

When Oakes went to talk to Morgan about harassing the Native child over the missing horses, Morgan armed. Morgan claimed he feared for his life and that Oakes had threatened to kill him. Morgan was charged with voluntary manslaughter, but was acquitted by an all-white jury who agreed with his story that he had acted in self-defense. To this day, this decision is controversial; there is evidence that the jury was motivated by racial bias.

The 20 Oldest American Indian Reservations In The U.S. You Should Know About

1. Brotherton Reservation, New Jersey — 1758

The Treaty of Easton in 1758 established what many historians consider the first official Indian reservation in what would become the United States. Created as a community called Brotherton (also known as Edgepillock or Indian Mills) in Burlington County, New Jersey, this reservation was intended as a place where Lenape (Delaware) converts could live under Quaker missionary supervision. The community flourished briefly but declined by the early 1800s as residents moved west or integrated into surrounding communities, leaving behind an important but often overlooked chapter in early American-Indian relations.

5. Allegany Reservation, New York — 1797

The Treaty of Big Tree in 1797 carved out several small Seneca reservations, including Allegany, from the tribe's much larger original territory in western New York. This treaty represented a devastating land loss for the Seneca Nation, reducing their holdings from millions of acres to just a few small parcels.

10. Cherokee Nation, Oklahoma — 1838 (Post-Removal)

Following the controversial Treaty of New Echota in 1835 and the devastating Trail of Tears in 1838, the Cherokee people re-established their nation in Indian Territory (present-day Oklahoma). The forced removal from their ancestral homelands in the Southeast resulted in thousands of deaths, but the Cherokee demonstrated remarkable resilience in rebuilding their government schools, and communities.

15. Standing Rock Reservation, North Dakota/South Dakota — 1868

Standing Rock Reservation traces its origins to the landmark Fort Laramie Treaty of 1868, which established the Great Sioux Reservation covering much of present-day South Dakota and parts of surrounding states. Later federal actions carved Standing Rock out of this larger territory, creating a reservation that spans the North Dakota-South Dakota border along the Missouri River.

20. Southern Ute Reservation, Colorado — 1873

The Southern Ute Reservation emerged from the complex web of treaties signed in 1868, which initially created a massive reservation covering much of western Colorado. The Brunot Agreement of 1873 dramatically reduced these original boundaries, forcing the Ute people onto a much smaller territory in southwestern Colorado.

This allowed for the corn to give structure for the beans to climb, the beans provided nitrogen for the soil, and the squash helped prevent weeds from growing. This group of crops is known as the "Three Sisters."



California Republicans are now pushing a proposal to split the state into two. While that will obviously never happen, it does highlight just how untenable the political situation in California has become under Democratic single-party rule.

Kavanaugh warns judges are 'not appointed to make' immigration policy decisions

Justice Brett Kavanaugh warned judges Monday (Sept. 8, 2025) that the role of the judiciary in immigration legal disputes is not to set policy, sending the **Supreme Court's** latest warning to lower courts via its emergency docket.

Kavanaugh's comments came in a concurrence of a 6-**3 order** lifting restrictions that a federal district court in Califorplaced on federal authorities' ability to conduct immigration operations in the Los Angeles area. The justice told lower-court judges that their role is only to ensure immigration policies and procedures are lawful and constitutional, rather than to weigh in with their own preferred policies.

"Especially in an immigration case like this one, it is also important to stress the proper role of the Judiciary," Kavanaugh wrote. "The Judiciary does not set immigration policy or decide" enforcement priorities. It should come as no surprise that some Administrations may be more laissez-faire in enforcing immigration law, and other Administrations more strict."

"Article III judges may have views on which policy approach is better or fairer. But judges are not appointed to make those policy calls. We merely ensure, in justiciable cases, that the Executive Branch acts within the confines of the Constitution and federal statutes."

Kavanaugh pointed to the high court as an example of staying within its "constitutionally assigned role" in a pair of rulings: in 2023's United States v. Texas and 2022's Biden v. Texas, both during the Biden administration, which deferred immigration policy to the executive branch rather than allowing for courts to





In 1992, the Houston Astros sat on top of the baseball world with the first overall pick in the MLB draft. Their decision would ripple through history, but not in the way they hoped. Hal Newhouser, a Hall of Fame pitcher who had turned to scouting, couldn't stop talking about one kid from Kalamazoo, Michigan -Derek Jeter.

