacked against conservatives that we have little chance of winning in the public square.

Every conservative knows this deep down. We know the Left controls the levers of cultural power and influence. This was true when I was growing up in ...

the 1970s, and it's even more true today. The legacy media is uniformly controlled by leftists. Higher education is proof that while the Soviet Union fell, communism won. Ditto K-12 education. And going back decades — even under Republican administrations — the vast apparatus of the federal government has steadily advanced a far-left

line. This is the truth that conservatives must learn — now more than ever. The good news is that some on the right are waking up. Trump is shredding leftist control in parts of D.C., while a growing number of conservatives are investing in institutions such as movie studios, new universities and education models, and media outlets and social media. But as exciting as Elon Musk's purchase of Twitter was, the truth is that conservatives need orders of magnitude more action and investment.

## ICE Arrest Ends in Deadly Shooting

**U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)** officers conducted an arrest operation targeting Silverio Villegas-Gonzales, which ended in his death after an altercation. According to authorities, Villegas-Gonzales allegedly dragged an ICE officer with his vehicle, prompting the officer to discharge his firearm.

The incident has sparked debate, with officials stressing the priority of public and officer safety, while community advocates have condemned the use of lethal force and demanded greater transparency. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has launched an internal review of the incident, and local authorities are cooperating with federal investigators to ensure a thorough examination of the events.

ICE reported that the incident escalated when Villegas-Gonzales allegedly attempted to drive into the arrest team, an action that may constitute violations of federal and state laws.