He saw something in him others didn't. Smooth hands, a presence beyond his years, a natural leader in the making. Newhouser practically begged the Astros' front office to take the shortstop. But fear got in the way. The Astros worried Jeter would demand a milliondollar bonus to skip college, so they passed. Instead, they signed Phil Nevin for \$700,000.

Newhouser was so furious, so heartbroken by the short-sightedness of the decision, that he quit his job in protest. Imagine believing in a young man's destiny so strongly that you'd walk away from the career you built just because no one else could see what you saw. That was Jeter. Even before he played a single game in the majors, he was inspiring conviction.

Meanwhile, the Yankees sat further down the draft board with the sixth pick. Their scout, Dick Groch, had watched Jeter at an all-star camp in Michigan. The organization hesitated,

worried Jeter would opt for college ball instead of signing. But Groch silenced the doubts with one of the most legendary lines in scouting history: "The only place Derek Jeter's going is Cooperstown." And just like that, Jeter became a Yankee for \$800,000 a bargain price for a future icon.

But the road wasn't glamorous. It was punishing.

Jeter's professional debut in rookie ball with the Gulf Coast Yankees was a nightmare. He went 0-for-7 at the plate with five strikeouts. His batting average over Pettitte - who would one day become Jeter's broththat season sunk to .202, flirting dangerously with the ers in pinstripes - looked at this skinny 156-pound Mendoza Line. It was so bad that his manager kid and wondered if the hype was just that: hype. benched him on the final day just to keep his num-

bers from looking even worse. He was homesick too, racking up \$400 phone bills just to hear his parents' voices. The kid who was supposed to be the Yankees' future looked fragile, raw, and very far away from Yankee Stadium.

Still, the organization pushed him forward to Greensboro in Class A. There, he hit just .247 in his first stretch of games and piled up nine errors in only 48 chances. Teammates like Jorge Posada and Andy But Jeter refused to quit. That offseason, he worked obsessively on his defense. By 1993, he began to turn heads. He hit .295 with five homers, 71 RBIs, and 18 stolen bases. Managers across the South Atlantic League voted him "Most Outstanding Major League Prospect." He piled up triples, hits, and confidence. Yet, even in success, his imperfections showed - 56 errors, a league record. But rather than labeling him a liability, Baseball America called him the "Best Defensive Shortstop," "Most Exciting Player," and owner of the "Best Infield Arm." It was clear now: the errors weren't signs of weakness, but of a player daring to reach further than most could dream.\

By 1994, Jeter was climbing fast. He tore through three levels of the minors, hitting .344, stealing 50 bases, and scooping up every "Minor League Player of the Year" award in sight. The whispers became a chorus — the Yankees had a star in the making.

Heading into 1995, Baseball America ranked him as the fourth-best prospect in all of baseball. The Yankees envisioned him as their starting shortstop. But fate, as it often does, tested him again. A shoulder injury slowed him down, and the Yankees signed Tony Fernández to hold the position. For now, Jeter had to wait in Triple-A.

Even when the 1994-95 MLB strike left the game in limbo, Jeter stayed true to his principles. He refused to cross the picket line as a replacement player, choosing patience and loyalty over an easy break. That decision said as much about his character as any stat line could.

Looking back, it's almost surreal. The Astros' fear cost them a dynasty-altering player. The Yankees' gamble gave them a captain. And Derek Jeter, once a homesick teenager striking out in rookie ball, was quietly writing the first chapters of a story that would end, just as Groch predicted, in Cooperstown.

Roy Jones Jr. was only 19 years old when he stepped into the ring at the 1988 Olympics in Seoul, South Korea. He fought with courage, speed, and heart, landing nearly three times as many punches as his opponent Park Si-hun of South Korea. The whole world could see who had won, but the judges stunned everyone by giving the gold medal to Park. Roy walked away with silver, but he carried the pain of that unfair loss for the next 35 years.

Decades later, something incredible happened. Park Si-hun traveled thousands of miles from South Korea to Roy's gym in Florida. He handed Roy the gold medal and said through a translator, "This medal belongs to you." As Roy held the medal that had once been denied to him for so long, his eyes filled with tears.

The two men shared a moment that was bigger than boxing and bigger than the gold medal. It was about truth, respect, and humility.
